- **What's Next:** Illinois closes out its 2019-20 home schedule, playing host to the Michigan State Spartans on Wednesday (Feb. 26) evening at State Farm Center. Tipoff is set for 7 p.m. CT.
- **Last Time Out:** Illinois surrendered 56 first-half points as Nebraska connected on 11 of 16 first-half three-point attempts en route to an 80-58 victory on Saturday (Feb. 22) at Pinnacle Bank Arena in Lincoln, Neb. The Fighting Illini regrouped after halftime, outscoring the Huskers on the third and fourth quarters, but were unable to overcome the 29-point halftime deficit. Sophomore forward **Kennedi Myles** (10 points, 12 rebounds) recorded her seventh double-double of the season to set a program freshman record. Senior guard **Brandi Beasley** led the Illini in scoring for the second-consecutive game, finishing with 13 points, including a pair of three-pointers. Senior guard Cierra Rice also knocked down a pair of threes to notch her second double-figures scoring game of the season with 10 points, all in the first half.
- **Take It To The Holešinská:** Redshirt junior **Petra Holešinská** leads Illinois and ranks 15th in the Big Ten in scoring at 13.5 points per game, thanks in part to a .431 three-point shooting percentage that sits third in the Big Ten and 18th in the NCAA. She also sits in a tie for second in the conference knocking down 2.6 three-pointers per game. She returned with a bang in the 2019-20 season opener, leading the team with a career-high 29 points on 9-for-16 shooting and five three-pointers. Her five treys matched her previous career-best, and her nine field goals set a new career mark as well. Holešinská's 29 points are the most for an Illini in a season opener in the 21st century.
- **"Myles" Beyond:** Illinois freshman **Kennedi Myles** ranks tied for fourth in the Big Ten with 8.6 rebounds per game, seventh among all Division I freshmen, while also sitting fifth in the conference with 2.0 steals per game. Her seven double-doubles set an Illinois freshman record, established with a 10-point, 12-rebound showing at Nebraska. The rookie also set an Illinois freshman record with 20 rebounds in a win over Evansville, passing a mark that had stood since 1976.
- **Dialing Long Distance:** Holešinská has knocked down 69 three-pointers this season and ranks tied for second in the conference at 2.6 per game. Her 159 career treys rank fifth all-time in program history just behind Mandy Cunningham (1990-94) who hit 168 in her Illini career. Senior **Ali Andrews'** 149 career three-pointers sit just behind Holešinská in a sixth-place tie Kyle Simmons (2015-16).
- **Terry Takin' Care:** Freshman Jeanae Terry leads the Illini with 86 assists on the season for an average of 3.2 assists per game. With only 46 turnovers on the season, she also paces the team with an assist-to-turnover ratio of 1.87, good for sixth in the Big Ten and 77th nationally.
- **Freshmen Making an Impact:** Illinois welcomed three true freshmen to the 2019-20 squad in **Kennedi Myles**, **Jada Peebles**, and **Jeanae Terry**. The three have been immediate contributors, accounting for 31% of the Illini's points, 37% of their rebounds, 44% of the team's assists, 49% of steals and 49% of blocks.
- **Beasley's Marks:** Senior guard Brandi Beasley ranks among the Illinois career leaders in both scoring (1,353; 17th) and assists (431; 4th). At her current scoring average of 8.4 ppg, and with at least three games remaining on the Illini schedule, she is on pace to finish just ahead of Kris Dupps (1,373 from 1991-95) in 16th, and needs 21 more assists to pass Lacey Simpson (351; 2005-10) for third on the career charts.
- **Persistence of Panagiotopoulou:** After battling through injury for her first 2+ seasons at Illinois, redshirt-sophomore **Nancy Panagiotopoulou** made her Illini debut against No. 20 Maryland on Jan. 23, posting four points on 2-of-2 shooting and four rebounds in 10 minutes of action. Panagiotopoulou has seen action in five of nine games since her debut and has knocked down 4-of-5 FG attempts.
- **Hot Start in 2019-20:** Illinois finished off the non-conference portion of their schedule with a 9-2 record, marking the best 11-game start for Illinois since the 2006-07 season. The non-conference was capped by a 58-51 Braggins' Rights win on December 20 in Columbia, marking the first win over the Tigers since the 2008 season.
- **One of the Greats:** Illinois head coach Nancy Fahey is in the midst of quite the storied career. She has accumulated 767 career victories, a number that ranks among the top totals in the NCAA. Her win total currently checks in at No. 20 among all NCAA head coaches, a category that's led by Pat Summitt (1098). Fahey's 767 career victories also rank ninth among current active NCAA Division I head coaches and 12th among all active NCAA head coaches. She has racked up the third-most career victories among active Big Ten head coaches as well. Of active head coaches with more than 700 victories, Fahey's .812 winning percentage entering this season ranked second only to Geno Auriemma (.884) and tied Stanford head coach Tara VanDerveer who boasted a 1067-247 career record heading into the 2019-20 campaign.

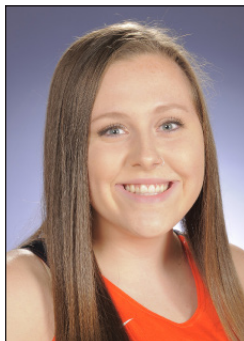
