DANIEL RIBEIRO

HEAD COACH // 2ND SEASON (11TH ON ILLINOIS STAFF)

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Daniel Ribeiro enters his second season as the head coach of the Fighting Illini men's gymnastics program going into the 2024 season.

In his first season as head coach, Ribeiro led the Illini to a third-place finish at the NCAA Tournament where nine Illini earned All-American status at the 2023 NCAA National Championships. Of the nine, Ashton Anaya still rings and Ian Skirkey (pommel horse) became national champions on their respective events.

Ribeiro takes over after spending the previous 11 years as an assistant coach, including seven seasons as the program's associate head coach under former head coach Justin Spring. Ribeiro earned National Assistant Coach of the Year and Central Region Coach of the Year honors in 2012 after helping lead the Illini to their first national championship since 1989 and fourth-consecutive Big Ten championship.

In the 11 seasons combined as an assistant and associate head coach, Ribeiro has helped oversee a program that has produced seven national champions, 70 All-Americans, 18 Big Ten Champions, two Big Ten Gymnasts of the Year, two Big Ten Freshmen of the Year and a Nissen-Emery award winner.

As a member of the Fighting Illini men's gymnastics team from 2008-11, Ribeiro won two NCAA titles on pommel horse (2009, 2011) and was a three-time captain, starting his sophomore year.

The Chestnut Ridge, N.Y., native is also a three-time Big Ten pommel horse champion, taking the conference crown in his freshman (2008), junior (2010) and senior (2011) seasons while earning first-team All-Big Ten accolades in each of those years as well.

Ribeiro's success was not limited to the collegiate stage, however, as the former All-American captured pommel horse gold at the 2010 U.S. Visa Championships between his junior and senior seasons.

Ribeiro also garnered academic honors during his time at Illinois, earning a spot on the Academic All-Big Ten list in 2010 and 2011 and achieving College Gymnastics Association All-America Scholar-Athlete status in 2010.

DON OSBORN

ASSISTANT COACH // 9TH SEASON

Don Osborn is entering his ninth season as the assistant coach for the men's gymnastics team, coming into the 2024 season. Osborn came back to Illinois after 20 years away and joined the team for the 2015-16 season.

Prior to coming back to the Illini, Osborn spent three years as the Champaign Gymnastics Academy boys' team coach and spent over a decade as the boys'

team coach at the Buffalo Grove Gymnastics Center as well. Osborn returned with experience coaching a multitude of gymnastics levels, including Junior Olympic National Team champions.

As the Illinois head coach from 1994-96, Osborn saw Illini gymnasts claim 12 Big Ten individual championships in addition to nine NCAA All-America accolades. He led the program to nearly 50 wins during his three years at the helm. The Indiana State University graduate also served as an assistant coach under Yoshi Hayasaki for eight seasons during which the Orange and Blue claimed a pair of Big Ten championships in addition to the 1989 NCAA National Championship team title.

To accompany his vast coaching experience, Osborn has also been a certified gymnastics judge since 1980.

TIM MCNEILL

ASSISTANT COACH // 1ST SEASON

Tim McNeill enters his second season as an assistant head coach for the Fighting Illini men's gymnastics program in the 2022-23 season. McNeill's hire was announced by interim head coach on Aug. 5, 2022.

In his first season at Illinois, McNeill helped guide the Illini to a third-place finish at the NCAA Tournament where Illinois had nine All-Americans, including two national champions.

Considered one of the most successful gymnasts in the history of Cal's program, McNeill earned All-American honors each of his four years as a Golden Bear from 2005-08. He captured the first of his school-record five NCAA individual championship titles as a sophomore when he won the pommel horse competition in 2006. He later claimed both the pommel horse and parallel bars titles at the NCAA Championships in both 2007 and 2008. At the end of his senior season, McNeill received the Pac-10 Medal as the most outstanding senior male student-athlete at Cal.

After graduating from Cal in 2008, McNeill spent the 2009 season as a graduate intern with the Bears before training full-time with the U.S. National team.

McNeill returned to his alma mater as Cal's head coach for three seasons from 2010-2013. As Cal's coach, McNeill was named the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation (MPSF) Coach of the Year in 2011. He guided the Bears to fourth-place NCAA finishes in both 2011 and 2012, with one individual pommel horse champion in 2012.

Four of his student-athletes became members of the U.S. National Team, two became members of the Filipino National Team, and one became a member of the Swiss National Team, all under his tutelage. McNeill went on to coach at the Olympic Trials in 2012, and he was chosen by USA Gymnastics to coach the U.S. delegation at the 2012 World Cup competition in Croatia.

Prior to his time at Cal, McNeill competed in three Junior Olympic National Championships in 2000, 2002 and 2004. In 2000, McNeill placed third on parallel bars, and in 2002 he finished fourth on pommel horse. In 2004 he broke through for a first-place finish on pommel horse, while also capturing third in all-around and fourth in the parallel and high bar competitions.

A fixture on the U.S. Senior National team from 2006-11, McNeill boasts an impressive resume on the international stage. He won his first international medal in 2010 when he placed third on parallel bars at the Moscow World Cup. Other highlights include competing in the finals of the 2008 Olympic Trials, winning pommel horse at the 2009 Winter Cup Challenge, and taking home the parallel bars title and finishing second in the all-around at the 2009 VISA Championships. McNeill earned a place on the U.S. team for the 2009 World Championships where he placed fifth on pommel and seventh in the all-around. In 2010, he was voted as the U.S. Gymnast of the Year.

Aside from gymnastics, McNeill is a voice in the community for mental health. He interned at both an HIV clinic, and a residential substance abuse facility. He also spent time as a mental health counselor at a substance abuse facility for adolescent boys. Later, McNeill opened his own private practice, helping adolescents and adults with mental health and substance abuse issues, while also providing sports guidance to help athletes perform at their highest potential.

FACILITIES

HUFF HALL

Huff Hall is a versatile, multi-use facility that serves as the home for the Illini men's and women's gymnastics and volleyball squads. It has a seating capacity of 3,800 for gymnastics meets. Huff Hall, once the longtime home of the Illinois State High School Association state basketball tournament, is known for creating the circus-like atmosphere that fostered the term "March Madness." This historical building on the U of I campus continues to make lasting memories in the hearts of all Fighting Illini fans.

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Illinois athletics enjoy a proud tradition in Huff Hall. Huff served as the host venue for the 2009 Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships and previously served as host for the 1991, 1995 and 2003 Big Ten Women's Gymnastics Championships. The historic building also hosted the 1992, 1995, 2004 and 2011 Big Ten Men's Gymnastics Championships, and was the site of the 1993 and 1999 NCAA Men's Gymnastics East Regional. It has also been the site of a 1994 NCAA first-round volleyball match, a 1995 NCAA second-round volleyball match, the first and second rounds of the 1997 NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament and the first and second rounds of the 1998, 2001, 2008-11, 2013 and 2014 NCAA Volleyball Tournaments.

Huff Hall is named for longtime Illinois athletic director and coach George Huff. Huff was Illinois' athletic director from 1901 to 1935, during a time in which Fighting Illini athletic programs enjoyed unparalleled success. Huff was the driving force behind the construction of Memorial Stadium. He also served as football coach from 1895 to 1899, and baseball skipper from 1896 to 1919. Known by many of his close friends and business associates as "G," Huff served as manager of the Boston Red Sox in 1907.

Huff Hall contains two volleyball practice courts and the volleyball game facility, as well as four basketball courts and a main court. In addition, the building contains spacious locker and squad rooms which were completely renovated in 2004.

Huff Hall also houses a weight room, equipment rooms, locker rooms, a training room, a wrestling room and one squash court, as well as many offices and classrooms. In 2004, Huff received several enhancements with the renovation of its training room and weight room. Within the last decade, Illinois has made multiple improvements to Huff Hall with the addition of a new scoreboard and video board a new sound system, new bleachers and new lighting.



FACILITIES

KENNEY GYM

Historic Kenney Gym, one of the university's oldest and most revered buildings, houses a unique training atmosphere and represents nearly a century of exercise tradition at the University of Illinois.

The upper level of Kenney Gym houses the Illinois gymnastics workout facilities. In this extensive facility, both the men's and women's gymnastics teams practice in a harmonious environment.

Kenney Gym accommodates Illinois gymnasts with its large variety of FIG specification equipment. Women's equipment includes four balance beams, two sets of ELITE uneven bars, two vaulting horses, a Palmer spring floor and a 40-foot long Tumble Trak. The historic building also features a weight room, running track, locker facilities and basketball and volleyball courts.

Named after former wrestling coach H.E. Kenney, Kenney Gym has long been a focus of innovative techniques and equipment in gymnastics training. The world's first foam-lined, in-ground "pit," developed for added safety in the instruction of tumbling and vaulting, was built here in 1963 and updated in 2016. In the summer of 2016, Kenney Gym underwent a renovation that improved training capabilities, especially on vault and floor. The addition of the brand new foam pit, along with a "makeover" has greatly enhanced the ability to utilize more gym space on all events.

2023 SEASON REVIEW

The 2023 season came to a close with a third-place finish at the NCAA Championships, pushing the Illini to a 17-11 overall record.

The Best in the Windy City

Illinois took home the first place trophy at the Windy City Invitational for the first time in four years after record breaking performances and was the first victory of newly appointed head coach Daniel Ribeiro's tenure. Amari Sewell started the night off strong for the Orange and Blue, beating his career high in vault with a 14.700, tying for first place and earning his first title as an Illini. Fletcher kept his momentum going into parallel bars, scoring a 13.750. Manivong snagged a 13.850 on high bar and beat his career-high. Connor McCool won the title for floor exercise with a 14.300. Ian Skirkey was the top scorer on pommel horse, attaining a 13.750. Ethan Boder was Illinois' top score on still rings with a 13.650.

Senior Night Knockout

The Illini dominated the last home meet in Huff Hall with their highest regular-season team score (411.550) against Nebraska. This was the first time the Illini have beaten a Big Ten opponent at home by 16 points since 1989 when Illinois defeated Michigan State 273.80-251.45, when the sport used a different scoring system. The win sealed an undefeated home record (3-0) for the first time since 2020 when they went 5-0. Connor McCool, secured a 14.600 on floor with Ian Skirkey grabbing a 14.750 on pommel horse. Ashton Anaya scored 14.300 on still rings with Amari Sewell securing a new career-high on vault, 14.800, marking the fourth career-high he broke in 2023. David Pochinka scored a 14.300 on parallel bars. The Illini scored a season-high 68.800 team score on the apparatus as well. Pochinka also tallied a 13.600 on high bar.

Make That Three

For the first time since the 2017 season, Illinois had three Big Ten Champions at the 2023 Big Ten Championships. Connor McCool took the title on floor exercise, followed by Ian Skirkey on pommel horse and Ashton Anaya on still rings. McCool had a near perfect routine on floor to score a 14.725. McCool became the first floor exercise Big Ten event winner since C.J. Maestas in 2015. Skirkey blew away the competition on pommel horse with a 14.80 and became Illinois' first horse conference event winner since Brandon Ngai in 2017. Max Farkhatau also earned second-team All-Big Ten honors after finishing third with a 13.825. Anaya captured a 14.475 on still rings and became the Big Ten still rings champion for the second straight season. The Illini had three qualifiers on vault with Evan Manivong scoring a 14.60, placing fourth. Amari Sewel scored a 14.425 placing sixth and Michael Fletcher took seventh-place with a 14.40. David Pochinka was the only Illini representative on parallel bars, placing third with a score of 14.225, also earning him second-team All-Big Ten.

Great End to a Great Season

Illinois finished the season on a high note when Ian Skirkey (pommel horse) and sophomore Ashton Anaya (still rings) both were named national champions at the NCAA Championships and nine All-Americans. This was the first time since 2012 Illinois has two national champions when C.J. Maestas won the still rings title and Paul Ruggeri won the vault title. This is also Skirkey's second time winning the pommel horse national title, the first being in 2021. The Illini also secured third place for the first time since 2018 with an impressive score of 415.590. Anaya secured his trophy with a 14.800 with Josh Cook also having a notable score with a 13.700 and Michael Fletcher scoring a 13.500. Amari Sewell not only broke his career-high with a 14.866 on vault, but earned fourth place in the event. David Pochinka scored a 14.566 on parallel bars and placed fourth while Will Hauke scored a 14.366 and earned eighth. McCool earned his All-America honor with seventh-place 14.533 floor performance. Skirkey scored a 15.133 to capture his second national title. Sebastian Ingersoll, who only competed twice this season, secured a 13.966, good enough for fourth place. Max Farkhatau was right behind his teammate, scoring a 13.833 and securing fifth place. Fletcher also competed in the all-around and scored a 81.331 for seventh place. The nine All-Americans is the most top-eight finishers Illinois has received since 2014, when the Illini secured 10.

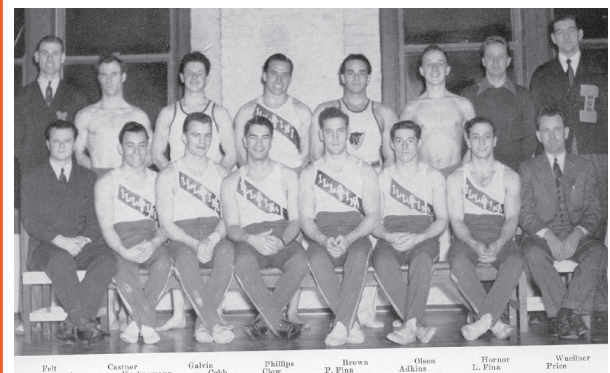
