THE GAME: FIU continues its eight-game road slate with a trip across the state of Florida to Fort Myers to take on Florida Gulf Coast. This will mark the seventh time these two schools have faced off, as the series is split dead even at three games apiece. Last season, FIU earned a 72-61 victory over the Eagles on Lime Court at FIU Arena. Senior Dennis Mavin was one of three players who scored in double figures in that game, scoring 19 points to go along with four rebounds.

vs. THE A-SUN: FIU has had plenty of success vs. Atlantic Sun teams, hoisting a 24-10 record against those opponents. In fact, the Panthers have won five of the last six games against A-Sun opponents and six of the last eight. Through three games against teams from the A-Sun this season, the Panthers are 2-1, most recently earning a 59-38 victory over Kennesaw State on Dec. 2. FIU's other win over an A-Sun team came in a one-point, 53-52 victory at Stetson on Nov. 18. Last season, FIU picked up three wins over Florida Gulf Coast, Stetson and Kennesaw State to go a perfect 3-0 against the conference. This year, the Panthers' schedule features four teams from the A-Sun including Stetson (11/18), USC Upstate (11/27), Kennesaw State (12/2) and Florida Gulf Coast (12/14).

vs. NON-CON: Coming off an 82-57 defeat at Louisville on Dec. 5, the Panthers enter Sunday's contest against the Eagles with a 5-4 record in non-conference action. FIU went 8-7 in non-conference games last year, including a home-court win against Florida Gulf Coast (72-61 on Dec. 7, 2013) and a home-court loss to No. 6/4 Louisville (85-56 on Dec. 21, 2013). Of the seven losses, two resulted in five points or less and five came away from the friendly confines of Lime Court at FIU Arena. FIU picked up wins away from home at Kennesaw State, vs. Warren Wilson and at Bethune-Cookman. Three of FIU's non-conference losses came at South Carolina, vs. Louisville and at Georgetown.

FIU HOLDS KENNESAW STATE TO RECORD LOW 38 POINTS: In the 59-38 victory over Kennesaw State on Dec. 2, the Panthers' defense held Kennesaw State to 38 points (27 percent, 14-of-52), the lowest in program history for any FIU opponent. The last time FIU held a team to less than 40 points in a game was Florida College on Nov. 14, 2013, when the Anthony Evans coached team held the Falcons to a then-opponent record low to 39 points. These two games are the only two instances in program history where FIU has held an opponent under 40 points in a game.

DRAPER DONS CAREER-HIGH IN WIN OVER OWLS: In the Dec. 2 win over Kennesaw State, junior Daviyon Draper had the best game of his career, scoring a career-high and game-high tying 16 points (7-of-13). The 16 points are the most in a Division I game for Draper. During his previous two seasons at Antelope Valley Community College, Draper did post a career-high 29 points at the junior college level.

STRONG DEFENSE LEADING THE WAY FOR FIU: A major point of emphasis in FIU's success this year has been its play on the defensive side to the ball. The Panthers have held their opponents to 60 points or less in five of nine games and over 70 points just twice in losses at Georgia State and Louisville. Through Dec. 10, FIU currently ranks first in Conference USA and 46th in the country in scoring defense, allowing 59.0 points-per-game. The Panthers have done an exceptional job at guarding the basket, holding opponents to just 38.7 percent shooting from the field, which ranks first in the conference and 68th nationally. Teams have found little success shooting from long-distance against FIU, as the Panthers are allowing opponents to shoot 25.3 percent from three-point range, good for second in C-USA and 13th in the country. FIU's 8.0 steals-per-game also currently sits first in the conference while ranking 63rd in Division I.

LOUISVILLE 82, FIU 57
December 5, 2014 • Louisville, Ky.
 FIU fell to the No. 5/5 Louisville Cardinals, 82-57, at the KFC YUM! Center. The Cardinals shot a season-high 57.1 percent from the field to help secure the victory and improve to 7-0 on the season. Leading the way for FIU was senior Dennis Mavin, who connected on seven field goals to score 15 points while grabbing three rebounds in 31 minutes of action. Senior Marco Porcher Jimenez scored 13 points off the bench and made his first four three-point attempts. Porcher-Jimenez also connected on a four-point play late in the game. Junior Tashawn Desir matched his career-high in assists with seven, while tallying seven points and grabbing two steals. FIU jumped out to a good start and had a lead for the 8:15 of the game. The Panthers shot 37 percent from the field while turning the ball over 25 times.

SCOUTING FLORIDA GULF COAST: The Eagles enter Sunday's contest with an 8-1 overall record and are ranked 12th in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 Poll. Off to its best start in Division-I program history, FGCU is coming off an 84-75 victory at Massachusetts on Dec. 7. Ranked 31st in the latest NCAA RPI, the Eagles suffered their only loss vs. Green Bay on Nov. 26. Scoring is a strength for this squad, as five players are averaging double-figures heading into Sunday's game. Leading the way for FGCU is Bernard Thompson, who is averaging 16.0 points-per-game to go along with 3.9 rebounds. Jamail Jones is averaging 11.8 points and 5.8 rebounds, while Marc-Eddy Norelia has tabbed 11.0 points-per-game to go along with a team-high 8.0 rebounds. Brett Comer has tallied 72 assists this year for FGCU, as he averages eight per-game. As a team, the Eagles are averaging 68.9 points-per-game on offense while allowing an average of 58.7 points.

LAST TIME vs Florida Gulf Coast in Miami, W, 72-61 on Dec. 21, 2013

In front of a packed house and a national television audience FIU routed FGCU, 72-61, from Lime Court at U.S. Century Bank Arena. Rakeem Buckles notched his sixth double-double of the season and the ninth of his career, finishing with 11 points, on 4-of-13 shooting, while going 2-for-2 from the line. Dennis Mavin scored a career-high-tying 19 points on 7-of-15 shooting, while hitting five of his seven shots from the line. Tymmell Murphy had a game-high 23 points, while going 10-for-10 from the charity stripe. The Panthers finished the night shooting 45 percent (23-of-51) and hit 88 percent of its free-throw attempts (22-of-25). FIU's biggest lead of the game was 11 points in a game that saw five lead changes. FIU edged FGCU on the boards, 37-33, while both teams had three blocks apiece.

OUTLET PASSES (PLAYERS)

■ **DENNIS MAVIN** has been FIU's biggest scoring threat through the first nine games of the season, averaging 16.3 points-per-game and scoring at least 15 points in seven of nine contests, as he is second in C-USA in scoring. Dating back to last season, he has scored in double-figures in nine of his last 10 games.

■ Mavin posted back-to-back 20-point games for the Panthers, netting 24 versus Wright State (11/28) and 22 against Cal State Fullerton (11/29). His 24 tallies against Wright State matched his career-high.

■ Mavin put up a 17-point and 10-rebound effort against Florida College on Nov. 14, marking his first career double-double. The 10 rebounds for Mavin were a career-high.

■ Redshirt junior **ADRIAN DIAZ** has made an immediate impact through his nine seven games in an FIU uniform. He currently ranks seventh in C-USA in rebounding (7.2), 3rd in C-USA in blocked shots and 37th nationally (2.2) and his 4.3 offensive rebounds-per-game rank ninth in the nation.

■ Diaz posted a career-high 33-point scoring effort at Georgia Southern. Diaz' 33 points in a game rank tied for seventh in program history and it was the most points for an FIU player in a single game since DeJuan Wright netted 35 points versus South Alabama on Feb. 25, 2012.

■ Diaz tallied the first double-double of his career versus Florida Memorial on Nov. 21 at FIU Arena. He scored 10 points and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds.

■ Diaz is in his first eligible season with the Panthers, after sitting out last season due to NCAA transfer rules. A native of Miami, Diaz played his previous two seasons of college ball at Kansas State.

■ Senior **MARCO PORCHER JIMENEZ** is coming off a 13-point game where he hit four treys at Louisville, including a four-point play. Porcher Jimenez led FIU in three-pointers made last season, draining 40 treys and shooting 35.1 percent from beyond the arc last season.

■ Sophomore **JASON BOSWELL** made his return to the Court for the Panthers on Nov. 24 at Georgia Southern after missing the first three games due to injury. The Bronx native has started at point guard in three of the last four games. Bringing a 6-6 frame to the Panther backcourt, Boswell was exceptional from the free-throw line last season, as he set the school record for most consecutive made shots from the charity stripe (27).

■ **RAY RODRIGUEZ** enter's Sunday's contest having made at least one three in four of eight games played to start the season. Rodriguez, a Miami native, comes to FIU after spending the 2012-13 season with North Florida. There, he averaged 2.4 points-per-game and was 20-for-56 from three-point range.

■ Sophomore **DOMINIQUE WILLIAMS** was one of FIU's most consistent players off the bench through the first four games, that he earned a spot in the starting lineup on Thanksgiving Day and has not lost it since. He is second on the team behind Adrian Diaz in field goal percentage, hitting 27-of-52 shots for a clip of 52 percent.

■ A transfer from Long Beach State, senior **KRIS GULLEY** brings experience to the three and four-spot on the floor. During his junior season at LBSU, the Texas native averaged 15.3 minutes-per-contest, making four starts and averaging 3.3 points-per-contest. His first year of collegiate basketball was played at Independence Community College before heading to LBSU.

■ Junior **TASHAWN DESIR** has proven his ability at getting after the basketball through the first eight games this season, as he is averaging over one steal per game. Desir has been good at distributing the basketball as well, as his 3.7 steals currently ranks eighth in C-USA.

■ Desir comes to FIU after spending two seasons at Monroe Community College in Rochester, N.Y., where he was one of the more prolific point guards at the JuCo level. For the 2013-14 season, Desir was named a third team NJCAA All-American, the Basketball Coaches Association of New York Junior College Men's Player of the Year, the Region III Tournament MVP along with being a first team All-Region selection.

■ Another junior college transfer, junior **DAVIYON DRAPER** brings a 6-7, 217 pound frame to the forward position for FIU. Draper posted a career-high 16 points vs. Kennesaw State on Dec. 2. He spent his previous two seasons at Antelope Valley Community College, where he averaged 13.8 points last season.

■ Rounding out the junior college transfers for FIU is **MICHAEL PHILLIP**, a 6-9 center who spent his previous two seasons at Monroe College. A defensive standout at the position, Phillip tallied 48 blocked shots for the Mustangs last season.

■ FIU welcomes two freshmen to this year's squad, including **LARRY DENNIS** (Wichita, Kan.), **HASSAN HUSSEIN** (Lorton, Va.). Dennis made his first career-start against Wright State and has started the last three games at the four-spot for FIU.

OUTLET PASSES (TEAM)

■ With Anthony Evans' concentrated approach on defense, FIU currently is first in Conference USA and ranks 46th in the country in scoring defense, allowing 59.0 points-per-game. The Panthers are also first in the Conference in steals (8.0) and fourth in blocks (3.9).

■ The Panthers enter Sunday's contest with at least one made three in 185-straight games.

■ With its 74-48 victory over Florida Memorial on Nov. 21, FIU started the season 3-0 for the first time since the 2002-03 season.

■ As a team, FIU posted 21 assists on Nov. 14 in a 64-42 victory over Florida College, marking the most for the Panthers since getting 22 dimes vs. Florida College last season on Nov. 14, 2013.

■ On a roster that consists of 15 players, a total of eight players dressed in an FIU uniform for the first time on Nov. 14 vs. Florida College.

In-person interviews will take place, either in the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (FIU Arena Room 211) or after practice. Please contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department for ALL interview requests. Other accommodations can be arranged through the Athletic Media Relations Department.

COACHES AND STAFF INTERVIEWS

Interviews with Head Coach Anthony Evans must come through the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Interviews should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. No member of the FIU staff may be interviewed without permission by the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Personal numbers of both coaches and staff members will not be given out.

COVERING PRACTICE

All practices are closed to the media, as are walk-throughs, at FIU Arena on the day of all home games. Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes will be made available after practice. Media members must contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (Greg Kincaid- Men's Basketball Contact) if they wish to attend post-practice or to set up interviews. No interview will be granted without the permission of the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department.

PRE-GAME INTERVIEWS

FIU players will not be available for any media activities on game day.

POST-GAME INTERVIEWS

The athletic media relations staff at FIU is aware of the importance of media coverage and places great importance on the role of the media insofar as it interacts with their respective duties. To ensure the most workable situation for members of both entities, the following procedures must be observed:

- 1) The FIU men's basketball program will observe a brief NCAA-prescribed cooling off period before beginning post-game interviews.
- 2) A post-game press conference will be conducted in Room 272 of FIU Arena with Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes.

PANTHERS IN THE SECOND GAME OF AN EIGHT-GAME ROAD TRIP:

FIU began an eight-game road trip at Louisville on Dec. 5, and it will conclude at UAB on Jan. 10. Following the contest with Kennesaw State on Dec. 2, FIU began a stretch of 44 days where it will not play a game from Lime Court at FIU Arena, as the Panthers' next home game is not until Jan. 15 versus Marshall. This is by far the longest stretch away from home in school history for FIU. The previous long was 38 days during the 2009-10 season when the Panthers went from Nov. 23 to Dec. 31, 2009 without playing at FIU Arena.

MAVIN FORCES OT, MATCHES CAREER-HIGH vs. WRIGHT STATE:

Senior guard Dennis Mavin matched his career-high in points with 24, which included a game-tying layup with four seconds remaining in regulation, to help lift FIU to a 61-59 overtime victory over the Wright State Raiders on Nov. 28. To go along with his 24 points, Mavin grabbed nine rebounds and three steals in 37 minutes of action.

DIAZ MAKING IMPACT ON THE OFFENSIVE GLASS:

In addition to his 13.8 points-per-game through eight contests, redshirt junior Adrian Diaz has been a big contributor on the boards as well, specifically the offensive glass. Through nine games, 39 of Diaz's 60 rebounds have come on the offensive end. As of Dec. 10, Diaz currently ranks tops in Conference USA in offensive rebounds (4.3 per-game) and ninth nationally in that category. DIAZ HAS CAREER NIGHT AT GEORGIA SOUTHERN:

Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz scored a career-high 33 points at Georgia Southern on Nov. 24. The Miami native stuffed the stat sheet, draining 33 points, seven rebounds, two assists and two blocks in 37 minutes of action, while going 12-of-16 from the field. Diaz' 33 points in a game rank tied for seventh in program history and it was the most points for an FIU player in a single game since DeJuan Wright netted 35 points versus South Alabama on Feb. 25, 2012. Meanwhile, his 12 made field goals mark the third time in the last two seasons that FIU player has made 12 field goals in a game. Tymell Murphy drained 12 field goals in games vs. North Texas and at Marshall last season.

FIU EARNS FIRST 3-0 START SINCE 2002:

With a victory over Florida Memorial on Nov. 21, FIU earned its first 3-0 start since the 2002-03 season, when the Donnie Marsh coached Panthers opened the season with victories over Morris Brown, Iona and Florida Gulf Coast. This is the third different occasion where an FIU team started the season with three victories. The other instance it happened was the 1983-84 season. The 2002-03 and 1983-84 squads both won their first four games of the season.

MAVIN'S LAYUP WITH 5.6 SECONDS REMAINING SINKS STETSON:

With 5.6 seconds remaining and FIU trailing by one, senior guard Dennis Mavin hit a clutch layup to give the Panthers a 53-52 victory over Stetson on Nov. 18. Mavin led the way for FIU on the scoring end, netting 15 points, nine of which came from the free throw line, in 40 minutes of action. The Panthers trailed for the majority of the game leading for just 33 seconds, including the final five seconds.

DIAZ POSTS CAREER-HIGH BLOCKS IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES TO OPEN SEASON:

After losing Rakeem Buckles to graduation last year, FIU was in need of some strong play in the post, offensively and defensively. Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz recorded five blocks in each of his first two games versus Florida College and at Stetson. Diaz became the first FIU player since David Gregg to record at least 10 blocks in a two-game span. Gregg accomplished the feat on Jan. 3 and Jan. 5 of the 1989 season. Last year, just one time an FIU player had at least five blocks in one game, when Buckles had eight blocks versus Stetson (11/18/13).

Junior Tashawn Desir led the way with seven assists in his first career game in an FIU uniform. Meanwhile, redshirt sophomore Ray Rodriguez (4) and sophomore Dominique Williams (3) each set career-highs for assists. Five of FIU's 10 players in the contest had at least three assists.

MAVIN POSTS FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE vs. FALCONS:

Senior guard Dennis Mavin scored 17 points and posted a career-high 10 rebounds as the Gainesville native tallied his first career double-double versus Florida College on Nov. 14. Mavin is the first FIU guard to get a double-double since DeJuan Wright had seven during the 2011-12 season for the Panthers.

The Panthers also will face Louisville, a squad that reached the Sweet 16 in last year's NCAA Tournament. In addition, FIU will take on cross-state rival Florida Gulf Coast and will play in a tournament hosted by USC Upstate during the Thanksgiving holiday. FIU's schedule features eight opponents that reached post-season competition last season including Louisville (NCAA), Louisiana Tech (NIT), FGCU (NIT), Southern Miss (NIT), Wright State (CIT), USC Upstate (CIT), Old Dominion (CBI) and UTEP (CBI).

34 YEARS OF BASKETBALL ON THE WEST SIDE:

The 2014-15 men's basketball season marks the program's 34th year. FIU began men's basketball during the 1981-82 season. That year, led by Head Coach Rich Walker, the Panthers finished 11-16. Including Walker, the program has had eight head coaches including Bob Weltlich (1990-95), Shakey Rodriguez (1995-00), Donnie Marsh (2000-04), Sergio Rouco (2004-09), Isiah Thomas (2009-12), Richard Pitino (2012-13) and Anthony Evans (2013-present).

THE (BASKETBALL) CITY THAT NEVER SLEEPS:

FIU's roster is quite spread out, as the team consisting of 15 players features players from 10 different states or countries. Of those 15, three have come from the New York City area. Juniors Tashawn Desir and Michael Phillip each hail from Brooklyn, while sophomore Jason Boswell comes from the Bronx. The tri-state area background is much deeper with FIU's squad as Head Coach Anthony Evans grew up in Brooklyn and Director of Operations Jarret Lockhart is a Bronx native as well.
