#### STORYLINES:

- Panthers looking to earn their fourth-consecutive Conference USA victory.
- Dennis Mavin enters Thursday's contest one point away from the 900-point plateau for his career.
- Middle Tennessee leads the all-time series between the two teams, 24-7.

**THE GAME:** The Panthers continue their eight-game road trip as they travel to Middle Tennessee on Thursday for an 8 p.m. matchup with the Blue Raiders. Thursday's game between FIU and Middle Tennessee will mark the 32nd meeting all-time between the two teams. FIU trails in the series history 24-7. Last season, FIU fell to Middle Tennessee 70-68 in Miami. Dennis Mavin poured in 15 points 5-of-7 shooting, including 2-of-3 from downtown. Rakeem Buckles added 12 points and six boards, while Tymell Murphy scored 11 points and recorded five rebounds.

**vs. CONFERENCE USA:** FIU holds a 43-95 all-time record against current schools in Conference USA. The most wins FIU has earned against any school in the league is 20 against Florida Atlantic, with the majority of those coming in Sun Belt action. The Panthers have also earned seven wins against Middle Tennessee and six wins over Western Kentucky, both schools that were also former SBC members.

#### DIAZ DOMINATES TO EARN SECOND DOUBLE-DOUBLE:

In FIU's 62-60 victory over the Florida Atlantic Owls in Boca Raton on Sunday, redshirt junior Adrian Diaz was dominant in the post, scoring 27 points on 11-of-14 shooting, while grabbing 11 rebounds to record his second-career double-double. The Miami native also added five blocks in the game, matching his career-high and marking the third time this season he has had five swats in a game.



**WHAT A COMBO!:** Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz put up a 20-point effort for the second time in three games, pouring in 27 points, while senior guard Dennis Mavin added 16 points as FIU's top two scorers accounted for 43 of the Panthers' 62 points in the win at Florida Atlantic on Jan. 4. The tandem combined to shoot 18-29 (62 percent) from the floor and accounted for seven of FIU's eight makes from the charity stripe. They both exploded in the second half with Diaz collecting 17 of his points and Mavin 14 of his in the second 20 minutes, accounting for 31 of the Panthers' 34 points. The duo scored the first 31 points of the second half for FIU before junior Daviyon Draper hit a key jumper with 13 seconds remaining in regulation. Tashawn Desir accounted for the other point, making a free throw with three seconds to play.

**6-0 AGAINST THE SUNSHINE STATE:** With two recent victories over Florida Atlantic and Florida A&M, the Panthers are now a perfect 6-0 versus the State of Florida. FIU picked up a 76-55 victory over Florida A&M on Dec. 29 at the Al Lawson Center to improve to 5-0 against teams from the Sunshine State. With a hard-fought 62-60 victory over Florida Atlantic on Sunday the Panthers improved to 6-0 against Florida schools. Also with the win, FIU has now won five of its last six against Florida Atlantic. The Panthers have one more game remaining against a Florida School, FAU on Feb. 3.

**vs. NON-CON:** The Panthers finished the 2014-15 season with a 7-6 record in non-conference action. Three of FIU's wins in non-conference play came at home this season, with the three others on the road and one at a neutral site. FIU picked up key road wins at Stetson and Florida Gulf Coast while also earning a 61-59 victory over Wright State at Spartanburg Marriott Upstate Classic. FIU went 8-7 in non-conference games last year, including a home-court win against Florida Gulf Coast (72-61 on Dec. 7, 2013) and a home-court loss to No. 6/4 Louisville (85-56 on Dec. 21, 2013). Of the seven losses, two resulted in five points or less and five came away from the friendly confines of Lime Court at FIU Arena. FIU picked up wins away from home at Kennesaw State, vs. Warren Wilson and at Bethune-Cookman. Three of FIU's non-conference losses came at South Carolina, vs. Louisville and at Georgetown.

## LAST TIME OUT

### FIU 62, FLORIDA ATLANTIC 60

January 4, 2014 • Boca Raton, Fla.

FIU opened up Conference USA play with a hard-fought 62-60 victory over the Florida Atlantic Owls in Boca Raton on Sunday. With the win, FIU has now won five of its last six against Florida Atlantic and improved to 6-0 this season versus schools from the State of Florida. Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz was dominant in the post, scoring 27 points on 11-of-14 shooting, while grabbing 11 rebounds to record his second-career double-double. The Miami native also added five blocks in the game, matching his career-high and marking the third time this season he has had five swats in a game. Senior Dennis Mavin scored 16 points in the win and added a career-high six assists, while sophomore Dominique Williams chipped in six points and matched his career-high in rebounds with nine.

**SCOUTING MIDDLE TENNESSEE:** The Blue Raiders enter Thursday's contest on a two-game losing streak, resulting in a 7-7 overall record and an 0-1 mark in C-USA action. Middle Tennessee is coming off a 54-49 setback to UAB in its conference opener this past Sunday in Murfreesboro. Prior to the UAB contest, the Blue Raiders fell 64-48 at Auburn on Dec. 29. Middle Tennessee comes into Thursday's bout averaging 58.4 points-per-game while allowing an average of 59.8 points-per-game. The Blue Raiders have been strong on the glass all season, ranking second in C-USA in defensive rebounding (32.1) and fourth in rebounding margin (2.1). Leading the way for Middle Tennessee offensively is Jacques Rozier (9.0) and Reggie Upshaw (8.6). Upshaw is the Blue Raiders' leading rebounder, as he is averaging 6.2 boards-per-game. Upshaw is also one of the team's top defensive players, leading the Blue Raiders in steals (16) and blocks (13). JaQuel Richmond is Middle Tennessee's assists leader entering Thursday's game, averaging just under three dimes-per-contest.

## LAST TIME vs Middle Tennessee in Miami, L, 70-68 on Feb. 8, 2014

Four Panthers scored in double-figures, led by Jerome Frink's 18 points, as FIU fell to Middle Tennessee, 70-68, from Lime Court at FIU Arena. With the score tied at 68-all, a layup by MT's Jaqawn Raymond with 24.6 seconds gave the Blue Raiders a 70-68 lead. A 3-point attempt by Cody Mann rimmed out with 4.4 seconds on the clock to snap the Panthers' three-game home winning streak. Frink scored a season-high 18 points on 7-of-10 shooting from the floor and a perfect 4-of-4 from the free-throw line. The Jersey City, N.J., native also collected five boards. Dennis Mavin poured in 15 points 5-of-7 shooting, including 2-of-3 from downtown. Rakeem Buckles added 12 points and six boards, while Tyrell Murphy scored 11 points and recorded five rebounds in the loss.

## OUTLET PASSES

■ **DENNIS MAVIN** is just one point shy of reaching the 900-point plateau for his career. The Gainesville native is also just seven points shy from reaching the 600-point mark for his career in an FIU uniform. Mavin's other 306 points came in his first two seasons at Florida Atlantic.

■ Once Mavin eclipses the 600-point mark in an FIU uniform, he will become the 31st player in program history to have scored at least 600 career points during their time at FIU.

■ Mavin currently ranks fifth in Conference USA in scoring (16.1), seventh in field goal percentage (45.6), sixth in defensive rebounds (4.6) and four in minutes played (33.8).

■ Mavin has posted 47 double-digit scoring games for his career and has five 20-plus point games for his career, including three this season. Mavin has led the Panthers in scoring in 10 of 14 games this season.

■ Redshirt junior **ADRIAN DIAZ** has drastically increased his field goal percentage over the last few games, as he now ranks first in Conference USA in field goal percentage and third in the nation, as he is shooting at a 65.8 percent clip.

■ Diaz also currently ranks 12th in Conference USA in scoring (14.1), while also ranking sixth in rebounding (6.9), and second in blocked shots. Diaz has posted five blocks in three different games this season.

■ Diaz has been strong on the offensive glass for the Panthers, averaging 3.8 offensive rebounds-per-game this season. The 3.8 clip for Diaz ranks second in C-USA and 14th nationally.

■ Over his last three games, Diaz is averaging 25.0 points, 7.7 rebounds and is shooting 86 percent from the field (32-for-37).

■ Diaz posted a career-high 33-point scoring effort at Georgia Southern. Diaz' 33 points in a game rank tied for seventh in program history and it was the most points for an FIU player in a single game since DeJuan Wright netted 35 points versus South Alabama on Feb. 25, 2012.

■ Diaz has tallied two double-doubles this season, most recently logging one at Florida Atlantic on Jan. 4. The first double-double of his career came versus Florida Memorial on Nov. 21 at FIU Arena. He scored 10 points and grabbed a career-high 11 rebounds.

■ Sophomore **DOMINIQUE WILLIAMS** has been stellar on the glass the last three games for FIU. Over the last three contests, Williams is averaging 8.3 rebounds, hauling in a career-high nine rebounds in two of those games. In two of those three games, Williams has led FIU in rebounding. The sophomore is currently third on the team in rebounding, averaging 4.8 boards-per-game.

## MAVIN DROPS CAREER-HIGH 27 POINTS AS FIU DOWNS FGCU: In

FIU's 69-63 victory at Floridg Gulf Coast on Dec. 14 at Alico Arena, senior Dennis Mavin tallied a career-high 27 points and 10 field goals made as the Panthers earned their second-straight win over the cross-state foe. Heading into Sunday's game, FGCU had an RPI of 33 (as of Dec. 11) and was ranked 12th in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Poll. Prior to the contest, the Eagles were 34-3 at Alico Arena since the start of the 2012-13 season and 22-1 against non-conference opponents since the start of the 2011-12 campaign. Also, the Panthers held FGCU's Brett Comer, the NCAA active career assists leader heading into the game, to a season-low three helpers.

**PANTHERS IN THE SIXTH GAME OF AN EIGHT-GAME ROAD TRIP:** FIU began an eight-game road trip at Louisville on Dec. 5, and it will conclude at UAB on Jan. 10. Following the contest with Kennesaw State on Dec. 2, FIU began a stretch of 44 days where it will not play a game from Lime Court at FIU Arena, as the Panthers' next home game is not until Jan. 15 versus Marshall. This is by far the longest stretch away from home in school history for FIU. The previous long was 38 days during the 2009-10 season when the Panthers went from Nov. 23 to Dec. 31, 2009 without playing at FIU Arena.

**FIU HOLDS KENNESAW STATE TO RECORD LOW 38 POINTS:** In the 59-38 victory over Kennesaw State on Dec. 2, the Panthers' defense held Kennesaw State to 38 points (27 per-

The last time FIU held a team to less than 40 points in a game was Florida College on Nov. 14, 2013, when the Anthony Evans coached team held the Falcons to a then-opponent record low to 39 points. These two games are the only two instances in program history where FIU has held an opponent under 40 points in a game.



## DRAPER DONS CAREER-HIGH IN WIN OVER OWLS:

In the Dec. 2 win over Kennesaw State, junior Daviyon Draper had the best game of his career, scoring a career-high and game-high tying 16 points (7-of-13). The 16 points are the most in a Division I game for Draper. During his previous two seasons at Antelope Valley Community College, Draper did post a career-high 29 points at the junior college level.

While several interviews are conducted over the phone, the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department will never give out student-athlete's cell phone numbers or private contact information. In-person interviews will take place, either in the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (FIU Arena Room 211) or after practice. Please contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department for ALL interview requests. Other accommodations can be arranged through the Athletic Media Relations Department.

### COACHES AND STAFF INTERVIEWS

Interviews with Head Coach Anthony Evans must come through the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Interviews should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. No member of the FIU staff may be interviewed without permission by the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Personal numbers of both coaches and staff members will not be given out.

### COVERING PRACTICE

All practices are closed to the media, as are walk-throughs, at FIU Arena on the day of all home games. Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes will be made available after practice. ### POST-GAME INTERVIEWS

The athletic media relations staff at FIU is aware of the importance of media coverage and places great importance on the role of the media insofar as it interacts with their respective duties. To ensure the most workable situation for members of both entities, the following procedures must be observed:

- 1) The FIU men's basketball program will observe a brief NCAA-prescribed cooling off period before beginning post-game interviews.
- 2) A post-game press conference will be conducted in Room 272 of FIU Arena with Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes.
- 3) Post-game interviews will NOT be held on the court.

Each visiting team will set its own post-game interview policies and procedures, which will be announced on game day. Check with the opposing media relations staff if you have any further questions.

**MAVIN FORCES OT, MATCHES CAREER-HIGH vs. WRIGHT STATE:** Senior guard Dennis Mavin matched his career-high in points with 24, which included a game-tying layup with four seconds remaining in regulation, to help lift FIU to a 61-59 overtime victory over the Wright State Raiders on Nov. 28. To go along with his 24 points, Mavin grabbed nine rebounds and three steals in 37 minutes of action.

**DIAZ HAS CAREER NIGHT AT GEORGIA SOUTHERN:** Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz scored a career-high 33 points at Georgia Southern on Nov. 24. The Miami native stuffed the stat sheet, draining 33 points, seven rebounds, two assists and two blocks in 37 minutes of action, while going 12-of-16 from the field. Diaz' 33 points in a game rank tied for seventh in program history and it was the most points for an FIU player in a single game since DeJuan Wright netted 35 points versus South Alabama on Feb. 25, 2012. Meanwhile, his 12 made field goals mark the third time in the last two seasons that FIU player has made 12 field goals in a game. Tymell Murphy drained 12 field goals in games vs. North Texas and at Marshall last season.

**FIU EARNS FIRST 3-0 START SINCE 2002:** With a victory over Florida Memorial on Nov. 21, FIU earned its first 3-0 start since the 2002-03 season, when the Donnie Marsh coached Panthers opened the season with victories over Morris Brown, Iona and Florida Gulf Coast. This is the third different occasion where an FIU team started the season with three victories. The other instance it happened was the 1983-84 season. The 2002-03 and 1983-84 squads both won their first four games of the season.

**MAVIN'S LAYUP WITH 5.6 SECONDS REMAINING SINKS STETSON:** With 5.6 seconds remaining and FIU trailing by one, senior guard Dennis Mavin hit a clutch layup to give the Panthers a 53-52 victory over Stetson on Nov. 18. Mavin led the way for FIU on the scoring end, netting 15 points, nine of which came from the free throw line, in 40 minutes of action. The Panthers trailed for the majority of the game leading for just 33 seconds, including the final five seconds.

**DIAZ POSTS CAREER-HIGH BLOCKS IN BACK-TO-BACK GAMES TO OPEN SEASON:** After losing Rakeem Buckles to graduation last year, FIU was in need of some strong play in the post, offensively and defensively. Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz recorded five blocks in each of his first two games versus Florida College and at Stetson. Diaz became the first FIU player since David Gregg to record at least 10 blocks in a two-game span. Gregg accomplished the feat on Jan. 3 and Jan. 5 of the 1989 season. Last year, just one time an FIU player had at least five blocks in one game, when Buckles had eight blocks versus Stetson (11/18/13).

**PANTHERS TALLY 21 ASSISTS AGAINST FLORIDA COLLEGE:** As a team, FIU posted 21 assists on Nov. 14 in a 64-42 victory over Florida College, marking the most for the Panthers since getting 22 dimes vs. Florida College last season on Nov. 14, 2013. Junior Tashawn Desir led the way with seven assists in his first career game in an FIU uniform. Meanwhile, redshirt sophomore Ray Rodriguez (4) and sophomore Dominique Williams (3) each set career-highs for assists. Five of FIU's 10 players in the contest had at least three assists.

**MAVIN POSTS FIRST CAREER DOUBLE-DOUBLE vs. FALCONS:** Senior guard Dennis Mavin scored 17 points and posted a career-high 10 rebounds as the Gainesville native tallied his first career double-double versus Florida College

on Nov. 14. Mavin is the first FIU guard to get a double-double since DeJuan Wright had seven during the 2011-12 season for the Panthers.

**THE SCHEDULE:** FIU's schedule features 12 home games on Lime Court at FIU Arena, three of those games being non-conference foes. The Panthers also will face Louisville, a squad that reached the Sweet 16 in last year's NCAA Tournament. In addition, FIU will take on cross-state rival Florida Gulf Coast and will play in a tournament hosted by USC Upstate during the Thanksgiving holiday. FIU's schedule features eight opponents that reached postseason competition last season including Louisville (NCAA), Louisiana Tech (NIT), FGCU (NIT), Southern Miss (NIT), Wright State (CIT), USC Upstate (CIT), Old Dominion (CBI) and UTEP (CBI).

**34 YEARS OF BASKETBALL ON THE WEST SIDE:** The 2014-15 men's basketball season marks the program's 34th year. FIU began men's basketball during the 1981-82 season. That year, led by Head Coach Rich Walker, the Panthers finished 11-16. Including Walker, the program has had eight head coaches including Bob Weltlich (1990-95), Shakey Rodriguez (1995-00), Donnie Marsh (2000-04), Sergio Rouco (2004-09), Isiah Thomas (2009-12), Richard Pitino (2012-13) and Anthony Evans (2013-present).

- Senior Dennis Mavin scored 16 points in the win and added a career-high six assists, while sophomore Dominique Williams chipped in six points and matched his career-high in rebounds with nine.
- FIU shot at least 50 percent from the floor for the third-straight game, shooting at an even clip of 50 percent.

**NOTES FROM WIN at FLORIDA A&M**

- Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz led the way for the Panthers scoring 19 points, with 15 of them coming in the second half, and grabbing seven rebounds.
- Junior Dennis Mavin had a nice outing as well, scoring 16 points, dishing out five assists and grabbing two steals in 35 minutes of action. Mavin and senior Marco Porcher Jimenez each made three shots from beyond the three-point arc.
- FIU had three players score in double-figures, as senior Marco Porcher Jimenez (14) and junior Daviyon Draper (10) rounded out the double-digit scorers.

**THE (BASKETBALL) CITY THAT NEVER SLEEPS:** FIU's roster is quite spread out, as the team consisting of 15 players features players from 10 different states or countries. Of those 15, three have come from the New York City area. Juniors Tashawn Desir and Michael Phillip each hail from Brooklyn, while sophomore Jason Boswell comes from the Bronx. The tri-state area background is much deeper with FIU's squad as Head Coach Anthony Evans grew up in Brooklyn and Director of Operations Jarret Lockhart is a Bronx native as well.

**WHERE'S THE BEACH?!** FIU gained lots of national attention last season after Lime Court at FIU Arena floor was resurfaced with a one-of-a-kind beach themed look. Due to structural damage to the floor that occurred during the offseason, FIU will be using a temporary floor during the 2014-15 season covering up the beach themed court. The floor comes from the Honda Center in Anaheim, Calif., which was used for the 2014 NCAA Tournament. Following the conclusion of this season, the floor will be replaced and the beach-themed court will return.

**RAINING THREES:** Entering Thursday's contest with the Blue Raiders, FIU has converted at least one three-point field goal in 191-straight games, dating back to Dec. 20, 2008.

**NEW C-USA FORMAT THIS SEASON:** The 2015 Conference USA Men's Basketball season will see two notable changes from a year ago. C-USA will play an 18-game regular season for the first time in the league's history. Also, the 2015 C-USA Championship will return to a 12-team, four-day format. The 2014 Championship in El Paso was a five-day format featuring all eligible teams.

- Named the eighth head basketball coach at FIU on April 16, 2013.
- Picked up his first win as the head coach at FIU with a 66-58 victory over Kennesaw State on Nov. 10, 2013. The win also marked the 100th-career victory for Evans.

FIU opened up Conference USA play with a hard-fought 62-60 victory over the Florida Atlantic Owls in Boca Raton. With the win, FIU has now won five of its last six against Florida Atlantic and improved to 6-0 this season versus schools from the State of Florida. Redshirt junior Adrian Diaz was dominant in the post, scoring 27 points on 11-of-14 shooting, while grabbing 11 rebounds to record his second-career double-double. The Miami native also added five blocks in the game, matching his career-high and marking the third time this season he has had five swats in a game. Senior Dennis Mavin scored 16 points in the win and added a career-high six assists, while sophomore Dominique Williams chipped in six points and matched his career-high in rebounds with nine.
