1. Ryan Metz made his first collegiate start on Sept. 26. Metz set career highs in yards (275), completions (20), attempts (28) and longest completion (57 yards).
2. The UTEP offensive line has continued its consistent play, allowing only two sacks in its first four games of 2015, including allowing zero during the last two games.
3. UTEP is 8-for-8 in the red zone in 2015, converting four touchdowns and four field goals.
4. Dating back to Nov. 8, 2014, Jay Mattox has made 13 consecutive field goals.
5. Autrey Golden has six kickoff return touchdowns in his career, making him the active FBS leader in the category.

MINERS TO FACE FIU IN MIAMI

UTEP (2-3, 0-1 Conference USA) will travel to Miami to take on FIU (2-3, 0-1 C-USA) on Oct. 10. Kickoff is slated for 10 a.m. MT at Ocean Bank Field at FIU Football Stadium. The game will be televised on the American Sports Network and on KDBC Channel 4 in El Paso. The Miners are coming off a 25-6 loss to UTSA, while the Panthers fell at UMass, 24-14, last week. Saturday's contest will mark UTEP's fourth road game of 2015 and first trip to the Sunshine State since the 2011 season when the Miners played at no. 18 USF and UCF. UTEP is 0-18-1 all-time in the Eastern Time zone. The last game played in the Eastern Time zone was in 2012 at East Carolina. The Miners are 1-2 on the road while the Panthers have played one home game, defeating N.C. Central 39-14 on Sept. 19.

UTEP VS. FLORIDA PROGRAMS

The Miners are 3-4 all-time versus schools from the state of Florida. Texas Western defeated Florida State 47-20 in the 1955 Sun Bowl, while UTEP defeated UCF 58-13 in 2008 and FIU 33-10 in 2013 in El Paso.

CONNECTIONS

UTEP Head Coach **Sean Kugler** was on the Pittsburgh Steelers staff and FIU tight ends coach Jason Brooks was on the Baltimore Ravens staff during the 2010 NFL season. The Steelers and Ravens met three times that season – twice during the regular season and again in the divisional playoffs.

FIU Offensive Coordinator Steve Shankweiler was the offensive line coach at East Carolina from 2005-2009. East Carolina and UTEP met during the 2007 and 2008 seasons.

ABOUT FIU

The Panthers are coming off a 24-14 loss at UMass on Oct. 3. FIU dropped to 2-3 overall and is 0-1 in Conference USA play after falling at LA Tech 27-17 on Sept. 26. FIU ranks fourth in the league in scoring defense, yielding 23.0 points per game. FIU's scoring offense ranks ninth, behind UTEP (23.2), averaging 21.4 points per contest. Sophomore QB Alex McGough is completing 64.6 percent (122-of-189) of his passes. McGough ranks tied for fourth in the league in touchdown passes (10), fifth in passing yards (1,129), tied for third in attempts (189) and fourth in completions (122). McGough is one of seven C-USA quarterbacks to have thrown two or less interceptions in 2015. Both of McGough's interceptions were returned for scores.

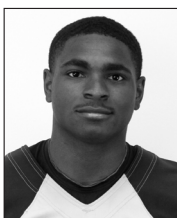

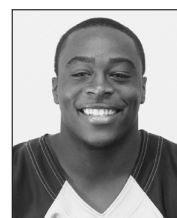

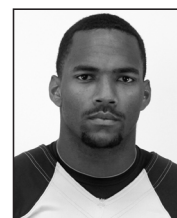

Sophomore RB Alex Gardner ranks 10th in conference in rushing yards per game (61.0). Gardner is averaging 3.6 yards per rush and has scored three rushing touchdowns. Gardner has also added 217 receiving yards, ranking second on the team in receptions (26). Sophomore WR Thomas Owens ranks 10th in C-USA in receiving yards per game (69.8), tied for sixth in receptions per game (5.8) and tied for second in receiving scores (five). FIU ranks tied for second in C-USA, behind UTEP, in sacks allowed (6.0). The FIU defense ranks tied for sixth with 9.0 quarterback sacks. Senior DE Denzell Perine ranks tied for second in the league with his 4.0 sacks. Sophomore LB Anthony Wint ranks tied for fourth in C-USA in tackles (41). Four different Panthers have picked off passes – junior S Jordan Davis, Wint, sophomore S Niko Gonzalez and senior CB Jeremiah McKinnon. All four of the picks were returned for zero yards.

LAST WEEK: UTSA 25, UTEP 6

Michael Egwuagu scored two touchdowns off UTEP turnovers in the second half as UTSA pulled away for a 25-6 victory over the Miners in the Conference USA opener for both teams on Oct. 3 in the Sun Bowl. The Roadrunners led the Miners 3-0 following a first half that featured two lightning delays, making it difficult for either team to get anything going. But it was all UTSA over the final 30 minutes as the Miners were only able to mount one scoring drive. UTEP turned it over five times, three times in the second half, as **Ryan Metz** was picked off four times in a game that lasted four and a half hours. Unable to get the ground game going, the Miners finished with 275 yards of offense, 216 through the air. Metz was 23-for-49 for 216 yards. UTEP managed only 95 yards on its first 12 drives. On nine of the 12 drives, the Miners ran three plays or less. By that point UTSA led 18-0. The Roadrunners received a 30-yard field goal from Daniel Portillo, a safety when **Kavika Johnson** was tackled in the end zone, a 25-yard scoring run from Jarveon Williams and a 40-yard interception return from Egwuagu (the extra point was no good). The UTEP offense did come alive late in the third quarter and into the fourth. The Miners finally dented the scoreboard with 12:34 remaining when Metz connected with **Jaquan White** for a 25-yard score, putting the finishing touches on a 10-play, 72-yard drive. White was the team's leading receiver with six catches for 77 yards. For a while, it looked like the Miners could rally behind Metz for the third time in three games. Down 18-6, UTEP moved the ball all the way to the Roadrunner 18-yard line and still had over five minutes remaining. But on third and 10, Metz's pass was intercepted in the end zone by UTSA's Nate Gaines. UTSA tacked on its final score when Gaines picked off Metz deep in UTEP territory in the final two minutes, and flipped it to Egwuagu for a 15-yard TD. The Miners had their six-game winning streak in the Sun Bowl snapped, losing to a C-USA opponent in the stadium for the first time in nearly two years. For the second straight game, Metz was the team's leading rusher with eight carries for 26 yards. **Jimmy Musgrave** led the defense with 12 tackles and **Alvin Jones** added 10. Jones accounted for three of the team's five sacks. UTSA, which gained 335 yards, was led by Blake Bogenschutz who completed 19-of-30 passes for 198 yards, and Williams who rushed for 133 yards. The teams have faced one another on three occasions as C-USA members with the visiting team winning every time.

FEWER PENALTIES

UTEP committed only two penalties for 26 yards on Oct. 3 against UTSA. The Miners committed 18 penalties combined in the previous two games at NM State (11-90 yards) on Sept. 19 and against Incarnate Word (7-68 yards) on Sept. 26. Prior to the NM State game, the Miners had committed only 10 penalties during the first two contests of 2015. Also prior to the game in Las Cruces, the Miners had averaged 4.6 penalties and 38.3 penalty yards per game in the previous 27 contests under head coach **Sean Kugler**.

LIGHTNING CRASHES

Oct. 3rd's game against UTSA was delayed twice due to lightning during the second quarter. The first came at the 11:11 mark and second with :11 left in the half. It was third such delay during the past seven seasons. The first came during the 2009 season at NM State where the game was delayed three hours. The second came at East Carolina in 2012.

MEET RYAN METZ

Redshirt freshman QB **Ryan Metz** made his first collegiate start on Sept. 26 against Incarnate Word. Metz set career highs in yards (275), completions (20), attempts (28) and longest completion (57 yards). This performance came after throwing for three scores and rushing for another in relief at NM State on Sept. 19. Metz, on the season, is completing 60.4 percent (64-of-106) of his passes for 743 yards, six touchdowns and five interceptions. On Oct. 3, Metz found Jaquan White for a 25-yard touchdown toss against UTSA. It's the first time a UTEP quarterback threw a touchdown pass in three consecutive games since Jameill Showers connected on touchdown passes against Old Dominion, at UTSA and versus Southern Miss in 2014.

RUN, RYAN, RUN!

Ryan Metz paced UTEP in rushing for a second consecutive week with 26 yards on eight carries against UTSA on Oct. 3. Metz compiled 46 yards on eight carries against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. On the season, Metz has rushed for 98 yards on 22 attempts (4.5 avg.) and a touchdown. Metz is the first UTEP quarterback to lead the team in rushing in back-to-back games since Shawn Gray did it in 1992 -- 78 yards at Colorado State (10/10) and 65 yards at San Diego State (10/17).

MORE ON METZ

Ryan Metz leads UTEP with 841 yards of total offense. Metz's 168.2 yards of total offense per game is ranked 10th in Conference USA through five weeks. Metz ranks seventh in Conference USA with his 128.5 rating. WKU's Brandon Doughty leads C-USA with a 184.7 efficiency rating. Metz also ranks seventh in completion percentage (60.4). Doughty leads C-USA with a 74.1 completion percentage.

PASSING YARDS DURING THE KUGLER ERA

Ryan Metz's 275 yards on Sept. 26 were the second-most passing during the **Sean Kugler** era. **Jameill Showers** threw for 365 yards at Colorado State on Sept. 28, 2013. Of the 30 games with Kugler at the helm, UTEP quarterbacks have hit 200 or more passing yards seven times, including three this season. Metz threw for 218 yards at NM State on Sept. 19 and 216 against UTSA on Oct. 3. Showers threw for 253 yards at NM State on Sept. 14, 2013 and 237 yards against LA Tech on Oct. 5, 2013. Last season, Showers recorded 201 yards at no. 25 Kansas (Sept. 27) and 209 yards at Rice (Nov. 11).

JAQUAN MAKING PLAYS

After winning Conference USA Special Teams Player of the Week with a 64-yard punt return for a touchdown on Sept. 26, WR **Jaquan White** registered a career-high 77 yards on six receptions, including a 25-yard receiving score, against UTSA on Oct. 3. White leads the Miners in receptions (21) for 209 yards and is tied for the team lead with WR **Autrey Golden** with a pair of touchdown receptions. 12 of his catches have gone for first downs, while eight of them have come on third down plays and another on fourth down.

BATSON GETTING BETTER

WR **Tyler Batson** entered Sept. 19's contest at NM State with one reception in his career. Over the last three games Batson has hauled in 12 receptions for 197 yards (16.4 avg.), including a career-best 69 yards on four receptions against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. Batson also registered a career-long 41-yard reception on Oct. 3 against UTSA. Batson broke out at NM State when he caught four passes for 61 yards, including a key 30-yard reception during the Miners' rally against the Aggies.

FROM REBOUNDED TO PASS CATCHING

Former UTEP basketball forward **Cedrick Lang** caught his first touchdown at NM State on Sept. 19. It was a six-yard reception in overtime to down the Aggies. Lang is using his fifth-year status to play tight end for head coach **Sean Kugler**. Lang recorded his first collegiate reception during the third quarter at Texas Tech -- a four-yard catch that went for a first down. On the season, Lang has five catches for 30 yards and a score.

PLINKE RUNNING HARD

Transfer TE **Hayden Plinke** knows how to use his 6-foot-4, 255-pound frame to bulldoze over defenders. On Sept. 26 against Incarnate Word, Plinke caught four passes for 80 yards, including a career-long 57-yard reception. But it was the first pass he hauled in that set the stage for the remainder of the evening. It was a nine-yard reception during the third quarter where Plinke broke away from the initial tackler, before it took literally six defenders to bring down the big tight end.

MORE ON PLINKE

Hayden Plinke registered a career-high seven receptions for 43 yards against UTSA on Oct. 3. Plinke is ranked second on the team in receptions (17), while his yards (231) lead the Miners. Plinke's 17 receptions rate sixth-best amongst C-USA tight ends, while his 231 yards rank fourth.

PLINKE'S CAREER DAY

Hayden Plinke led UTEP in receptions (four) and yards (87) against Texas Tech on Sept. 12, including a 42-yard catch and punishing run. Plinke's yards were the most for a tight end during the **Sean Kugler** era, surpassing **Eric Tomlinson's** 75 yards at Colorado State on Sept. 28, 2013. Plinke was also the first tight end to lead the Miners in receiving since **Craig Wenrick's** 50-yard performance at Middle Tennessee on Nov. 30, 2013. Plinke's 87 yards at Texas Tech were the most for a UTEP tight end since **Jamar Hunt's** 86 yards to open the 2008 season at Buffalo.

ROTECTING THE FIELD GENERAL

Though the UTEP offensive line surrendered a pair of sacks on Oct. 3 against UTSA, the Miners have still only yielded four sacks in their first five games of 2015, including allowing zero during games against NM State and Incarnate Word. So far, UTEP ranks first in Conference USA in sacks allowed and tied for 13th nationally. Dating back to last season, the Miners' offensive line has allowed only 17 sacks in 18 games. Air Force and Toledo are the only two programs to allow zero sacks in 2015. Texas Tech and Utah have only allowed one apiece.

BIGGER O-LINE

The final game of head coach **Sean Kugler's** first season (2013) saw a starting offensive line that averaged 298 pounds. Since then, Kugler has assembled a starting offensive line that averages 310 pounds in 2015. LT **Jerome Daniels** (305 lbs.), LG **Will Hernandez** (330 lbs.), C **Eric Lee** (305 lbs.), RG **Derek Elmendorff** (310 lbs.) and RT **Chris Thomas** (300 lbs.) compose the starting run blockers/pass protectors. The second unit offensive line averages 332 pounds. According to the depth chart LT **Anthony Kyles** (300 lbs.), LG **Josh Silvas** (375 lbs.), C **Derron Gatewood** (315 lbs.), RG **Christopher Misaalefua** (355 lbs.) and RT **John De La Rosa** (315 lbs.) make up the second unit.

KEEPING AN EYE ON ERIC LEE

Senior C **Eric Lee** was named to the Rimington Trophy Spring Watch List on May 19. The list includes 52 of the best centers in Division I football. Lee saw playing time for the first time last season, starting in all 13 games. Lee is one of six starting centers in Conference USA to make their return for the 2015 campaign. The others are redshirt junior Jarred Barr (Charlotte), senior Kirby Wixson (LA Tech), redshirt junior Josh Chester (Middle Tennessee), junior Kaydon Kirby (North Texas) and junior Cameron Tom (Southern Miss).

THE BROTHERS LAUFASA

Darrin and **Jeremiah Laufasa** made their first collegiate start together on Sept. 19 in Las Cruces, N.M. -- Darrin at the fullback position and Jeremiah at the tailback spot. The Laufasa brothers are the only brothers on an FBS program starting in the backfield. But they are not the only brothers making starts on the same side of the ball. Air Force's Connor and Patrick Healy are starting line-backers and Maryland's Levern and Taivon Jacobs are starting wide receivers.

TIME BANDITS

UTEP lost the time of possession on Oct. 3 against UTSA, 34:16 to 25:44, for the first time since Nov. 21, 2014 at Rice. Though the Miners lost it on Saturday, winning it has been a consistent element during the **Sean Kugler** era. In 2014, UTEP won the time of possession in 12 of 13 games. The Miners ranked second in the nation in time of possession (34:57) behind Michigan State (35:21) in 2014. UTEP has led in time of possession in 16 of the last 18 games dating back to the 2014 season. Overall during Kugler's three seasons at the helm, the Miners have won time of possession in 23 of 30 games. UTEP currently ranks second in Conference USA and 19th nationally with its 32:45 time of possession. Rice is first in C-USA at 35:48, while NC State leads the nation at 36:47.

RED ZONE OFFENSE

UTEP is 9-for-11 in the red zone in 2015. The Miners have converted four field goals and five touchdowns when getting near the goal line. UTEP ranks sixth in Conference USA with its 81.8 percent conversions.

OPPONENT PENALTIES

UTEP opponents have been penalized 33 times for 343 yards, which ranks first in Conference USA and tied for 32nd nationally (68.6 penalty yards per game). Tulsa leads the nation with 103.3 opponent penalty yards per game. Miners' opponents are averaging 6.6 penalties per game, ranking tied for fourth in conference and 59th nationally. LA Tech leads the conference with 38 opponent penalties, while UTEP ranks tied for fourth.

CONSECUTIVE STARTS

Four Miners made their 18th consecutive start dating back to last season on Saturday. OL **Jerome Daniels**, OL **Will Hernandez**, OL **Eric Lee** and DL **Roy Robertson-Harris** achieved the feat. FB **Darrin Laufasa**, dating back to 2013, has started 25 of 30 games, while Robertson-Harris has made 26 starts in his last 30 games since 2013.

#JUGGERNAUT JONES



9.0- The amount of **TACKLES FOR LOSSES** accumulated by the El Paso native during the 2015 season. That total ranks first in Conference USA and 14th nationally. His tackles for losses have resulted in opposing teams dropping 41 yards (4.5 yards per TFL).

2ND- Jones' five tackles for losses against NM State rank second in the **NATION** for a single game in 2015. Georgia's Jordan Jenkins racked up 5.5 during a game earlier this year.

BTH- Where Jones **RANKS IN THE COUNTRY** in the **SACK ATTACK** category after terrorizing the UTSA backfield. The sophomore tallied a career-high three sacks against the Roadrunners. He has a total of 5.5 during the 2015 season.

37- The number of **TOTAL TACKLES** Jones has accumulated in 2015. That number ranks 12th in Conference USA.

FEWEST SENIORS ON OFFENSE

UTEP is one of 25 FBS schools with four or less seniors at offensive skill positions (QB, RB, WR, TE) in 2015. The Miners feature three seniors in those positions: RB **Jeremiah Laufasa**, TE **Cedrick Lang** and WR **Autrey Golden**. There are seven other programs that feature only three seniors. Those schools are Colorado, Miami, Minnesota, Ohio State, Purdue, Washington State and Wyoming. Three schools (Eastern Michigan, Florida State and Louisville) have two seniors, while six programs (Kentucky, Nevada, Old Dominion, Pitt, Syracuse and Wake Forest) feature only one senior. UCF is the only program not to have any seniors at a skill position. The Miners have a total of five seniors on offense. OL **Eric Lee** and OL **Josh Silvas**, Golden, Lang and Laufasa are the featured seniors. UCF and Louisville have four, Kentucky and Old Dominion have three, while Florida State, Nevada, Pitt and Wake Forest feature two seniors on offense.

TACKLING BEHIND THE LINE OF SCRIMMAGE

UTEP registered 11 tackles for loss against UTSA on Oct. 3. It was the most tackles for loss since posting 11 against LA Tech during the 2003 season and the most during the **Sean Kugler** era. The previous high under Kugler was 10 tackles for loss against North Texas in 2014. The 2004 Miners registered a program high 15 at San Jose State. The UTEP defense ranks third in Conference USA in tackles for loss (31.0) and third in TFL/G (6.2). The Miners are tied for 41st nationally in that category.

SACK ATTACK

Like last season, it took a while for UTEP defensive players to get to the quarterback. After only recording zero sacks in the first two games, the Miners are now tied for second with Middle Tennessee in Conference USA with 11 sacks on the season. UTEP tallied five sacks against UTSA on Oct. 3 and four versus Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. Southern Miss leads the league with 13 sacks. UTEP ranks tied for 34th nationally, while Oklahoma State leads the nation with 22.0 sacks in 2015. UTEP is on pace to match last season's total of 26 sacks. The Miners registered two sacks during the first five games of 2014.

LEADER OF THE SACK

LB **Alvin Jones** has been a sack machine as of late. The sophomore entered the 2015 campaign with 1.5 sacks. So far, Jones leads Conference USA and ranks eighth nationally with 5.5 sacks after posting a career-best 3.0 against UTSA on Oct. 3. Wisconsin LB Joe Schobert leads the nation with 9.0 sacks. Jones' three-sack performance is tied with Florida Atlantic's Trey Hendrickson and North Texas' Jarrian Roberts for most in a single game in C-USA this season.

MORE ON JONES' QB HARASSMENT

Alvin Jones's 3.0 sacks on Oct. 3 were the most by a Miner since Jeremy Castillo's 3.0 sacks at Alabama during the 2001 season. If Jones keeps this pace, he would finish with around 13 sacks on the season, surpassing Melvin Besses' single-season program record of 11 back in 1979. The only other Miners to register double-digit sacks in a season were Menson Holloway with 10.5 in 2000 and Ricky Massey's 10.0 in 1991.

UTEP CAREER SACKS

Alvin Jones now has seven sacks in his career as a Miner. He would need five more to crack the all-time sacks list. Five Miners (**Joe Terry**, **Ross Puritty**, **Ricky Massey**, **Barron Wortham** and **Horace Miller**) have registered 12.0 sacks during their respective careers – all tied for 10th in program history. **Gonzalo Floyd's** 20.0 career sacks leads the all-time list, while **Chris Mineo** ranks second with 16.5 and **Herman Whiting** ranks third with 16.0.

ALVIN RACKING UP TACKLES

Alvin Jones has played consistent so far in 2015, leading the UTEP defense with 37 tackles and is tied for first with 17 solo stops. Jones ranks 10th in Conference USA and is on pace for 84 tackles in 2015. Jones tallied 10 tackles against UTSA on Oct. 3, one short of his career best (11 tackles at NM State on Sept. 19). Jones registered nine on Sept. 26 against Incarnate Word.

JONES' TACKLES FOR LOSS

Alvin Jones leads Conference USA and is tied for ninth in the nation with 9.0 tackles for loss. Jones recorded 3.0 more tackles for loss against UTSA on Oct. 3, while tallying a career-high 5.0 at NM State on Sept. 19. Jones registered 9.0 tackles for loss in 2014. Jones has 18.0 tackles for loss in his career, needing 12.5 to crack the all-time list in program history. **Barron Wortham** leads the all-time list with 45.0, while **Chris Mineo** and **Jeremy Jones** are tied for ninth with 30.5. Wisconsin's Joe Schobert ranks first nationally with 13.0. Jones' 5.0 tackles for loss in Las Cruces were the most since **Menson Holloway** amassed five at Tulsa on Oct. 7, 2000. **Lucien Johnson** racked up 17.0 tackles for loss in 1975, the single-season high in program history. **Troy Collavo** and **Jeremy Jones** each tallied 14.5 during the 2005 season, ranking tied for ninth in school history.

THE SAFETY DANCE

Alvin Jones got a hold of NM State quarterback Tyler Rogers in the end zone during the first quarter on Sept. 19 to record UTEP's first safety since Horace Miller tallied a safety on Nov. 16, 2013 against FIU in the Sun Bowl.

SKY'S THE LIMIT

LB **Sky Logan** had added to the linebacking depth for UTEP. Logan played his second consecutive game on Oct. 3 against UTSA, recording a career-best five tackles including two tackles for loss and tallying his second career sack. Logan had a memorable night against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26, as the sophomore transfer registered three tackles, a quarterback sack and a tackle for loss. It was Logan's first extensive playing time, as he did see action at no. 18 Arkansas to open the season but didn't have any stats.

'SUPER FLY' JIMMY MUSGRAVE

LB **Jimmy Musgrave** has been flying around the gridiron in 2015, making big hits and key tackles. The senior captain registered a career-high 12 tackles versus UTSA on Oct. 3, surpassing his high of 10 stops against North Texas last season. Musgrave currently ranks second on the team in tackles (29) including two tackles for loss. He's chipped in with a pass breakup and two quarterback hurries.

PRESSURE COOKER

DL **Roy Robertson-Harris** tied a career high with three quarterback hurries against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26 and posted another against UTSA on Oct. 3. He leads the team with five hurries. Robertson-Harris hasn't registered a sack in 2015, but opposing offensive linemen will have to take note that he's inching closer every week. Robertson-Harris has eight sacks during his career as a Miner and is four away from cracking the top 10 in program history.

USHER THE PASS RUSHER

It took a few games, but DL **Nick Usher** finally tallied a sack, two actually against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. In fact Usher's two sacks were a career high for the junior defensive end. Usher has five sacks in his UTEP career (3.0 in 2014). Usher also registered his first career fumble recovery during the fourth quarter against UTSA on Oct. 3.

HYNSON'S FIRST SACK

Redshirt freshman DB **Adrian Hynson** tallied his first collegiate sack for a loss of eight yards during the first quarter on Oct. 3 against UTSA. Hynson has played in all five games in 2015, chipping in with nine tackles (five solo) and one tackle for loss (eight yards).

KALON IMPROVING

After struggling his first two collegiate games, true freshman DB **Kalon Beverly** has stepped up. Beverly registered a career-best nine tackles on Oct. 3 against UTSA, a week after recording his first interception that went for a 24-yard pick six. Beverly currently ranks third on the team in tackles (25) and tied for first with 17 solo stops. Beverly added his first collegiate pass breakup against the Roadrunners.

TRAUN'S FIRST INT

DB **Traun Roberson** recorded his first collegiate interception late in the first quarter against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. Roberson is currently a graduate student, playing his sixth year. Roberson was injured early during the 2010 season, followed by rehabbing in 2011. He was injured again in 2012, playing in only three games in two seasons. But Roberson has played in 26 games his last three seasons, including three in 2015. He's also made seven starts during that span.

THE GOLDEN STANDARD

Autrey Golden returned two kickoffs for scores in 2014. The first was a 98-yard return in the third quarter against Southern Miss, while the second came at WKU, 92 yards for a TD in the first quarter. He has six kickoff return touchdowns in his career (ranked No. 1 in program history), making him the active FBS leader in the category. Golden is tied for second in Conference USA history and tied for third in NCAA history. He is now just one back of C-USA and NCAA

record-holder Tyron Carrier of Houston (seven). Former Clemson star C.J. Spiller also shares the NCAA marker with seven kickoff returns for scores. Golden has a total of 103 career returns, rating 13 behind all-time leader Cedric Johnson (116).

GOLDEN'S KICK RETURN YARDAGE

Autrey Golden returned one kickoff for 16 yards on Saturday. He now has 2,666 yards in his UTEP career, ranking second behind Cedric Johnson's 2,757. Golden needs 92 yards to become UTEP's all-time leader. On the season, Golden is averaging 21.8 yards on 15 kickoff returns with a season-long of 31 yards.

SLASH

Autrey Golden can find the end zone in multiple ways, as he scored his 12th career touchdown on Sept. 26 versus Incarnate Word. Golden hauled in a 10-yard touchdown reception, making it his third overall touchdown on the season and fourth career receiving score. His first touchdown in 2015 came on a reverse play to the left side that went 10 yards into the end zone during the season opener at Arkansas. It was his first rushing score since Nov. 16, 2013 versus FIU. Golden has six kickoff returns for touchdowns, four receiving and two rushing scores.

MUCH IMPROVED PUNT RETURN GAME

Jaquan White took a punt 64 yards to pay dirt during the fourth quarter on Sept. 26 against Incarnate Word. It was UTEP's first traditional punt return for a score since **Johnnie Lee Higgins Jr.** returned one 88 yards on Oct. 14, 2006. White's 64-yard return is the longest in Conference USA so far. White is averaging 20.0 yards on six returns (120 yards). The last Miner to average double-digits in return average was **Marlon McClure** (13.1) in 2010.

LEADING C-USA IN PUNT RETURNS

UTEP is averaging 17.4 yard per punt return to lead Conference USA, while ranking tied for 19th nationally in 2015. The Miners have returned seven punts for 122 yards – also leads conference. UTEP is one of 30 schools to return at least one punt for a score. Maryland, Utah and Illinois lead the way with two returns for touchdowns apiece. **Jaquan White** and LA Tech's **Paul Turner** have the only two punt returns for touchdowns in C-USA.

SPECIAL JAY

Junior K **Jay Mattox** connected on a career-long 50-yard field goal against Incarnate Word on Sept. 26. Mattox's field goal make is currently tied for the second longest in Conference USA behind UTSA's Daniel Portillo's 51-yard make. LA Tech's Jonathon Barnes connected on a 50-yard field goal on Oct. 3. Mattox is 6-for-7 on field goal conversions and is ranked seventh for kickers in conference averaging 6.0 points per game. Mattox leads the Miners with 30 points and is 12-for-12 in extra points. Mattox has made a dramatic improvement on his field goal kicking, connecting on 82.6 percent (19-of-23) since the start of the 2014 season after only 46.7 percent (7-of-15) in 2013.

AUTO-MATTOX

After connecting on field goals of 50 and 24 yards on Sept. 26 and dating back to the WKU game on Nov. 8, 2014, **Jay Mattox** made 13 consecutive field goals. Mattox was 2-for-2 against WKU, Rice (Nov. 21) and Utah State (Dec. 20), and was 1-for-1 against Middle Tennessee (Nov. 29). And in 2015, Mattox is 6-for-7 after missing an attempt on Oct. 3 versus UTSA. **Jose Martinez** connected on 15 in a row during the 2008 season, the previous longest streak.

MATTOX'S CAREER RANKINGS

Jay Mattox has also connected on 87-of-88 extra points and 26-of-38 field goals during his career at UTEP. Mattox currently ranks tied for sixth in program history with **Scott Wedell** with 165 kicking points. **Reagan Schneider** is the career leader for kickers with 287 points. Mattox's 87 PATs rank fifth in program history behind **Jose Martinez's** 89.

KICKOFF COVERAGE RANKINGS

UTEP ranks second in Conference USA in kickoff coverage (41.7 net avg.). Florida Atlantic ranks first with its 42.7 net average. The Miners are averaging 65.0 yards per kickoff and UTEP is one of five schools with double-digit touchbacks (14). Marshall has 20 touchbacks, while Florida Atlantic has 14, Middle Tennessee has 11 and Rice has 10.

UTEP'S NEW PUNTER

El Paso native **Alan Luna** is averaging 44.5 yards per punt in 2015. The redshirt freshman had a long of 60 yards during the second quarter at Arkansas in the season opener. Luna currently ranks third in Conference USA after five weeks. Luna has booted 27 punts for 1,202 yards, including six inside the 20-yard line. Florida Atlantic's Dalton Schomp leads the league with 48.0 yards per punt, while Marshall's Tyler Williams has 18 punts inside the 20-yard line.

#GOLDEN STANDARD

SENIOR AUTREY GOLDEN is seeing more action at wide receiver in 2015, but is best known for his special teams play. He's considered one of the greatest kickoff returners in NCAA history.

2,666 – the amount of **YARDS GAINED RETURNING KICKOFFS** during Golden's career. His total ranks second in school history behind Cedric Johnson's 2,757 return yards.

6 – the amount of **KICKOFF RETURN TOUCHDOWNS** Golden has scored during his career. He is UTEP's all-time leader and the active leader in the FBS, leaving him one shy of tying the NCAA record. Golden returned two for scores in each of his first three seasons.

12 – the total number of times Golden has **REACHED PAYDIRT** during his career. His 10-yard receiving touchdown versus Incarnate Word was his third score for the Orange and Blue this season. Overall Golden has six kickoff return TDs, four receiving TDs and two rushing scores.





OVERALL PUNTING

UTEP is ranked ninth in Conference USA with a 35.9 net per punt average. Florida Atlantic leads with a 40.6 average. The Miners have yielded 147 yards on 28 punts (5.2 average per return) this season.

CAPTAINS

The Miners' captains for 2015 feature four seniors and one junior -- (offense) WR **Autrey Golden** and RB **Aaron Jones**, (defense) DL **Roy Robertson-Harris** and LB **Jimmy Musgrave**, and (special teams) DB **Traun Roberson**.

HOME COOKIN'

There are 22 El Paso products on the 2015 roster (three seniors, four juniors, five sophomores and 10 freshmen), including eight on this week's depth chart -- RG **Derek Elmendorff**, WR **Cole Freytag**, LB **Alvin Jones**, P **Alan Luna**, QB **Ryan Metz**, WR **Warren Redix**, LG **Josh Silvas** and DB **Brandon Moss**.

HEAD COACH SEAN KUGLER

Sean Kugler is in his third season as UTEP's head coach, as he went from two wins in his first season to a winning campaign and a bowl bid during his second. He was a four-year letterwinner for the Miners (1985-88) and a three-year starter at right guard. Kugler returned to the Sun City as a UTEP assistant coach (1993-2000), working as a graduate assistant/defensive line coach in 1993, tight ends & assistant strength and conditioning coach in 1994 and offensive line coach from 1995-2000. He coached in the NFL with Detroit (2001-05), Buffalo (2007-09) and Pittsburgh (2010-12) and was also assistant head coach at Boise State in 2006 when the Broncos finished 13-0 and upset Oklahoma, 43-42, in the Fiesta Bowl.

PLAYERS TURNED COACHES

Sean Kugler is the second UTEP head coach who played for the Miners at one time. The other is **Walter Milner**, a three-year letterman from 1931-33 who served as head coach in 1942. Kugler is one of 14 active Division I head coaches who played at the school where they are currently coaching.
