**FIU Interim Head Coach Ron Cooper:** Cooper (Jacksonville State, 1983) is in his first season as interim head coach (1-0, 1.000) and 10th season overall as a head coach (.45-.56, .446). Cooper is 23-33 as an FBS head coach and 22-23 as an FCS head coach. He has never faced UTEP.

**UTEP Head Coach Sean Kugler:** Kugler (UTEP, 1989) is in his fourth season at UTEP (15-27, .357). Kugler is 1-1 all-time versus the Panthers.

**Series History:** Saturday will mark the third meeting all-time between the two programs with the series tied, 1-1. The last meeting between the two teams resulted in a 52-12 win for the Panthers on Oct. 10, 2015, in Miami, Florida.

## Game 6 – FIU Heads West to Face UTEP on Saturday

Coming off the team's first win of the season, FIU will hit the road and head west to take on the UTEP Miners on Saturday, Oct. 8. Kickoff is set for 8:00 p.m. ET with the game being streamed on C-USA TV. Fans can also listen to the game on Conquista 106.3 FM. Josh Appel (play-by-play) and Wes Carroll (color analyst) will be in the booth all season long.

FIU rushed for the most yards in a game since 2010 and wrestled the Don Shula Bowl Trophy from Florida Atlantic in a spirited 33-31 win in Shula Bowl XV at FIU Stadium Saturday night.

The Panthers rushed for 270 yards against the Owls led by Alex Gardner's 119 yards and Anthony Jones who had 90 yards. Quarterback Alex McGough rushed for 61 yards and two touchdowns.

For his efforts, Gardner was named the Shula Bowl MVP for FIU. It was the second consecutive Shula Bowl MVP honor for Gardner, who received the distinction last year in Boca Raton. Greg Howell, who rushed for 101 yards, was named the Shula Bowl MVP for FAU.

The 270 rushing yards for FIU were the fifth most in the program's 14-plus year history and it was the most FIU had rushed for since 2010. Against Troy in 2010, the Panthers ran for a program-record 448 yards. Three Panthers: Darriet Perry, T.Y. Hilton and Darian Mallary each rushed for more than 100 yards against Troy.

Junior linebacker Anthony Wint, who has recorded double-digit tackles in three-straight games as well as in four of the team's five outings on the year, anchored a defense that made a number of crucial stops versus the Owls. The Homestead, Florida, native, tied a season-high in tackles with 12 and forced a crucial fumble on Saturday, earning this week's Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week honors.

The Panthers come into Saturday's game averaging 335.2 yards of total offense-per-game and 17.4 points-per-game. McGough, who was responsible for three touchdowns on Saturday (two rushing, one passing), has thrown for 747 yards on 68-of-129 passing. The Tampa native has recorded two passing touchdowns this season. Joining McGough in the backfield is Gardner, who comes into this week's game with 407 rushing on 84 carries and three rushing touchdowns. The Jacksonville, Florida product is coming off his third 100-yard rushing game with 119 versus the Owls on Saturday. His three 100-yard rushing games are tied for the second-most in the conference this season. Fellow running back Jones had a career-high 90 yards rushing and one touchdown versus the Owls to increase his season total to 191 yards on 40 carries and two touchdowns.

Tight end Jonnu Smith leads all Panthers with 22 receptions for 248 yards. The Ocala, Florida, product has caught a pass in 37-straight games (second-longest streak in school history – 44-straight by Cory McKinney - 2002-2005).

Defensively, the Panthers are led by redshirt junior Treyvon Williams, who has recorded 57 tackles this season, including 4.0 tackles for loss and 3.0 sacks. Williams is second in the conference and seventh in the nation in tackles-per-game (11.4). Right behind Williams is Wint, who has notched 55 tackles with 3.5 tackles for loss and 0.5 sacks. Wint is third in the conference and eighth in the nation in tackles-per-game (11.0). Safety Niko Gonzalez is the secondary's leading tackler with 35 (23 solo), followed by redshirt sophomore Shermarke Spence, who has tallied 22 (15 solo).

Saturday's game will be the third all-time between the two teams. Last season the Panthers defeated the Miners, 52-12, recording 518 yards of total offense (eighth-most in FIU history), while breaking the school record for points in a half (41).

#### Credentials

Credentials for FIU home football games are for working media only. Requests for media credentials should be made in writing on organizational letterhead at least one week prior to home games. Requests should be directed to Paul Dodson, Assistant AD for Media Relations - 11200 Southwest 8 Street FIU Arena, Room 211 Miami, FL 33199. Requests from media covering visiting teams will be confirmed first with each opponent's sports information contact.

Spouses, dates, children under 18 and other non-workers are not permitted in working media areas in compliance with the working code of the Football Writers Association of America (FWAA). All media services (statistics, telephones, game information, etc.) will be readily available for your convenience.

All credentials that cannot be mailed will be left at Media Will Call, which is located Gate 11 (just north of the Field House). Will call will open two (2) hours prior to kickoff. Members of the media picking up credentials at Will Call must provide photo identification and the name must match the name on the credential.

#### Photographers

Photo credentials are issued on a game-by-game basis. FIU will adhere to all NCAA guidelines regarding sideline photography that limit shooting to outside the restraining line enclosing the playing field and outside the 25-yard lines.

#### Parking

Preferred parking at FIU Stadium is extremely limited. Media requesting parking should contact Athletic Media Relations well in advance. Media Parking is located in Lot 7 (west of the stadium).

#### Press Policies

Working space in the press box is limited and assigned on a first-come, first-served basis. Credentials will be issued according to the following criteria:

- 1.) Local and state newspapers by circulation, wire services, national publications, newspapers from opponents' area and student newspapers from FIU and opponents' schools.
- 2.) Other daily newspapers with preference to those that regularly cover FIU.
- 3.) Radio and television personnel not broadcasting but considered reporting.
- 4.) Non-daily newspapers, with preference to those that regularly cover FIU.
- 5.) Scouts.

Freelance bloggers and/or non-daily writers may be asked to produce copies of actual publications in which their work has appeared. In some cases, these materials will be requested as verification of writers' status.

#### Telephones

A limited number of telephone lines are available in FIU Stadium's press box for working media.

FIU provides an ISDN, and Ethernet connection and one business telephone line free of charge to the primary visiting radio outlet.

#### Wireless Internet

The FIU Stadium press box offers free wireless Internet service to media members. Instructions will be provided in the press box on game day.

#### E-Mail/Fax Services

Following each FIU home game, the Athletic Media Relations office will e-mail and/or fax whatever information media members need to their respective agencies. Please ask any member of the FIU athletic media relations staff for assistance on this matter.

#### Post-Game Interviews

After a cooling off period, FIU Head Coach Ron Cooper will be brought to a designated interview room, along with requested players. **THE FIU LOCKER ROOM IS CLOSED TO THE MEDIA.**

Each visiting team will set its own post-game interview policy.

#### Practice Policies

During the season practices are normally conducted at Ocean Bank Field at FIU Stadium. Practice are open to the media. Photographers and videographers should contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department for days and times to shoot practice.

#### Student-Athlete Interviews

Selected FIU players will be made available following practices on Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons throughout the season. Telephone interviews can also be arranged through the FIU Athletic Media Relations office. No players' phone numbers will be given out.

#### Ron Cooper Interviews

Interim Head Coach Ron Cooper is available for on-field interviews at the end of practices, Tuesday through Thursday. For out-of-town interviews with Coach Cooper, please contact the FIU Media Relations office.

#### Conference USA Media Services

Conference USA produces a weekly football release on Mondays throughout the season, which includes updated standings, statistics, results and previews. ## Ron Cooper Named Interim Head Coach

On Sunday, Sept. 25, Ron Cooper was named interim head coach of the FIU football team. Cooper, who entered the year as the team's defensive coordinator also served as the team's defensive backs coach in 2015.

This marks Cooper's fourth head coaching stint (Eastern Michigan – 1993-1994; Louisville – 1995-1997; Alabama A&M – 1998-2001). Saturday will mark his 102nd game as a collegiate head coach (FBS and FCS).

## Wint Named C-USA Defensive Player of the Week

Junior linebacker Anthony Wint has been named the Conference USA Defensive Player of the Week for the week ending Oct. 2 the league announced on Oct. 3.

Wint tied a season-high in tackles with 12 on Saturday night to help FIU defeat rival Florida Atlantic, 33-31, and guide the Panthers to their first win of the season. The Homestead, Florida, native also had a tackle for loss and forced a key fumble in the third quarter that led to an FIU touchdown.

## Familial Faces

The 2016 FIU schedule features no first-time opponents on it. This marks the first time in FIU history that the Panthers will not face at least one first-time opponent in a season. In the 15-year history of FIU football, the Panthers have faced 61 different schools from 23 different states as well as the District of Columbia.

## Versus the Lone Star State

Saturday will mark FIU's 11th trip to the state of Texas with the Panthers owning a 4-6 mark in games played in the Lone Star State. The last time FIU visited Texas, the Panthers lost to North Texas, 17-14, on Nov. 22, 2014. The Panthers have played the Mean Green more times than any other team from Texas - eight times (5-3).

## Ground and Pound

On Saturday, Oct. 1, the Panthers rattled off 270 yards rushing versus Florida Atlantic. Averaging 5.5 yards-per-carry, FIU recorded the fifth-highest rushing total in school history and the most rushing yards since the 2010 season.

## Run, McGough, Run

Quarterback Alex McGough wasn't going to let running backs Alex Gardner and Anthony Jones have all of he fun versus Florida Atlantic. The Tampa, Florida, native rushed for a career-high 61 yards on seven carries including a career-best two rushing touchdowns. One of his touchdown was a career-long 35-yard scamper on fourth-and-one to give FIU a 14-7 lead in the second quarter.

## Interim Head Coach Ron Cooper (Second Season at FIU)



Ron Cooper was named FIU interim head coach on Sept. 25, 2016. Cooper enters his second season on the Panthers' coaching staff and his first as defensive coordinator. Cooper served as the team's defensive backs coach in 2015.

Cooper brings over 30 years of coaching experience to the Panthers' staff, including nine as a head coach on the collegiate level. The 2016 season will mark his fourth stint as a defensive coordinator.

Cooper wrapped up his first season with the Panthers in 2015, overseeing a unit that recorded the sixth-most passes defended (51) and pass breakups (42) in school history. The Panthers had the second-best pass defense in Conference USA, allowing just 221.0 yards-per-game through the air (No. 62 nationally).

Cooper coached Jeremiah McKinnon and Richard Leonard to all-conference honors as the two combined for 16 pass breakups and four interceptions. The secondary accounted for eight of the team's nine picks last season, including a pair for touchdowns (McKinnon -31 yards; Niko Gonzalez - 58 yards).

Prior to FIU, Cooper served as defensive backs coach at USF (2013-2014).

In his two seasons at USF, Cooper helped see the Bulls record 20-or-more turnovers each season, while the defense scored five touchdowns. In 2013, the Bulls triple their forced turnovers from nine the previous season to 25 and score three defensive touchdowns. USF grabbed 11 interceptions, after posting just two the previous season, and ranked 26th in the FBS against the pass.

Cooper transitioned to the NFL after spending three seasons (2009-11) as LSU's secondary coach. He mentored one of the top secondaries in the country that included national award winners in CB Morris Claiborne, CB Patrick Peterson and CB Tyrann Mathieu. Cooper coached two Thorpe Award winners, Peterson in 2010 and Claiborne in 2011, which is given to the top defensive back in college football, and two Bednarik Award winners, Peterson in 2010 and Mathieu in 2011, given to the nation's Defensive Player of the Year. As a sophomore in 2011, Mathieu was also named as a finalist for the Heisman Trophy.

All three players earned consensus All-American honors under Cooper, with Claiborne and Mathieu becoming the first cornerback teammates to earn first-team AP honors in NCAA history. In 2011, Claiborne (Coaches) and Mathieu (AP) each earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year honors, while Peterson (Coaches) earned SEC Defensive Player of the Year in 2010 before being selected fifth overall in the 2010 NFL Draft.

Cooper spent five years at South Carolina prior to being hired by LSU, serving as the defensive backs coach (2004), outside linebackers/special teams coordinator (2005), secondary/assistant head coach (2006-07) and safeties coach (2008). In 2008, Cooper assisted with a defense that ranked No. 1 in the SEC and No. 2 in the nation in pass defense, allowing just 160 yards per game. With the Gamecocks, Cooper helped the team to appearances in the 2005 Independence Bowl, 2006 Liberty Bowl and 2009 Outback Bowl.

Prior to his stint at South Carolina, Cooper spent 2003 as the defensive coordinator at Mississippi State and 2002 as the secondary coach at Wisconsin. He broke into the head coaching ranks with Eastern Michigan (1993-94) and went on to become head coach at Louisville (1995-97) and Alabama A&M (1998-01). Cooper's 1995 Louisville team led the nation in takeaways and finished No. 9 in the nation in scoring defense. The following season, the Cardinals ranked No. 4 in the country in both total defense and rushing defense. At Alabama A&M, Cooper guided the Bulldogs to the Southwestern Athletic Conference Championship Game in 2000. His squad led the nation in rushing defense and they ranked No. 8 nationally in scoring defense. He also discovered DE Robert Mathis and coached him in his first three collegiate seasons with Mathis still holding the school record for career sacks and tackles for loss.

Before becoming the head coach at Eastern Michigan, Cooper served as an assistant coach at Notre Dame (1991-92), helping the Irish to victories over No. 3-ranked Florida in the 1992 Sugar Bowl and No. 4-ranked Texas A&M in the 1993 Cotton Bowl.

Cooper also served as the defensive coordinator at UNLV (1990), assistant coach at East Carolina (1989), defensive coordinator at Murray State (1987-88), assistant coach at Austin Peay (1985-86), graduate assistant at Minnesota (1984) and graduate assistant at Appalachian State (1983).

On the field, Cooper was a four-year letter winner at Jacksonville State, where he was a part of two Gulf South Conference championships in 1981 and 1982. Cooper also played in the NCAA Division II playoffs three times during his career, reaching the semifinal round in 1982.

Cooper earned his bachelor's degree from Jacksonville State in 1983 and later received his master's degree from Appalachian State in 1986. He and his wife, Djuna, have a daughter, Tyler, and two sons, Tristan and Deuce.

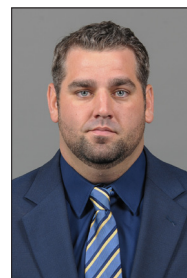

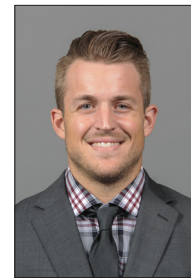

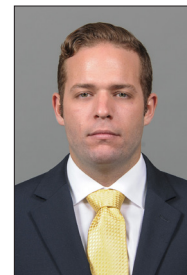

## Indiana 34, FIU 13

MIAMI (Sept. 1, 2016) -- Indiana scored 22 unanswered points in the fourth quarter to come from behind to defeat FIU 34-13 in the season opener for both teams on Thursday night at FIU Stadium.

Down 13-12, the Hoosiers took the lead for good when quarterback Richard Lagow connected with Danny Friend on a 21-yard touchdown pass early in the fourth quarter. Lagow added a 6-yard touchdown run with 6:54 left in the game to extend the Indiana lead to 27-13.

The Hoosiers used a balanced offense to take control of the game late. Indiana rushed for 246 total yards and passed for 240 yards. Devine Redding led all rushers with 135 yards.

The Panthers rallied from a 12-3 deficit in the second quarter thanks to a nifty kickoff return by sophomore Anthony Jones, whose return of 31 yards set FIU at its 44.

One play later quarterback Alex McGough and freshman receiver Stanley Thomas hooked up on a 40-yard strike to the Indiana 14. Junior running back Alex Gardner punched it in for the score from one yard out to narrow the IU lead to 12-10.

Late in the third quarter McGough and Thomas again made a long distance connection this time of 45 yards to the Indiana 30. Thomas, playing in his first college game, led all receivers with 91 yards.

The Panthers got down to the Hoosiers 12 before taking the lead.

FIU claimed a 13-12 edge after Austin Taylor hit a 29-yard field goal with eight seconds left in the third quarter. It was one of two field goals by Taylor, who opened the scoring with a 24-yard field goal less than six minutes into the first quarter.

McGough was 23 of 46 for 263 yards and had three interceptions. Tight end Jonnu Smith led FIU with eight receptions and had 83 receiving yards. Gardner had seven catches for 70 yards.

Defensively, Treyvon Williams led all tacklers with 13 stops, including a sack. The FIU senior linebacker had a game-high nine solo tackles. Anthony Wint had 12 tackles and Niko Gonzalez had 10 tackles.

MIAMI (Sept. 9, 2016) -- Maryland scored the first 17 points of the game against FIU to take control and defeat the Panthers 41-14 Friday night at FIU Stadium. The Terrapins (2-0) added 24 unanswered points after the first FIU (0-2) touchdown in the second quarter.

FIU took the opening possession and reached the Maryland 39 after quarterback Alex McGough started 4 of 6 for 35 yards but the Panthers drive ended when they couldn't convert a fourth-and-3.

Maryland responded with a 23-yard field goal by Adam Greene after the Panthers defense contained the Terps, who had a first-and-goal at the FIU 5.

The Terps scored the first touchdown of the game when Jermaine Carter picked off McGough and returned the turnover 14 yards for a score. Maryland led 10-0 after the first quarter.

Maryland freshman running back Lorenzo Harrison scored his first collegiate touchdown early in the second quarter to extend the lead to 17-0. Harrison scampered 40 yards through the left side.

The Panthers answered on the ensuing possession thanks to a 55-yard run by Alex Gardner, who burst through the middle from the FIU 41 to the Maryland 4. On the next play Gardner scored from four yards out. Gardner had a game-high 109 rushing yards.

However, down 17-7 was as close as FIU would get. The Terps scored the next 24 points before the Panthers final touchdown.

FIU's second touchdown occurred in the fourth quarter when redshirt freshman quarterback Maurice Alexander found receiver Austin Maloney in the back right corner of the end zone for each player's first collegiate touchdown.

Alexander, who played the entire second half and parts of the first half, was 9 of 18 for 131 yards. McGough finished 5 of 10 for 39 yards.

UCF used two quarterbacks, starter McKenzie Milton and Patti, who combined to throw for 225 yards.

MIAMI (Oct. 1, 2016) -- FIU rushed for the most yards in a game since 2010 and wrested the Don Shula Bowl Trophy from Florida Atlantic in a spirited 33-31 win in Don Shula Bowl XV at FIU Stadium Saturday night.

As the clock ticked down in the final seconds of the fourth quarter, the Panthers stormed across the field to collect the Shula trophy that was sitting on a table on the FAU sideline during the game.

The Panthers rushed for 270 yards against the Owls led by Alex Gardner's 119 yards and Anthony Jones who had 90 yards. Quarterback Alex McGough rushed for 61 yards and two touchdowns.

For his efforts, Gardner was named the Shula Bowl MVP for FIU. It was the second consecutive Shula Bowl MVP honor for Gardner, who received the distinction last year in Boca Raton. Greg Howell, who rushed for 101 yards, was named the Shula Bowl MVP for FAU.

The 270 rushing yards for FIU were the fifth most in the program's 14-plus year history and it was the most FIU had rushed for since 2010. Against Troy in 2010, the Panthers ran for a program-record 448 yards. Three Panthers: Darriet Perry, T.Y. Hilton and Darian Mallary each rushed for more than 100 yards against Troy.

In the early stages of the fourth quarter FIU trailed 31-30 but the Panthers running game put them in position to take the eventual lead.

FIU started at its 37 and on the first play Jones ran through the FAU defense for 35 yards to the FAU 28. Gardner collected 13 yards after that to set up Austin Taylor, who drilled a 32-yard field goal to give the Panthers a 33-31 lead.

The teams gave an initial glimpse of the back-and-forth game that awaited in the first two possessions. On the second play of the game, Howell rushed for a 68-yard touchdown. FAU led 7-0.

FIU tied it on the ensuing possession. The Panthers matriculated down field in 12 plays capping their drive with McGough running for a 17-yard touchdown. Nearly midway through the second quarter, McGough made the Owls bite on the read-option and coasted 35 yards in for his second rushing touchdown.

FAU led 17-14 at halftime and intercepted McGough on the first play of the second half and returned it for a touchdown. Azee Al-Shaair took the pick six 30 yards for the score that increased the Owls lead to 24-14.

FIU answered with consecutive touchdowns on a 3-yard run by Jones and a 26-yard pass from McGough to Thomas Owens.

McGough finished 15 of 30 for 199 yards passing with a touchdown pass and two interceptions. Owens had four catches for 61 yards to lead FIU. Jonnu Smith had four grabs for 59 yards
