■ FIU closes out the road portion of its non-conference schedule as it travels across Interstate-75 and Alligator Alley to face intrastate foe Florida Gulf Coast University on Dec. 11 at Alico Arena in Fort Myers ... Tipoff is slated for 8:15 p.m. ... The game can be seen live on ESPN3 with Dave Moulton calling the action and J. Webb Horton providing color commentary ... The matchup against FGCU will be the final game of a three-game road stretch for the Panthers that began on Nov. 30 at Elon University in Elon, North Carolina (L, 84-81 ot) ... Following its game with the Eagles, FIU will begin a season-long five-game homestand beginning on Dec. 15 against Georgia Southern (7 p.m.)

■ The Panthers are coming off a 70-54 loss at No. 20/23 South Carolina on Dec. 4 ... Eric Nottage scored a team-high 20 points, all coming in the second half, while Michael Kessens added 12 points and 10 rebounds for his fifth double-double of the season - and his third-straight - and the 18th of his collegiate career ... Anthony Boswell chipped in with 10 points ... The meeting with the Gamecocks was the first against a Top 25 team for FIU since dropping an 82-57 decision at No. 5 Louisville on Dec. 5, 2014.

## HEAD COACH ANTHONY EVANS



- **Head Coach • St. Thomas Aquinas (N.Y.) (1994)**
- **146-152 (.490) Overall (10th Season) • 47-58 (.448) at FIU (Fourth Season)**
- **Family • Wife, Kisha; Son, Anthony**
- **Date of Birth • March 25, 1970 in Brooklyn, N.Y.**

- Named the eighth head basketball coach at FIU on April 16, 2013.
- Picked up his first win as the head coach at FIU with a 66-58 victory over Kennesaw State on Nov. 10, 2013. The win also marked the 100th-career victory for Evans.
- During the 2015-16 season, Evans continued to watch over the development of All-Conference USA second team member - and NABC All-District honoree Adrian Diaz, one of the top defenders in C-USA. Diaz would become the all-time leader in blocked shots at FIU during his senior campaign. In addition, junior college transfer, Donte McGill rose to be one of the top offensive players in the league averaging 16.1 points-per-game, good enough for eighth in C-USA.
- During the 2014-15 campaign, Evans saw two of his players earn All-Conference USA honors. Dennis Mavin earned second team honors while Adrian Diaz was named to the All-C-USA Defensive Team. Diaz finished the year as the league leader in blocked shots per game (3.0 bpg), and was sixth in NCAA Division I in total blocked shots (99) and seventh in blocked shots per game.
- In his first season at the helm, led FIU to a 15-win season. FIU picked up a big 72-61 victory over cross-state rival and 2012 Sweet Sixteen squad Florida Gulf Coast on Dec. 7 at FIU Arena. FIU earned seven Conference USA wins in its inaugural season in the league, including two victories over rival Florida Atlantic.
- Coached Tylmell Murphy to a Second-Team All-C-USA honor for his play during the 2013-14 season. Murphy finished the year averaging 16.6 points-per-game (No. 4 in the conference) on 58.6 percent shooting from the floor (No. 4 in the conference; No. 18 nationally).
- During his time with the Spartans, Evans amassed a 99-94 record, including back-to-back, 20-win seasons (26-10 in 2011-12 & 21-12 in 2012-13).
- During the 2012-13 season, led Norfolk State to an undefeated Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference regular season mark (16-0) en route to being named the MEAC Coach of the Year and the team's second-straight post-season berth with an automatic bid to the 2013 National Invitation Tournament (NIT).
- Was finalist for the Ben Jobe Award for the 2012-13 campaign, presented to the top minority coach in Division I basketball. He was also named a finalist for the Hugh Durham Award, presented to the top mid-major coach in Division I, and the Jim Phelan Award, presented to the top Division I coach.
- In 2011-12, took the Spartans to new heights with the program's first-ever Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) title and perhaps the biggest upset in NCAA Tournament history. In the 2012 NCAA Tournament, the Evans-led Spartans knocked off the No. 2 seed Missouri Tigers, 86-84, becoming the fifth No. 15 seed (at the time) to defeat a No. 2 seed.

■ McGill leads the team in scoring through nine games this season, averaging 19.1 points-per-contest ... Kessens is averaging a double-double netting 14.5 points-per-game, good enough for second on the team, and a team-high 11.9 rebounds-per-outing ... Nottage rounds out the double-digit scorers netting 12.2 points-per-contest.

■ Anthony Evans is in his fourth season as head coach of the Panthers, and his 10th season overall as a head coach, at both Norfolk State and FIU.

## UP NEXT FOR FIU

■ Following the game at Florida Gulf Coast, the Panthers will return home for a season-long five-game homestand, starting on Dec. 15 against Georgia Southern (7 p.m.) ... FIU will also face Northern Illinois on Dec. 17 (7 p.m.), North Florida on Dec. 21 (7 p.m.), and begin Conference USA play against Marshall on Dec. 31 (1 p.m.) and WKU on Jan. 2 (7 p.m.).

## THE MATCHUP

### SCOUTING THE EAGLES

■ The Eagles come into Sunday's game with the Panthers boasting a 6-3 record following a 73-69 win over Siena on Friday night in Fort Myers ... FGCU has won five-straight games after starting the season 1-3 ... All three losses came against RV Florida (80-59) on Nov. 11, at Baylor (81-72) on Nov. 16 and at No. 13 Michigan State (78-77) on Nov. 20.

■ Brandon Goodwin leads three players in double figures for FGCU, averaging 15.3 points-per-game while Zach Johnson is netting 13.6 points-per-contest ... Christian Terrell rounds out the double-digit scorers dropping in 11.1 points-per-outing ... Demetris Morant and Antravarius Simmons pace the Eagles on the glass, grabbing 5.4 rebounds-per game.

### THE SERIES AGAINST FGCU

■ Sunday's game between FIU and FGCU will be the ninth meeting all-time in the season series ... The Eagles lead the series 4-2, although the actual on court record has the series tied at 4-4 ... FIU had two wins vacated - from the 2002-03 season and the 2003-04 season - due to NCAA sanctions.

## THE LAST TIME VS. THE EAGLES

■ FIU suffered a tough loss, on Dec. 6, 2015, when cross-state rival Florida Gulf Coast handed the Panthers a 84-76 setback in overtime on Lime Court at FIU Arena ... It was FIU's third consecutive loss.

■ FGCU used a 14-0 run, over a 2:32 stretch in the second half, to wipe out a 13-point FIU advantage, and take the lead, 61-60, with 7:41 left in regulation ... The Eagles took control of the overtime scoring the first 10 points, before Adrian Diaz got the Panthers back on the board, with five seconds left in the game on a dunk ... FGCU would ultimately outscore FIU 13-5 in the extra session.

■ Adrian Diaz led four players in double figures, scoring a team-high 19 points ... Jason Boswell and Donte McGill each added 13 points apiece, and Daviyon Draper chipped in with 10 points ... Diaz also grabbed nine rebounds, blocked seven shots, and equaled his career-high for steals, with three, in 40 minutes of action.

■ The Panthers finished the game shooting 49.1 percent (26-of-53) from the field on the day, and 42.9 percent (6-of-14) from behind the three-point arc ... FIU hit just 60 percent (6-of-10) from the free-throw line ... In addition, the Panthers handed the ball over 16 times leading to 15 FGCU points.

## LAST TIME OUT FOR THE PANTHERS

■ FIU is coming off a 70-54 loss to No. 20/23 South Carolina on Dec. 4 in Columbia ... The game against the Gamecocks was the Panthers' first against a Top 25 team for FIU since dropping an 82-57 decision at No. 5 Louisville on Dec. 5, 2014 ... **Scan the QR code with your mobile device to see the complete game recap and stats.**

■ Eric Nottage scored a team-high 20 points, all coming in the second half, while Michael Kessens added 12 points and 10 rebounds for his fifth double-double of the season - and his third-straight - and the 18th of his collegiate career ...

Anthony Boswell chipped in with 10 points ... Cameron Smith also grabbed eight rebounds while Nottage also pulled down six rebounds in the loss.

■ On the afternoon, the Panthers shot 41.3 percent (19-of-46) from the field, while also outrebounding the Gamecocks, 35-34 ... Unfortunately for FIU it recorded a season-high 23 turnovers that led to 24 points off miscues for South Carolina.

## 50-PLUS

■ Through nine games this season, the Panthers have hit for better than 50 percent from the field in four of the nine outings, and just missed 50 percent in a fifth game ... FIU's most recent 50 percent performance was a 53.7 percent (29-of-54) outing against Binghamton on Nov. 27.

■ In the season opener on Nov. 11 against Florida Memorial, FIU shot 54 percent (27-of-50) from the floor while the Panthers hit at a 51.9 percent clip (28-of-54) at Stetson in the loss to the Hatters on Nov. 14 ... It was the first time that FIU had back-to-back 50-percent performances since hitting 57.7 percent (30-of-52) against UTSA on Feb. 13 and 51.8 percent (29-of-56) at North Texas on Feb. 18, of 2016 ... FIU only had back-to-back 50 percent shooting nights three times last season.

■ In the second game of the Red Diamond Roundball Classic in Mobile, Alabama, the Panthers just missed the 50 percent mark, hitting 49.2 percent (30-of-61) of their shots from the floor.

■ FIU shot a season-best 58.6 percent (34-of-58) from the field against Ave Maria on Nov. 23 ... The Panthers' shooting performance from the field against the Gyrenes was their best since hitting 60.4 percent (32-of-53) from the floor against Arkansas State on Nov. 29, 2012.

## FREE LOADERS

■ The Panthers come into the game with Florida Gulf Coast having shot over 81 percent from the free throw line in three of their nine games, and 75 percent in one other contest ... FIU is shooting 73.5 percent from the line on the year.

■ FIU shot 81.8 percent (18-of-22) against South Alabama on Nov. 18 and then 85.7 percent (12-of-14) the next day against Jacksonville on Nov. 19 during the Red Diamond Roundball Classic in Mobile, Alabama.

■ The Panthers posted an impressive 88.9 percent (16-of-18) shooting performance from the charity stripe at Elon on Nov. 30 ... That was FIU's best performance from the line on the year, and their best since hitting 94.4 percent (17-of-18) from the line at WKU on Jan. 7, 2016.

■ FIU has had a clear advantage in rebounding in its eight games this season, holding a rebounding margin of +8.9 ... The Blue and Gold have not been outrebounded in any game this season.

■ Michael Kessens has dominated the glass in his nine games with FIU this year ... He has either led or shared team-high rebounding honors in seven-of-nine games this season and has recorded double-figure rebounds in five outings this season, en route to his team- and Conference USA-high (through games of Dec. 9) 11.9 rebounds-per-game ... Kessens is also fifth in the nation in rebounds-per-game.

■ Kessens' 23 rebounds at Elon on Nov. 30 was a school single-game record and the fifth most in a single game in C-USA history ... It was also tied for the second most in Division I this season (through games of Dec. 9).

■ Kessens pulled down 17 rebounds on Nov.18 against South Alabama.

## DONTE'S TEAM

■ The Panthers lost two of their most productive players from last season in Adrian Diaz and Daviyon Draper, however return their leading scorer from last year Donte McGill ... The senior averaged 16.1 points-per-game last season and was one of FIU's most consistent players hitting for better than 50.0 percent from the field 15 times on the year ... He also scored double figure points in 26 games on the season, which included 11 games of 20 points or more.

■ McGill currently leads the team in scoring, averaging 19.1 points-per-game on the year ... He has produced four 20-point outings in the Panthers' eight games this season coming against Florida Memorial (25 points) on Nov. 11, Jacksonville (23 points) on Nov. 19, Ave Maria on Nov. 23 (23 points) and at Elon (27) on Nov. 30 ... He just missed the 20-point mark with 19 points against Youngstown State on Nov. 20 ... He has netted 20-plus points in two of the last three games played and three of the last five entering the Florida Gulf Coast game.

■ Kessens followed that up with a 12-point, 17-rebound affair in the Panthers' next game against South Alabama on Nov. 18 in the first game of the Red Diamond Roundball Classic.

■ Kessens posted back-to-back double doubles with an 18-point, 10-rebound performance against Binghamton on Nov. 27 ... He followed that up with a 17-point, school single-game record 23-rebound effort at Elon on Nov. 30.

■ Joining Kessens is Eric Lockett (Chipola C.C.), who began his collegiate career at George Mason, Richard Bivens (East Los Angeles C.C.), Ronald Whitaker (SW Tennessee C.C.), Jay Harvey (Shawnee C.C.) and Osasumwen Osaghae, the lone freshman newcomer on the roster who played his scholastic ball at Southridge Senior H.S. in Miami.

## FIU ADDS ONE DURING EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

■ FIU Head Coach Anthony Evans announced the signing of 6-foot-5, 185-pound guard Joshua Stamps from Chicago, Illinois (Trinity Valley C.C./Curie Metropolitan H.S.) to a National Letter of Intent during the recent early signing period.

■ Stamps, currently a sophomore at Trinity Valley in Athens, Texas, is averaging 12.4 points-per-game for the Cardinals through nine games this season on 41.9 percent shooting from the field, including 36.8 percent from three-point range, and 76.5 percent from the free throw line ... ■ Eight teams on the Panthers' schedule this year – South Carolina (NIT), Florida Gulf Coast (NCAA), Northern Illinois (Vegas 8), North Florida (NIT), Middle Tennessee (NCAA), UAB (NIT), Old Dominion (Vegas 8) and Louisiana Tech (Vegas 8) – advanced to the postseason at the end of the 2015-16 season.

### PANTHERS PICKED 11th IN C-USA PRESEASON POLL

■ The FIU Panthers were picked to finish 11th in the Conference USA preseason poll which was selected by the leagues 14 head coaches.

■ UAB picked up 10-of-14 first place votes claiming the top spot ... Defending Conference USA Tournament champion Middle Tennessee, who received three four first place votes was picked second, while Western Kentucky, Marshall and Old Dominion were slated third through fifth, respectively ... UTEP, Louisiana Tech, Charlotte, Rice and North Texas round out the top 10 ... The rest of the C-USA coaches poll is as follows: 11. FIU, 12. Florida Atlantic, 13. Southern Miss, and 14. UTSA.

### PASTRANA JOINS FIU STAFF

■ FIU Head Coach Anthony Evans hired a veteran assistant coach during the offseason as Florida native Erik Pastrana joined the Panthers' staff.

■ Pastrana returns to the Sunshine State after serving the past three seasons as assistant coach at Stephen F. Austin University (SFA) in Nacogdoches, Texas ... While on the bench for the Lumberjacks, Pastrana helped guide the program to arguably one of its most successful three year stretches in school history, winning three Southland Conference (SLC) Tournament Championships – including NCAA Tournament wins in two of his three seasons – and posting a three-year overall record of 89-14, and a 53-1 mark in conference play (59-1 including games in the Southland Conference Tournament).

■ At SFA, Pastrana worked primarily with the Lumberjacks frontcourt players, with those players enjoying tremendous success under his tutelage. Jacob Parker was a two-time All-SLC selection and SLC Player of the year at the conclusion of the 2013-14 season, while Thomas Walkup earned back-to-back SLC Player of the Year honors in 2014-15 and 2015-16, and was also tabbed a two-time Associated Press Honorable Mention All-America.

■ During the 2015-16 campaign, SFA logged a 28-6 record and an 18-0 slate in conference play for the second time in three seasons ... Among the 28 wins was a first round upset in the NCAA Tournament of No. 3 seeded, and eighth-ranked, West Virginia, 70-56.

### DONTE MCGILL NOTES

■ Donte McGill is currently averaging a team-leading 19.1 points-per-game on the year, while shooting 45.2 percent (61-of-135) from the field.

■ McGill had the second-best scoring performance of his collegiate career, netting 27 points, including 23 in the second half, at Elon on Nov. 30 ... McGill was 9-of-21 (42.9 percent) from the field, 1-of-3 (33.3 percent) from three-point

range and a perfect 8-of-8 (100 percent) from the charity stripe against the Phoenix ... He also had a season-high tying five rebounds and two steals.

■ McGill got the season off to a solid start with a 25-point effort against Florida Memorial on Nov. 11 ... At the time it was tied for his second highest point total of his career, at FIU, also accomplishing the feat against Elon on Dec. 4, 2015 ... McGill also fell just shy of his 25-point season-opening performance, twice, with a 23-point outing against Jacksonville on Nov. 19 during the second day of the Red Diamond Roundball Classic and against Ave Maria on Nov. 23.

■ McGill has poured in 20-plus points in 13 of his last 29 games and in 15 of his last 34 outings, dating back to last season.

■ In addition, McGill has scored in double-figures in 33 of his 39 games played for the Panthers, and in 16 of his last 17.

■ McGill returns to the hardwood for his final collegiate season at FIU after leading the Panthers in scoring during the 2015-16 campaign ... The senior averaged 16.1 points-per-game last season and was one of FIU's most consistent players hitting for better than 50.0 percent from the field 15 times on the year ... He also scored double-figure points in 26-of-31 games played - which included 11 games of 20 points or more - and in 25-of-27 games to end last season.

■ McGill finished last season eighth in Conference USA in scoring and fifth in three-point field goal percentage (42.2 percent).

■ McGill was, surprisingly, third on the team in rebounding last year grabbing 4.6 boards-per-game, which included 1.5 rebounds-per-game on the offensive glass from the guard position.

■ McGill poured in a career-high 29 points - 23 of which came in the first half - against Louisiana Tech on Jan. 14, 2016 ... He was 10-of-18 (55.6 percent) from the field, including 3-of-5 (60.0 percent) from three-point range, and a perfect 6-of-6 (100.0 percent) from the free-throw line ... McGill's 55.6 percent from the floor marked, a then, career-high.

■ Michael Kessens is second on the team in scoring, averaging 14.5 points-per-game and leads the Panthers - and Conference USA (through Dec. 9) - in rebounding, grabbing 11.9 rebounds-per-contest ... His 11.9 boards-per-outing is fifth in the nation through games of Dec. 10.

■ Kessens is leading the team in field goal shooting percentage, hitting 64.7 percent (44-of-68) of his shots from the floor on the year ... He has shot better than 65 percent five times this season, and 50-plus percent six times - including in his last five games played ... In addition, Kessens is hitting at a remarkable 75 percent clip (27-of-36) in his last five games.

He scored 11 points and 13 rebounds at Stetson on Nov. 14, and followed that up with a 12-point, 17-rebound effort at South Alabama on Nov. 18 ... It was Kessens' 14th and 15th double-doubles, respectively of his collegiate career spanning Longwood, Alabama and now FIU.

■ Kessens has posted three-straight double-doubles ... He recorded an 18-point, 10-rebound performance against Binghamton on Nov. 27 ... He then logged 17 points and a school single-game record 23 rebounds at Elon on Nov. 23 before scoring 12 points and grabbing 10 rebounds at No. 20/23 South Carolina on Dec. 4 ... Kessens has 18 double-doubles during his collegiate career.

■ Kessens is a transfer from Alabama where he played in all 33 contests, starting 21 games in his final season with the Crimson Tide ... Connected on 48-of-86 shots on the year to rank third on the team in field goal percentage (.558) ... Averaged 3.7 points-per-game and 3.5 rebounds per outing in 2015-16 ... Played in 65 career games for the Tide with 31 starts.

■ Played his rookie season at Longwood University for current FIU assistant coach Mike Gillian who was head coach of the Lancers ... Earned numerous accolades, including selection to the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Freshmen All-America Team and Big South Freshman of the Year ... Voted the Virginia Sports Information Directors Association (VaSID) Rookie of the Year ... Averaged 13.7 points- and 8.8 rebounds-per-game in his one season with the Lancers.

## ERIC NOTTAGE NOTES

■ Eric Nottage is currently averaging 12.2 points-per-game, good enough for third on the team in scoring ... In addition, the Miami native is second on the team in rebounding, grabbing 5.9 boards-per-contest from the guard position.

■ Nottage is shooting 52.7 percent (39-of-74) from the field on the year, but is also hitting at a 58.1 percent (18-of-31) clip in his last four games and 57.1 (8-of-14) from behind the three-point arc in his last three games played.

■ Nottage had a career-high 20-point performance at Stetson, on Nov. 14, in which he shot 70 percent (7-of-10) from the field and 3-of-4 (75 percent) from both behind the three-point arc and the free-throw line ... He surpassed his previous career-best of 15 points against LIU on Nov. 15, 2015... Nottage also had five rebounds and had four assists in 25 minutes of action ... In addition, he also had five rebounds in the loss to the Hatters.

■ Most recently, Nottage equaled his career-best at No. 20/23 South Carolina on Dec. 4 when he netted 20 points - all coming in the second half against the Gamecocks - on 7-of-11 (63.6 percent) from the field and 3-of-4 (75 percent) from both behind the three-point arc and the free throw line ... Nottage also had six rebounds, two assists and two steals against South Carolina.

■ Nottage followed up his original career-high against Stetson on Nov. 14 with an 18-point effort at South Alabama on Nov. 18 to go along with his eight rebounds.

■ Nottage had an impressive 16-point scoring performance at Elon on Nov. 30, in addition to a career-high tying nine rebounds ... Nottage scored all 16 points in the second half, including the last 12 points of regulation for FIU in the overtime loss ... He hit the game tying trey as time expired in regulation, after retrieving the rebound from his initial three-point attempt just seconds before.

■ Nottage netted 12 points on 80 percent (4-of-5) shooting from the field, including 3-of-4 (75 percent) from three-point range, and 1-of-2 (50 percent) from the free throw line against Binghamton on Nov. 27.

■ Nottage saw action in all 32 games last season for the Panthers, and started in nine of the first 10 games ... Nottage averaged 4.3 points-per-game and provided solid backup in the backcourt for FIU.

■ Nottage led the Panthers in total assists (81) and assists-per-game (2.5 apg) during 2015-16 ... He has dished out four assists or more nine times, including a career-high six dimes against Louisiana Tech on Jan. 14, 2016.

While several interviews are conducted over the phone, the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department will never give out student-athlete's cell phone numbers or private contact information. In-person interviews will take place, either in the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (FIU Arena Room 211) or after practice. Please contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department for ALL interview requests. Other accommodations can be arranged through the Athletic Media Relations Department.

### Coaches and Staff Interviews

Interviews with Head Coach Anthony Evans must come through the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Interviews should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. No member of the FIU staff may be interviewed without permission by the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Personal numbers of both coaches and staff members will not be given out.

### Covering Practice

All practices are closed to the media, as are walk-throughs, at FIU Arena on the day of all home games. Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes will be made available after practice. # PLAYER NOTES

## KIMAR WILLIAMS NOTES

■ Kimar Williams is currently averaging 5.8 points-per-game on the year and has scored in double figures in three of his nine outings, including a season-high 11-point effort at South Alabama on Nov. 18 ... His three double-figure games in the first four contests equal the same amount in 32 games played during his 2015-16 freshman campaign.

■ Williams also scored 10 points and grabbed six rebounds in the season-opener against Florida Memorial on Nov. 11 ... He was 4-of-8 (50 percent) from the field and 2-of-4 (50 percent) from the free-throw line in the win.

■ Williams averaged 3.8 points-per-game in 32 games - including 22 starts - and averaged 3.0 rebounds-per-game during the 2015-16 season ... He scored in double figures three times, including a career-high 13 points at Northern Illinois on Dec. 19, 2015.

■ Williams may have averaged just 3.8 points-per-game during his freshman season at FIU, however the Philadelphia native made a significant impact getting his teammates involved on the floor ... The 6-1 sophomore finished tied for fifth in Conference USA among all freshmen in assists, handing out 2.5 per-outing ... In addition, he recorded the second most assists in a season (79) at FIU, second only to former Panther great, and NBA and international standout Carlos Arroyo (135).

## ANTHONY BOSWELL NOTES

■ Anthony Boswell scored a season-high 10 points on 4-of-6 (66.7 percent) shooting from the field and 2-of-3 (66.7 percent) from three-point range against Ave Maria on Nov. 23 ... Boswell equaled that mark with a 10-point effort at No. 20/23 South Carolina ... He was 3-of-6 (50 percent) from the field, 2-of-4 (50 percent) from three-point range and 2-of-2 (100 percent) from the free throw line.

■ Boswell also had seven points against Youngstown State on Nov. 20 during the final day of the Red Diamond Round-ball Classic.

■ Boswell finished last season fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 5.0 points-per-game ... He was the only player on the Panthers' roster to start in all 32 games.

■ Boswell scored in double-figure points in six games last year, including a career-high 14 points against Oral Roberts on Nov. 22, 2015.

## ELMO STEPHEN NOTES

■ Elmo Stephen comes into tonight's game fourth on the team in scoring, averaging 7.4 points-per-game on the year.

■ Stephen has recorded double-figure scoring performances in two of his last four games, including a career-high 20-point night against Ave Maria on Nov. 23 ... 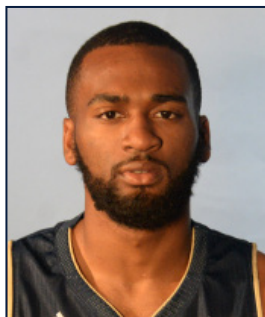

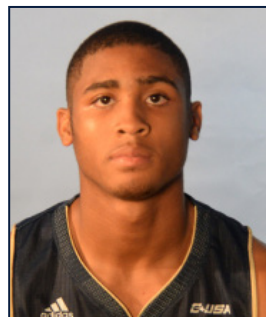
