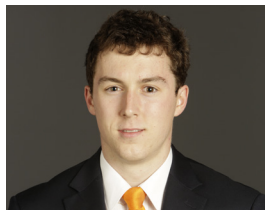

OPENING TIP

■ After playing its first three C-USA games on the road, UTEP (2-13, 0-3 C-USA) will be home for three straight and seven of nine starting on Thursday when it hosts FIU (4-12, 0-3 C-USA). Tip-off is at 7 p.m.

■ UTEP will try to snap a six-game home losing streak against the Panthers, who are winless in six road games this season.

■ The Miners will be playing three consecutive C-USA home games for the fifth time since joining the league in 2005. This also occurred once each during the 2011-12, 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons. UTEP was 3-0 twice and 2-1 twice in the previous three-game C-USA homestands.

■ The matchup with FIU on Thursday is UTEP's first in the Don Haskins Center since Dec. 22, three weeks to the day.

■ The Miners are 72-17 in C-USA home games. UTEP has won 16 of its last 17 league home games dating back to the 2014-15 season; the only loss was to FIU, 79-69, on Jan. 23, 2016.

■ The Miners have been particularly good in C-USA home games in the month of January, posting a 31-6 record with wins in 20 of their last 23 outings.

■ UTEP is 43-12 in C-USA home games under coach Tim Floyd.

ABOUT FIU

■ The Panthers have three starters and eight letterwinners back from last year's 13-19 squad. The returning starters are senior guard Anthony Boswell, senior guard Donte McGill and sophomore guard Kimar Williams.

■ McGill is averaging a team-leading 18.8 ppg, fourth in C-USA. He leads the league and rates 10th nationally in free throw percentage (.924).

■ Graduate transfer Michael Kessens, who played in 65 games for Alabama from 2014-16, is averaging 14.1 ppg and 10.1 rpg (first C-USA/25th NCAA). The 6-9, 228-pound Kessens is shooting 57.1 percent from the field.

■ Senior forward Elmo Stephen has stepped up his game in C-USA play, averaging 12.0 ppg while shooting 58.3 percent (7-for-12) from three-point land. He averaged 6.4 ppg in non-conference games with a .279 (12-for-43) three-point percentage.

■ FIU has been one of the top teams in C-USA in rebound margin (+5.4 rpg, third) and free throw percentage (.731, fourth).

■ The Panthers' 0-6 road mark includes losses at Stetson (82-67), South Alabama (69-64 in overtime), Elon (84-81 in overtime), South Carolina (70-54), Florida Gulf Coast (82-63) and Florida Atlantic (73-64).

SERIES HISTORY

■ UTEP is 7-1 all-time against FIU and 5-1 since the Panthers joined Conference USA for the 2013-14 season.

■ The Miners have knocked the Panthers out of the league tournament each of the last two years.

■ Last year the Panthers won at the Haskins Center, 79-69, ending UTEP's 11-game Conference USA homecourt win streak.

THE LAST MEETING

■ Lee Moore scored a career-high 30 points, 22 in the second half, as UTEP advanced to the C-USA Championship quarterfinals with an 85-77 victory over FIU on March 9, 2016 at Legacy Arena in Birmingham.

■ UTEP led by 15 points in the first half, only to see the Panthers rally to take a three-point lead in the final five minutes before closing the game with an 18-7 run.

■ Donte McGill scored 16 of his 24 points in the second half for FIU. Daviyon Draper added 17 points and Adrian Diaz had a double-double with 14 points and 11 rebounds.

■ The Miners had two runs in the first half. The first was 10-2 and extended a 13-12 lead to 23-14. The second was 10-4 and pushed a 28-19 advantage to 38-23. UTEP led 40-29 at the half.

■ The Miners had their difficulties at the free throw line to start the second half and FIU was able to hang around as a result. The Panthers cut the lead to single digits early in the frame and, off an 18-8 run, pulled within one (56-55) with 9:49 to go.

■ When Diaz made two free throws with 5:01 to play, FIU had its first lead (67-65) since 3-2.

■ Draper's three at the 4:19 mark allowed the Panthers to match their largest lead of three points (70-67). Dominic Artis answered with a three for the Miners to tie it. That started a run of 10 straight points that put UTEP up 77-70 and back in charge.

■ Moore scored 10 points in the final 3:22. He finished 8-for-9 from the field and 12-for-12 from the line with seven rebounds, five assists and three steals.

■ Earvin Morris scored 25 points, 15 in the first half, for the Miners. Artis added 11 points, five rebounds and five assists with no turnovers for a UTEP team that only had seven giveaways.

■ The Miners shot 51 percent and the low turnover number was crucial on a night where they were out-rebounded 43-24.

LAST GAME:

SOUTHERN MISS 73, UTEP 65

■ UTEP's Omega Harris and Dominic Artis combined for 49 points, but Southern Miss converted 16 Miner turnovers into 24 points and raced to a 73-65 victory on Saturday in Hattiesburg.

■ The Miners couldn't get to the line in the first half. In the second half they went to the line 19 times, making 12, and held Southern Miss to 39.3 percent shooting. That was good enough to play the Golden Eagles to a 34-34 draw, but not enough to carve into a 39-31 halftime deficit.

■ UTEP got down by 11 early in the second half. The Miners scored the next seven points to make it 48-44, but couldn't get closer.

■ Another key stretch came midway through the second half when, after Harris' free throw made it a six-point game (54-48), Southern Miss' Robert Thomas nailed a three-pointer.

■ Finally, with UTEP trailing by six (69-63) and under two minutes left, Artis and Harris missed a series of shots that could've made things interesting had they gone down.

■ The duo shot a combined 19-for-41 from the field, 4-for-19 from three-point range and 7-for-12 from the line as Harris scored a career-high 26 points, and Artis added 23 points, 13 rebounds and four steals.

■ The Miners went on a 9-2 run early in the first half to take a 13-10 lead. The game was closely contested for most of the period until the Golden Eagles outscored the Miners 9-2 over the final 3:01 to go into the locker room up eight. Artis ended a string of nine consecutive points for the Golden Eagles by banking in a jumper right before the buzzer.

■ Quinton Campbell scored 24 points with 10 rebounds for Southern Miss. Cortez Edwards scored 17 points. The Golden Eagles shot 46.3 percent and scored 30 points in the paint.

■ Dominic Artis was ninth in the nation in assists (6.5 apg), 16th in minutes (36.2 mpg) and 34th in steals (2.1 spg) through Jan. 10. Omega Harris was 24th in minutes (35.8 mpg).

ARTIS' ALL-AROUND SEASON

■ Dominic Artis leads the Miners in rebounding (6.5 rpg), assists (6.5 apg), steals (2.1 spg) and minutes (36.2 mpg), and ranks second in scoring (15.1 ppg).

■ Eight players have led the Miners in assists and steals in a season -- Byron Walker (1981-82, 1982-83), Jeep Jackson (1985-86), Tim Hardaway (1986-87, 1987-88, 1988-89), Prince Stewart (1989-90), Alton Sanders (1997-98), Eugene Costello (2000-01, 2001-02), Filiberto Rivera (2003-04) and Edgar Moreno (2005-06). No player has led UTEP in assists, steals and rebounds.

■ Artis has led the Miners in scoring five times, rebounds five times, assists 14 times and steals 11 times in 2016-17.

■ Artis leads C-USA in assists and ranks second in steals. The last Miner to lead the league in assists was Filiberto Rivera in the WAC in 2004-05 (7.2 apg), and the last to lead the conference in steals was Randy Culppepper in 2010-11 (2.03 spg).

■ Since Conference USA's inception for the 1995-96 season, only one player has led the league in assists and steal average. That was LA Tech's Kenneth Smith in 2013-14.

■ Artis has tied the school record for most games with 12+ assists in a season (three). Rivera also compiled three such games during the 2004-05 season.

■ Artis' collective points, rebounds, assists and steals amount to 454, which is 25.6 percent (454-of-1,772) of UTEP's team total.

MORE ON "D.A"

■ Dominic Artis has career totals of 962 points, 375 rebounds, 413 assists and 134 steals in his fourth collegiate season (2012-14 at Oregon, 2015-present at UTEP). He has played in 101 career games.

■ Artis has dished out 268 assists at UTEP including 170 last season, 10th-most in school history.

■ Artis ranks 14th in school history in assists. Marvin Kilgore and Johnny Melvin are tied for 12th place with 270 assists, Julian Washburn is 11th with 274 and C.J. Cooper is 10th with 275.

2016-17 UTEP BASKETBALL

■ The UTEP record for assists by a two-year player is 381 by Filiberto Rivera in 2003-05.

■ Artis has come close to posting only the second triple-double in school history on several occasions. Last season's close calls came versus Loyola (16 points/nine rebounds/eight assists), UTRGV (21 points/eight rebounds/eight assists), LA Tech (23 points/10 rebounds/nine assists) and Florida Atlantic (13 points/nine rebounds/nine assists). He had eight points/nine rebounds/13 assists in the opener against Louisiana College, and 20 points/10 rebounds/nine assists versus Western Michigan. The only triple-double in Miner history was registered by Jason Williams versus Lipscomb (17 points, 11 rebounds, 10 assists) in the NIT on March 14, 2006.

■ Artis has recorded multiple steals in nine games this season, including a career-high tying five at New Mexico on Dec. 7.

ARTIS & 100 DIMES

■ With two more assists, Dominic Artis will go over the century mark for the second consecutive season at UTEP.

■ He will become the 14th Miner to enjoy multiple 100-assist campaigns, joining Byron Walker (1981-82, 1982-83), Jeep Jackson (1985-86, 1986-87), Tim Hardaway (1986-87, 1987-88, 1988-89), Prince Stewart (1988-89, 1989-90, 1991-92), Eddie Rivera (1991-92, 1992-93), Eggie McRae (1998-99, 1999-00), Eugene Costello (2000-01, 2001-02), Filiberto Rivera (2003-04, 2004-05), Jason Williams (2003-04, 2004-05, 2005-06), Marvin Kilgore (2006-07, 2007-08), Julyan Stone (2008-09, 2009-10, 2010-11), Jacques Streeter (2011-12, 2012-13) and C.J. Cooper (2013-14, 2014-15).

OMEGA IS THE ALPHA

■ Omega Harris leads UTEP in scoring (17.4 ppg) after collecting 6.7 ppg as a freshman and 12.3 ppg as a sophomore.

■ Harris is a career 44 percent (260-for-591) shooter from the field, 39.5 percent (105-for-266) from three and 74.9 percent (134-for-179) from the line. He has scored 759 points.

■ He is tied for 14th in school history in three-point field goals (105) with former teammate Earvin Morris.

■ Harris' .395 career three-point field goal percentage would tie for fourth in the UTEP record book.

■ Harris has scored 20+ points five times this season. He had two 20-point games combined in his first two years with the Miners.

■ Dating back to last season, he has scored in double figures 21 times in his last 23 games (13 of 15 in 2016-17).

■ The 17 points after halftime against Northern Arizona (Dec. 16) were the most Harris has scored in a half at UTEP.

SECOND COMING

■ 7'1" Matt Willms returned this season after missing most of 2015-16 with a fracture of the navicular bone in his foot that required a similar surgery as fellow big men Joel Embiid and Greg Oden.

■ It was the second major surgery of Willms' career; he had surgery for a torn labrum in his shoulder in 2014.

■ Willms is second in Conference USA in field goal percentage (.590) while averaging 10.1 points, 5.4 rebounds and 1.1 blocks.

■ Willms has appeared in 78 games for the Miners, with 48 starts, and collected 479 points, 322 rebounds and 75 blocked shots. His career field goal percentage is .562 (186-for-331).

■ He is tied for 11th place in school history in blocked shots with Marlon Maxey. Claude Britten is in 10th place with 78 blocks.

BARRETT'S BREAKOUT

■ Freshman Deon Barrett scored a career-high 25 points in the second half at New Mexico on Dec. 7.

■ Barrett tied the school freshman record with seven three-pointers against the Lobos. Randy Culpepper also made seven versus SMU in the Conference USA Tournament on March 12, 2008 in Memphis.

■ Barrett's .875 three-point percentage (7-for-8) versus UNM was the best for a UTEP player in a game with a minimum seven makes. The previous record was .778 (7-for-9) by Jarvis Mullahon at NM State on Nov. 28, 1998.

■ Barrett tied the Conference USA record for three-point percentage in a game (minimum eight attempts) with his performance at UNM. Tulane's Patrick Lewis was also 7-for-8 at Saint Louis on Feb. 14, 1996.

■ Barrett's seven three-pointers against UNM are tied for the most by a C-USA player this season. LA Tech's Jacobi Boykins also made seven at Louisiana-Lafayette on Dec. 10.

■ Barrett is averaging 5.1 points and 1.5 assists in 18.7 minutes per game. He leads UTEP in three-point field goal percentage (.444).

FRESHMEN UNDER FLOYD

■ Deon Barrett's 25 points at New Mexico were the second-most by a Miner freshman under seventh-year head coach Tim Floyd.

■ Barrett became the seventh UTEP freshman to tally 20 points or more in a game during the Floyd era.

JAKE DOES THE DIRTY WORK

■ Jake Flaggert led Conference USA in charges drawn (18) last season, and is back at it in 2016-17 with a team-leading 14 in 15 games.

■ Flaggert has 38 charges drawn in his Miner career (76 games).

■ Three of Flaggert's four career double-figure scoring games have come early this season, including a personal best 15 points against Northern Arizona (Dec. 17). Flaggert also had a UTEP-high five three-point field goals versus the Lumberjacks.

■ Flaggert also pulled down a collegiate best nine rebounds versus Maryland Eastern Shore on Dec. 21.

■ He leads the Miners with a .909 free throw percentage and has made 10-of-11 attempts.

■ Flaggert played a career-high 36 minutes in the C-USA opener at UTSA (Jan. 1).

JONES' STORY

■ One of the freshmen UTEP is counting on this season -- 6-11 Kelvin Jones -- has had an amazing road to El Paso.

■ He grew up in Galeana, Chihuahua, Mexico, where his father was the mayor. He played soccer and volleyball.

■ In 2011, after cartel violence claimed two relatives, the family left in the middle of the night and moved to Bismarck, North Dakota.

■ Jones started playing basketball his freshman year in high school. He was 6-9 and the school didn't have a volleyball program.

■ He finished his prep career at Hobbs [N.M.] High School, where he averaged 14.7 points, 9.9 rebounds and 3.2 blocks for a 30-2, state championship team.

■ Jones put on 20 pounds in-between his junior and senior seasons.

■ He walked on his first year at UTEP and sold pesticides door-to-door in Houston so he could have enough money to pay for his college tuition.

■ Jones is averaging 3.3 points, 3.5 rebounds and 1.0 blocks in 15 games (two starts).

MINERS TIE 3-POINT RECORD

■ UTEP made 15 three-pointers at New Mexico on Dec. 7 to tie the school single-game record.

■ The Miners also made 15 triples versus UT Permian Basin (Nov. 22, 2003) and East Carolina (Feb. 13, 2010).

■ The Miners' 15 three-pointers versus UNM tied the second-most by a C-USA team in 2016-17. Marshall made 17 at Cincinnati on Dec. 22.

MINER NUGGETS

■ The Miners have held four of their last six opponents to field goal percentages under 40, although they haven't been able to post a win. During that span the Miners' defensive field goal percentage is .411 (129-for-314). In the first nine games of the season, opponents shot 48.1 percent.

■ The Miners also have yielded 69.3 ppg over the last six games, down from 75.2 ppg in the first nine outings.

■ UTEP is third in C-USA in defensive field goal percentage for league games only (.401) behind LA Tech (.387) and Old Dominion (.393).

■ UTEP has had two double-figure scorers in four of its last five games.

■ The Miners' last game at Southern Miss produced two 20-point scorers in a C-USA game (Dominic Artis & Omega Harris) for the first time since Feb. 11, 2016 at FIU (Harris & Lee Moore).

■ Omega Harris is sixth in C-USA in scoring for league games only (20.3 ppg).

■ Omega Harris has scored 20 points in back-to-back games for the first time as a Miner. He is the first UTEP player to score 20+ points in consecutive games versus C-USA opponents since Earvin Morris did so against UTSA (23) and FIU (25) in March of last year.

■ Harris tied career-highs for field goals made (nine) and attempted (18) in the Miners' last game at Southern Miss.

■ Harris has scored in double figures in a career-high 10 straight games. Artis has the longest streak by a Miner player in 2016-17 (12 games).

■ Artis' 13 rebounds at Southern Miss on Saturday were a career best, and his third double-digit output this season.

■ Paul Thomas has been the Miners' most-improved player since the start of conference play, averaging 8.0 points and 5.7 rebounds with a .579 field goal percentage.

■ Thomas has played 30 minutes or more in two of the last three games, the only times in his career that he has reached that mark.

■ UTEP has used eight different starting lineup combinations in 15 games, with nine players making at least one start.

■ The Miner bench has been outscored by a combined 322-201 this season, with the differential more pronounced in league play (65-11).

■ UTEP has outrebounded back-to-back C-USA opponents (LA Tech & Southern Miss) for the first time since February of 2016. However, the last time they outrebounded consecutive league foes on the road was in January of 2010 (Memphis & UCF).

THE FLOYD ERA

■ UTEP has posted 124 wins under coach Tim Floyd, who is in his seventh season.

■ The Miners have fashioned a mark of 63-40 in Conference USA play under Floyd, with top-three finishes on three occasions (tied for second 2010-11, third 2012-13, tied for second 2014-15).

■ UTEP has registered double-digit C-USA victories in five of the six years, including in each of the last four.

MORE ON FLOYD

● Tim Floyd is in his seventh season on the UTEP bench with a career record of 452-270, including 124-90 with the Miners.

● He has the most career wins among current C-USA coaches.

● Floyd ranks second in school history in victories behind the legendary Don Haskins (719) and has also coached the second-most games of any UTEP coach (214).

● Floyd has enjoyed 20 winning seasons in 22 years as a collegiate head coach. His teams have made eight NCAA Tournament appearances and five trips to the NIT.

● Floyd previously was the head coach at Idaho (1986-88), New Orleans (1988-94), Iowa State (1994-98) and USC (2005-09). He was also head coach of the Chicago Bulls (1998-2002) and the New Orleans Hornets (2003-04) in the NBA.

DEFENSE UNDER FLOYD

● UTEP has allowed less than 70 points 134 times under Tim Floyd (in 214 games), less than 60 points 73 times and less than 50 points on 17 occasions.

● The Miners have held 86 teams under 40 percent shooting, posting a 71-15 record. UTEP has lost four times this season where opponents have shot less than 40 percent, all over the last six games.

MINERS SIGNED UP FOR SAN JUAN

■ UTEP is one of eight teams participating in the 2017 Tire Pros Puerto Rico Tip-Off. The Miners will join Boise State, Florida State, Illinois State, Iowa State, South Carolina, Tulsa and Western Michigan in the event Nov. 16-19 at the Coliseo Roberto Clemente in San Juan. The tournament field was announced in November by ESPN Events.

■ Iowa State and Tulsa participated in the 2016 NCAA Tournament, while Florida State and South Carolina earned bids to the NIT.

■ UTEP will be making its first appearance in the tournament, but Miner head coach Tim Floyd is no stranger to the event. His USC Trojans were invited to the 2008 Puerto Rico Tip-Off.

NOVEMBER SIGNEES

■ Evan Gilyard, Kobe Magee, Tirus Smith and Roderick Williams have signed national letters of intent to play basketball at UTEP beginning with the 2017-18 season, Miner head coach Tim Floyd announced in November.

■ Gilyard is a 5-9, 160-pound guard from Simeon Career Academy in Chicago, which has produced numerous NBA standouts including Milwaukee Bucks forward Jabari Parker and New York Knicks guard Derrick Rose. Gilyard is regarded as a three-star prospect by ESPN and the no. 13 player in Illinois. He averaged 13.5 points and 3.2 assists last season while shooting 49 percent from three-point range. He was second team All-City, two-time All-Conference and honorable mention All-State. He scored 14 points in the fourth quarter of the city championship game as Simeon beat Kenwood 54-49. Gilyard, who has led Simeon Career Academy to a 96-7 record, continued to turn heads on the AAU circuit this summer while playing for the Meanstreets' 16- and 17-under teams.

■ Magee is a 6-0, 140-pound guard from Brandeis High School in San Antonio. He averaged 17.9 points as a junior with 79 three-pointers, helping Brandeis to a 31-2 mark and a top-10 state ranking. He has scored 1,281 points in 89 prep games (14.4 ppg) with 147 three-point field goals and owns a career .421 percentage from beyond the arc. A starter since his freshman year, Magee has garnered All-District honors twice and has been a part of three 20-win teams. He was appointed to the Northside NISD and San Antonio ISD All-Tournament teams on a pair of occasions.

■ Smith is a 6-8, 230-pound forward from Petal (Miss.) High School. Now in his third year as a varsity letterwinner, he was appointed to The Clarion-Ledger's "Dandy Dozen" as one of the 12 best players in the state of Mississippi for the 2016-17 campaign. He averaged 16 points, 11 rebounds and 2.5 blocks last season. Smith participated in the MAC/Mississippi Sports Medicine All-Star Classic as a member of the South team in March. Smith also played for the Elfrid Payton Elite AAU team.

■ Williams is a 6-7, 210-pound forward from Los Angeles, Calif. who is currently attending East Los Angeles College. He will have three years of eligibility with the Miners. Williams previously played at Price High School in L.A., where he was named the 2015 John R. Wooden High School Player of the Year for the CIF Los Angeles City Section (Division VI). He led Price in scoring in back-to-back years and to the semifinals at the 2015 California state playoffs. Regarded as a three-star recruit by ESPN.com and the no. 19 player in California, Williams averaged 16 points and seven rebounds as a prep senior. He was first team All-CIF.

■ The Miners' fall recruiting class also includes guards Isiah Osborne and Trey Wade who are currently with the program and sitting out the 2016-17 campaign. The 6-5, 190-pound Osborne averaged 15.0 points at the University of Windsor last year. He was named the CIS (Canadian Interuniversity Sport) Rookie of the Year as well as the OUA (Ontario University Athletics) Rookie of the Year. The 6-5, 180-pound Wade hails from South Cobb High School in Austell, Ga. He averaged 19.1 points and 7.5 rebounds as a senior in 2015-16, shooting 48 percent from the field.

LOOKING AHEAD

■ The Miners will host Florida Atlantic on Saturday at 7 p.m. UTEP leads the series 3-1, including a clean sweep during the 2015-16 season. The Miners beat the Owls in El Paso (71-56) and Boca Raton (89-82).

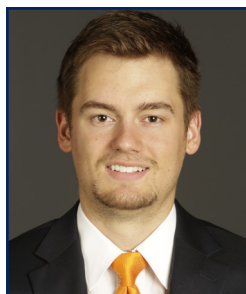
