BLUE RAIDER BREAKDOWN

- ♦ Middle Tennessee debuted in the first NCAA RPI of the season at eighth in the country before rising as high as third and enters the game against FIU with the 23rd-rated RPI in Division I basketball
- ♦ Middle is currently represented in the USA Today Coaches Poll with four points
- ♦ The Blue Raiders received three votes worth seven points in the week six (Dec. 12) AP poll, marking the first time they have been represented in the poll since March 4, 2013
- ♦ MT stands atop the Conference USA standings as the lone unbeaten at 5-0, its best start in league play since the 2011-12 season when the Blue Raiders started 9-0 in the Sun Belt
- ♦ Senior F **JaCorey Williams** is currently eighth in the nation in field goals made (138)
- ♦ Through 18 games **JaCorey Williams** (17.9 ppg), **Giddy Potts** (15.2 ppg) and **Reggie Upshaw** (15.2 ppg) all stand in the Top 12 in Conference USA in scoring
- ♦ Among active D-I players, **Giddy Potts** is 11th in the nation in career 3-point percentage (.437) while **Reggie Upshaw** is 16th in career rebounds (787)
- ♦ MT has protected the ball at an exceptional rate in 2016-17, currently standing 13th in the nation in turnovers per game (10.7), 25th in turnover margin (+3.5) and 13th in assist-to-turnover ratio (1.50)
- ♦ The Blue Raiders also rank 37th nationally in field goal percentage, converting 48.0 percent of its shots as a team
- ♦ With double-doubles against Vanderbilt (13 points, 10 rebounds), at Belmont (18 points, 11 rebounds) and at VCU (17 points, 14 rebounds), **Williams** became the first Blue Raider since Aylton Tesch in January 1996 to record three consecutive double-double outings
- ♦ Middle Tennessee swept the Challenge in Music City where senior F **JaCorey Williams** was named Tournament MVP after averaging 24.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game while junior G **Giddy Potts** joined him on the all-tournament team with his 17.7 points, 5.7 boards and 4.0 assists per outing

♦ MT has 82 total wins since joining Conference USA in 2013-14, trailing only LA Tech among current C-USA members

TOP-RANKED DEFENSE >

♦ Middle had one of the top two scoring defenses in Conference USA in each of its first three seasons in the league, holding opponents to 68.9 points per game in 2015-16, 62.4 in 2014-15 and 62.6 in 2013-14

♦ With that strong of a defense, the Blue Raiders have been nearly unstoppable when scoring 70 points, boasting a 49-5 record (.907) since 2013-14 when topping the 70-point mark

♦ Defense has long been a staple for Head Coach **Kermit Davis** as he is 176-32 (.846) at the helm of the Blue Raider basketball program when his teams top 70 points

GOING STREAKING >

♦ Middle Tennessee has made a 3-pointer in 686 consecutive games, a streak that spans over 19 seasons, with the last time it failed to convert a trey coming on Jan. 14, 1995 against Murray State

THE BIG THREE >

♦ Middle Tennessee's big three - senior F **JaCorey Williams** (17.9 ppg), junior G **Giddy Potts** (15.2 ppg) and senior F **Reggie Upshaw** (15.2 ppg) - are one of the elite scoring trios in the nation, combining for nearly 50 points per outing

♦ The Blue Raiders are one of just five NCAA Division I programs in the nation that boast three players each averaging over 15 points per game entering the weekend alongside Arizona State, Kentucky, Marshall and UNC Wilmington

♦ If the high-scoring trio can all finish the season at or above 15 points per game, they would be the first to do so at MT under Head Coach **Kermit Davis**

♦ The most recent occurrence at MT is the trio of Randy Henry (19.5), Chris Rainey (18.7) and Kerry Hammonds (17.2) in 1988-89, who led the Blue Raiders to a 97-83 NCAA Tournament win against Florida State

- ♦ The Panthers returned three starters and eight letter-winners from their 2015-16 squad
- ♦ Senior G **Donte McGill** leads FIU and is third in Conference USA in scoring (18.8) and has the seventh-ranked free throw percentage (.924) in the nation
- ♦ Graduate transfer **Michael Kessens** leads FIU and Conference USA in rebounding (9.7) and ranks 32nd nationally
- ♦ FIU is the third-best offensive rebounding team in Conference USA, averaging 10.8 offensive boards per outing

SERIES HISTORY

- ♦ The Blue Raiders and Panthers will be meeting for the 36th time with MT holding a 27-8 advantage in the series while MT has won four of the last five and 12 of the last 14
- ♦ Each of the last 29 meetings have come under Head Coach **Kermit Davis**, who is 24-5 against FIU
- ♦ MT has won seven of the last eight in Miami and four out of five as Conference USA opponents
- ♦ Middle Tennessee has faced FIU more times (35) than all other opponents from Florida combined (30)
- ♦ MT and FIU will meet twice again this season and have met twice in the same season 16 times before, including the 2010-11 and 2012-13 seasons in which they met three times each year

LAST TIME OUT

MIDDLE TENNESSEE 91, WKU 76 >

- ♦ Middle Tennessee got its first look of the season at rival WKU Saturday at the Murphy Center and extended its winning streak to five games with a 91-76 victory
- ♦ The Blue Raiders (15-3, 5-0), Conference USA's lone unbeaten team in league play, showed their dominance over the Hilltoppers (9-10, 3-3) on both sides of the ball from the opening tip
- ♦ They opened up a 27-11 lead midway through the first half thanks to a 12-0 run over a 4.5-minute span, and ended the first half with a 46-32 advantage then held WKU at bay in the second half for the win
- ♦ The hot start was a direct result of Middle Tennessee's strong effort on the backboards
- ♦ WKU entered the game with C-USA's 11th best average rebound margin at minus-.6 per contest, and the Blue Raiders took advantage by outrebounding the Hilltoppers 34-18
- ♦ Junior F **Reggie Upshaw**, who is now fifth all-time at MTSU in rebounds, led the way with 10 to go along with 19 points for his 17th career double-double
- ♦ Freshman G **Tyrik Dixon** dished out eight assists, a new career best, and also had a career-high 17 points, including a perfect five-for-five night from 3-point range
- ♦ Senior F **JaCorey Williams** led the Blue Raiders in scoring with 27 points on 12-of-19 shooting
- ♦ Sophomore G **Antwain Johnson** added nine and junior F **Brandon Walters**, who is averaging 6.6 points and 5.2 rebounds in just 12 minutes in conference play, ended with six points and a career-high eight boards

FIU 55, UTSA 57 >

- ♦ The FIU men's basketball team, who trailed by as many as 14 points in the second half, stormed back to take as much as a three-point lead with less than four minutes left in the game, but could not hold on as UTSA pulled out a gut-wrenching 57-55 win Saturday afternoon
- ♦ **Elmo Stephen** scored a career- and game-high 21 points, while **Michael Kessens** and **Eric Nottage** added 17 and 13 points, respectively
- ♦ Kessens also pulled down a team-high nine rebounds in the loss
- ♦ The Panthers had two opportunities in the final 27 seconds to regain the lead, but a three-point shot by Stephen and a missed layup by Nottage left FIU just short
- ♦ The Panthers shot a season-low 34.5 percent (20-of-58) from the field on the afternoon and just 29.2 percent (7-of-24) from three

- ◆ Middle Tennessee notched its sixth win away from the Murphy Center with a 79-66 win at Belmont

- ◆ The Blue Raiders matched their best start since 2011-12 at 8-1 after winning at South Alabama, 67-55

- ◆ Junior G Ed Simpson represented the Blue Raiders as one of 111 NCAA Division I men's basketball players nominated
- ◆ Simpson was one of five nominees from Conference USA
- ◆ The five D-I men's basketball honorees will be announced in February

REMEMBER NOVEMBER >

- ◆ With seven wins in the opening month of college basketball, the Blue Raiders set a new program record for wins in the month of November
- ◆ The previous record of six came in the 2011-12 season when MT logged wins against Austin Peay (twice), Loyola Marymount, UCLA, UNC Greensboro and Cumberland in November

WIRE-TO-WIRE WIN IN OXFORD >

- ◆ The Blue Raiders earned a 77-62 win on the road against SEC foe Ole Miss, leading the Rebels from start to finish on their home floor
- ◆ Reggie Upshaw notched his 16th career double-double in the contest, totaling 15 points, 10 rebounds and a career-high eight assists
- ◆ Giddy Potts added 20 and JaCorey Williams had 10 in the contest in which Middle jumped out to a 48-19 lead at halftime
- ◆ The win gave MT its second consecutive victory against SEC opponents as they defeated Auburn 88-81 last season at Bridgestone Arena

SWEEP IN MUSIC CITY >

- ◆ The Blue Raiders won the Challenge in Music City championship with a weeked sweep on Thanksgiving weekend
- ◆ Middle opened the weekend with a 68-63 win against UNC Wilmington behind a 22 point, eight assist and seven rebound performance from all-tournament team selection Giddy Potts

- ◆ MT got back on track against Toledo with an 80-70 win in which they never allowed the Rockets to take a lead and were up by as much as 23

- ♦ The contest was the first time MT topped the 100-point plateau since a 102-52 win against Tennessee Temple on Dec. 17, 2013
- ♦ The Blue Raiders are now 8-1 in their last nine season openers and have won seven straight season openers played in the Murphy Center
- ♦ Kermit Davis is 11-4 in season openers at Middle Tennessee after the win against Milligan

- ♦ Primarily playing the power forward position in 2015-16, **Reggie Upshaw** led the Blue Raiders in rebounding (8.5), assists (76) and steals (51) while ranking second in scoring (13.7)
