■ The Panthers look to snap their two-game losing streak to FGCU ... FIU last defeated the Eagles at home, 72-61, on Dec. 7, 2013




■ The game against the Eagles is the fifth of nine home games that FIU will play during an 11-game stretch that started on Nov. 27, against South Carolina ... Following Wednesday's contest the Panthers will take on Hartford on Dec. 22 at 7 p.m. before heading into the holiday break.

■ Willy Nunez, Jr. led four players in double figures for the Panthers, with 18 points, in its recent 76-67 loss to James Madison on Dec. 16 ... Hassan Hussein added 17 points, and Brian Beard, Jr. and Eric Lockett 10 points apiece.

■ Anthony Evans is in his fifth season as head coach of the Panthers, and his 11th season overall as a head coach, at both Norfolk State and FIU.

## HEAD COACH ANTHONY EVANS



- **Head Coach • St. Thomas Aquinas (N.Y.) (1994)**
- **155-176 Overall (11th Season) • 56-82 at FIU (Fifth Season)**
- **Family • Wife, Kisha; Son, Anthony**
- **Date of Birth • March 25, 1970 in Brooklyn, N.Y.**

- Named the eighth head basketball coach at FIU on April 16, 2013.
- Picked up his first win as the head coach at FIU with a 66-58 victory over Kennesaw State on Nov. 10, 2013. The win also marked the 100th-career victory for Evans.
- During the 2015-16 season, Evans continued to watch over the development of All-Conference USA second team member - and NABC All-District honoree - Adrian Diaz, one of the top defenders in C-USA. Diaz would become the all-time leader in blocked shots at FIU during his senior campaign. In addition, junior college transfer, Donte McGill rose to be one of the top offensive players in the league averaging 16.1 points-per-game, good enough for eighth in C-USA.
- During the 2014-15 campaign, Evans saw two of his players earn All-Conference USA honors. Dennis Mavin earned second team honors while Adrian Diaz was named to the All-C-USA Defensive Team. Diaz finished the year as the league leader in blocked shots per game (3.0 bpg), and was sixth in NCAA Division I in total blocked shots (99) and seventh in blocked shots per game.
- In his first season at the helm, led FIU to a 15-win season. FIU picked up a big 72-61 victory over cross-state rival and 2012 Sweet Sixteen squad Florida Gulf Coast on Dec. 7 at FIU Arena. FIU earned seven Conference USA wins in its inaugural season in the league, including two victories over rival Florida Atlantic.
- Coached Tymell Murphy to a Second-Team All-C-USA honor for his play during the 2013-14 season. Murphy finished the year averaging 16.6 points-per-game (No. 4 in the conference) on 58.6 percent shooting from the floor (No. 4 in the conference; No. 18 nationally).
- During his time with the Spartans, Evans amassed a 99-94 record, including back-to-back, 20-win seasons (26-10 in 2011-12 & 21-12 in 2012-13).
- During the 2012-13 season, led Norfolk State to an undefeated Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference regular season mark (16-0) en route to being named the MEAC Coach of the Year and the team's second-straight post-season berth with an automatic bid to the 2013 National Invitation Tournament (NIT).
- Was finalist for the Ben Jobe Award for the 2012-13 campaign, presented to the top minority coach in Division I basketball. He was also named a finalist for the Hugh Durham Award, presented to the top mid-major coach in Division I, and the Jim Phelan Award, presented to the top Division I coach.
- In 2011-12, took the Spartans to new heights with the program's first-ever Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) title and perhaps the biggest upset in NCAA Tournament history. In the 2012 NCAA Tournament, the Evans-led Spartans knocked off the No. 2 seed Missouri Tigers, 86-84, becoming the fifth No. 15 seed (at the time) to defeat a No. 2 seed.

### SCOUTING FLORIDA GULF COAST

■ Florida Gulf Coast comes into Tuesday's game with a 7-5 record and losers of three of its last four games, after winning six of its first eight ... The Eagles are coming off an 83-64 loss to Oral Roberts on Saturday night in Fort Myers ... Brandon Goodwin led the way with 20 points, while Christian Terrell and Michael Gilmore added 14 and 10 points, respectively in loss.

■ Brandon Goodwin leads four players in double-figures for the Eagles, netting 18.3 points-per-game, while also grabbing 4.9 rebounds-per-outings ... Christian Terrell and Zach Johnson and are averaging 14.0 points- and 13.5 points-per-game, respectively ... Michael Gilmore rounds out the double-figure scorers, netting 10.0 points-per-outing ... Terrell also leads FGCU in rebounding, grabbing 6.0 boards-per-contest.

## LAST TIME OUT AGAINST FGCU

■ FIU dropped a 82-63 loss at Florida Gulf Coast on Dec. 11, 2016, in Fort Myers in the Panthers' final non-conference road game of the year.

■ Donte McGill was one of two players in double figures for the Panthers, netting a game-high 25 points on 6-of-14 shooting from the field, including 1-of-2 from behind the three-point arc, and a perfect 12-of-12 from the charity stripe ... Michael Kessens was the Panthers' only other player in double figures with 14 points.

■ FIU shot just 37.9 percent (11-of-29) from the field in the second half and a mere 1-of-11 (9.1 percent) from behind the three-point arc ... The Panthers finished the game hitting 38.5 percent (20-of-52) from the field on the night.

■ FIU was outrebounded for the first time this season (39-23).

## LAST TIME OUT

■ The FIU men's basketball team started a season-long six-game home stretch on Saturday night with a 76-67 loss to James Madison at the Barry University Health & Sports Center ... The game was moved to Barry due to scheduling conflicts with the Ocean Bank Convocation Center ultimately caused by Hurricane Irma.

■ Willy Nunez, Jr. led four players in double figures with 18 points and Hassan Hussein added 17 points ... Brian Beard, Jr. and Eric Lockett chipped in with 10 points apiece.

■ The Panthers shot 46.3 percent (25-for-54) from the field on the night, their fourth highest percentage of the season, but only hit 22.2 percent (4-for-18) from behind the arc and 56.5 percent (13-for-23) from the free-throw line in the loss ... They also recorded their lowest steal total of the season, with five.

■ FIU's advantage in the high percentage shots in the paint was 36-28, and their 16-9 advantage in fast break points were offset by committing a season-high 18 turnovers that led to 21 James Madison points.

## LEARNING ON THE JOB

■ With only six players returning from last year's roster (including Jay Harvey who missed the season with a foot injury), the Panthers return just 23.8 percent of the minutes played during the 2016-17 campaign ... Eric Lockett (795), Hassan Hussein (230), Michael Douglas (355), Ronald Whitaker (122) and Osasumwen Osaghae (12) accounted for 1,514 of FIU's 6,350 minutes played last season.

## FILLING THE VOID

■ The Panthers lost quite a bit of production from last season, both in the scoring column and on the boards ... FIU lost 83.6 percent (1821-of-2178) of its scoring from last season, and 72 percent (758-of-1052) of its rebounding from last season.

## THE IRONMEN

■ Three players on the FIU roster have put in substantial minutes on the floor for the Panthers this season ... Eric Lockett, (36.6 mpg), Brian Beard, Jr. (33.3 mpg), and Trejon Jacob (31.0 mpg) are all averaging at least 31 minutes-per-game this year.

■ Lockett's 36.6 minutes-per-contest is currently third in Conference USA (through games of Dec. 17) ... He has played 35 or more minutes in eight of FIU's 11 games, including 43 minutes in an overtime affair against Stetson on Nov. 12, and a career-high 50 minutes in a triple-overtime outing in the next game against Elon on Nov. 17.

■ Beard, Jr. is just outside the top 10 in C-USA in minutes played-per-game with 33.3 per-outing ... He has played 40-plus minutes twice against Stetson (43) on Nov. 12 and a career-high against Elon (47) on Nov. 17 ... In addition, he played 36 minutes at USF on Dec. 11 and 35 minutes in the next game at North Florida on Dec. 13.

■ Jacob has played 35-or-more minutes in four of the Panthers 11 games this season including a career-high 40 minutes against Stetson on Nov. 12, and 38 against Concordia-St. Paul on Nov. 19.

■ Through games of Dec. 17, FIU is ranked first in Conference USA in steals-per-game, averaging 8.2 per-outing ... So far in their 11 games, the Panthers have recorded fewer than five steals just once, with that coming against James Madison (4) on Dec. 16.

■ FIU has posted double-digit steals four times this season against Florida Memorial (13) on Nov. 10, South Carolina (10) on Nov. 27, South Alabama (12) on Dec. 2 and North Florida (10) on Dec. 13.

■ FIU is averaging 8.7 steals-per-game in its last six games.

■ Two players on the Panthers' roster are ranked among the league leaders in steals - and one nationally - so far this season through games of Dec. 17 ... Brian Beard, Jr. leads the team, is tops in Conference USA, and ninth in NCAA Division I (through Dec. 16) in steals this season, averaging 2.9 take-aways-per-game ... Eric Lockett is just below the two-steal-per-game threshold, recording 1.6 per-game, 11th in C-USA.

■ Lockett and Beard, Jr. are tied for the single-game season-high in C-USA in steals with six ... Lockett set the bar against Florida Memorial in the season-opener on Nov. 10, and Beard, Jr. did so on Dec. 11, at USF.

■ Beard, Jr. has recorded 17 steals in the last four games (4.25 spg) against South Alabama (5) on Dec. 2, USF (6) on Dec. 11, North Florida (4) on Dec. 13, and James Madison (2) on Dec. 16.

## DOUBLE DIPPIN'

■ Eric Lockett posted the first two double-doubles of the season for the Panthers ... Lockett recorded his first career double-double against Elon on Nov. 17, with, a then, career-high 21 points and a career-best 13 rebounds in a 87-85 triple-overtime loss ... At USF on Dec. 11, Lockett netted 18 points and 11 rebounds in the Panthers' 65-53 win,

## CLOSE BUT NO CIGAR

■ FIU certainly had its share of hard luck games during the 2016-17 season ... Of FIU's 24 losses last season, 10 of FIU's setbacks were by five points or less, with three losses by seven points.

■ Of their 19 losses, during the 2015-16 season, 11 of the Panthers' setbacks were by six points or less ... During FIU's final 12 games of 2015-16, in which it lost 10 games, the Panthers dropped six of the 10 by no more than five points, and five of the losses by four points or less.

■ The Panthers suffered their first heart-breaker of the season, dropping a 70-64 (ot) decision to Stetson on Nov. 12.

■ FIU's 95-87 triple-overtime loss to Elon - its second in as many seasons - was the longest game for FIU since a five-overtime game against UALR (W, 116-114) on Jan. 30, 2005, and the second longest in school history.

■ Is averaging 3.7 points- and 1.6 rebounds-per-game.

■ Had the best game of his short collegiate career on Nov. 17 against Elon, netting a career-high 17 points and grabbing a career-best five rebounds.

■ Scored 10 points on 5-for-7 shooting (71.4 percent) from the field against Florida National on Nov. 29.

■ Banks is known for his backboard-shattering dunk that made him an Internet sensation in January 2017 ... ■ Beard, Jr. is third on the team in scoring, averaging 14.1 points-per-game, and leads the Panthers in assists dishing out 4.3 per-contest, good enough for eighth in Conference USA (through games of Dec. 17) ... Has scored in double figures in nine-consecutive games played.

■ Has dished out no fewer than four assists in seven of the 10 games he has played in ... Tied his career-high for assists with seven against James Madison on Dec. 16 ... Also dropped seven dimes against Florida Memorial in the season-opener.

■ Is tops in Conference USA, and ninth in the nation, in steals-per-game, averaging 2.9 per-contest.

Also had four assists and two steals against the Gamecocks ... ## MEDIA INFORMATION

### Interviews - General

ALL INTERVIEWS, both on the local and national levels with the FIU men's basketball team are coordinated by Michael Hogan, men's basketball media relations contact.

The FIU Athletic Media Relations Department has the right to refuse any interview request. Contacting student-athletes, coaches and staff without permission from the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department is not permissible and may result in revocation of credentials.

### Student-Athlete Interviews

Interviews should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance through the FIU Media Relations Department (305-348-1496). While several interviews are conducted over the phone, the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department will never give out student-athlete's cell phone numbers or private contact information. In-person interviews will take place, either in the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (FIU Arena Room 211) or after practice. Please contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department for ALL interview requests. Other accommodations can be arranged through the Athletic Media Relations Department.

### Coaches and Staff Interviews

Interviews with Head Coach Anthony Evans must come through the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Interviews should be scheduled at least 24 hours in advance. No member of the FIU staff may be interviewed without permission by the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department. Personal numbers of both coaches and staff members will not be given out.

### Covering Practice

All practices are closed to the media, as are walk-throughs, at FIU Arena on the day of all home games. Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes will be made available after practice. Media members must contact the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department (Michael Hogan - Men's Basketball Contact) if they wish to attend post-practice or to set up interviews. No interview will be granted without the permission of the FIU Athletic Media Relations Department.

### Pre-Game Interviews

FIU players will not be available for any media activities on game day.

### Post-Game Interviews

The athletic media relations staff at FIU is aware of the importance of media coverage and places great importance on the role of the media insofar as it interacts with their respective duties. To ensure the most workable situation for members of both entities, the following procedures must be observed:

1. The FIU men's basketball program will observe a brief NCAA-prescribed cooling off period before beginning post-game interviews.
2. A post-game press conference will be conducted in Room 272 of FIU Arena with Head Coach Anthony Evans and selected student-athletes.
3. Post-game interviews will NOT be held on the court.

Each visiting team will set its own post-game interview policies and procedures, which will be announced on game day. Check with the opposing media relations staff if you have any further questions.
