• BULLDOGS AND PANTHERS CLASH ON SATURDAY NIGHT

Louisiana Tech will be going for win No. 20 on Saturday night when they host FIU at 6 p.m. inside the Thomas Assembly Center on Karl Malone Court. A win would mark the fifth straight season of 20+ wins for the second longest streak in program history. The Bulldogs are riding a season-best five-game winning streak and remain alone in second in the league standings.

• FRESHMAN DUO LEAD DUNKIN' DOGS TO VICTORY

There was a youth movement on Thursday night inside the Thomas Assembly Center as the freshman duo of Jalen Harris and DaQuan Bracey combined for 35 points to help the Bulldogs overpower Florida Atlantic by a final score of 95-69.

Bracey registered his first career double-double with 14 points, a career-high 12 assists and a career-high four steals while Harris came off the bench to register a game-high 21 points. Harris also had two of the team's season-best eight dunks, one of which was No. 6 on ESPN's #SCTop10.

• DURING WINNING STREAK

A big reason as to why the Bulldogs are on a season-best five-game winning streak right now is their three-point shooting. From beyond the arc, the team is shooting a staggering 46 percent.

Redshirt senior Erik McCree is averaging 19.8 points per game during this span and has made 18-of-27 three-pointers (67 percent). Others shooting the three-ball really well are Jacobi Boykins (13-27), Jy'lan Washington (7-10) and DaQuan Bracey (4-8).

When Eric Konkol was announced as the 18th head coach of Bulldog Basketball on May 18, 2015, he said during the introductory press conference that he wanted to continue the standard of excellence that had been built over the last few years.

And that he did by leading LA Tech to a 23-10 overall record, the most victories by a first-year head coach in program history. As a result, he was named a finalist for the 2016 Joe B. Hall Award which is presented annually to the top first-year coach in Division I college basketball.

The Bulldogs had several highlight wins during the 2015-16 season, defeating eight teams who advanced to the postseason (most since 1989) and besting seven teams who posted 20+ victories (most since 1991).

Of those was a win in non-conference play at Ohio State, the program's first over a Big Ten school in 30 years. More came during Conference USA action as LA Tech was one of only two teams in the league to beat the regular season champions UAB and the tournament champions Middle Tennessee.

The 'Dogs were picked preseason to finish fifth but ended up in a tie for third in the league to help earn the program's fourth straight postseason appearance which came in the inaugural Vegas16 Tournament. The team also continued their dominance at home, claiming a 16-1 record inside the Thomas Assembly Center.

Konkol came to Ruston having spent the previous four seasons on the staff of Miami's head coach Jim Larranaga. Prior to that, he was with Larranaga for seven years at George Mason assisting in all aspects including recruiting, practices, individual player workouts and game preparation.

Known as the team's offensive coordinator, he aided the 2014-15 Hurricanes team to a 25-13 record, the second most wins in program history, and an appearance in the National Invitation Tournament Championship game.

In his third season at Miami, Konkol and the Canes returned no starters from the previous season, but the team still posted its seventh-straight winning season with a 17-16 overall record while ranking No. 2 in field goal defense and No. 3 in scoring defense in the ACC, good enough for No. 11 and No. 39 nationally.

The program saw several firsts in his second season, including the Canes ACC regular season and tournament championships, a No. 2 ranking in the national polls and 29 total victories with 15 league wins. Miami matched program bests in earning a No. 2 seed in the NCAA Tournament and playing in the Sweet 16.

Konkol previously worked from 2002 through 2005 and 2007 through 2011 at George Mason with Larranaga. In the interim, he spent two years coaching at national power Hopkins High School in Minnesota under Ken Novak, Jr. - who was named 2011 ESPN RISE National Boy's Basketball Coach of the Year - and had a short stint on the coaching staff at North Dakota State.

Konkol worked daily with ACC and Lute Olson National Player of the Year and All-American Shane Larkin, who left UM after his sophomore season to enter the 2013 NBA Draft. Larkin was a finalist for the Bob Cousy, Naismith and John R. Wooden awards and named the ACC tournament MVP.

A native of Amherst, Wis., Konkol is a 2000 graduate of the University of Wisconsin at Eau Claire with a bachelor's degree in kinesiology, with an emphasis in exercise management. He played three seasons of basketball for the Division III program - advancing to the national championship game in 2000. He received the team's Inspiration Award after his junior and senior seasons with the Blugolds, and was an honorary captain as a senior.

Konkol and his wife Meagan, have two sons, Ethan and Ryan.

ABOUT THE PANTHERS

FIU is in 13th place in the league standings with just two conference wins coming against UAB and North Texas. Two of the Panthers league losses have come in overtime, including a 69-66 defeat at Southern Miss this past Thursday night.

The team has now played five overtime games this season and has lost all five. They have also yet to win a road game, posting an 0-13 mark away from Miami.

The Panthers have a dynamic one-two punch in guard Donte McGill and forward Michael Kessens. McGill ranks fourth in the conference in scoring with an average of 18.9 points per game. Meanwhile, Kessens (graduate transfer from Alabama) leads the league in rebounding with an average of 9.2 boards per contest.

THE SERIES -- LA Tech leads 5-4

LA Tech and FIU split the season series three times when league foes in the Sun Belt Conference from 1998-2001. Since becoming conference opponents again in 2013-14 in C-USA, the Bulldogs have won two of the three meetings.

LAST MEETING -- Jan. 14, 2016

Louisiana Tech could not keep up with hot-shooting FIU as the Bulldogs fell on the road to the Panthers, 88-74, inside FIU Arena in Miami.

LA Tech was able to crash the glass which resulted in a season-high 18 offensive rebounds. However, the largest run the team could muster was a 5-0 run due to FIU's ability to make shots.

The Panthers ended up shooting 57 percent from the field and 50 percent from three-point range, led by Donte McGill who scored a game-high 29 points, 23 of which came in the first half.

On the flipside, LA Tech shot just 41 percent from the field and 25 percent from beyond the arc. Dayon Griffin led the Bulldogs with 16 points. Alex Hamilton and Merrill Holden also scored in double digits with 13 and 11 points, respectively.

HOME SWEET HOME

MULTIPLE STREAKS IN THE TAC

The home dominance began on Feb. 16, 2012 with a 58-53 non-conference victory over North Dakota. The Bulldogs went on to win its remaining three home games that season versus Central Arkansas, San Jose State and Hawai'i.

The streak carried over into the 2012-13 season when the 'Dogs went 14-0 in the TAC, marking the first home undefeated season since 1998-99. Unfortunately, the streak ended at 19 games (seventh longest in program history) with a loss in non-conference.

However, a new streak began on Dec. 7, 2013 with a 69-50 win against Southern. The team went on to win 13 straight that season (including a thrilling 89-88 victory versus Iona in the first round of the NIT), on top of going a perfect 17-0 in 2014-15. While it marked the seventh time the Bulldogs had gone undefeated in the TAC which was built in 1982, the 17 victories shattered the record for most home wins in a single season (previous record was 14 which was done three times).

The streak came to an end at 39 straight with a three-point loss last season on Jan. 7, 2016. At the time, it was tied for the second longest in the country and was one shy of tying the program record. The 'Dogs also had their 29-game non-conference home winning streak (third longest in the country at the time) and their perfect 18-0 record in C-USA action come to an unfortunate halt.

NEARLY UNSTOPPABLE IN NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

With the impressive numbers, the Bulldogs have become nearly an unstoppable force at home during non-conference action. Despite this season's loss to Florida Gulf Coast on Dec. 20, LA Tech is still a whopping 58-2 in such games dating back to the start of the 2008-09 season.

NEARLY UNSTOPPABLE IN C-USA PLAY AS WELL

Louisiana Tech has played 33 games inside the Thomas Assembly Center against C-USA opponents since joining the league in 2013-14. The Bulldogs have amassed a record of 31-2 in those games which is the best home winning percentage of any C-USA team over the last three-plus seasons.

After struggling through the first five games of the season, Erik McCree found his rhythm. He has registered 11 double-doubles (most in C-USA) in the last 22 games, including a stretch of five straight which was the most by a Bulldog since current NBA All-Star Paul Millsap did it in eight straight in 2005.

NEON GREEN LIGHT FOR BOYKINS

Every offseason, head coach Eric Konkol has a shooting drill. With one ball, one rebounder and five minutes on the clock, you have to try to make as many three-pointers as possible. If you can make at least 60 in that span, you have what is called the neon green light during a game.

In the very first chance he got this past summer, junior sharp shooter Jacobi Boykins made 73 to set a new program record before it was later topped by Erik McCree (76).

During a four-game stretch, he made 23 of 35 three-point attempts (66%). He was particularly en fuego at Louisiana-Lafayette when he made seven straight three's during an 8:48 span in the second half. He has become the only Bulldog in program history to make 5+ three-pointers in four straight games.

POINT GUARD U

Point Guard U is here to stay at LA Tech. After the losses of All-American point guards Speedy Smith and Alex Hamilton, some could have anticipated a dropoff this season at the position. Not so far though with the rise of freshman DaQuan Bracey.

The cat-quick point guard has started the last 21 games and has a team-high 157 assists (5+ in 20 games), breaking the single season freshman record of 142 that was held by Speedy Smith.

Bracey is currently one of only three freshman point guards in the country with at least 150 total assists this season. The other two are on the midseason watch list for National Freshman of the Year (Lonzo Ball, UCLA; Dennis Smith, Jr., NC State).

As if his assists numbers weren't impressive enough, his assist/turnover ratio (+3.74) is off the charts, ranking first in C-USA and fifth in Division I basketball (best of any freshman).

HARRIS PROVIDING OFFENSIVE SPARK OFF BENCH

Despite missing six games this season (four due to injury and two due to illness), true freshman Jalen Harris has still shown how much of a natural scorer he is, averaging 10.2 points per game which is the third most on the team.

He made his first career start versus Oklahoma Baptist, scoring a career-high 24 points on 10-of-15 shooting. It was the most points scored by a Bulldog freshman since Raheem Appleby scored 30 at New Mexico State on Feb. 2, 2012.

In returning from injury, he was named C-USA Co-Freshman of the Week after posting 14 against FGCU and 17 versus LSUS in week seven. One reason for the scoring has been his efficiency from the foul line where he has missed only four and is shooting a team-best 91 percent (42-of-46).

MCCREE JOINS 1,000 POINT CLUB WITH CAREER NIGHT

Erik McCree dominated on the basketball court, registering a career-tying 33 points in a convincing 88-59 win over Southeastern Louisiana on Dec. 3. He needed only 22 points that night to become the 39th Bulldog in program history to reach 1,000 career points. He did it in the first half, scoring 24 of his 33 points before intermission.

The redshirt senior also pulled down a career-high 18 rebounds which is the most by a Bulldog since Olu Ashoalu had 18 boards in 2011.

DAVIS SUFFERS SEASON-ENDING INJURY FOR SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON

Senior guard/forward Qiydar Davis played in the first seven games of the season last year. He had made five starts and was averaging 10.6 points and 6.7 rebounds, but unfortunately he suffered a knee injury against Jackson State which sidelined him the rest of the year.

It was like deja vu this season for Davis. After making five starts, he suffered a knee injury at California on Nov. 30 which will put him out for the entire season yet again.

BACK-TO-BACK CONFERENCE USA PLAYERS OF THE YEAR

In 2015, LA Tech point guard Kenneth "Speedy" Smith was named the Conference USA Player of the Year. Last season, that crown came back to Ruston as Bulldog point guard Alex Hamilton received the honor. Both also earned All-American honors (nine total in program history).

LA Tech was one of nine schools in the country to claim back-to-back conference players of the year, but they were one of only two programs to have multiple athletes earn the award (Texas Southern -- SWAC). It marked the first time LA Tech has had back-to-back winners and marked only the third time it has been done in C-USA history.

STRONGER THAN EVER

Casey Cathrall came on board as the Director of Strength and Conditioning for Bulldog Basketball in August of 2015. Ever since being part of his program, the team has experienced tremendous gains in the weight room.

For the four incoming freshmen who joined the strength program on July 11, the gains have been through the roof.

- Freshman DaQuan Bracey has the team record in the 3/4 court spring of 3.03 (NBA Combine record is 2.96).
- Freshman Jalen Harris has added 10 pounds, increased bench press by 40 pounds.
- Freshman JaColby Pemberton has added 11 pounds, increased 5 to 15 on chin ups.
- Freshman Oliver Powell increased bench press by 35 pounds.

REPLACING ALEX HAMILTON

Alex Hamilton's (aka Mr. And-1) storied career came to an end as a Bulldog last season, earning Honorable Mention All-America and C-USA Player of the Year honors after averaging 19.8 points, 5.7 rebounds and 6.2 assists per game.

He ended his four-year career as the all-time winningest player in program history with 106 victories (made 108 straight starts). Along the way, he became the first player in program history to rank in the top five in career points (1,986 for third most), career assists (501 for fourth most) and career steals (215 for second most).

The point guard also became the program's all-time career leader in free throws attempted (834) and free throws made (604). And no one can forget him recording the third triple-double in school history with 25 points, 11 rebounds and 11 assists on senior night in his final game at home. It was the first since 1991.

DEFENSE UNDER WHITE/KONKOL

In the last five-plus seasons, the defense has forced at least 15 turnovers in over half of the games played (110 out of 200). The Bulldogs are 92-18 in those contests.

The defense has cranked up even more in some games, forcing 20+ turnovers 39 times. The Bulldogs did it five times last year and have done it twice this season, forcing 25 by Alabama State and 23 by Rice.

"WE WILL CONTINUE TO BE THE #DUNKINDOGS" -- ERIC KONKOL

The phrase Dunkin' Dogs was coined in 1982 when Karl "The Mailman" Malone and "Big Will" Simmons threw down dunk after dunk. What followed was a run of nine 20-win seasons and nine straight postseason appearances (five NCAA, including a Sweet 16 appearance in 1985, and four NIT appearances, including a Final Four appearance in 1986).

The Dunkin' Dogs came and went over the next two decades, but reappeared starting in 2013 when they recorded 96 slams. The 2013-14 team eclipsed the century mark with 138 dunks. That was followed up by a new record of 142 slams in 2014-15.

During Eric Konkol's introductory press conference on May 18, 2015, he assured LA Tech fans that we would continue to be the Dunkin' Dogs. He was telling the truth as the Dunkin' Dogs registered 95 slams in 2015-16. Expect even more this season.

KONKOL INKS THREE IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

In an announcement made on Nov. 16, head coach Eric Konkol and his coaching staff inked two guards -- Exavian Christon from Arkansas and Amorie Archibald from Florida -- as well as forward Anthony Duruji from Maryland.

Christon is a 6-foot-4-inch, 190-pound shooting guard who stars at Hot Springs High School in Hot Springs, Arkansas. He is rated as the No. 4 best player in the state by Arkansas Hoops. He led the Panthers to top five rankings in 5A with records of 29-3 and 33-4, including an appearance in the state semifinals last season as a junior while averaging 18 points, six rebounds and four assists per game.

Archibald is a 6-foot-3-inch combo guard who was the second leading scorer in the entire state of Florida as a junior with an average of 28.5 points per game at Trinity Christian Academy in Deltona, Florida. He also averaged 8.5 assists, 7.0 rebounds and 2.4 steals per game.

Duruji is a 6-foot-8-inch forward who hails from Germantown, Maryland where he has starred at St. Andrews Episcopal School. As a junior, he averaged a double-double with 15 points and 10 boards per contest and was an All-MAC selection. He is also a standout track and field athlete, earning a second place state finish in the 4A high jump.

A total of SIX Bulldogs (50%) out of 12 scholarship players shoot left-handed which includes Erik McCree, Jacobi Boykins, Joniah White, Omar Sherman, JaColby Pemberton and DaQuan Bracey. Currently, the Bulldogs start four lefties.

BULLDOG GREAT PAUL MILLSAP NAMED NBA ALL-STAR FOR FOURTH STRAIGHT YEAR

LA Tech great and current Atlanta Hawks Paul Millsap was selected to participate in the 2017 NBA All-Star game for a fourth consecutive year. Millsap, now in his 11th season in the NBA and fourth with the Hawks, starred as a Bulldog from 2003-06 while totaling 1,708 career points and 1,172 career rebounds (three-time all-conference selection).

In Sports Illustrated's list of the top 100 NBA players of 2017, Millsap was ranked 15th.

The Louisiana Tech Hall of Famer is the only player to ever lead the NCAA in rebounding three consecutive years. He has been recognized for the past six years and eight of the past nine as the recipient of the Bob Pettit Award by the Louisiana Association of Basketball Coaches (LABC) which goes out annually to the most outstanding professional basketball player from a Louisiana college.

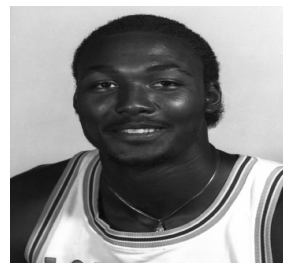

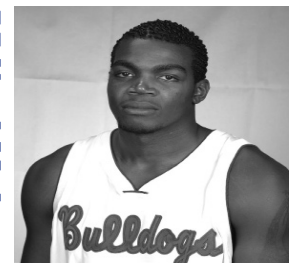

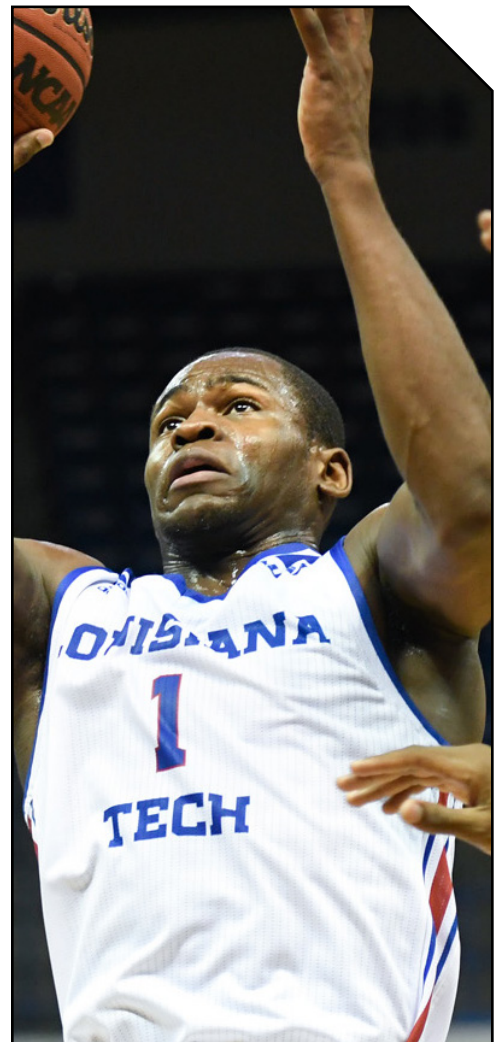
