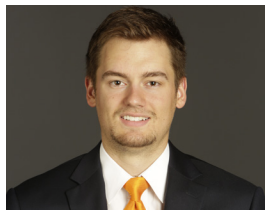

OPENING TIP

■ UTEP (12-15, 10-5 C-USA) wraps up its Sunshine State tour at FIU (6-22, 2-13 C-USA) on Saturday at 5 p.m. MT. The Miners won at Florida Atlantic, 60-55, on Thursday for a season-high fourth consecutive victory.

■ The Miners are 4-6 on the road but have won four straight C-USA away games for the first time since the 2013-14 season. The Miners were victorious in their first five league contests outside of El Paso that year.

■ With a win over FIU, UTEP would finish above .500 (5-4) in C-USA road games for the first time since 2014-15 when it was also 5-4. The Miners also finished above .500 on the road in league play in 2005-06 (4-3), 2008-09 (5-3), 2009-10 (7-1) and 2013-14 (7-1).

■ The Miners are tied for third place in the league standings with Old Dominion (17-10, 10-5 C-USA). UTEP will host the Monarchs on March 2. The top four teams in C-USA will earn a bye to the league tournament March 8-11 in Birmingham.

■ UTEP's four-game winning streak is its longest since reeling off six wins in a row in February of 2016.

■ The Miners have double-digit C-USA wins for the fifth consecutive season and for the eighth time in nine years.

ABOUT FIU

■ The Panthers will send out five seniors in Saturday's game against the Miners -- guards Anthony Boswell, Donte McGill and Eric Nottage, and forwards Michael Kessens and Elmo Stephen. McGill (19.1 ppg), Kessens (13.3 ppg), Nottage (11.3 ppg) and Stephen (9.8 ppg) are the team's top four scorers. Boswell averages 2.9 ppg. All have started at least 14 games in 2016-17.

■ FIU is 6-8 at home this season, 2-6 in league play with wins over UAB (94-85) and North Texas (90-71).

■ The Panthers are coming off a 69-67 loss to UTSA on Thursday at FIU Arena. They trailed by 20 points (43-23) late in the first half and rallied to take a one-point lead three times in the last five minutes, but the Roadrunners' Lucas O'Brien drained the game-winning three-pointer with nine seconds left.

■ FIU has lost three times this season on a game-winning shot with less than 10 seconds left.

■ McGill was the only Panther in double figures against UTSA with 22 points, his 13th 20-point game

of the season. Kessens added nine points and nine rebounds.

■ Kessens, the transfer from Alabama, is averaging 9.2 rebounds to rank first in Conference USA.

■ The Panthers are second in C-USA in free throw percentage (.751) behind Charlotte (.764). McGill is shooting 92.7 percent (101-for-109) from the charity stripe, tops in the league and third nationally.

SERIES HISTORY

■ UTEP is 8-1 all-time against FIU and 6-1 since the Panthers joined Conference USA for the 2013-14 season. The Miners have beaten the Panthers in the Conference USA Championships each of the last two years. In 2015, UTEP scored an 83-71 quarterfinal victory in Birmingham. In 2016, the Miners held off the Panthers in the first round of the tourney, 85-77, also at Legacy Arena.

■ The Miners are 3-0 all-time in Miami with victories during the 1999-2000 (88-81), 2014-15 (67-64) and 2015-16 (84-74) seasons.

THE LAST MEETING

■ Dominic Artis sank the game-winning jumper right before time expired, giving the UTEP Miners a breathtaking, 88-87 double overtime victory over FIU on Jan. 12 in the Haskins Center.

■ Artis finished with 18 points, nine rebounds, 10 assists and three steals as the Miners ended a 12-game losing streak and posted their first win in almost two months.

■ With 1.6 seconds on the clock, Jake Flaggert in-bounded the ball. FIU's Eric Lockett got a hand on it but couldn't secure it, the ball went to Artis and he nailed the fadeaway. Officials took considerable time to review the shot before ruling that it did indeed come before the buzzer (replays showed that the ball was out of Artis' hand with 0.4 seconds left).

■ UTEP rallied from a 45-41 deficit with 12:58 remaining in regulation with an 18-0 run, then squandered a 14-point lead (59-45) over the last 7:08 as FIU forced overtime. The Panthers outscored UTEP 21-7 down the stretch.

■ Artis was big in the first overtime as well, making two free throws with nine seconds left to tie it at 77. The Panthers' Eric Nottage, who made two threes in the first overtime, missed one with a second left that could've given his team the win.

■ In the second overtime, Nottage put FIU ahead by four (87-83) on a basket with 46 seconds left. Artis hit a three-pointer to make it a one-point game with 34 seconds remaining before coming up with the game-winner.

■ The Miners had numerous heroes. Omega Harris scored 20 points for the third consecutive game. Paul Thomas had a 19 points with 11 rebounds. He made his first seven shots and finished 7-for-8 from the field. Trey Touchet scored in double figures for the second time as a Miner with 11 points, and he provided some much-needed stability at the line (6-for-6) for a UTEP team that finished 16-for-30 at the stripe.

■ The Miners won the battle of the boards, 47-35, against one of C-USA's top rebounding teams. They shot 49.3 percent to FIU's 44.8 percent.

■ The Miners received eight points and seven rebounds from Matt Willms, and nine points, eight rebounds and three blocks from Kelvin Jones.

■ FIU, playing without two starters in leading scorer Donte McGill and Cameron Smith, had six double-figure scorers as Kimar Williams led the way with 16 points.

LAST GAME: UTEP 60, FLORIDA ATLANTIC 55

■ UTEP held Florida Atlantic to 22 second-half points, and pulled away late for a 60-55 win over the Owls on Thursday night in Boca Raton.

■ The Miners outscored the Owls 28-22 in the second half. They limited FAU to 33.3 percent (9-for-27) shooting, including 1-for-13 from three-point range, over the last 20 minutes.

■ Gerdarius Troutman, who scored 22 points and made six threes at UTEP on Jan. 14, had one field goal in each half and was 2-for-5 from the field, 0-for-3 from distance. Justin Massey, averaging 9.1 ppg, was 1-for-4 from the floor and 1-for-3 from beyond the arc. Adonis Filer scored 13 of his game-high 15 points in the second half for the Owls.

■ UTEP led by as many as six points in the first half, but the Owls rallied to take a 33-32 lead into the locker room. After the teams traded baskets to open the second stanza, the Miners went on an 8-2 run and built a 42-37 lead on a jumper by Kelvin Jones with 12:56 remaining.

■ UTEP wouldn't trail again, although there were some anxious moments when the Owls cut a seven-point deficit down to three (58-55) on two free throws by Filer with 56 seconds left. Troutman missed a three that could've tied it with 19 seconds left and, following a wild scramble for the loose ball, Omega Harris missed a breakaway dunk. But Trey Touchet secured the key offensive rebound with 11 seconds remaining, and Jake Flaggert made two big free throws with six seconds left to push the lead back to five.

■ The Miners outrebounded the Owls 32-30 as Dominic Artis (nine rebounds) and Harris (eight) combined for 17 boards. Artis scored seven of his team-high 12 points in the last five minutes, including a crucial three-pointer with 3:51 left that gave UTEP its biggest lead (56-49). He also provided a pivotal jumper with 1:11 to go on a strong move into the lane that put the Miners in front 58-53.

■ Harris scored 11 points, Matt Willms 10 and Jones added a career-high 10 with two steals in 15 minutes off the bench. His minutes were huge as the reigning Conference USA Player of the Week, Paul Thomas, was limited to 16 minutes due to foul trouble. Jones made 5-of-7 shots and the UTEP bench was a combined 8-for-10 from the floor.

MINERS IN THE NCAA STATS

■ Dominic Artis was 13th in the nation in minutes (36.7 mppg), 21st in assists (5.8 appg) and 25th in steals (2.1 spg) through Feb. 23. Omega Harris was 20th in minutes (36.3 mppg).

THOMAS APPOINTED C-USA PLAYER OF THE WEEK

■ Sophomore forward Paul Thomas was named the Conference USA Player of the Week on Monday.

■ Thomas put together back-to-back double-doubles in leading UTEP to a pair of road victories last week. He averaged 20.0 points and 12.5 rebounds, shooting 68 percent (17-for-25) from the field and 85.7 percent (6-for-7) from the line. He also collected five assists, a block and four steals over 69 minutes (34.5 mppg) of action.

■ Thomas established career-highs for points (23) and rebounds (14), making 10-of-16 shots in a 77-71 victory at North Texas Feb. 16. Two days later, he scored 17 points on 7-of-9 shooting, and pulled down 11 rebounds with two steals in a 79-71 triumph at Rice. Thomas scored 15 of his 17 points in the second half against the Owls.

■ This is the first C-USA Player of the Week honor for Thomas. He is the third Miner to be honored as Player of the Week this season, joining Dominic Artis (Nov. 21) and Matt Willms (Jan. 30).

STREAKING AGAIN

■ The Miners have a season-long four-game win streak. It marks the 11th time that UTEP has enjoyed a win streak of four games or more in Conference USA play since joining the league in 2005. UTEP's longest C-USA win streak was 15 games from Jan. 6, 2010 to Jan. 5, 2011.

■ UTEP has posted five or more C-USA wins in a row on five occasions, most recently a six-game string during the 2015-16 season.

■ The Miners have won their last four C-USA road games. UTEP's longest C-USA road win streak is seven games twice, during the 2009-10 season and over the course of the 2012-13 and 2013-14 campaigns. The Miners had a five-game C-USA road win streak spanning over the 2013-14 and 2014-15 seasons.

ON A ROLL

■ The Miners have won 10 of their last 12 games after starting the C-USA slate 0-3.

■ Over the last 12 games, UTEP has allowed 62.2 ppg (746 points) with a defensive field goal percentage of .383 (259-for-676) and a defensive three-point field goal percentage of .268 (79-for-295). The Miners have shot 48.3 percent (314-for-650) from the floor during that span.

BALL SECURITY

■ The Miners have committed just 134 turnovers over the last 12 games, an average of 11.2 per outing.

■ UTEP's Jake Flaggert and Trey Touchet have combined for an assist/turnover ratio of 34-7 in C-USA games. Flaggert hasn't committed a turnover in any of the last 11 contests (a span of 335 minutes), and Touchet has committed four turnovers in the last 12 games (a span of 239 minutes).

■ Over the last 12 games, the Miners have outscored opponents 151-118 in points off turnovers. In the first 15 games they were outscored 257-224.

DOMINATING THE PAINT

■ Over the last 12 games, UTEP has outscored opponents in the paint 382-250 with at least 40 points on four occasions.

■ UTEP's 60 points in the paint at Marshall matched its most in a game under Tim Floyd. The Miners also scored 60 in the paint in a double-overtime contest against Colorado State on Nov. 28, 2015.

COMING FROM BEHIND

■ During their recent 10-2 surge, the Miners have trailed in the second half in six of their wins.

■ The Miners have faced double-digit second half deficits and won three times -- versus UAB (down 11), Middle Tennessee (down 17) and North Texas (down 10). The 17-point second-half comeback versus Middle Tennessee tied for UTEP's second-largest under Tim Floyd.

C-USA NAILBITERS

■ UTEP has played seven C-USA games decided by five points or less this season, breaking the school record of six originally set by the 2014-15 team. The Miners have five C-USA wins by five points or less to tie the school standard. UTEP was 5-0 in C-USA games decided by five points or fewer during its league championship 2009-10 season.

SHUTTING DOWN THE BREAK

■ UTEP has allowed zero fast break points in seven of its last 10 contests (UTSA, Marshall, UAB, Middle Tennessee, LA Tech, Southern Miss, Rice).

■ During that span the Miners have outscored opponents 56-27 in fast break points.

DYNAMITE "D"

■ The Miners have held 11 of their last 18 opponents to shooting percentages below 40. During that span their composite defensive field goal percentage is .392 (388-for-990).

■ The Miners lead C-USA in field goal percentage defense (.387) and three-point field goal percentage defense (.279) for league games only.

■ UTEP is second in C-USA in scoring defense for league games only (63.3 ppg) behind Middle Tennessee (60.9 ppg). Throw out overtimes and the Miners have yielded an average of 60.9 ppg in 15 C-USA contests.

MINERS RACKING UP THE MINUTES

■ UTEP's Dominic Artis has played 990 minutes this season and is on pace for 1,137 in 31 games. Omega Harris has played 945 minutes and is on pace for 1,090 in 30 games (Harris did not play versus Northwestern State on Dec. 3).

■ Nine Miners have played 1,100 minutes in a season (Randy Culpepper, Tim Hardaway, Stefon Jackson, Christian Polk, Eddie Rivera, Julian Stone, Omar Thomas, Julian Washburn, Jason Williams).

■ Artis' minutes per game (36.7) would be a school record, and Harris' (36.3) would rank fifth.

ARTIS' ALL-AROUND SEASON

■ Dominic Artis leads the Miners in rebounding (6.5 rpg), assists (5.8 apg), steals (2.1 spg) and minutes (36.7 mpg), and ranks second in scoring (15.0 ppg).

■ Eight players have led the Miners in assists and steals in a season, most recently Edgar Moreno in 2005-06. No player has led UTEP in assists, steals and rebounds.

■ Artis has led the Miners in scoring seven times, rebounds 10 times, assists 21 times and steals 20 times in 2016-17.

■ Artis has tied the school record for most games with 12+ assists in a season (three). Filiberto Rivera also compiled three such games during the 2004-05 season.

■ With 157 assists, he has the 13th-most in a season in school history. With 56 steals, he has the 12th-most in a season.

MORE ON "D.A."

■ Dominic Artis has totals of 1,141 points, 453 rebounds, 472 assists and 159 steals in his college career (2012-14 at Oregon, 2015-present at UTEP).

■ Artis is fifth in school history in assists (327).

■ Artis has come close to posting only the second triple-double in school history on several occasions, including four times this season. He had eight points/nine rebounds/13 assists in the opener against Louisiana College, 20 points/10 rebounds/nine assists versus Western Michigan, 18 points/nine rebounds/10 assists against FIU and 14 points/nine rebounds/nine assists at WKU. The only triple-double in Miner history was registered by Jason Williams versus Lipscomb (17 points, 11 rebounds, 10 assists) in the NIT on March 14, 2006.

DOMINIC'S NEAR-EXCLUSIVE CLUB

■ Dominic Artis is the first player in school history to tally 400 points, 150 rebounds, 150 assists and 50 steals in a season.

■ He is one of only four Conference USA players to achieve the feat. The others are Cincinnati's Kenny Satterfield (2000-01), UAB's Paul Delaney III (2006-07) and LA Tech's Alex Hamilton (2015-16).

■ Artis became the second player in the country to reach those milestones in 2016-17, after UCLA star Lonzo Ball.

OMEGA IS THE ALPHA

■ Omega Harris leads UTEP in scoring (16.5 ppg) and is tied with Dominic Artis for the team lead in double-figure scoring games (24). He had his 16-game double figure scoring streak, longest by a UTEP player in six years, snapped against Middle Tennessee on Feb. 4.

■ He is 10th in school history in three-point field goals (118). Rico Nelson and Julian Washburn are tied for eighth place with 119 three-pointers.

■ He has scored 943 career points.

■ Harris has scored 20+ points seven times this season, matching the total of the team leader the last two years (Vince Hunter in 2014-15, Lee Moore in 2015-16). The last UTEP player to compile more than seven 20-point games in a season was Randy Culpepper in 2010-11 (17).

SECOND COMING

■ 7'1" Matt Willms returned this season after missing most of 2015-16 with a fracture of the navicular bone in his foot that required a similar surgery as fellow big men Joel Embiid and Greg Oden.

■ It was the second major surgery of Willms' career; he had surgery for a torn labrum in his shoulder in 2014.

■ Willms is averaging 11.5 points, 5.3 rebounds and 1.0 blocks.

■ He is 10th in school history in blocked shots (86). Brian Stewart is ninth with 87 rejections.

■ Willms is trying to become the second UTEP player to lead Conference USA in field goal percentage (.598). The first was Cedrick Lang during the 2014-15 season (.620).

THOMAS' IMPROVEMENT

- Paul Thomas has been the Miners' most improved player from the start of the season. Thomas is averaging 10.1 points and 7.1 rebounds in league games, shooting 55.2 percent from the field.
- Thomas has led UTEP in rebounding a team-leading 12 times this season, and has been the Miners' leading scorer in two of the last three contests.
- He has scored in double figures in nine of the last 14 games overall.
- Thomas has five double-doubles in 2016-17, second-most on the squad behind Dominic Artis' eight. He has had 10+ rebounds on seven occasions to lead the team.

JAKE DOES THE DIRTY WORK

- Jake Flaggert led Conference USA in charges drawn (18) last season, and is back at it in 2016-17 with a team-leading 28 in 27 games.
- Flaggert has 52 charges drawn in his Miner career (88 games).
- Four of Flaggert's five career double-figure scoring games have come this season, including a personal best 15 points against Northern Arizona (Dec. 17). Flaggert also had a UTEP-high five three-point field goals versus the Lumberjacks.
- Flaggert is shooting 41.2 percent from three-point land and 77.8 percent from the line.

JONES' STORY

- UTEP's 6-11 freshman center Kelvin Jones has had an amazing road to El Paso.
- He grew up in Galeana, Chihuahua, Mexico, where his father was the mayor. He played soccer and volleyball.
- In 2011, after cartel violence claimed two relatives, the family left in the middle of the night and moved to Bismarck, North Dakota.
- Jones started playing basketball his freshman year in high school. He was 6-9 and the school didn't have a volleyball program.
- He finished his prep career at Hobbs [N.M.] High School, where he averaged 14.7 points, 9.9 rebounds and 3.2 blocks for a 30-2, state championship team.
- Jones put on 20 pounds in-between his junior and senior seasons.
- He walked on his first year at UTEP and sold pesticides door-to-door in Houston so he could have enough money to pay for his college tuition.

BENCH COMES UP BIG

- With Kelvin Jones scoring in double figures for the first time as a Miner (10 points), the UTEP bench was highly productive in Thursday's win at Florida Atlantic.
- Miner reserves Jones, Deon Barrett and Trey Touchet combined to score 17 points on 8-of-10 shooting.
- Jones became the fourth Miner to score in double figures off the bench in 2016-17, joining Terry Winn versus Western Michigan (10 points), Barrett at New Mexico (25 points) and Trey Touchet against FIU (11 points).
- UTEP has gotten a double-digit point total from its bench in back-to-back games for the first time since mid-December. Miner reserves scored 15 points at Rice (Feb. 18) and 17 at Florida Atlantic on Thursday.

THE FLOYD ERA

- UTEP has posted 134 wins under coach Tim Floyd, who is in his seventh season.
- The Miners have fashioned a mark of 73-42 in Conference USA play under Floyd, with top-three finishes on three occasions (tied for second 2010-11, third 2012-13, tied for second 2014-15). UTEP has registered double-digit C-USA victories in six of the seven years, including in each of the last five.

MORE ON FLOYD

- Tim Floyd is in his seventh season on the UTEP bench with a career record of 462-272, including 134-92 with the Miners.
- He has the most career wins among current C-USA coaches.
- Floyd ranks second in school history in victories behind the legendary Don Haskins (719) and has also coached the second-most games of any UTEP coach (226).
- Floyd has enjoyed 20 winning seasons in 22 years as a collegiate head coach. His teams have made eight NCAA Tournament appearances and five trips to the NIT.
- Floyd previously was the head coach at Idaho (1986-88), New Orleans (1988-94), Iowa State (1994-98) and USC (2005-09). He was also head coach of the Chicago Bulls (1998-2002) and the New Orleans Hornets (2003-04) in the NBA.

DEFENSE UNDER FLOYD

- UTEP has allowed less than 70 points 143 times under Tim Floyd (in 226 games), less than 60 points 78 times and less than 50 points on 18 occasions.
- The Miners have held 93 teams under 40 percent shooting, posting a 77-16 record.

NOVEMBER SIGNEES

- Evan Gilyard, Kobe Magee, Tirus Smith and Roderick Williams have signed national letters of intent to play basketball at UTEP beginning with the 2017-18 season.

■ Gilyard is a 5-9, 160-pound guard from Simeon Career Academy in Chicago, which has produced numerous NBA standouts including Milwaukee Bucks forward Jabari Parker and New York Knicks guard Derrick Rose. Gilyard is regarded as a three-star prospect by ESPN and the no. 13 player in Illinois. He averaged 13.5 points and 3.2 assists last season while shooting 49 percent from three-point range. He was second team All-City, two-time All-Conference and honorable mention All-State.

■ Magee is a 6-0, 140-pound guard from Brandeis High School in San Antonio. He averaged 17.9 points as a junior with 79 three-pointers, helping Brandeis to a 31-2 mark and a top-10 state ranking. A starter since his freshman year, Magee has garnered All-District honors twice and has been a part of three 20-win teams. He was appointed to the Northside NISD and San Antonio ISD All-Tournament teams on a pair of occasions.

■ Smith is a 6-8, 230-pound forward from Petal (Miss.) High School. Now in his third year as a varsity letterwinner, he was appointed to The Clarion-Ledger's "Dandy Dozen" as one of the 12 best players in the state of Mississippi for the 2016-17 campaign. He averaged 16 points, 11 rebounds and 2.5 blocks last season. Smith participated in the MAC/Mississippi Sports Medicine All-Star Classic as a member of the South team in March.

■ Williams is a 6-7, 210-pound forward from Los Angeles, Calif. who is currently attending East Los Angeles College. He will have three years of eligibility with the Miners. Williams previously played at Price High School in L.A., where he was named the 2015 John R. Wooden High School Player of the Year for the CIF Los Angeles City Section (Division VI). He led Price in scoring in back-to-back years and to the semifinals at the 2015 California state playoffs. Regarded as a three-star recruit by ESPN.com and the no. 19 player in California, Williams averaged 16 points and seven rebounds as a prep senior. He was first team All-CIF.

■ The Miners' fall recruiting class also includes guards Isiah Osborne and Trey Wade who are currently with the program and sitting out the 2016-17 campaign. The 6-5, 190-pound Osborne averaged 15.0 points at the University of Windsor last year. He was named the CIS (Canadian Interuniversity Sport) Rookie of the Year as well as the OUA (Ontario University Athletics) Rookie of the Year. The 6-5, 180-pound Wade hails from South Cobb High School in Austell, Ga. He averaged 19.1 points and 7.5 rebounds as a senior in 2015-16.

LOOKING AHEAD

- UTEP will close out the regular season with home games versus Old Dominion (March 2) and Charlotte (March 4) next week. The Old Dominion game will tip at 6 p.m., and the Charlotte game will start at 1 p.m.

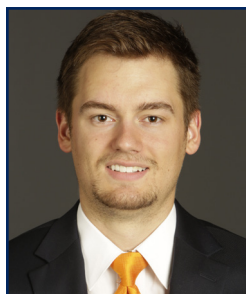

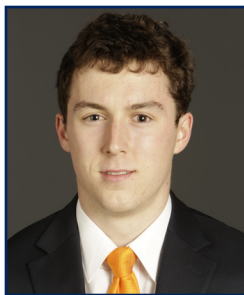

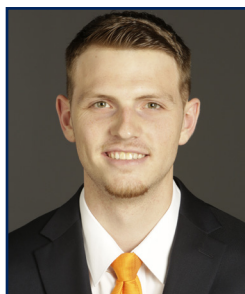
