### QUICK HITTERS

- ▶ Over the last two games, MT has outscored the opposition 39-10 in the second half
- ▶ Senior WR Patrick Smith has 23 receptions over the last four games
- ▶ Middle Tennessee's 61 points scored against UTM went down as the most by the Blue Raiders since scoring 77 in a win over FAU in 2016.
- ▶ MT has been bowl eligible nine times in the last 12 years and has reached a bowl game a school-record three straight years.
- ▶ The 2018 season will be the **104th** for Blue Raider football and the **20th** at the FBS level.
- ▶ WR **Ty Lee** has hauled in at least one reception in **31** straight games which ranks as the 4th longest streak in MT history and is the 7th longest current streak in the country.
- ▶ In MT's last **22 wins**, it has averaged 527.3 yards of total offense and allowed 371.6.
- ▶ QB **Brent Stockstill** has thrown at least one TD pass in **28** straight games, which ranks as the second longest streak nationally behind Penn State's Trace McSorley (33).
- ▶ LB **Khalil Brooks** ranked 21st nationally last year in TFLs with 17.0 and has 5.5 so far this season.
- ▶ WR **Ty Lee** ranked 19th nationally last year in receptions per game with 6.1 but is reeling in 4.0 a game this season.
- ▶ MT is **28-14** all-time in C-USA play and is averaging **198.7** yards rushing per game.

- ▶ Middle Tennessee is **25-7** in its last 31 home games.
- ▶ In their last **50** conference games, the Blue Raiders have a mark of **34-16**.
- ▶ Over the last 74 games, the Blue Raiders have come up with 74 interceptions. The team had 15 picks in 2013 by eight different players, 13 in 2014, 17 in 2015, 11 in 2016 but just five in 2017.
- ▶ Consecutive Start Leader: **Carlos Johnson** (19).
- ▶ Under **Rick Stockstill**, the Blue Raiders have been involved in 21 games that were decided in the final minute of regulation or overtime. The team is 13-9 in those games and have won nine of the last 12.
- ▶ **Rick Stockstill** is third on the school's all-time wins list with **82** victories.

## ATHLETIC COMMUNICATIONS

### Press Conference

On Mondays at 10:30 AM, in the Kennon Sports Hall of Fame building, selected players and Coach Stockstill meet with the media individually for a press conference. The weekly conferences will be held every Monday before a game. Media can park in the area located between the practice field and the weight room on campus. The Athletic Communications Office will transcribe quotes that will be put on GoBlueRaiders.com and also emailed to the Blue Raiders' primary and football lists. A video feed of Stockstill, along with the players, will be available on Youtube.com/GoBlueRaiders.tv. The Press Conference will be shown live on Facebook Live.

### Practice

Members of the media can interview coaches and players on Tuesday and Wednesday of game-week after practice. All practices are closed. Following Wednesday's practice, student-athletes will not be available for interviews until the conclusion of the game on Friday/Saturday.

### Postgame Interviews

Middle Tennessee's locker room is closed. Media will be asked to submit a list of player requests to Mark Owens at the start of the 4th quarter. During home games, players will be available to the media first in the Murphy Center Green Room (lower level) followed by Head Coach Rick Stockstill.

A photographer work area is setup prior to each game in the southeast corner of Murphy Center. Tables and internet access will be setup just outside the Green Room for use by all photographers.

## A LOOK AT THE SERIES

► The Blue Raiders and Panthers have met 13 times in football with MT holding a 9-4 advantage in the series which began in 2005. The Blue Raiders have won five of the last six, including three in a row.

► MT is 4-1 against FIU since joining C-USA in 2013

► MT is 6-1 at home against FIU and 3-3 in Miami. Rick Stockstill is 9-3 against the Panthers.

## STOCKSTILL REACHES 10,000

► With a 25-yard pass to Casey Gatlin at Marshall, senior quarterback Brent Stockstill topped the 10,000-yard mark for his career which is a Blue Raider record. Stockstill is now one of just 11 quarterbacks in the history of Conference USA to pass for over 10,000 yards in a career. He is also just the 24th player in NCAA history to reach 10,000 yards and is one of just three active signal-callers with 10,000 yards.

## STOCKSTILL TIES RAMSEY

► QB Brent Stockstill recorded his 16th career 300-yard passing game and his second of the season when he tallied 317 yards against Marshall. Stockstill is now tied for 7th all-time in C-USA history with former Tulane star Patrick Ramsey with 16 300-yard outings. With his next 300-yard game he will tie Mike White (WKU) and Kevin Kolb (Houston) for 5th.

## MOFFATT HAS CAREER GAME

► Safety Jovante Moffatt turned in a career performance with his 17-tackle effort against Marshall. Moffatt's previous high was 15 against FAU (2017). Moffatt also forced a fumble that led to first-half points for the Blue Raiders. It was only Moffatt's second game of the season and now has 25 stops in his two outings. His

17 stops were just three off Middle Tennessee's single-game Top 10 list.

## SECOND HALF D

► One week after limiting FAU to 125 yards and no touchdowns in the second half, the Blue Raider defense proved dominant in the second half once again at Marshall. The defense held Marshall to 149 yards and seven points in the second half as Middle Tennessee erased a 17-10 halftime deficit. More importantly, the defense was huge in the decisive third quarter when it held Marshall to 59 yards. In the last two games, MT has outscored the opposition in the second half by a combined 39-10 and allowed just 274 yards.

## 9 TIMES IN 12 YEARS

► In 12 years under Rick Stockstill, Middle Tennessee has reached bowl eligibility nine times and eight times in the last nine years. The Blue Raiders have been bowl eligible under Rick Stockstill in 2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016 and 2017. The nine bowl eligible years during the 12-year span is more than any FBS team in Tennessee and equals the

most of any program in C-USA.

**STOCKSTILL OWNS THE RECORD BOOK**

► QB Brent Stockstill entered his senior season owning virtually ever career passing mark at Middle Tennessee. The left-hander is the record holder in passing attempts, completions, yards, touchdowns, passing efficiency, passing yards per game, consecutive completions, 300-yard passing games and 400-yard passing games. Stockstill is also the all-time leader in total offense.

**ANDERSON SHOWING VERSATILITY**

► Brad Anderson, who spent most of his freshman year at running back, started the year at wide receiver but due to injuries late at Georgia and in wins over FAU and Marshall he has been used more at running back. The Huntsville, AL, native turned in six catches for a career-high 141 yards against UTM and now leads MT with 26 receptions for 321 yards on the year. Anderson, who was second on the team in receiving in 2017 with 33 grabs, currently leads the Raiders with a 4.8-yard per carry average.

**SMITH SHINING**

► Senior receiver Patrick Smith is making the most of his final season in blue and white. The Nashville natives best year was 2017 with

29 receptions and after four games in 2018 Smith already has 24 grabs. In his last three games, Smith owns 23 catches for 279 yards and five touchdowns.

**HARRIS LEADING DEFENSE**

► Linebacker Darius Harris (6-2, 238) is coming off a career year that saw him come into his own down the stretch. Harris, the MVP of the Camellia Bowl, had 64 tackles to go with 7.5 TFLs, 4.5 sacks and six pass breakups. After five games, Harris leads the team with 42 tackles and 3.0 sacks.

**GIANT KILLERS**

► Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have a knack of knocking off Power 5 opponents. With the win at Syracuse last season, MT now has five wins over Power 5 foes in the Rick Stockstill era. MT has wins over Maryland (2008, 2009), Georgia Tech (2012), Missouri (2016) and Syracuse (2017) with six others being decided by a touchdown or less. The Raiders will have plenty chances in the future with games against Georgia and Kentucky in 2018; Michigan, Duke and Iowa in 2019; and Ole Miss and Virginia Tech in 2020.

**WINNING TURNOVER BATTLE**

► Winning the turnover battle is critical in collecting victories in football. Under Rick Stockstill, MT has a mark of 52-14 when winning the turnover battle and is 42-6 during bowl eligible years (2006, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015, 2016, 2017). Over the last 80 games (since 2012), MT is 27-3 when winning the turnover battle.

**MR. SENIORITY**

► Middle Tennessee head coach Rick Stockstill is in his 13th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders. His 13 seasons make him the longest tenured head coach in Conference USA while ranking 6th nationally.

▶ During its history, Middle Tennessee owns an impressive **170-55-1** (.754) record when a back gains 100 or more yards rushing. Under Rick Stockstill, a Blue Raider has reached the 100-yard mark 56 times and the team has a **48-8** mark in those games.

#### 30 IS MAGIC

▶ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raiders are **64-7** when scoring 30 points or more. The seven losses came at Louisville in 2007 when the Raiders fell 58-42; at Troy in 2011, 38-35; at home against WKU in 2011, 36-33 (2OT); against Western Michigan in the Popeyes Bahamas Bowl in 2015 (45-31); at home against WKU in 2016 (44-43); against Hawai'i in the Hawai'i Bowl (52-35); and at WKU (41-38 3OT) in 2017.

four times in each of the last two years under Franklin, including three games over 300 yards.

▶ MT turned in its best rushing game of the year and fifth highest under Rick Stockstill when it had 320 yards against ODU in 2017.

▶ MT has gone over the 500-yard mark of total offense in a game 11 times under Tony Franklin. The Blue Raiders did it twice in 2017 with the most recent coming against ODU (586).

▶ 13 different players scored MT's 38 offensive touchdowns in 2017. Only six players have scored TDs this season.

▶ MT had a 1,000-yard rusher and a 1,000-yard

receiver in 2016 under Franklin for the first time in school history.

▶ Over the last 28 home games, MT is averaging 39.6 points a contest (1,109 points).

▶ In five years of C-USA action, MT has rushed for 8,345 yards in 42 league games. That averages out to 198.7 yards a game.

▶ QB Brent Stockstill owns 16 career 300-yard passing games which ties him for 7th all-time in C-USA history. His next one will tie him for 5th.

**90-YARD DRIVES**

▶ The Blue Raiders have put together 24 scoring drives of 90 or more yards under Rick Stockstill. MT had four 90-yard-or-longer drives in 2016, none in 2017 and one so far in 2018. The longest drive under Stockstill was a 99 yarder in a 2007 win at Louisiana-Monroe.

**DEFENSIVE NOTES**

**DEFENSE SHOWING IMPROVEMENT**

▶ Middle Tennessee's new-look defense enjoyed quite the turnaround in 2017. They ranked 35th in total defense, 30th in rushing defense and 16th in tackles for loss. The Raiders were 96th in total defense in 2016 before Scott Shafer took over.

**DEFENSIVE SCORES**

▶ Under Rick Stockstill, the Blue Raider defense has scored 28 defensive touchdowns, and 23 have come since 2009. Of the 28 scores, 18 have been interceptions and 10 have come by way of fumble returns. The Raiders had just two defensive scores in 2016, only two in 2017 and one so far in 2018.

**10 TIMES FOR DEFENSE**

▶ Middle Tennessee's defense has held the opposition to under 400 yards of total offense in 11 of 18 games under Scott Shafer. MT did it nine times in 2017 and twice so far in 2018. The Raiders only had four games in 2016 prior to Shafer's arrival. FAU, UAB, WKU and Ark. St. are the only teams to go over 400 yards.

## PLAYER NOTES

### Brent Stockstill

► Has **87** career TD passes, owning the Blue Raider all-time mark and ranking 1st among active NCAA players. He is also tied for **6th** all-time in C-USA history (needs 10 more to tie for 4th) and is trying to become the 24th player in history to reach 100 TDs.

► Has seven career games with four or more touchdown passes.

► With **10,250** career passing yards, the senior ranks 10th all-time in Conference USA history. He needs 390 more yards to surpass Paul Smith (Tulsa) for 9th place.

► Had a career-high 434 passing yards against WKU in 2016 which ranks as the third most in school history for a single game.

► With 432 passing yards against Hawai'i in 2016, Stockstill became the first multiple 400-yard passer in school history.

► Set a new school record when he connected on his first 22 passes in the win over AAMU in 2016. Stockstill broke the previous mark of 19 set by Logan Kilgore in 2011.

► His 4,005 passing yards in 2015 was tops in the country among freshmen and was a new MT single-season and C-USA freshman record. He also led all freshmen in touchdown passes with 30.

► Stockstill set the new NCAA freshman completions record with 327 (Kentucky's Jared Lorenzen had 321 in 2000) and fell just 53 yards shy of breaking Jameis Winston's NCAA freshman passing record of 4,057 yards.

► Set a new school record with four straight 300-yard passing games in 2015.

► His 31 touchdown passes in 2016 was a new school record and broke the previous mark of 30 set by Stockstill himself in 2015.

### Ty Lee

► Ranks 6th all-time in receiving yards at MT and needs 374 more to surpass Demetric Mostiller for 5th place.

► Ranks 10th at MT with 14 career touchdown receptions. He needs two more to tie Ed Batties, George Dykes and G.E. McCormack for 7th place.

► Has hauled in at least one reception in **31** straight games which ranks 4th longest all-time at MT. He needs one more to tie Demetric Mostiller for third. The all-time record is 43.

## RAIDER ROUNDUP

► The top-scoring quarter in the Rick Stockstill

have combined for 49 tackles. Moffatt has 25 stops and Blankenship 24.

► After a rocky first half against defending C-USA champ FAU, the Blue Raider defense held the Owls to just 125 total yards in the second half and allowed dynamic back Devin Singletary 39 yards rushing.

► In his first career game, freshman **Gregory Grate** picked off a pass against UTM and returned it 97 yards for a touchdown. It went down as the third longest in MT history and tied for the 15th longest in C-USA history.

► In his first collegiate start, **Grate** led MT with a personal-best nine tackles at Georgia.

► LB **DQ Thomas** had a career night in the win over UTM by registering six solo stops to go with 2.0 sacks, 3.0 TFLs, a pass breakup and a hurry. Thomas leads the team with 4.0 sacks.

► MT had 32 sacks in 2017 and 25 came in the seven wins. That total went down as the fourth most in school history.

► MT held Bowling Green in 2017 to just 1

total rushing yard in week 4 which went down as the third fewest ever allowed in a single game by the Blue Raiders. It was also the fewest since giving up just five yards against North Texas in 2016.

► The Blue Raiders recorded six sacks against Syracuse in 2017 which was their most in a game since registering six in a win over UAB in 2014 - a span of 32 games. It was also the most ever against a Power 5 team under Rick Stockstill. MT also later had six sacks in 2017 bowl win over A-State.

► MT owns two shutouts since entering C-USA play in 2013. MT defeated FIU 48-0 in 2013 and downed Alabama A&M last year 55-0.

► Overall, the Blue Raiders have 74 interceptions in their last 74 games.

MT has scored in 118 straight home games (last shutout was 9/23/1995 vs Murray State).

▶ Largest margin of victory in the I-A era: 59 points vs Charlotte 9/19/15 (73-14) ... Largest margin of defeat in the I-A era: 59 points vs Oklahoma 9/23/06 (59-0).

#### RAIDERS IN THE NFL

▶ MT currently has five players on NFL rosters. Benny Cunningham (Bears), Kevin Byard (Titans), Josh Walker (Jaguars), Richie James (49ers) and Charvarius Ward (Chiefs).

#### ACADEMICS ARE A TOP PRIORITY

▶ Academic success at MT has been a high priority for 13th-year coach Rick Stockstill.

Under his reign, the Blue Raiders have seen 96 percentage of student-athletes earn their degree entering the 2018 season. MT, who has also been impressive with APR scores under Stockstill, has been publicly recognized by the NCAA for APR success twice in the last eight years. Also under Stockstill, the Blue Raiders have taken home six Academic All-District honors and produced an Academic All-American.

▶ Middle Tennessee has eight student-athletes entering the 2018 season already with a degree in hand. The graduates are Gatlin Casey, Cordell Hudson, Brent Stockstill, Darius Liggins, Angelo Owens, Jahmal Jones, Darius Harris and Carlos Johnson.

▶ On Dec. 7, 2017, Middle Tennessee was one of just seven programs nationally to earn the AFCA's 2017 Academic Achievement Award. The Blue Raiders recorded a perfect 100 percent graduation rate for freshmen football student-athletes class of 2010.

# RICK STOCKSTILL

Head Coach  
13th Year - Florida State '82  
2-Time Coach of the Year

Winning on the field, off the field and having a first-class football program from top to bottom is the goal of any university at the highest level of intercollegiate athletics. That is exactly what Middle Tennessee has as a result of the leadership of head coach Rick Stockstill.

In his 13th season at the helm of the Blue Raiders, Stockstill is the sixth-longest tenured coach in the country and third-longest in MT history. With his long tenure have come numerous achievements and accolades, including:

- 2006 Sun Belt co-champions
- 2009 New Orleans Bowl and 2017 Raycom Media Camellia Bowl champions
- 79 wins, third all-time in program history
- 7 bowl appearances and bowl eligible 9 times
- 2 NCAA awards for APR success (2011, 2012)
- American Football Coaches Association's 2017 Academic Achievement Award
- Back-to-back eight-win seasons in 2012-13 for first time in 21 years
- Six of the top eight crowds in Floyd Stadium history, including top three
- 8 All-Americans (1 Academic All-American)
- Three conference defensive players of the year
- Produced 36 First Team All-Conference honors
- Four bowl game MVPs
- Six NFL Draft picks and a pro bowler
- Produced the school's all-time leader in passing yards, receptions, sacks and interceptions
- 2018 recipient of the Grant Teaff "Breaking the Silence" Award

Stockstill and the Raiders advanced to their third bowl game in as many seasons in 2017 when they went to Montgomery, Alabama and took down Arkansas State for the Raycom Media Camellia Bowl championship, the first time in program history they played in bowl games in three successive seasons. It was also the seventh bowl game for MT under Stockstill's guidance and second win, joining the 2009 New Orleans Bowl title.

The first of the three-year bowl streak came in 2015, when MT held a 7-6 record and Popeyes Bahamas Bowl berth. The Blue Raiders had to show a tremendous amount of grit to become bowl eligible, winning all four games in November.

Prior to the three years finishing in bowl games, Stockstill led Middle Tennessee to three straight second-place finishes in Conference USA's East Division from 2012-14, including a berth in the Bell Helicopter Armed Forces Bowl in 2013 against Navy.

Some regard the 2012 season as his best coaching job after leading the Blue Raiders to the nation's biggest win improvement from the previous year. They won just two games in 2011, but Stockstill turned the 2012 MT squad around, finishing with an 8-4 record that included an FBS school record five road wins. They also received votes in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll three straight weeks, another school record, and upset ACC Coastal Division Champion Georgia Tech. Along the way, he produced a Freshman All-American, eight all-conference players and a national offensive player of the week.

Throughout his 13-season tenure, Stockstill has also shown a commitment to academics. The Blue Raiders have gone from an APR score of 892 to a very impressive 992, the biggest increase of any program in the country.

Born Dec. 23, 1957 in Sidney, Ohio, Stockstill grew up in Georgetown, Kentucky, and then moved to Fernandina Beach, Florida, where he was inducted into the Fernandina Beach Hall of Fame in 2006. He was a three-year letterman at Florida State as a quarterback, where he was team captain and earned Honorable Mention All-American honors in 1981 under Coach Bobby Bowden. During his career at FSU, the Seminoles had two top-10 final Associated Press rankings and had wins over powers Notre Dame, Pittsburgh, Ohio State and Nebraska. Stockstill, who received his bachelor's degree from FSU in 1982, made three bowl trips with the Seminoles.

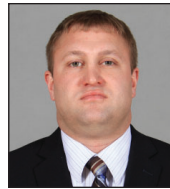

- Middle Tennessee's first scoring drive of 2018 when for 93 yards which was its first 90+ yard drive since Nov. 26, 2016 against FAU (92 yards). It went down as the 24th 90-yard scoring drive under Rick Stockstill.
- Senior punter Matt Bonadies enjoyed a solid night for the Blue Raiders. Bonadies punted four times for a 42.8 yard average and two of his kicks were downed inside the 20-yard line. The Buford, GA, native had a long punt of 50 yards.
- Ten different Blue Raiders players caught passes against Vanderbilt, led by Brad Anderson and Ty Lee with five receptions each, while Tavares Thomas finished with four receptions.
- Official delay of tonight's game due to lightning in the area was 21 minutes... LB Darius Harris, LB Chris Melton and DB Darryl Randolph played in their team-leading 40th career game tonight ... WR Ty Lee made his team-leading 17th straight start ... OL Chandler Brewer started his team-high 37th career game tonight against Vandy ... QB Brent Stockstill has now thrown at least one touchdown pass in 24 straight games played which is the second longest streak in the country (behind PSU's Trace McSorley) ... WR Ty Lee has now caught at least one pass in 27 straight games which ties David Youell for 5th all-time at MT ... WR CJ Windham hauled in his second career TD pass in the first quarter.

RAIDERS FALL IN OPENER

NASHVILLE - Troubles offensively cost Middle Tennessee, as the Blue Raiders traveled to Vanderbilt and were defeated 35-7 in their season opener.

It was the fourth loss in a row for the Raiders in the series, which is in its final year in the current contract.

"I told them [after the game], I like this team and I'm not down on this team one bit," head coach Rick Stockstill said. "I'm sick to my stomach that we lost, and they're sick to their stomachs because they lost. We're still going to be a dang good football team.

"I feel a lot better about this team than I did at this point last year."

Middle Tennessee (0-1) looked to have control of the Commodore (1-0) defense in the first quarter, as a 4-yard pass from redshirt senior Brent Stockstill to junior CJ Windham ended a 93-yard drive with a touchdown. It knotted things at seven with two minutes left in the opening frame, and momentum had been snatched.

From there, though, the Blue Raider attack turned inconsistent.

It started with a bad lateral pass from Brent Stockstill to sophomore Brad Anderson that was dropped and returned 3 yards by Vanderbilt's Dayo Odeyingbo for what proved to be the game-winning score with 14 minutes left in the first half.

Middle Tennessee's defense did all it could to hold things close, holding Vanderbilt to just 89 total yards in the first half. But, the costly mistakes and inconsistencies on offense voided the good effort.

The Blue Raiders moved the ball effectively, getting to the Vanderbilt side of the field five times after their scoring drive in the first quarter. However, all five drives ended without points (three punts, an interception and a missed field goal).

Brent Stockstill finished the game 24 of 36 for 178 yards, one touchdown and an interception, and he added 10 yards rushing. He was sacked six times.

Ten Blue Raiders caught at least one pass, led by Anderson and junior Ty Lee with five catches apiece, Anderson for 37 yards and Lee for 25.

Defensively, redshirt senior linebacker Darius Harris led the way with eight tackles, a sack and tackle for loss. Khalil Brooks added five tackles and a tackle for loss, and Chris Melton and Kylan Stribling also had five tackles apiece.

BLUE RAIDERS ROLL IN HOME OPENER

MURFREESBORO - It wasn't pretty at times, but a win is a win.

That's what Middle Tennessee Head Coach Rick Stockstill told his team after the Blue Raiders (1-1) sent their fans home happy with a 61-37 win over UT Martin (0-2) at Floyd Stadium.

"Winning is hard," he said. "This was a grind ... it was a tough, competitive game." Not everything went MT's way against its old OVC rival. The Blue Raiders surrendered 460 total yards (355 passing), gave up an onside kick, allowed four sacks, missed two extra points, suffered six costly penalties and gave up 12 third-down conversions.

Despite the miscues, Middle Tennessee was able to grow as much as a 23-point lead midway through the third quarter thanks to its offense and hung on.

"When you win and don't play your best, that's always a positive," Coach Stockstill said.

The Blue Raiders took a 26-17 lead into halftime and expanded on it quickly after the break thanks to redshirt senior quarterback Brent Stockstill and a good special teams play.

After Stockstill marched the blue and white down the field for a touchdown, red-shirt freshman linebacker Wayne Parks recovered a poor punt attempt on the ensuing Skyhawk drive and returned it 35 yards for another score, giving MT a 40-17 lead that was its largest of the game to that point.

The Skyhawks tried a dramatic comeback after the punt return TD, cutting the lead all the way down to 47-37 with 9 ½ minutes left in the contest, but MT wouldn't be denied its first win of 2018.

Stockstill answered a 59-yard UTM scoring drive with an eight-play, 75-yard drive highlighted by a 39-yard reception by sophomore Brad Anderson. The drive ended with a 26-yard passing score to Patrick Smith, his third receiving TD of the night.

UT Martin attempted another answer, getting the ball down into the red zone, but freshman Gregory Grate Jr. iced the game with a 97-yard pick six to put Middle Tennessee up by the 61-37 final.

Stockstill finished 25 of 34 for 407 yards and five TDs through the air, his third career 400-yard passing game. Anderson was his favorite target, catching six balls for 141 yards, and Smith had five grabs for 87 yards and three TDs, tied for a school single-game record. CJ Windham added three catches for 86 yards and two TDs.

Alongside Stockstill in the backfield, redshirt freshman Chaton Mobley got the first start of his Blue Raider career and responded well. The Fulton, Tennessee native finished with 12 carries for 55 yards and the first two TDs of his college career.

Defensively, Middle Tennessee racked up five sacks as a team, led by two from Thomas, who also had six tackles and three tackles for loss.
