CAREER FIRSTS

- DB Dorian Hall's first quarter interception was the first of his career.
- LT D'Ante Demery, QB James Morgan, RG Shacquille Williams and WR CJ Worton all earned their first starts on offense, while DB Olin Cushion III, LB Edwin Freeman, DB Dorian Hall and DE Kevin Oliver earned

BACK TO WORK

- After missing all of 2017 due to injury, RB Anthony Jones scored two touchdowns on the ground and rushed for 91 yards.
- Before tonight, Jones had not scored a touchdown since Nov. 19, 2016 (Marshall).
- Jones scored twice on Saturday night, earning his first two-score game as a Panther.
- The redshirt senior finished with 91 yards, which is the most since earning 121 against Marshall (Nov. 19, 2016).

OTHER NOTABLES

- A total of 29 Panthers earned playing time in the first quarter.
- LB Sage Lewis earned a career-high 18 tackles against the Hoosiers on Saturday night.
- The 18 tackles are tied for fifth overall with Keyonvis Bouie, who achieved the feat three times during his career.
- DB Ike Brown earned a career-high 9 tackles on Saturday night.
- FIU has now scored on 25-straight redzone attempts.
- The Panthers are now 0-11 against teams from the Big Ten.
- FIU fell to 3-13 all-time in season openers.
