## QUICK HITS

■ FIU closes out its first Conference USA homestand of the season on Jan. 12, when it welcomes Old Dominion to the Ocean Bank Convocation Center ... Tipoff is slated for 7 p.m. and can be seen live on ESPN+ ... The Panthers look to improve to 12-6 on the year.

■ FIU's 11-5 start is tied for the best 15-game start in program history, joining the 1984-85 squad that also started the season 11-5.

■ FIU comes into the ODU game following a hard-fought 69-66 win over Charlotte on Jan. 10 ... Trejon Jacob scored a team-high 19 points while Osasumwen Osaghae and Antonio Daye, Jr. added 13 and 10 points.

■ Through Jan 10, Brian Beard, Jr. leads NCAA in steals-per-game (3.4) and total steals (55) ... Osasumwen Osaghae is 21st in the nation in offensive rebounds-per-game (3.4) ... FIU is also fifth in scoring (89.4).

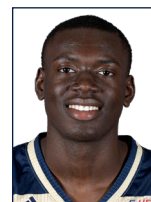

## HEAD COACH JEREMY BALLARD | 11-5 CAREER RECORD | 2-1 CONFERENCE USA RECORD



Jeremy Ballard was officially introduced as the ninth head coach in the history of the FIU men's basketball program on April 23, 2018, at a press conference in the Ocean Bank Convocation Center.

Ballard arrives at FIU after serving as associate head coach at VCU in 2017-18. He has spent 14 seasons as an assistant coach at the Division I level with coaching stints at Pitt, Illinois State, VCU, Tulsa and his alma mater Colgate.

As associate head coach at VCU, Ballard was reunited with current VCU head coach Mike Rhoades, who he coached with prior on the staff of former VCU head coach and current Texas head coach Shaka Smart. Ballard's main focus was VCU's defense. The Rams finished 18-15 this past season and advanced to the Atlantic 10 Conference Quarterfinals. Forward Justin Tillman was named All-Atlantic 10 Conference First Team, as well as to the All-Defensive Team.

His most successful stretch came with the Rams from 2012-15. Ballard helped lead VCU to a 79-28 mark and three straight NCAA Tournament appearances during his initial tenure in Richmond from 2012-15. During that time, VCU won at least 26 games each season and finished each season ranked in the Associated Press Top-25. In all, Ballard coached three eventual NBA players at VCU, including Troy Daniels, Briante Weber and Treveon Graham.

At the time of his hiring at FIU, Ballard was the sixth former Smart assistant to become a head coach. Rhoades, Will Wade (LSU), Mike Jones (Radford), Jamion Christian (Mount St. Mary's) and Mike Morrell (UNC Asheville) are the others.

Ballard served as an assistant on Kevin Stallings' Pitt staff during the 2016-17 season, where he coached All-ACC Third Team and USBWA All-District II forward Michael Young and All-ACC Honorable Mention selection Jamel Artis. Young led the ACC in scoring averaging 19.6 points per game. Young went on to sign with the Washington Wizards while Artis signed with the Orlando Magic.

In 2015-16, Ballard helped guide Illinois State to an 18-14 overall record and a 12-6 Missouri Valley Conference mark, which tied for second place and signified ISU's highest league finish and most conference wins since 2007-08. Working primarily with Illinois State's forwards, Ballard helped MiKyle McIntosh earn MVC Most-Improved Team accolades. McIntosh was also a 2016 All-MVC Honorable Mention Team selection.

In 2014-15, Ballard helped VCU to its first Atlantic 10 Conference Tournament title. VCU was ranked as high as No. 10 in the Associated Press Top-25 Poll during that period, and on his watch, the Rams earned five all-conference accolades, including two first-team honors.

During his first year as an assistant with the Rams, Ballard worked closely with shooting guard Troy Daniels, who would set a VCU single-season school record with 124 3-pointers. Daniels has since played for four NBA franchises. He signed a multiyear contract extension with the Memphis Grizzlies in 2016 and currently is with the Phoenix Suns.

Ballard's three seasons on Smart's staff at VCU (2012-15) were preceded by five seasons at Tulsa (2007-12) where he helped guide the Golden Hurricane to 109 victories, including three 20-plus win seasons. Tulsa had nine all-conference honorees, including a first-team selection in each of his final four seasons with the Golden Hurricane. Ballard either recruited or coached three NBA players – Jordan Clarkson, Jerome Jordan and Ben Uzoh – during his time at Tulsa.

In his first season, Tulsa piled up 25 wins and a berth in the Conference USA championship game. The Golden Hurricane eventually won the inaugural College Basketball Invitational Championship and that postseason appearance was followed by back-to-back National Invitation Tournament showings.

Prior to his time with the Golden Hurricane, Ballard was an assistant at his alma mater Colgate University (2004-07). During his time as a student-athlete at Colgate, Ballard won the prestigious ECAC Merit Medal Award twice, becoming only the third player in Colgate history to do so. He twice earned Patriot League Academic Honor Roll recognition and was given the title of the team's best defensive player by the coaching staff during his senior season. Ballard also served as a captain during his senior season.

An Atlanta native, Ballard graduated from Colgate in 2003 with a bachelor's degree in English and a minor in religion. He has a son, Khalif Jamal.

## SCOUTING OLD DOMINION

■ Old Dominion comes into its game with FIU with an 11-5 record and a 1-2 mark in Conference USA, following its 80-73 loss to Florida Atlantic on Thursday ... ODU has won nine of its last 11 after starting the season 2-3.

■ Ahmad Carter leads the Monarchs in scoring, netting 17.8 points-per-contest, while B.J. Stith is second in scoring, averaging 17.7 points-per-outing, and is grabbing a team-high 8.4 rebounds-per-contest.

## THE SERIES AGAINST THE MONARCHS

■ Old Dominion holds a 6-0 series lead in all-time meetings with FIU ... All of the games have come while members of Conference USA ... The Panthers have scored 60-or-more points just once in the series, with that coming during the 2015-16 season (L, 64-60).

## LAST TIME OUT

■ FIU bent but didn't break on Thursday night as the Panthers hung on for a 69-66 win over Charlotte.

■ Trejon Jacob scored a team-high 19 points, with 14 coming in the second half, while Osasumwen Osaghae added 13 points and Antonio Daye, Jr. chipped in the 10 points in the win ... In addition to Osaghae's 13 points, he rejected a career-high seven shots, had seven rebounds and a career-best three steals ... Devon Andrews grabbed a team-high eight rebounds.

■ With the Panthers leading by as many as 17 points, 51-34, with 15:14 left in the game, Charlotte made its way back into single digits when the 49ers hit the second of two free-throw attempts to make the score 62-53 with 4:44 left in the contest ... Charlotte then cut the lead to one, 67-66, capping off a 13-2 run with 13 seconds remaining ... That was as close as the 49ers got.

■ FIU shot 37.3 percent (22-of-59) from the field on the night, including 42.9 percent (12-for-28) in the first half ... The Panthers also forced Charlotte into 23 turnovers on the night, leading to 23 points ... The blue and gold held an 18-2 advantage in fast break points.

## ROAD WARRIORS

■ Last weekend started another stretch that will keep the Panthers away from home for the majority of the time ... With their game against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3 (W, 83-76), FIU starts another stretch of seven games where five will come on the road ... Following this week against Charlotte (W, 69-66) and Old Dominion (Jan. 12, 7 p.m.) at home, FIU will close out the stretch with three-straight on the road, at WKU (Jan. 17, 8 p.m. ET), at Marshall (Jan. 19, 7 p.m.) and at Florida Atlantic (Jan. 23, 7 p.m.).

## CONFERENCE USA BONUS PLAY FORMAT

Within the format, the 14 Conference USA programs will play each other once and their travel partner twice in the first seven weeks of the conference season. At the end of the seven weeks, teams will be placed in one of three groups based on conference standings through the first 14 games of league action. The teams will be divided into two groups of five (1-5 and 6-10) and a group of four (11-14). During the final three weeks, teams will play within their respective grouping for the last four games of conference play. Home and away games within the groups will be determined by a preset formula.

Once all 18 games have been completed, the top 12 teams based on final league standings will be seeded in the conference tournament. Teams will be guaranteed seeding within their respective group. For example, if a program lands in the second group (6-10), it will seed no higher than six and no lower than 10 in the tournament field.

■ FIU is currently averaging 96.1 points-per-game at home this season ... Prior to their home game against USF on Dec. 18 - an 82-73 loss - the Panthers averaged an impressive 103.6 points-per-game at home ... The Panthers have hit the century mark in five of their eight games at home this season ... On the flip-side, FIU is allowing just 75.2 points-per-game on its home floor.

## FIU COMING-FROM-BEHIND WINS

■ FIU's 83-76 come-from-behind win over Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3, was its seventh of the season, out of its 10 total wins ... The largest deficit that the Panthers have come back from was 15 points, against Florida Gulf Coast on Nov. 28, en route to an 81-80 win.

■ FIU's 121-89 loss at Arkansas on Dec. 1, snapped the Panthers' four-game winning streak, its longest since the 2015-16 season when it won four-consecutive games against Binghamton (66-49), Florida A&M (64-45), Florida Atlantic (76-59) and WKU (75-72) ... Prior to the 2015-16 season the Panthers won six-straight during the 2013-14 campaign.

## ... AND SO DID THE HOME STREAK

■ FIU's 82-73 loss to USF on Dec. 18, snapped the Panthers' 10-game home winning streak, dating back to their 67-64 win against Rice on Feb. 24, 2018 ... Entering the game against the Bulls, it was the 27th longest streak in the nation ... The Panthers' last loss in the OBCC, prior to Dec. 18, was to Old Dominion, 64-54, on Jan. 18, 2018.

## OT WOES

■ Although FIU has not played any overtime games this season, the Panthers have struggled since the 2015-16 season in extra session games, having lost their last 12-straight overtime games, the longest overtime losing streak in the nation ... Six of the losses have been by three points or less ... **FIU's all-time overtime games are listed on page 12.**

## DROPPIN' SOME' C-NOTES

■ FIU's 117 points against Johnson & Wales marked the second-straight game that the Panthers reached the century mark ... The Panthers scored 110 points in the season-opening 110-84 win over Webber International on Nov. 7 ... Prior to this season, the last time that an FIU team hit the 100-point mark in regulation was on Feb. 26, 1998, pouring in 101 points against Centenary in a 101-74 win in the TAAC Tournament ... That was the second of two-straight games where the Panthers scored 100-or-more points ... FIU also did it five days before in a 117-79 win over Troy on Feb. 21, 1998.

■ FIU logged its third 100-plus-point game when it scored 102 points in a 102-93 win over Youngstown State on Nov. 18, and also accomplished the feat in its next outing, against Ave Maria on Nov. 23, in a 104-84 win in the Johnny Bach Classic at Fordham.

■ The Panthers hit the 100-point plateau on Dec. 13, with a 102-89 win against North Florida, and most recently poured in 108 points in a 108-67 win over Florida Memorial on Dec. 20.

■ The Panthers' six 100-point games are tied for the second most in a season in school history, joining the 1982-83 team ... The most 100-point outings in a season for FIU came during the 1997-98 campaign with seven.

## A SEASON'S WORTH IN 20 MINUTES

■ During the 2017-18 season, FIU averaged 70.7 points-per-game, and scored 70-or-more points in 14 of their 32 games ... On Nov. 10, against Johnson & Wales, FIU hit that scoring average from a year ago, however it did it in the first half, leading at the break, 70-27.

■ FIU's first half total was three shy of equaling the school record for points in a half, set against Miami Christian on Dec. 16, 1982, when the Panthers scored 73 points in a 137-54 win ... That game against Miami Christian is the game that FIU still holds records for points in a game and margin of victory (+83).

## WREAKING HAVOC

■ FIU has certainly caused issues for its opponents, defensively, in its 16 games this season, issues that have also led to production on the offensive end.

■ The Panthers have forced its foes into 355 turnovers on the year, for an average of 22.2 per-outing, and have forced their opponents into 20-or-more turnovers in 10 of the 16 games, and better than 30 twice ... In comparison, prior to this season and dating back to the 2012-13 season, FIU had forced its opposition into 20-or-more turnovers in just six games, with the most during that stretch being two, during 2017-18.

■ This season, FIU has benefited from its defense, getting 357 of its 1,430 total points off the opponents' 355 turnovers, or 25.0 percent of its scoring.

## NEW LOOK PANTHERS

■ FIU has eight players returning from last year, including two of the more exciting players in Conference USA - Brian Beard, Jr. and Trejon Jacob - however it also welcomes six new additions to the hardwood, and four new faces calling the shots on the sidelines.

■ The Panthers added three freshman in Phillip Smith, Antonio Daye, Jr., and James Ametepe (walk on), in addition to junior college transfer Devon Andrews ... FIU also welcomed Cameron Corcoran, a transfer from Little Rock, who will sit out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

■ Jeremy Ballard, the sixth member of the Shaka Smart coaching tree (at the time of his hiring), will walk the sidelines as a head coach for the first time in his career during the 2018-19 campaign ... He has assembled a veteran staff of assistants - Associate Head Coach David Cason (came from FBCU), assistant coaches Jesse Bopp (came from IMG Academy) and Joey Rodriguez (came from VCU) - that also join him in their first seasons at FIU.

■ A catalyst of VCU's historic 2011 Final Four squad, and one of the most beloved Rams in program history, Joey Rodriguez comes to FIU after serving one season

as director of player development at VCU where he worked with Ballard, and former Rice Head Coach Mike Rhoades ... Rodriguez starred for VCU as a point guard from 2007-11 ... Rodriguez was one of the driving forces behind VCU's 2011 march from the NCAA First Four to the Final Four ... He averaged 10.4 points, 5.2 assists and 3.2 rebounds that season, including 9.0 points and 7.7 assists in the Rams' five NCAA Tournament wins, before losing to Butler, 70-62, in the National Semifinals.

### BRIAN BEARD, JR. NOTES

■ Had a banner season during his first year with the Panthers, being named Third Team All-Conference USA and was also selected to the C-USA All-Defensive Team ... Averaged a team-high 16.4 points-per-game for FIU, which was good enough for ninth in Conference USA, and a team-best 2.9 steals-per-outing, which was first in C-USA and fifth in the nation ... He also led the team, and was fifth in C-USA, in assists logging 5.7 per-game.

■ Beard, Jr. set the school single-season records for steals (90) and assists (178) last year ... In addition, his 508 points scored, during 2017-18, was the eighth most scored in a single season at FIU, and the third most scored by a junior ... Netted double figures in 28-of-31 games played, and 20-or-more points nine times.

■ Beard, Jr. currently leads the team in scoring (19.1 ppg), assists (6.4 apg), and steals-per-game (3.4 spg) ... In addition, he leads Conference USA in steals, is second in assists and third in scoring (through Jan. 10).

■ Beard, Jr. has scored double figures in 41 of his 47 games at FIU, including a career-high 36 points against Youngstown State on Nov. 18 ... He also poured in 30 points in the season finale against Southern Miss on March 7, in the Conference USA Tournament first round ... He has netted 20-or-more points in 17 games - and in seven of his last 13 - and 25-or-better in six.

■ Beard, Jr. has handed out five-or-more assists in 34 games with the Panthers, and seven-or-better 22 times, including in the last 10 out of 17 games dating back to last year ... He dropped a career-high 10 dimes

against Louisiana Tech on Feb. 3, 2017, and equaled that against Columbia on Nov. 17 ... Beard, Jr. has dished out 102 assists in 16 games this year.

■ Beard, Jr. has also recorded 10 games with five-plus steals, equaling his career-high of six, four-times, at USF on Dec. 11, 2017, Hartford on Dec. 22, 2017, Florida Atlantic on Dec. 30, 2017, and at Fordham on Nov. 16, 2018.

■ In netting his career-high of 36 points against Youngstown State on Nov. 18, Beard, Jr. shot 69.2 percent (9-for-13) from the field and was 16-for-20 (80.0 percent) from the free-throw line in the win ... In addition, he dished out seven assists against the Penguins.

■ Beard, Jr. turned in an impressive outing in a loss at Arkansas on Dec. 1, recording 21 points, sharing team-high rebounding honors with eight, dishing out six assists and logging five steals against the Razorbacks.

■ The California native had a solid performance against North Florida on Dec. 13, pouring in a game-high 29 points to go along with a team-high eight rebounds, six assists and four steals ... Beard, Jr. was 9-for-19 (47.4 percent) from the field and 10-of-12 (83.3 percent) from the charity stripe.

■ Beard, Jr. got the Conference USA season off to a rousing start, pouring in a game-high 28 points against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3 ... In addition to his scoring total, he also handed out seven dimes against the Blue Raiders.

■ Beard, Jr. has made considerable improvements on his shooting from the free-throw line since the start of the season ... In his first five game, he was shooting just 61.2 percent (30-for-49) from the line, with his best percentage being 75.0 percent (3-for-4) against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 9 ... However, in his last 10 outings, Beard, Jr. is shooting at an 80.8 percent (59-for-73) clip, having hit below 80.0 percent just twice, coming at Florida Gulf Coast (33.3 percent, 1-for-3), at Middle Tennessee (74.1 percent, 5-for-7) and at UAB (75.0 percent, 6-for-8).

### BEARD, JR. CLIMBING THE CHARTS; MOVES INTO SECOND ALL-TIME IN CAREER ASSISTS

■ In just 47 career games on the floor for FIU, Brian Beard, Jr. has made his mark in the Panthers' record books ... Beard, Jr. is currently second all-time in school history in career assists (280), surpassing Dwight Stewart (264, 1989-93) against Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3 ... He sits second only to Carlos Arroyo (1997-2001) who finished his career with 459 assists, however Arroyo's total came over four years.

#### BEARD, JR. TABBED C-USA POW

■ Brian Beard, Jr. was named the Conference USA Player of the Week for the week ending, Nov. 18 ... It is the second such honor for Beard, Jr.

■ Beard, Jr. recorded a career week, helping FIU to a 3-1 record, including a 2-1 ledger at the Johnny Bach Classic at Fordham University in the Bronx, New York ... He averaged an

impressive 25.8 points-per-game in the four games, to go along with 7.8 assists, 4.0 rebounds and 3.5 steals-per-outing for the Panthers, and also shot 48.3 percent (29-for-60) from the field ... During the Johnny Bach Classic, Beard, Jr. averaged 28.0 points, 8.0 assists and 4.0 steals-per-game.

#### DEVON ANDREWS NOTES

■ Devon Andrews is currently second on the team in scoring, averaging 14.5 points-per-game ... He is also second in rebounding, grabbing 5.1 boards-per-outing and steals, averaging 1.9 per-game ... He is eighth in Conference USA in steals and 15th in scoring.

■ Devon Andrews had quite a debut in the season-opener against Webber International ... Andrews poured in a career-high 23 points on 9-of-13 (69.2 percent) shooting from the field, including going 2-for-2 from three-point range, and 3-for-5 from the free-throw line (60.0 percent) ... Andrews also had five rebounds, four assists, a blocked shot and a steal, in only 22 minutes.

■ Andrews followed up his debut performance with a 20-point effort against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 9 ... Andrews had a near-perfect night, shooting 8-for-8 from the field, 2-for-2 from behind the three-point arc, and 2-for-4 from the free-throw line, in just 15 minutes.

■ The Ohio native scored a team-high 20 points against UAB on 50.0 percent (5-for-10) shooting from the field and 75.0 percent (9-for-12) from the free-throw line to go along with a team-best seven rebounds.

■ The Ohio native recorded his first career double-double on Nov. 17, against Columbia when he posted a 17-point, 11-rebound effort.

■ Andrews netted 15 points against FGCU on Nov. 28, along with a team-high eight rebounds, a career-high four steals and a career-high tying four assists.

■ Through 14 games played this season, Andrews is shooting 57.6 percent (80-for-139) from the field, sixth in C-USA ... Andrews has shot under 50.0 percent just four times this season for the Panthers, however those have been in four of the last seven games.

■ Jacob had an impressive 20-point performance in the Conference USA opener at Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3 ... Jacob netted 20 points on 6-for-9 (66.7 percent) from the field - all coming from behind the three-point arc - and a perfect 2-for-2 from the charity stripe ... He also shared team-high rebounding honors, grabbing a season-high seven to go along with two steals.

FIU Men's Basketball Head Coach Jeremy Ballard announced on Nov. 20, the signing of 6-foot-6, 220-pound guard/forward Dante Wilcox (West Palm Beach, Florida/Oxbridge Academy) to a National Letter of Intent.

"We are thrilled to announce the addition of Dante Wilcox to our FIU Family," said Ballard. "He is first and foremost an extremely high character young man who fits in seamlessly with the culture of our program and university. As a player Dante embodies the core values of what our program is all about: toughness, versatility, competitiveness, and skill level. Dante has the ability to both play and defend multiple positions which is a perfect fit for our position-less system. He possesses an ever-increasing skill level with an appetite for aggressive, physical play that has direct carry over to our style of play. We are also truly excited to add another Florida native who has been so well coached on the high school and AAU levels who comes from an incredibly supportive family. We are really looking forward to what Dante will bring to Panther Nation."

A four-year starter at Oxbridge Academy in Palm Beach County, and a two-year captain, Wilcox was recently named to the Palm Beach Post Preseason Boys Basketball Fab Five.

As a junior, Wilcox helped lead Oxbridge to its third-straight regional finals berth, averaging a team-best 14.1 points-per-game on 59 percent (107-for-182) shooting from the field. In addition, He also recorded 9.8 rebounds, 1.6 assists, 1.4 steals and 1.3 blocked shots-per-game. For his efforts, he was named First Team All-County by the Palm Beach Post.

Wilcox was just as impressive as a sophomore, during the 2016-17 season, averaging 13.6 points-per-game, on 63 percent (144-for-227) shooting from the floor, and grabbing 9.7 rebounds-per-outing. He also averaged 2.0 blocks, 1.9 assists and 1.8 steals-per-game.





■ Against Charlotte, Jacob recorded a 19-point performance on 8-for-13 (61.5 percent) from the field and 3-for-6 (50.0 percent) from three-point range.

■ Jacob has been a presence on the boards, grabbing six-or-more rebounds, 13 times while with FIU.

### ANTONIO DAYE, JR. NOTES

■ Antonio Daye, Jr. is averaging 7.8 points-per-game and 2.9 rebounds-per-outing ... Daye, Jr. has come off the bench in 14 games, however has started the last two ... He is also second on the team in assists dishing out 2.4 per-game.

■ Earned his first career start against UAB on Jan. 5, and netted 13 points and grabbed three rebounds ... He followed that up with a 10-point effort while tying his career-high with four assists.

■ Recorded a career-high 16 points, against Ave Maria on Nov. 23, on 4-for-8 shooting (50.0 percent) from the field and 8-for-11 (72.7 percent) from the free-throw line.

■ Had a 15-point, three-rebound, two-assist effort on Dec. 1, at Arkansas ... Daye, Jr. shot 50.0 percent (5-for-10) from the field and 5-for-10 (50.0 percent) from the line.

■ Posted his fifth-career double-figure performance of his short FIU career, with 11 points at Middle Tennessee on Jan. 3 ... Daye, Jr. was 5-for-7 (71.4 percent) from the field and a perfect 1-for-1 from the line ... Also had three assists, two rebounds and two steals against the Blue Raiders.

■ Daye, Jr. only netted four points to go along with three assists and a rebound against Ohio on Dec. 30, however, recorded a career-high five steals against the Bobcats.

### ISAIAH BANKS NOTES

■ Scored a season-high 14 points against Webber International, on Nov. 7, on 7-of-11 shooting from the field (63.6 percent), to go along with five rebounds ... He followed that up with a 12-point, three-rebound, three-steal performance against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 9 ... Shot 66.7 percent (4-for-6) from the field, including 50.0 percent (2-for-4) from three-point range.

■ Banks also posted a 13-point performance against Columbia on Nov. 17, on 6-of-9 (66.7 percent) shooting from the field, and most recently an 11-point, six-rebound performance at Arkansas on Dec. 1, and a 10-point performance against North Florida on Dec. 13.

■ An athletic backcourt player, Banks may be best known for his backboard-shattering dunk that made him an Internet sensation in January 2017 ... The play was ESPN Sportscenter's No. 1 Play of the Day on January 11, in addition to the No. 2 Dunk of the Year – second only to Spartanburg (S.C.) Day

School, and current Duke phenomenon, Zion Williamson – and the No. 9 Play of the Year by MaxPreps ... Following his senior campaign, Banks was a first team all-state selection by the Georgia Coaches Association ... He was also named the Georgia-Alabama All-Star Game Slam Dunk Champion.

### WILLY NUNEZ, JR. NOTES

■ Is hoping to have an injury-free 2018-19 season after playing in only six games last season ... Logged 26.7 minutes-per-outing for the Panthers, averaging 12.7 points-per-game ... Scored in double figures in four of his six games for FIU, including a career-high 19 points against Florida National on Nov. 29, 2017 ... Also has 18 points against James Madison on Dec. 16, 2017.

- Osaghae is a former walk-on who earned a scholarship during the summer of 2018.
- Is averaging 8.6 points-per-game and leads the team in rebounding, grabbing 7.5 boards-per-game ... His rebounds-per-game average is also sixth in Conference USA, through Jan. 10 ... In addition, Osaghae is shooting 66.2 percent (45-for-68) from the field, tops on the team and third in C-USA.
- Osaghae is currently ninth in the nation in blocks, rejecting 2.6 per-contest and 21st in the nation in offensive rebounds-per-game, grabbing 3.4 per-outing.
- He recorded his first career double-double with a career-high tying 10 points and a career-best 12 rebounds against Johnson & Wales on Nov. 9 ... Was 4-for-6 (66.7 percent) against the Wildcats.
- Followed up his first career-double-double with his second-straight - in what was the best overall game of his FIU career, against Milwaukee on Nov. 13 ... 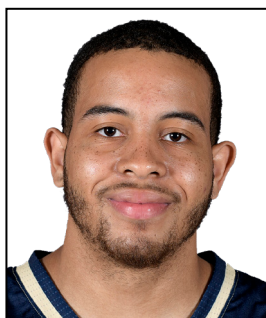
