Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss is playing in its 105th football season, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 606-447-27, which is 41st best among FBS teams by winning percentage (.574).
- The Will Hall era got its first victory over Grambling State 37-0 as the Golden Eagles posted their first shutout since 2017. He became the top man of the program on Dec. 2, 2020 (formally introduced on Dec. 7). Hall is the school's 22nd full-time head coach.
- The Golden Eagles snapped an eight-game losing streak last week when they defeated Louisiana Tech 35-19 in Ruston.
- Southern Miss had a string of five-straight winning seasons snapped last season after finishing 3-7. Coach Jay Hopson resigned following the opening game against South Alabama and the program used two interim coaches - Scotty Walden and Tim Billings - during the year. The program has collected 23 winning seasons over the last 28 (including 2021) and appeared in 18 bowl games during that time.

Nuggets From the Louisiana Tech Contest

- Southern Miss snapped a two-game losing streak to Louisiana Tech.
- The Golden Eagles put up 21 points in the first half -- the most points in the opening half this season.
- Frank Gore, Jr. started his second game at quarterback for the Golden Eagles. He started in the wildcat. Gore, Jr. scored from the 1-yard line with 7:25 left in the opening quarter. It marked his third TD of the year and fifth of his career. He added his first two touchdown passes as well in the contest.
- The Golden Eagles enjoyed scoring drives of 73 and 80 yards marking the eighth time they have had scoring drives of 70 or more yards.
- In total, four different Golden Eagles took snaps under center. Demarcus Jones marked the 11th different Golden Eagle to take a snap from center in 2021.
- Jason Brownlee enjoyed his first multi-touchdown reception game of his career.
- Grayson Gunter scored his first touchdown as a Golden Eagle on a 20-yard pass from Antavious Willis to put Southern Miss up by nine with 6:37 left in the game. It was the first career passing touchdown for Willis and the first time this season that Southern Miss has scored three times through the air.
- Demarcus Jones entered the contest with two rushing yards on the season, and finished with a career-high 87 yards on 14 carries.
- Dajon Richard went over 100 yards for the first time in his career, surpassing his previous best of 76 yards. He finished with 120 yards on 22 carries. It marks the third time the Golden Eagles have had a 100 yard rusher this season.
- Hayes Maples forced his first and second fumbles of the season, while Santrell Latham recovered Maples' second strip of the game and rumbled 72 yards on the return to set up the Eagles' second scoring drive. Latham's fumble return was the longest of the season for Southern Miss, surpassing Everitt Cunningham's 47-yard TD return against Troy.
- DaShawn Crawford recorded his 3.5 TFL on the season, pushing LA Tech back four yards on the opening play of the second half.
- Dominic Quewon recorded a sack for the second-straight game, forcing Allen into an intentional grounding for a loss of 16 yards in the third quarter and dragged down Allen again in the fourth for his fifth career sack.
- The Nasty Bunch allowed just 100 yards through the air, marking the second time the season they've allowed 100 yards or less through the air.
- Averie Habas picked off the first pass of his career with 1:32 left in the game and scampered six yards into the endzone to seal the win for the Golden Eagles. It's the third-straight game the Southern Miss defense has had a pick six.
- Josh Carr, Jr. recorded the Golden Eagles' fifth turnover of the game with his first career interception with just 38 seconds left on the clock.
- The defense didn't allow a touchdown for the second time, while the five turnovers forced were the most by the Nasty Bunch this season.
- Mason Hunt booted four punts for 160 yards to average 40 yards.

Will Hall

Head Football Coach | First Season - 2-9 (.182) / Overall - Seventh Season 58-29 (.667)

At his introductory press conference last December as the 22nd head coach of Southern Miss football, Will Hall talked about how 'attitude is everything' in his initial comments to those in attendance at Reed Green Coliseum.

Since then, that attitude has provided a relentlessly positive approach in how he has prepared his players for the upcoming season, elevated the growth of every facet of this football program, while energizing a fan base as it embarks on a new era of Golden Eagle football.

Hall, a native of Amory, Miss., comes to Southern Miss after serving the last two years as offensive coordinator at Tulane.

Hall made an immediate impact on the Tulane offense and helped the Green Wave rewrite their offensive record books. He helped Tulane post one of the most successful offensive seasons in program history in 2019. The Green Wave finished the season ranked 11th in the nation in rushing offense (243.2), 22nd in total offense (449.3) and 30th in scoring offense (33.1). Hall helped the Green Wave rush for over 200 yards in nine games in 2019 and over 300 times four times.

The Tulane offense set the program record in rushing yards at 3,162 yards in 2019. The offense ranked second in program history in rushing yards per game (243.2), rushing touchdowns (33) and rushing first downs (166). Tulane's offense also eclipsed 500 yards five times, including a season-high 634 total yards against UConn. The Green Wave also set a season-high in passing yards against the Huskies with 323.

In 2020, the Green Wave enjoyed more success offensively as they finished No. 17 nationally in rushing offense (217.1), No. 19 in first downs (258) and No. 22 in scoring offense (34.7), while adding two more 500-yard total offensive games to his resume.

Hall joined the Green Wave coaching staff after he spent the 2018 campaign as the Associate Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach at the University of Memphis where he helped guide the Tigers to the American Athletic Conference Championship game for the second straight season and helped the Tigers to their fifth straight bowl appearance.

During his lone season at Memphis, Hall helped guide the Tigers to a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns during the regular season. In addition, Memphis finished the regular season with 3,311 rushing yards, setting a new school record.

Memphis' offense ranked in the nation's top 10 in rushing (No. 5, 275.9), scoring offense (No. 6, 43.8) and total offense (No. 6, 530.3) under Hall's assistance. In addition, Hall helped four Memphis offensive players earn All-AAC honors.

Hall joined the Memphis staff in January 2018 after spending the 2017 season as the offensive coordinator for the Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns, where six offensive players received all-conference honors. The Cajuns ranked among the best in the nation in red zone offense and turnovers lost with just 16.

In his one season as offensive coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette, the Ragin' Cajuns compiled the Sun Belt Conference's third-best rushing offense with 2,204 yards and 27 rushing touchdowns. The Louisiana-Lafayette offense tied for the second-fewest turnovers in the Sun Belt during the 2017 season. The Cajuns were also efficient in the red zone, leading the Sun Belt by scoring on 92.9-percent of their red zone chances.

In his three-year head coaching stint at West Georgia (UWG), Hall led the Wolves to a 31-9 record, the first Gulf South Conference (GSC) title since 2000 and a pair of NCAA Division II semifinal appearances. His first two seasons at UWG produced a pair of 12-win seasons before he finished 7-4 in 2016.

Success was immediate for Hall as the Wolves set multiple school records, won their first GSC title in 14 years and reached the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Under his direction, a program that had not made an impact in the conference, much less nationally, in over a decade transformed into the talk of the nation in NCAA Division II. Under Hall's direction, the Wolves were nationally ranked for 17 weeks consecutively and earned the program's first No. 1 national ranking on Oct. 26, 2015.

Hall's first UWG squad in 2014 caught more than a few people by surprise. The Wolves finished the regular season strong with a 9-2 record and earned the program's first NCAA playoffs bid since 2000. Road wins at Tuskegee, Delta State, and Valdosta State were the first postseason victories in the school's Division II history and gave UWG the NCAA Super Region 2 title.

Though UWG caught no one by surprise in 2015, it didn't matter. Hall's juggernaut roared through the first nine games of the regular season, all wins, and none were closer than a 17-point margin. A three-touchdown, Week 8 win over nationally ranked North Alabama pushed the Wolves into the top spot in the nation in Division II for the first time in school history.

Hall was twice named GSC Coach of the Year and was the Super Region 2 Coach of the Year.

In his first season at West Georgia, more than 30 team and individual records fell. In addition to setting records, the Wolves hauled in individual accolades. Sixteen players earned All-Gulf South Conference recognition and seven received All-American distinction, which included the program's first Academic All-American in Alex Macaulay.

From 2011-13 as the head coach at West Alabama, his teams won two league titles and twice earned spots in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Hall's players also have had success at the next level, and among that group of honored athletes is 2015 Super Bowl hero and current Tennessee Titan Malcolm Butler, who was a two-time All-GSC performer for Hall at West Alabama. In the spring of 2016, offensive tackle Dominique Robertson became the first UWG player in school history to receive an invitation to the NFL Draft Combine.

Prior to his six seasons at West Alabama, Hall enjoyed successful stints on the coaching staff at Arkansas-Monticello, Southwest Baptist, Henderson State, and Presbyterian. Hall's achievements in the coaching profession are a carryover from his illustrious career on the playing field at North Alabama.

Hall played for his father, Bobby Hall, at Amory High School leading the Panthers to the 1998 Mississippi High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class 3A state title. From 1999-2000, he attended Northwest Mississippi Community College, where he was a two-time National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American.

In 2000, Hall set a NJCAA record for total offense in a season (4,075 yards) and added an NJCAA single-game record with nine touchdown passes.

Hall then moved to North Alabama, where he was a quarterback for the Lions from 2002-03. He won the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2003, emblematic of being America's top player in NCAA Division II. In 2003, Hall, who threw for 3,531 yards and 30 touchdowns, led the Lions to a 13-1 record and an NCAA Division II semifinals appearance.

In 2004, Hall signed a contract to play for the Tupelo FireAnts of the National Indoor Football League. Playing once again for his father, who was the head coach for the team, Hall passed for 2,046 yards and 44 touchdowns while rushing for 13 scores in the 14-game season.

A 2003 graduate of North Alabama, Hall, and wife Rebecca, have two sons – Tripp and Pete.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) – Corey Acosta's 44-yard field-goal attempt as time expired was tipped at the line, falling far short, as Southern Miss fell just short of a 24-23 loss to visiting FIU before 21,891 at Roberts Stadium.

FIU freshman Silas Spearman III rushed for 136 yards and two touchdowns on 29 carries and Austin Taylor kicked a 27-yard field goal with 6 minutes, 53 seconds, left in the game that proved to be the game-winning points.

Spearman, who had netted 33 yards on 22 rushes coming into the game, scored on runs of 3 and 1 yards in the second quarter, and backup quarterback E.J. Hilliard hit T.J. Lowder with a 16-yard scoring pass just 57 seconds before half as the Golden Panthers held a 21-16 edge at the break.

FIU defensive tackle Isame Faciane made sure it didn't, getting a hand on Acosta's low kick.

Southern Miss quarterback Allan Bridgford completed 26 of 45 passes for 243 yards and three touchdowns. But he also threw two interceptions and lost a fumble when sacked near the end of the first half that led to an FIU touchdown.

Two of Bridgford's scoring passes went to Markese Triplett, who had seven catches for 96 yards. For Triplett, it was the first multiple touchdown game of his career.

FIU starting quarterback Jake Medlock, who completed 5 of 10 passes for 88 yards, was intercepted twice before being lifted late in the first half. Medlock appeared to be shook up after a hard hit while chasing down a bad snap in the end zone that Southern Miss turned into a safety with 2:14 left in the second quarter.

Hilliard completed 8 of 13 passes for 93 yards and a touchdown, that gave the Golden Panthers a 21-16 halftime lead.

USM went back ahead 23-21 on Bridgford's 6-yard pass to Triplett with 6:45 left in the third quarter. But Taylor came through in the final period, capping a nine-play, 52-yard drive that saw the Golden Panthers convert a fourth-and-2 from the USM 34-yard line.

Taylor, who had missed from 48 yards in the third quarter, missed a 45-yard attempt with a minute left to play.

That led to a frantic, downfield charge by USM that saw Bridgford complete two passes to Triplett for 25 yards, including one on a fourth-and-10.

A pass interference call on FIU's Sam Miller moved the ball to the FIU 27, but USM could not execute on its final chance.

Bower Center Dedicated Earlier This Year

Southern Miss Athletics hosted an open house to dedicate the Bower Academic Center, Saturday, Sept. 11, at the Cook Library. The Bower Academic Center, named in honor of former player, assistant coach and long-time head coach Jeff Bower, features individual tutor/study rooms, computer lab, classroom, quiet study space and housing all student-athlete academic support staff. The 18,000-square foot space gives Golden Eagle student-athletes four times the amount of academic space than its previous facility.

The Bower Academic center was built with privately raised funds through the Athletic Foundation and officially opened in August of 2020, but the dedication was delayed until now due to COVID-19 restrictions and precautions.

The FIU Series

- This will be the second time these two teams have played in football. The Panthers captured a 24-23 decision in Hattiesburg, Oct. 5, 2013.
- Corey Acosta's 44-yard field goal on the last play of the game was blocked by Isame Faciane. Austin Taylor recorded a 27-yard field goal with 6:43 remaining to give the visitors the lead that they didn't relinquish the rest of the way (go to page 3 for the entire recap).
- Nine Golden Eagles call the Sunshine State their home including Frank Gore, Jr., who is the only player listed from Miami. The others include Luke Baker (Naples), Da'Quan Bailey-Brown (Pompano Beach), Rachuan Mitchell (Jacksonville), Bryce Foxworth (Pinellas Park), Douglas Gearity (St. Cloud), Michael Ples, Jr., (Tallahassee), Seth Roberson (Oviedo) and Emanuel Rushing (Winter Springs).
- Joe Perkins, a second-year freshman for the Panthers, is the only FIU player hailing from Mississippi. Perkins, from Jackson, played at Madison-Ridgeland Academy.
- One member of the FIU coaching staff, Deke Adams, is a former Golden Eagle linebacker and assistant coach for the program.

In Conference USA Play

The Golden Eagles are in their 26th season of Conference USA play. Southern Miss holds an all-time mark of 115-79 (.593) in C-USA contests, including a 60-37 mark at home, while compiling a 55-42 ledger on the road. In the previous 25 seasons of C-USA play, Southern Miss enjoyed 18 seasons of winning marks as well as two years of finishing at .500.

Five Time C-USA Champions

Southern Miss has five Conference USA titles, including one since divisional play started during the 2005 campaign. They captured their first league title contest and the school's fifth overall league crown - more than any other school in the conference - when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.

The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles have won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss is 1-2 in C-USA championship games.

Pro Traditions

Southern Miss, which has a reputation in training and producing professional talent over the years, has a long list of former players that have reached the NFL including the likes of Ray Guy, Brett Favre, Sammy Winder, Michael Boley and Jamie Collins. Southern Miss has had at least one player drafted in 15 of the last 21 NFL drafts. Since 1942, 129 players have been drafted by the NFL, AFL or AAFC, which including a school-best four on nine different occasions.

The Golden Eagles at Home

Since the start of the 1976 season, following the renovation of M.M. Roberts Stadium, the Golden Eagles have posted a 156-76 (.672) record at The Rock. The program has finished at .500 or better in home games for a season 39 times during that span.

The Offensive Line

The Golden Eagle offensive front line has had nine different players get a starting nod in 2021. With Arvin Fletcher deciding to forgo the remainder of his career during the UTEP week and the 50 starts to his name during his career, Khalique Washington now is the veteran in terms of starts with 30. In fact, Washington has made 21 consecutive starts. Southern Miss has used five different starting lineups through the first 11 games up front - having used the lineup of Paul Gainer, Jr. (left tackle), Gerquan Scott (left guard), Briason Mays (center), John Bolding (right guard) and Washington (right tackle) in the last three games.

The Quarterback Chronicles or Super Back U

Southern Miss has used a total of 11 players to take center snaps this season - the most in the FBS - after losing both Trey Lowe (Grambling State) and Ty Keyes (Rice) early during the year to injury. Another QB Jack Walker, who suffered a hand injury earlier in the year that prevents him from throwing, has taken some snaps during the year along with second-year freshman Jake Lange, who has started four games and appeared in seven, as well as freshman Tee Webb and senior Jake Smithhart coming off the bench. Smithhart had been a student coach for the program, before being activated last month. Running back Chandler Pittman, also took some snaps under center, but was injured as well and lost for the season. The last quarterback to start at least four-straight games before Lange this season for the Golden Eagles was Jack Abraham, who started the final game of 2018 under center and went on to start 18-straight contests.

The Golden Eagles used quarterbacks No. 8, No. 9 and No. 10 at UTSA when Frank Gore, Jr., Antavious Willis and Dajon Richard all took snaps - all in the wildcat formation. Gore, Jr., is now the fourth different player to start taking snaps from the center this season and the 32nd since the start of the 1987 season as well as the 15th since the beginning of the 2012 campaign.

Demarcus Jones became the 11th Golden Eagle to take snaps as the term Super Back continues to take hold this season. Southern Miss threw three touchdown passes last week at Louisiana Tech, including the first two of his career by Gore, Jr. The trio of Super Backs threw for 110 yards on 8-of-12 throws last weekend. Another pass was thrown from a wide receiver spot.

Big Play Brownlee

Southern Miss junior Jason Brownlee - who battled injuries in the preseason - leads the team with 41 catches for 545 yards and six touchdowns, despite having to mesh with all the different signal callers this fall. He posted a solid performance against Rice with eight catches for a career-best 127 yards and against Middle Tennessee registered a career-high nine catches for 120 yards and his fifth career 100-yard receiving game.

He recorded a touchdown catch for the second-straight game against North Texas with four catches for a team-high 53 yards. He caught Frank Gore, Jr.'s first pass of 32 yards at UTSA and followed that with his first two-touchdown catch game - both from Gore, Jr. - last weekend at Louisiana Tech as he caught five passes for 67 yards.

Brownlee first made an impact in 2020 as a Golden Eagle. At one point during the year, Brownlee had scored in four consecutive games and topped the 100-yard mark in three-straight contests before being limited to 35 yards on five catches against Rice. Brownlee also displayed big play prowess, following up an 88-yard touchdown against Tulane on Sept. 25 with a 68-yard scoring reception at North Texas. He had 11 pass receptions of 20 or more yards and had two of the three longest receptions of 88 and 68 last season. He led the team in receptions (34), receiving yards (610) and touchdown catches (5).

The Junior, Whose A Freshman, Leads the Rushing Corps

Frank Gore, Jr. has led the Golden Eagles offense in a couple of roles this season. He is the team's top running back with 733 yards on the ground with three rushing scores and has also been called to take snaps from the center and has converted 6-of-11 passes for 108 yards with two touchdown passes, both coming last weekend at LA Tech. He also leads the team in all-purpose yards with 888, as he also has 155 receiving yards.

His best day of the year rushing came with a career-high 162 rushing yards on 21 carries versus Grambling State. His rushing total was the eighth-most ever by a Golden Eagle freshman (See chart on the left side of this page).

He notched his second 100-yard rush performance with 123 yards on 20 carries versus UTSA. When Gore has rushed for 100 yards in his career, the Golden Eagles are 4-1.

Gore, Jr., led the team in rushing a season ago with 708 yards on 121 carries for a 5.9 rush average. Gore was a second-team All-Conference USA selection in 2020 and was a member of the league's All-Freshman team. Gore is a member of the preseason watch lists for both the Doak Walker Award, for the nation's top running back, and the Maxwell Award, for the country's most outstanding player.

Nasty Bunch D Continues Solid Play

Through 11 games, Southern Miss ranks No. 46 nationally in total defense, allowing 355.5 yards per contest. The group is also No. 75 in the country in rushing defense (156.2 ypg), holding opponents to under 100 yards on the ground three times and 22nd in passing yards allowed at 199.4 per game.

The Golden Eagles are surrendering 28.9 points per contest, ranking No. 87 in the country. But of the 318 points allowed by the team, the Golden Eagles have given up 63 points directly off turnovers, 34 points on short fields after turnovers, 14 points on two kick returns for scores, and one safety when the quarterback was sacked in the end zone, cutting the number to the defense allowing to 18.6 points per contest.

The program also registered its first shutout since 2017 when they defeated Grambling State 37-0 and did not give up a defensive touchdown last week at LA Tech.

Shorts Large on Tackles

Defensive back Malik Shorts continues to play well on defense, leading the way for the Golden Eagles through 11 games. Shorts posted a game-high 10 tackles at Alabama with an interception and followed that with a game-high 12 stops the next game at Rice. Versus UTEP, he notched six tackles, to go along with an interception and the team's only tackle for loss. Against UAB, he collected a team-high and career-high tying 14 tackles and posted four stops at Middle Tennessee. Against North Texas, Shorts posted a game-high 13 stops.

In seven games this season, he has either led or tied for the team high in tackles. Shorts ranks first in tackles with 89 including two tackles for loss, two interceptions and seven pass breakups.

Shorts ranked second in tackles last season at 81, including 14 tackles versus Louisiana Tech as well as a team-high 11 stops at WKU. He had three 10 or more tackles contests three times in 2020. He tallied his lone interception of the season against UTSA.

Latham No. 2 in Country in Fumble Recoveries

Santrell Latham recovered his third fumble of the season and returned it 72 yards last week at LA Tech and now ranks No. 2 in the country in that category. He also has forced four fumbles which ranks No. 6 in the country.

Latham ranks fifth on the team in tackles with 44, including five for loss. He missed the UTEP due to injury, but came back to register four tackles off the bench against UAB and collected a team-high seven stops versus Middle Tennessee.

Some Random Notes to Round Things Out

Here are some random notes regarding Southern Miss football:

- The team features two players whose Dads played in the NFL - Devin Thomas (Adalius Thomas, who also played for the Golden Eagles (1996-99) and Frank Gore, Jr. (Frank Gore, Sr.)
- Southern Miss has three non-offensive touchdowns and one returned via a kickoff return.
- The Golden Eagles currently rank No. 12 nationally in first downs allowed with 183 (16.6 per game)

Maples Returns as Team's Leading Tackler

Linebacker Hayes Maples, a second-team All-Conference USA selection a year ago, has 55 stops with 3.5 tackles for loss and 2.0 sacks. Maples registered four tackles, including a half sack and a tackle for loss against South Alabama in the opener, followed by two solo tackles against Grambling. After posting a solo tackle at Alabama, Maples responded with six stops versus Rice and UTEP. He recorded his first double-digit tackle contest of 2021 with 10 against North Texas. He had a team-high eight stops versus UTSA and added eight more tackles, two forced fumbles, a tackle for loss and a pass breakup at LA Tech.

Maples led the Golden Eagles last season with 91 tackles, as well as a team-high eight tackles for loss. Maples posted five double-digit tackle performances last year, including a career-high 15 tackles versus Tulane. He was a member of the Rotary Lombardi preseason watch list.

Ratcliff and Kitchen Lead the D-Line in Stops

Sophomore Josh Ratcliff and senior Eriq Kitchen continue to lead the Golden Eagles up front on defense as the pair of defensive linemen rank first and second in tackles among that group with 32 and 27, respectively. Ratcliff tied a career high with five tackles against Rice and three assisted stops versus UTEP. He posted two tackles and a fumble recovery against UAB and an assisted tackle at Middle Tennessee. Ratcliff has at least two stops in nine of 11 games.

Kitchen has played in all 11 games and started in eight, posting 7.5 tackles for loss with 4 sacks. He has at least four tackles in five games this season.

Briggs Bourgeois Enjoying Strong Start to Season

Redshirt junior Briggs Bourgeois has converted 7-of-13 field goals this season, including a 36-yarder at UTSA. He has made 49-of-50 career extra-point attempts, starting his tenure by making his first 34 tries before being snapped versus Troy. As a kickoff specialist, 21 of his kickoffs have been touchbacks.

Bourgeois handled most of the kicking duties last season, after missing the previous year with a leg injury. In 2020, Bourgeois connected on 12 of 16 field goals and all 29 extra-point attempts. His 49-yard field goal against Tulane was a career-long, and Southern Miss' longest since Parker Shaunfield on Sept. 29, 2018.

Hunt Boots the Ball Down the Field

Redshirt junior Mason Hunt, who punted in the first game last season and averaged 32.2 yards per punt over four tries against South Alabama in his only action of the year, battled Griffin Fleming in the preseason before earning the start at punter on opening day against South Alabama.

Hunt, who was named to the Ray Guy Award Watchlist, won the job and did not disappoint as he blasted eight punts for an average of 47.9 yards in the opener. It was, at the time, the longest average by a Golden Eagle punter in a game since Zac Everett enjoyed a 48.7 punting average over three punts against ULM on Sept. 8, 2018.

Hunt enjoyed his best punting day of the season, averaging 51.7 yards per punt over six punts against UTEP. Of his punts, three were over 50 yards including a career-long 63 and 60-yard punts. He pinned the Miners back inside the 20-yardline four times including the 1, 4 and 6 yardlines. He also added a punt to the Miner 9 that was returned for six yards to the 15, but a facemask penalty forced the ball up to the 30.

This season, Hunt averages 43.4 yards over 68 punts with 38 fair catches, 17 inside the opponents 20 and 14 or more for 50 yards.

Game Recaps

MOBILE, Ala.—South Alabama scored 31 unanswered points and took advantage of four Southern Miss turnovers to defeat the Golden Eagles 31-7 Saturday night at Whitney Hancock Stadium in the season opener for both teams.

The loss spoiled the debut of Southern Miss coach Will Hall.

Southern Miss jumped out to an early lead in the opening period as they capped a 16-play, 73-yard drive with a one yard Trey Lowe touchdown run. It looked like the Golden Eagles had their drive end at the Jaguar 30 on a fourth-down play, but targeting on South Alabama kept the drive alive leading to the game's first score.

The Jaguars responded with a drive of their own as they took a 68-yard run on five plays, which was set up on a 48-yard pass from Jake Bentley to Jalen Tolbert to inside the five. Bentley then hit Trent Tyre three plays later on a one-yard throw in the front corner of the end zone to even the score.

After Southern Miss fumbled the ball on the ensuing kickoff, USA took advantage of the miscue. The Jaguars got the benefit of a roughing the passer call during the pivotal drive, helping lead to a five-yard pass from Bentley to Kareem Walker to put them up 14-7.

Following that 14-7 halftime advantage, USA took the opening kickoff of the second half to score on their opening possession of the second half on a Bentley one yard run.

The Jaguars added a Diego Guajardo 48-yard field goal in the third quarter and Davyn Flenord picked off a pass and returned it 48 yards in the final minute to close out the contest.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) — Frank Gore Jr. ran for a career-best 162 yards and a touchdown and Southern Miss breezed to a 37-0 victory over FCS-member Grambling State Saturday night at The Rock.

The Golden Eagles (1-1) used a 12-yard TD toss from Trey Lowe III to Jason Brownlee to grab a 7-0 first-quarter lead and stretched their advantage to 10-0 on Briggs Bourgeois' 40-yard field goal in the second quarter. Gore Jr. raced 51 yards for a score midway through the second quarter to put Southern Miss up 17-0. From there Bourgeois kicked two field goals, Dajon Richard scored on a 27-yard run and backup QB Ty Keyes got in on the act with an 11-yard TD pass to Jakarius Caston to cap the scoring.

Williams, the Ohio State transfer, had three monster plays. He opened the game with a 100-yard kickoff return, then added an 81-yard touchdown catch on his second touch and another 83-yard runback in the top-ranked Crimson Tide's 63-14 win over Southern Miss on Saturday night.

Williams and the Crimson Tide (4-0) needed just 14 seconds to put to rest any worries of a letdown against Southern Miss (1-3).

Bryce Young was nearly flawless in throwing for five touchdowns while completing 20 of 22 passes for 313 yards.

Williams, meanwhile, had 258 all-purpose yards on just four touches.

The performance was marred only by a third quarter interception — his first of the season — at the goal line when the ball bounced off Williams, who was unstoppable when he caught the ball.

Williams spun out of the grasp of a defender and raced the remaining 65 yards untouched.

Roydell Williams ran for 110 yards and Jase McClellan gained 97, plus a 9-yard touchdown catch. Jahleel Billingley caught five passes for 105 yards and a score.

Even an Alabama mistake resulted in a touchdown.

John Metchie III was diving toward the goal line in the first quarter when he was knocked out of bounds. The ball popped out after he tried to reach back across the pylon, but tight end Cameron Latu reached across the line and pulled it into the end zone.

Southern Miss freshman Ty Keyes made his second straight start in place of an injured Trey Lowe. Keyes passed for 131 yards and two touchdowns with an interception. He also led the Golden Eagles with 41 rushing yards.

"I thought our young quarterback really grew up tonight," coach Will Hall said, adding that "he showed he belongs in an environment like this."

Game 9: North Texas 38, at Southern Miss 14 (Nov. 6, 2021)

HATTIESBURG, Miss.—North Texas scored 38 unanswered points to rally and defeat Southern Miss 38-14 in Conference USA West Division action at Carlisle-Faulkner Field at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Southern Miss jumped out to a 14-0 advantage as the squad took their first possession 66 yards on five plays, which culminated in a 17-yard pass from freshman Jake Lange to Jason Brownlee.

The drive started on a nine-yard pass from Lange to Grayson Gunter, before Frank Gore, Jr., raced 38 yards into Mean Green territory. Gore, Jr., finished the contest with 82 yards rushing on 12 carries, while Lange threw for 116 yards on 17-of-25 attempts.

Brownlee added four catches for 53 yards. The Golden Eagles increased their advantage on North Texas' next possession when Jay Stanley picked off an Austin Aune pass and returned to 55 yards for a score. It was the first time a Golden Eagle returned a pick for a score since DQ Thomas returned a UAB pass 55 yards in 2019.

North Texas, though, used their ground game to eat up the clock as they tallied 321 yards on the ground and held the football for 34 minutes, 14 seconds. In all, the Mean Green collected 537 total yards.

The Golden Eagles took the momentum into the locker room at halftime as they stopped the Mean Green at the goal line on the last play of the half to take a 14-7 lead at intermission.

In the second half, Ikaika Ragsdale recorded two third-quarter touchdowns – from 2 and 44 – yards to take lead for good. Isaiah Johnson led all rushers with 119 yards on 17 carries with a score, while Ragsdale ended the contest with 112 yards on 15 carries.

The Mean Green also added a pair of touchdowns on fumble returns in the second half.

With the game tied at 17 with six minutes remaining, UTSA noseguard Jaylon Haynes recovered a fumble by Southern Miss quarterback Antavious Willis at the Golden Eagles 35. The turnover led to Hunter Duplessis' go-ahead, 24-yard field goal with 4:39 remaining.

UTSA sealed the victory with 4:25 remaining on a fumble recovery by Charles Wiley at Southern Miss 9 after Corey Mayfield Jr. stripped Willis as he fled the pocket. Sincere McCormick scored on the ensuing play to give the Roadrunners a 27-17 lead.

UTSA had two fumble recoveries and an interception. McCormick rushed for 90 yards and a touchdown.

Southern Miss entered the game allowing 30.2 points per game but held UTSA to single touchdown for much of the contest. The Golden Eagles had two interceptions, including a 34-yard touchdown return by Natrone Brooks on the second play of the second half to put Southern Miss up 17-10.

Southern Miss started freshman Frank Gore Jr. at quarterback, which caught UTSA off guard defensively. The son and namesake of the New York Jets running back, Gore has started at running back all season and wasn't listed at quarterback on the team's depth chart entering the game.

Gore finished with 123 yards rushing and a touchdown on 20 carries and completed 2 of 3 passes for 33 yards before exiting the game in the second half with an injury.

A season-high crowd of 30,105 did impact Gore and the Golden Eagles. After his first career completion on a 32-yard pass to the Roadrunners' 2-yard line, the Golden Eagles had a false start, delay of game, bobbled snap and a fumbled snap that pushed them back to the 26-yard line. Missed a 37-yard field goal.

RUSTON, La. (AP) -- Frank Gore, Jr. threw two touchdowns on four completions and Southern Miss beat Louisiana Tech 35-19 on Friday night.

Gore was one of four players at quarterback that totaled 110 passing yards as the Golden Eagles (2-9, 1-6 Conference USA) dumped LA Tech (3-8, 2-5) in its last home game of the year.

Averie Habas then sealed the victory when he stepped in front of a screen pass and returned it for a score from six yards out.

Willis, a redshirt freshman, was 3-for-3 passing for 32 yards.

Dajon Richard ran for 120 yards on 22 carries for Southern Miss.

Marcus Williams Jr. ran for 88 yards on 17 carries for LA Tech.
