QUICK HITS---

- » The UConn Huskies will be back on the road this Saturday night as they travel to Conference-USA foe FIU for a 7:00 pm match-up on ESPN3. Saturday's game marks the first-ever meeting between the two schools and is the first of four match-ups scheduled over the next six years. The Huskies will host FIU in 2023 and 2025 and return to Miami in 2027.
- » UConn put an end to a three-game slide last time out, putting together a fourth-quarter comeback to top Fresno State, 19-14, at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field. The Huskies earned the program's first-ever win over a team from the Mountain West Conference (0-6 coming into the game). UConn sophomore running back Devontae Houston capped a 100-yard rushing day with the go-ahead touchdown with 2:20 left in the fourth quarter, closing off an 11-play, 94 yard drive. The UConn defense led the way, holding the Bulldogs to 187 total yards of offense, 157 through the air and 30 yards on the ground, all season-lows. The Bulldogs were 0-for-7 on third down and 0-for-2 on fourth down while the Huskies finished with two sacks, 6.0 tackles for a loss while forcing a season-best three turnovers
- » UConn posted their first win over a BCS school since a victory at UMass in 2019, ending a streak of 18-straight losses. UConn got its first win over a BCS opponent at home since the 2017 season when they beat Tulsa (20-14), a streak of 17-straight.
- » UConn Head Coach Mora returned to the sidelines for the first time since November 18, 2017 (L, 28-23 @USC), his final game of a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.
- » THE STADIUM: The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and are set to begin its 19th season as the home of UConn football. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 65-53 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

Head Coach Jim Mora

James L. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021, and officially began his tenure on Nov. 28. He is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success," said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.



"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego; Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

NEWS & NOTES ---

- » Junior linebacker Jackson Mitchell is the Huskies top-tackler and is second in the country in total tackles with 66 stops this season. He is ranked seventh in tackles per game at 11.0. He is tied for 20th nationally with 28 solo tackles. He has posted double digit tackles in three of the six games and has twice this season matched his career-high for tackles in a game. Mitchell made 16 stops in the season opener at Utah State and then had 16 in the loss to Syracuse. In the loss at Michigan, he made 10 tackles, the 11th time in his career he has recorded double digit tackles in a game. He also has 4.0 tackles for a loss, 2.5 sacks, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery on the season.
- » UConn's defense is ranked 52nd in the nation in team sacks with 14.0 on the year, a 2.33 per game average. Junior linebacker Jackson Mitchell and junior defensive lineman Eric Watts share the team lead with 2.5 sacks apiece this season. The UConn defensive line combination of Watts, sophomore Jelani Stafford (2.0), r-sophomore Dal'mont Gourdine (1.5), r-freshman Pryce Yates (1.5), sophomore Colin McCarthy (1.0) and r-junior Sokoya McDuffie (1.0) have posted 9.5 sacks on the year.
- » On the flip side, the UConn offensive line has allowed just 7.0 sacks, ranked 27th nationally (1.17 pg).
- » The UConn offense was led by sophomore Devontae Houston in the Fresno State win, who recorded his first career 100-yard game, carrying the ball 23 times for 105 yards and a score, all-new career bests. R-Sophomore Kevens Clercius caught two passes for a career-best 79 yards. His 40-yard reception from Zion Turner was a season-long reception. Freshman Justin Joly caught a career-best three passes for 34 yards while sophomore Aaron Turner caught his second touchdown of the season.
- » Sophomore kicker Nick Ruelas matched his career-high with two made field goals in the win over Fresno, connecting from 26 and 28 yards. He is now 5-of-6 on the season. Ruelas kicked the first field goals of his career, hitting a pair in the 4th quarter (47yd, 54yd) in the loss at Utah State. Ruelas's 54 yarder was the first 50-plus yard field goal since Michael Tarbutt hit from 50-yards at Tulsa in 2018. Ruelas now owns the second longest field goal in UConn school history, with his 54-yarder coming in behind school record holder Jim McManus who hit a 56-yard field goal against New Hampshire in 1998. It is the longest field goal in UConn's FBS history (2002-present).
- » The Huskies are among the least penalized teams in college football this season. UConn ranks 20th in fewest penalties per game (5.00) and 22nd in fewest penalty yards per game (41.47). The Huskies committed a season-low two penalties in the loss at NC State.
- » Senior Tre Wortham recorded his first interception of the season and the sixth of his career. Senior linebacker Ian Swenson also picked-off his first pass of the year and of his career in the win.
- » The Huskies continue to battle through injuries this season, with no less than a dozen players having been sidelined since the season started. The Huskies have been without starting quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson who left the game on UConn's second drive at Utah State and wide receiver Keelan Marion who left after catching a first quarter touchdown pass against the Aggies. UConn starting running back Nate Carter missed the last two games and will be sidelined for the season. Cornerback Kaleb Anthony was injured in the loss at NC State and expected to be out the remainder of the season.
- » UConn lost a pair of key offensive contributors to injury in the preseason as sophomore place kicker Joe McFadden and r-sophomore receiver Cam Ross suffered season-ending injuries. McFadden was the Huskies top-point producer last season, scoring 55 points in 2021. He hit 12 field goals on 17 attempts with a long of 47 yards. Ross saw his 2021 season cut short due to injury, playing in just two games, catching eight passes for 60 yards. In 2019 as a freshman, Ross hauled in a team-best 60 passes for 723 yards and four scores, all team-bests.
- » UConn had four Huskies named to college football award watch lists this preseason. UConn linebacker Jackson Mitchell has been named to the watch list for the 2022 Butkus Award while sophomore running back Nate Carter has been named as one of the preseason candidates for the 2022 Doak Walker Award UConn running back. Grad student Robert Burns has been named to the watch list for the 2022 Wuerffel Trophy, college football's premier award for community service and long snapper Tommy Zozus was announced as a preseason candidate for the Patrick Mannelly Award.

The Huskies are 1-3 against teams currently in Conference-USA. UConn has a win over FAU in 2002 and is 0-3 against Middle Tennessee. The Huskies lost to Middle Tennessee last season at home, 44-13. UConn has four dates scheduled with FIU starting this Saturday and also will play future member Liberty this season at home and on the road in 2027. The Huskies faced past members of the league during their stints in Conference-USA. The Huskies faced Cincinnati (0-1), Louisville (0-1), Marshall (0-1) and USF (0-2) when they were members of the league.

Scouting the Panthers...

Coming off their bye week, the FIU Panthers traveled to future C-USA member New Mexico State last weekend and came away with a 21-7 win. Quarterback Grayson James completed 13-of-19 passes for 182 yards and three scores, all coming in the first half against the Aggies. The win snapped a 19-game skid against FBS opponents dating back to a 2019 win over Miami. It also ended a 16-game road losing streak for the Panthers. FIU will be at home on Saturday night for the first time since their season-opening win over Bryant on September 1st. The Panthers come in averaging 17.8 points per game and throw for 216.8 yards per game behind James. On the season, he has completed 72-of-119 passes for 663 yards, seven touchdowns and two picks. Tyrese Chambers is the team's top-receiving target, hauling in 25 passes for 247 yards and three scores through four games.

UConn sophomore running back Nate Carter (Rochester, NY) ran for a career-high 190 yards on 20 carries as the Huskies came up short in the 2022 season opener, 31-20 to Utah State at Merlin Olsen Field at Maverik Stadium in Logan, Utah.

The Huskies (0-1) jumped out to a 14-0 lead thanks to a big first quarter before the Utah State offense rang off 24-unanswered points to close the first half.

The first quarter belonged to the Huskies as UConn built their two-touchdown lead while piling up 180 yards of offense, 152 coming on the ground. After forcing the Aggies to punt on their first drive, UConn's Carter help set up the first touchdown of the season with the longest run of his career, a 52-yard burst deep into USU territory.

R-So. starting quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson (Orange, NJ) capped the opening nine-play, 79-yard drive by plunging in from a yard out for his first career touchdown and a 7-0 lead at 10:05.

The Huskies got a turnover on the Aggies' second drive, with junior linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, Conn.) forcing and recovering a fumble, but Roberson would exit on the second play of the ensuing drive with an injury leading to true freshman Zion Turner's (Fort Lauderdale, FL) collegiate debut.

The frosh was picked-off on his second career pass attempt but he bounced back to lead a four play, 79-yard scoring drive that gave the Huskies a 14-0 lead at 1:38 in the first. Carter again fueled the scoring drive, ripping off a 44-yard run while Turner ended it with his first career scoring strike, a 13-yard completion to Keelan Marion (Atlanta, Ga.) to make it 14-0.

The UConn defense forced two punts, a turnover and a turnover on downs on Utah State's first four drives but the Aggie offense found its footing in the second quarter and ran off 24 unanswered points to close the first half. USU quarterback Logan Bonner led four scoring drives with under 11 minutes to go in the first half, with three touchdowns and a field goal with one second left on the clock capping the first half scoring.

A stingy defensive effort kept the Huskies in the game into the fourth quarter where a pair of sophomore Noe Ruelas (West Hartford, Conn.) field goals pulled UConn to withing 24-20 with 10:09 to go in the game.

The Aggies (1-0) answered as Bonner capped a 13 play, 75-yard drive with his third touchdown throw of the game, hitting Brian Cobbs in the back right corner of the endzone to push the lead to 31-20. Utah State's defense sealed the win away with their second interception of the day with 4:46 left, then using 10-plays to run out the clock for the win.

Bonner led the Aggies offense to 542 total yards, throwing for 281 yards on 20-of-29 passints. Cobbs led all receivers with seven catches for 78 yards and a score. On the ground, Tyler Calvin, Jr. finished with 161 yards on 33 carries while Robert Briggs ran for 85 on 10 touches with a touchdown.

For UConn, Turner finished his first career game going 12 for 31 for 109 yards, a touchdown and two interceptions. The Huskies finished with 364 total yards, 245 coming on the ground.

Defensively, Mitchell finished with 16 total tackles, a sack, a forced fumble and a fumble recovery. Senior Ian Swenson (Wilmette, Ill.) posted 12 tackles while r-sophomore Malik Dixon (Orlando, Fla.) made 11 stops.

For the second-straight week, UConn sophomore running back Nathan Carter (Rochester, NY) topped 100-yards rushing as the Huskies piled up-274 yards on the ground en route to a 28-3 win over in-state foe Central Connecticut at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Huskies (1-1) notch their first victory of the season and the first for first-year head coach Jim Mora at UConn. UConn improves to 19-2 against FCS opponents since 2002 in dealing the Blue Devils a loss in their season opener.

The UConn defense allowed just three points in Saturday's win, the fewest points allowed since a 2015 win at Tulane (7-3). CCSU finished with just 242 total yards of offense with just 78 yards rushing.

Carter paced the offense with 123 yards coming on 23 carries and a third quarter touchdown, his first of the season. Carter also hauled in one pass for 18 yards in the win. Classmate Brian Brewton (Miami, FL) carried 10 times for 62 yards.

In the air, true freshman Zion Turner (Fort Lauderdale, FL) made his first career start and completed 14-of-22 passes for 172 yards and a pair of touchdowns with an interception. Sophomore tight end Brandon Niemenski (Mountaintop, PA) and r-sophomore Jacob Flynn (Southington, CT) each caught touchdowns in the win.

After a scoreless first quarter, the Blue Devils posted the game's first points on a Cristiano Rosa 28-yard field goal to cap a six-play drive coming off blocking a UConn field goal attempt early in the quarter. The Huskies answered with a 14-play, 80-yard drive to take a lead they would never give up as Turner hit Niemenski on an 11-yard scoring strike.

Out of halftime, the Blue Devils saw their opening drive stall out on the Husky four-yard line but a 14-yard field goal attempt from Rosa missed off the upright. UConn responded with a 14 play drive that covered 80 yards and was capped by a Carter 17-yard burst for six and a 14-3 lead.

The Huskies made it 21-3 at 11:19 in the fourth quarter as Turner found Flynn for his first career touchdown and freshman running back Victor Rosa (Bristol, CT) closed out the scoring with his first career-touchdown, an 11-yard run to cap a 14-play, 88 yard drive late in the game.

Junior Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) led the defense with seven tackles, five solo while grad student Brandon Bouyer-Randle (Battle Creek, MI) recorded his first career interception in the win.

Syracuse junior quarterback Garrett Shrader threw for 287 yards and three touchdowns and ran two more in to lead the Orange past the UConn Huskies, 48-14, at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field.

The Syracuse (2-0) signal caller finished the night completing 20-of-23 passes with touchdown throws of 47, 18 and 39 yards in the win. Sophomore running back Sean Tucker carried it 27 times for 112 yards and a score for the Orange.

UConn (1-2) was held to 187 of total offense in the loss, just 92 through the air and 10 first downs. Sophomore running back Nathan Carter (Rochester, NY) led the Huskies with 71 yards rushing on 16 carries. Sophomore Devontae Houston (Roanoke, AL) recorded his first career touchdown, a 28-yard second quarter run for six.

Freshman quarterback Zion Turner (Fort Lauderdale, FL) completed 14-of-17 throws for 92 yards and a score, a 56-yard hook-up with sophomore Aaron Turner (Ellicott, MD) in the third quarter, his first career touchdown catch.

Syracuse scored on all five of their possessions in the first half, held the ball for 20:05 and outgained the Huskies 309-105 in building a 27-7 lead at the half. The Orange set the tone for the first half right off the opening kick-off, putting together a 12-play, 69-yard drive capped by a one-yard plunge from quarterback Shrader.

The Orange took a 17-0 lead after the first quarter before the Huskies would answer with nine-play drive that covered 79 yards and 10:09, their longest of the young season, as sophomore Devontae Houston (Roanoke, AL) burst of left end for a 28-yard score with 11:45 left in the half. Syracuse answered the Huskies right back and closed the first half with a 12-yard scoring drive, resulting in Andre Szymt's second field goal of the night, and a 10-play drive that saw Shrader hit Courtney Jackson on an 18-yard scoring strike.

UConn got on the board again in the third quarter as Turner closed out a six-play, 75-yard drive hitting Turner on a swing pass and the sophomore caught a block and flew through the defense for a 56-yard score to cut it to 34-14.

The Orange, who finished six-of-six on trips into the red-zone, closed out the scoring behind Shrader who ran in his second of the night at 2:29 in the third and hit D'Marcus Adams on a 39-yard strike at 14:07 in the fourth. Syracuse finished with 465 total yards of offense and 29 first downs.

The UConn defense was led by junior Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) who matched his career-high in tackles for the second time this season, making 16 stops and adding a half sack.

Michigan running back Blake Corum ran for five touchdowns as the No. 4 nationally ranked Wolverines dealt the visiting UConn Huskies a 59-0 loss in front of 109,639 at Michigan Stadium on Saturday afternoon.

The Huskies (1-3) were held scoreless for the first time this season and first time since a 49-0 loss at home to Purdue last fall. UConn had just 110 yards of total offense and six first downs in the loss.

Freshman quarterback Zion Turner (Fort Lauderdale, FL) was the Huskies leading rusher with 42 yards on seven carries. Turner completed just 4-of-16 passes for 17 yards on the day. Fellow true freshman Victor Rosa (Bristol, CT) had a career-high 14 carries.

Defensively, junior linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) led the Huskies with 10 tackles, his third game this season with double-digit stops. Junior Eric Watts (Sumter, SC) and grad student Brandon Bouyer-Randle (Battle Creek, Mich.) each recorded a sack, their firsts of the season.

Michigan finished with 465 yards of total offense, picked-up 26 first downs and converted on all eight of their trips into the red-zone, seven for touchdowns. Corum carried the ball 12 times for 71 yards while Michigan starting quarterback J.J. McCarthy finished 15-of-18 for 214 yards in the win.

The Wolverine defense forced 10 punts, held UConn to just 2-of-14 on third down and let the Huskies over midfield just once on 13 drives. Corum scored four of his five touchdowns in the first half as the Wolverines built a 38-0 lead into halftime.

The Huskies had a punt blocked early in the second quarter, setting up Michigan on the UConn 18-yard line and setting up Corum's third TD run of the day. The Michigan special teams struck again with 6:05 left in the second quarter as A.J. Henning returned a punt 61-yards for score and a 31-0 lead.

Corum's fifth scoring run of the afternoon came on an 11-yard scamper with 4:36 left in the third, capping off Michigan's longest drive of the day at 11-plays and 83 yards.

NC State quarterback Devin Leary threw for 320 yards and four touchdowns to lead the No. 12 nationally ranked Wolfpack past the UConn Huskies, 41-10, Saturday night in front of 56,919 at Carter-Finley Stadium.

The Huskies (1-4) drop their third-straight, losing to a Top-25 nationally ranked program for the second-consecutive week. UConn freshman running back Victor Rosa (Bristol, CT) carried six times for 43 yards and a touchdown in the loss. Freshman quarterback Zion Turner (Fort Lauderdale, FL) completed 10-of-12 passes but for just 39 yards.

NC State (4-0) put together 492 yards of total offense, 323 in the air, 29 first downs while going 10-for-14 on third down. Defensively, the Wolfpack kept the Huskies under wraps to the tune of 160 yards of total offense, just 2-fo-12 on the third down and eight total first downs.

The Wolfpack wasted no time jumping on the scoreboard, scoring 14 seconds into the game as Leary connected with Thayer Thomas for a 75-yard score on their first play from scrimmage. Leary commanded the NC State offense to scores on their first five drives, 357 yards of total offense, to 56 yards for the Huskies, while holding the ball for 20:01 en route to a 31-3 halftime lead.

Leary finished the first half 25-of-32 for 275 yards and three touchdowns while the Wolfpack converted 6-of-7 on third down and held the Huskies to 0-for-6.

The Huskies got a turnover in the closing minutes of the first half as linebacker Brandon Bouyer-Randle (Battle Creek, MI) got his second interception on the season and set UConn up on the NC State 10-yard line. The Wolfpack defense stood tall, getting a sack on second down and forced a Noe Ruelas (West Hartford, CT) 28-yard field goal as time expired.

UConn got on the board late in the fourth quarter as Rosa capped off a 10-play, 70-yard drive with an 11-yard run for six to cap the scoring.

Sophomore safety Durante Jones (Atlanta, GA) turned in a career-high 13 tackles while r-sophomore Malik Dixon-Williams (Orlando, FL) made 11 stops, matching his career-high. Linebacker Bouyer-Randle finished with nine tackles to go with his interception.

Leary's night ended in the fourth quarter with the quarterback finishing 32-of-44. He found nine different receivers on the night and hit Thayer for five catches and 115 yards. Michael Allen carried it 10 times for 66 yards while Sumo-Kamgbaye had 49 yards rushing on four carries and a score.

UConn sophomore running back Devontae Houston (Roanoke, AL) capped a 100-yard rushing day with the go-ahead touchdown with 2:20 left in the fourth quarter to lift the Huskies to a 19-14 win over visiting Fresno State at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field Saturday afternoon.

The Huskies (2-5) snap a three-game slide and earn the programs first-ever win over a team from the Mountain West conference in the process.

The UConn defense led the way, holding the Bulldogs to 187 total yards of offense, 157 through the air and 30 yards on the ground, all season-lows. The Bulldogs were 0-for-7 on third down and 0-for-2 on fourth down while the Huskies finished with two sacks, 6.0 tackles for a loss while forcing three turnovers, a season-best.

Houston finished with a career-best 105 yards, his first career 100-yard effort, on 23 carries.

The Huskies held a 3-0 lead after the first quarter, but the Bulldogs jumped up at 9:33 in the second as Nikko Remigio returned a punt 87-yards for a touchdown and a 7-3 lead. UConn's Noe Ruelas (West Hartford, CT) kicked his second field goal of the first half to cap a nine-play, 76-yard drive with 4:37 left to send UConn into the half trailing 7-6.

Fresno State took the second half kick-off to their 38-yard line and needed just five plays to cover 62 yards with Jordan Mims plunging in from a yard out to put the Bulldogs up 14-6 early in the third quarter. From there, the UConn defense took over, keeping Fresno off the scoreboard, getting an interception, and forcing three-straight punts to give the Husky offense a chance.

UConn freshman quarterback Zion Turner (Fort Lauderdale, FL) hit sophomore Aaron Turner (Ellicott City, MD) for a five-yard score at 5:18 in the third, but the two-point try failed leaving the Huskies trailing 14-12 into the fourth. A third-straight Bulldog punt was downed at the UConn six-yard line with 8:26 left and Turner put together an 11-play drive over the next 6:06 to put the Huskies on top.

The Huskies converted three third downs on the 94-yard drive and Houston capped it off breaking off right tackle and scampering up the sidelines for a 17-yard score for a 19-14 lead with 2:18 left. The Husky defense took over, forcing a turnover on downs as junior linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) created a fourth-and-13 with a sack on third down. UConn ran out the clock with grad student Robert Burns (Miami, FL) sealed the win picking up a clinching first down on a fourth-and-two, seven-yard.

Turner finished eight-of-15 for 130 yard and a touchdown. Mitchell made eight tackles with a sack while senior linebacker Ian Swenson (Wilmette, Ill.) had five stops and an interception.

Fresno State's Logan Fife completed 16-of-22 for 157 yards and threw two picks. Jalen Moreno-Cropper caught five passes for 76 yards.
