### Quick Hits---

- » The UConn Huskies return home for the first of three-straight at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field this Saturday when the FIU Panthers come to East Hartford. Game time is scheduled for 3:30 with coverage on CBS Sports Network.
- » The Huskies are looking to rebound after falling to 0-2 on the season after last weekend's 35-14 loss at Georgia State. GSU took a 21-0 lead into the half and led 28-0 at the end of the third. The Huskies struggled on offense in the first half and were out gained 247 to 88 in total yards. UConn ran it 22 times in the first 30 minutes but managed just 25 yards as they found themselves in a hole they couldn't get out of.
- » UConn quarterback Ta'Quan Roberson saw action after starter Joe Fagnano had to exit with injury in the second quarter. Roberson led two fourth quarter scoring drives and finished 19-of-30 for 216 yards and a pair of touchdowns with an interception in the loss. Roberson will take over starting quarterback duties starting with this week's match-up with FIU. It was announced that Fagnano will be forced to miss the remainder of the season due to his shoulder injury.
- » Grad transfer linebacker Noah Plack had his best game as a Husky, finishing with 13 tackles, two for a loss while senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell made seven stops and had a half a sack.
- » Grad transfer wide receiver Brett Buckman and junior wideout Kevens Clercius both caught touchdowns in the loss, their first scores of the season.
- » UConn Head Coach Mora returns for his second season leading the Huskies. Mora guided UConn to a 6-7 record in year one and brought the Huskies back to a postseason bowl game for the first time since the 2015 season. After a 1-4 start to the season, Mora led UConn to a 5-2 run through the rest of the regular season to become bowl eligible. Mora was hired as the 32nd head coach in program history in November of 2021. He returned to the sidelines for the first time since 2017 after a six-year stint as the head coach at UCLA. Mora led UCLA to a 46-30 record and four bowl appearances. His 31 years of coaching experience also included head coaching stints with the NFL's Atlanta Falcons and Seattle Seahawks.

UConn ran for a season-high 295 yards to go on the road and grab a 33-12 win at FIU last fall. Sophomore Devontae Houston ran for a career-best 135 yards and freshman Victor Rosa had 89 yards and two scores to pace the Husky rushing attack. The Huskies created three FIU turnovers in the first half and turned them into 17 points on their way to building a 20-0 lead at the half. UConn came into the game averaging 167.7 yards rushing and in the first half rang up 172 on the ground led by Houston. The sophomore running back had 132 of his 135 yards on 11 carries in the first half but was forced from the game with an injury at the beginning of the third quarter. The Huskies scored on all-four of their trips to the red-zone in the first half with Rosa capping off a pair of 11-play drives with touchdown runs. Senior defensive back Tre Wortham had two interceptions in the half, the second with 47 seconds left to set up a Noe Ruelas field goal to end the half. FIU was able to pull within 26-12 with 5:22 left in the fourth but the Huskies put the game away as Cale Millen held the ball on a read-option play and flew untouched off left tackle for a 49-yard score with 2:56 left to make produce the 33-12 final. Quarterback Zion Turner finished the game 14-for-19 for 102 yards while also catching a touchdown from Millen in the win.

**Scouting the Panthers...**

After a season opening loss at Louisiana Tech, the FIU Panthers have won two-straight and come into Saturday's match-up fresh off a 46-39 win over North Texas last weekend at home. Sophomore running back Kejon Owens rushed for a career-high 101 yards on 10 carries and scored three touchdowns to lead Panthers against the Mean Green and was named the Conference USA Offensive Player of the Week for his efforts. Classmate Shomari Lawrence leads the rushing attack with 254 yards on 38 carries through three games, ninth among NCAA leaders. Lawrence is averaging 6.7 yards per carry and has rushed for a pair of scores. Freshman quarterback Keyone Jenkins has thrown for 583 yards and three touchdowns in two games this season. Kris Mitchell is off to a fast start, catching 17 passes for 297 yards, a 17.5 yards per catch average, with three scores. Mitchell ranks third in the NCAA in receiving yards. On defense, the Panthers have forced six turnovers so far this season led by senior linebacker Donovan Manuel who has three forced fumbles while also leading the team in tackles with 38, 20 solo stops, and 5.0 tackles for a loss.

**UConn vs. Conference-USA...**

The Huskies are 1-3 against teams currently in Conference-USA. UConn beat FIU last season and is 0-3 against Middle Tennessee. UConn has two more future dates scheduled with FIU (2025-H and 2027-A) and also will play Liberty on the road in 2027. The Huskies faced past members of the league during their stints in Conference-USA. The Huskies faced Cincinnati (0-1), FAU (1-0), Louisville (0-1), Marshall (0-1) and USF (0-2) when they were members of the league.

## Head Coach Jim Mora

James L. Mora was named as the head football coach of the University of Connecticut on Nov. 11, 2021 and is the 32nd head coach in the program's history, which dates back to 1896.

In his first season in Storrs, Mora spearheaded a "Husky Revolution" that saw UConn finish with a 6-6 regular season record and make a return to the college football postseason for the first time since the 2015 campaign. The Huskies finished their season 5-1 on their home field at Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field capped by knocking off nationally ranked Liberty to clinch bowl eligibility and set the Huskies up for an appearance in the 2022 Myrtle Beach Bowl.

"Jim is a proven winner, a man of integrity, and he possesses the experience and the energy to lead our football program back to success,"

said David Benedict, UConn Director of Athletics. "Jim is excited and undaunted by this challenge, and we both know that this program has great potential. I'm certain that, under Coach Mora's leadership, UConn football will once again realize that potential."

Mora, 60, brings 31 years of coaching experience in both the college ranks and the NFL to Storrs. He has 10 years of head coaching experience, including six as the head coach of UCLA where he accumulated a 46-30 overall record and a 29-24 mark in Pac-12 play. Mora led the Bruins to the 2012 Pac-12 South Championship and won the 2013 Sun Bowl and 2014 Alamo Bowl. The Bruins were ranked as high as No. 7 nationally during the 2014 and 2015 seasons.

"I am excited to have the opportunity to become the head football coach at the University of Connecticut," Mora said. "UConn possesses a nationally-recognized academic and athletics brand and I am thrilled to become a member of the community that makes up UConn Nation. This program is loaded with potential."

Under Mora, 30 Bruins were selected in the NFL Draft, including at least one first rounder in every year except one. The 30 NFL Draft selections were the most of any Pac-12 program during that time.

A 1983 graduate of the University of Washington, Mora took over for Mike Holmgren as head coach of the Seattle Seahawks in 2009. He had served as assistant head coach and defensive backs coach for Seattle in the 2007 and 2008 campaigns. The Seahawks went 10-6 and finished first in the NFC West in the 2007 season and won the Wild Card game in the playoffs.

In his initial season as the head coach of the Atlanta Falcons in 2004, Mora directed the team to an 11-5 record, becoming just the eighth rookie head coach in NFL history to win 11 games and the 11th to bring home a division title. The Falcons captured the NFC South title and earned an appearance in the NFC Championship Game for only the second time in franchise history. Mora was honored as the NFC Coach of the Year following the 2004 season.

Prior to becoming the head coach for the Falcons, Mora served on the San Francisco 49ers coaching staff from 1997-2003. He spent his last five seasons in San Francisco as the defensive coordinator. In his first year, the 49ers finished No. 1 in the NFL in total defense, No. 2 in pass defense (25 interceptions), takeaways (41) and run defense, as well as finishing No. 3 in the league in sacks (54).

The 1998 squad tied for No. 1 in the NFC and No. 4 in the NFL in interceptions, with 21. In the 2002 and 2003 seasons with San Francisco, the defense finished no lower than fourth in the NFL versus the run, and in 2003 produced 42 sacks, to tie for second in the conference. The 1997 team advanced to the NFC Championship Game and had three defensive players voted to the Pro Bowl, while the 1998 and 2002 squads captured Wild Card Game wins.

From 1992-1996, Mora worked on the staff of his father, James E. Mora, as the secondary coach with the New Orleans Saints. The Saints put together the No. 1 pass defense in the league during Mora's first two years with the team.

In 1985, Mora broke into the NFL coaching ranks with the San Diego Chargers under head coach Don Coryell. He spent seven seasons with the Chargers, advancing from the league's first quality control coaching position to defensive backs coach, while working for head coaches Coryell, Al Saunders and Dan Henning.

NFL Pro Bowlers who have played under coach Mora over the years include -- Julian Peterson, LB-Seattle and San Francisco; Marcus Trufant, DB-Seattle; Allen Rossum, DB-Atlanta; Patrick Kerney, DL-Atlanta; Roderick Coleman, DL-Atlanta; Keith Brooking, LB-Atlanta; DeAngelo Hall, DB-Atlanta; Michael Vick, QB-Atlanta; Alge Crumpler, TE-Atlanta; Warrick Dunn, RB-Atlanta; Bryant Young, DL-San Francisco; Lance Schulters, DB-San Francisco; Merton Hanks, DB-San Francisco; Eric Allen, DB-New Orleans; Tyrone Hughes, DB-New Orleans; Gill Byrd, DB-San Diego; Anthony Barr, LB-Minnesota.

Mora began his coaching career in 1984 at the University of Washington. While at UW, Mora had the opportunity to be a part of two Rose Bowl teams as a player (1981-loss to Michigan; 1982-win over Iowa), and helped the Huskies land a berth in the 1985 Orange Bowl (win over Oklahoma) as a graduate assistant coach. During his five seasons in the Husky program, Washington compiled a 48-12 overall record.

## NEWS & NOTES ---

**Mitchell Leads the D...** Through two games, senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell is 14th in the NCAA in tackles, with 22 on the year, 11.0 per game. Jackson is climbing up the UConn record book for career tackles. The senior now has 347 stops over four seasons, moving him up to eighth on the all-time list. Alfred Fincher (2001-04) is next up in seventh place with 357 career tackles.

Mitchell, a 2022 Butkus Award semifinalist, started all 13 games last fall, leading the team with 140 tackles (50 solo), 9.5 tackles for loss and 4.5 sacks. Mitchell was seventh among NCAA leaders in tackles, averaging 10.8 stops per game on the season.

**Running Game Struggles...** The UConn rushing attack through two games has struggled, averaging 105.0 yards per game. Last season, the Huskies averaged 191.0 yards per game on the ground, ranked 33rd nationally. In last Saturday's loss at Georgia State, UConn ran it 31 times but managed just 50 yards. In the first half, UConn ran it 22 times but managed just 25 yards.

UConn returned their two leading rushers from a year ago. Sophomore Victor Rosa led the team in rushing as a true freshman, running for 636 yards on 140 carries and had a team-best 11 touchdowns. Junior Devontae Houston had 578 yards in 10 games and averaged a team-high 6.9 yards per carry. Houston found the end zone three times last year.

**Buckman Off To Fast Start...** Grad transfer Brett Buckman is coming off a career-game in the loss at Georgia State. Buckman hauled in nine catches for 93 yards, both career-highs, and caught a 32-yard touchdown from Ta'Quan Roberson in the fourth quarter, his first as a Husky. On the season, Buckman has a team-best 11 catches for 112 yards. Buckman transferred in from the University of Delaware where he appeared in 33 games in four seasons and had 61 career receptions for 763 yards and a touchdown for the Blue Hens.

**Fagnano Under Center...** After winning the starting quarterback battle in camp, senior Joe Fagnano made his UConn starting quarterback debut in the season opening loss to NC State. Fagnano got the Husky offense to a fast start, engineering a 12-play, 75 yard scoring drive to open the game, hitting his first three passes along the way. Fagnano finished the game 14-of-26 for 113 yards with an interception. In game two, Fagnano was 4-of-9 for 60 yards and ran nine times for 14 yards, getting sacked once against Georgia State. Fagnano was removed from the game in the second quarter due to an injury and it was announced on Tuesday that the senior quarterback will be forced to miss the remainder of the season. He will have shoulder surgery this week.

Fagnano transferred to UConn from the University of Maine last spring and will have two years of eligibility remaining. Fagnano played three seasons for the Black Bears, playing under UConn offensive coordinate Nick Charlton who was Maine's head coach prior to his move to UConn. In 2022, he posted career high passing totals, completing 208 passes for 2,231 yards and 15 touchdowns against just six interceptions. Fagnano also had career-best rushing numbers last fall, running for 296 yards on 93 carries for three scores. In the fall of 2021 he had 794 yards passing and six touchdowns in four games in the fall of 2021. During the spring 2021 COVID-19 season, he earned All-CAA Second Team honors after finishing the short season with 795 yards and eight touchdowns while running for two more. He was the team's Offensive Rookie of the Year award in 2019 after passing for 1,835 yards and 17 touchdowns in eight games as a freshman.

**Ta'Quan Steps In...** R-Junior Ta'Quan Roberson stepped in for injured starter Joe Fagnano in the second quarter on Saturday at Georgia State. Roberson completed 19-of-30 passes for 216 yards and two touchdowns, all career-best marks for the transfer from Penn State. Roberson's two touchdown throws were his first as a Husky. In 2022, Roberson was named the starter out of summer camp but was lost for the season to a knee injury on the team's second drive of the season opener at Utah State. Roberson will now move into the starting quarterback roll.

**Experience Up Front...** One of the strengths of this year's UConn team will be up front with the offensive line. The Huskies return four of five of a unit that started every game last season and finished the season leading a rushing attack that piled up 2,483 yards rushing, the third highest team total in program history. UConn has a pair of senior guards

in All-American Christian Haynes and Noel Ofori-Nyadu back as well as their two tackles in senior Valentin Senn on the left side and r-junior Chase Lundt at right tackle. The group allowed just 17 sacks, 1.38 per game, last year, ranked 29th in the NCAA.

**Return of Cam Ross ...** R-Junior wide receiver Cam Ross will head into the start of a season healthy for the first time since 2019, his freshman campaign. Through the first two games this season, Ross has six catches for 60 yards. Foot injuries cost Ross the better parts of the 2021 and 2022 seasons. After going down in training camp last fall, Ross battled back and played three games at the end of the year, recording a pair of catches in the Myrtle Beach Bowl loss to Marshall. In 2019, Ross led UConn with 60 catches and 723 receiving yards to rank second nationally among true freshmen in receptions per game (5.5) and total receptions. He caught four touchdowns that season as well.

**Tons of Tight Ends...** The Huskies have a wealth of options to occupy the tight end position this fall. UConn has seven players listed at the position on the depth chart expected to contribute. Sophomore Justin Joly came on during the second half of his freshman season and finished as the top receiving threat among the group with 12 catches for 250 yards and two scores. UConn brought in r-sophomore transfer Alex Honig from TCU and sophomore transfer Louis Hansen from Michigan to bolster the depth.

**Kicking Battle...** In addition to a starting quarterback competition in camp, the Huskies also had a battle for the starting kicker duties. R-Sophomore Joe McFadden was named as the starter by head coach Jim Mora and will handle both place kicking and kick-off duties. McFadden was the starter in 2021, making 12 of 17 with a long 47 yards as a true freshman. A season-ending knee injury prior to 2022 training camp cost McFadden last season but junior Noe Ruelas stepped in and finished 12 of 16 on field goals, with a long make of 54 yards at Utah State.

**Returning All-American...** UConn r-senior offensive lineman Christian Haynes returns to the Husky offensive line after an All-American season in 2022. Haynes leads four returning starters on the offensive line and last season became just the third Husky in the FBS era to earn All-American honors after being named to the Sporting News and Associated Press All-American teams. Haynes helped lead an offensive line that fueled a rushing attack that averaged 191.0 yards per game and allowed just 17 sacks on the season, just 1.42 per game. In his UConn career, he has started 37-straight games over three seasons. During the 2023 preseason, Haynes has found his name listed on the 2023 Sporting News Preseason All-American Team (1st team), the 2023 Athlon Sports College Football Preseason All-America Team (2nd team offense), the 2023 Walter Camp Preseason FBS All-American team, presented by 777 (2nd team offense), and the 2023 Phil Steele Preseason All-American team (3rd team offense)

**New to the Coaching Staff...** The Huskies will have a few new faces on the sidelines in 2023. Head Coach Jim Mora brought in former Husky **Kashif Moore** to be his wide receivers coach. Moore was a four-year letterwinner at UConn from 2008-11. He spent last season at Albany as the receivers coach. **Antonio Wilcox** joins the staff as the team's running backs coach. Wilcox spent the previous two seasons in the same role at Furman University. Mora announced at the end of camp the addition of **John Pagano** as a special assistant to the head coach. Pagano is a 26-year NFL coaching veteran, most recently as the linebackers coach with the Denver Broncos. Assistant coach **John Marinelli** was elevated to the role of passing game coordinator for 2023 after serving as the tight ends coach last year. **Christian Pace**, who was an analyst last season on Mora's staff, has been elevated to assistant coach and replaces Marinelli coaching the tight ends.

**Third Year as an FBS Independent...** The 2023 campaign will mark the third season the Huskies will compete as an independent. UConn has three match-ups with teams from the ACC this season (NCSU, Duke, BC). The Huskies will take on a pair of teams from the Sun Belt (Georgia State, JMU) and their former conference, the AAC (Rice, USF). The schedule also features single match-ups against teams from the SEC (Tennessee), the Mountain West (Utah State), Conference USA (FIU) and the NEC from FCS (Sacred Heart). In addition, UConn will have first-ever meetings this season against Georgia State, Rice and Sacred Heart.

**The Stadium:** The Huskies moved into Rentschler Field in East Hartford for the 2003 season and begin their 20th season of play at their off-campus home in 2023. The stadium officially became known as Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field in 2015. UConn has an all-time record of 69-54 at Rentschler Field and a 35-18 mark in non-conference games prior to re-classifying as an independent in 2020. UConn set a new all-time single-game attendance record at Rentschler Field on Sept. 21, 2013 against Michigan with a crowd of 42,704. That capacity was achieved with extra bleachers brought in for that game.

**20 Seasons at The Rent...** The 2023 season marks the 20th season of UConn football at Pratt & Whitney Stadium. Each week, we will look back on a key game or moment in the history of UConn football at the East Hartford stadium. **This week's highlight: September 19, 2008** – Sept. 19, 2008 – Junior tailback Donald Brown scored on a three-yard run with 6:04 remaining in the fourth quarter and the UConn defense held Baylor on fourth down with less than a minute to play as the Huskies went on to beat the Bears, 31-28, before a crowd of 38,870 at Rentschler Field. Following Brown's go-ahead score, Baylor freshman quarterback Robert Griffin III had one last drive to take the lead or pull the game even. RGIII converted two third downs but the UConn defense stood tall and stalled the drive out at the Connecticut 39 to earn the hard-fought win.

NC State quarterback Brennan Armstrong threw for 155 yards and ran for 96 and a pair of touchdowns as the Wolfpack came to Pratt & Whitney Stadium at Rentschler Field and dealt the UConn Huskies a 24-14 loss in the 2023 season opener for both teams.

Thursday night's home opener for the Huskies was played in front of 36,526 fans, the biggest opening night at The Rent since the 2010 opener against Texas Southern which had 37,359. It was the largest home crowd since the Huskies 2013 match-up with Michigan which drew 42,704.

The Huskies (0-1) got the night off with a bang, after taking the opening kickoff then marching 75 yards in 12 plays for the season's opening score and a 7-0 lead thanks to an 18-yard scamper to the right corner of the endzone by sophomore running back Victor Rosa (Bristol, Conn.). Newly named starting quarterback Joe Fagnano (Williamsport, Pa.) hit on his first three passes of the night and picked-up a key third down conversion on the drive.

NC State (1-0) answered right back, needing nine plays to cover 66 yards on the ensuing drive with Armstrong capping it off with a four-yard run off tackle for six to knot it at 7-7. The Wolfpack defense put UConn in check the rest of the first half, limiting the Huskies to just 45 yards of offense and took a 10-7 lead into the locker room.

The Wolfpack used an 11-play drive that covered 91 yards and 6:27 in the third quarter to extend their lead to 17-7 as Delbert Mimms plunged in from a yard out.

The UConn offense sparked to life on the ensuing drive with Rosa blazing his way on the first play up the left sidelines for a 71-yard touchdown, the longest score of the young back's career. Rosa was flagged for unsportsmanlike conduct for flipping into the endzone, forcing the Huskies to kick off from their own 20. Julian Gray had a 40-yard return and an unnecessary roughness call on UConn tacked on 15 more yard to set up NC State at the UConn 27-yard line.

Armstrong need just four plays to extend the lead, running in from eight-yards out for his second score on the night and a 24-10 lead with 34 seconds left in the third.

The UConn defense got a fourth down stop at midfield early in the fourth quarter but couldn't capitalize and a late eight-play drive was cut short as Fagnano was intercepted with 2:20 left to seal the win for NC State.

NC State finished with 209 yards on the ground led by Armstrong's 96 on 19 carries. The Wolfpack held the ball for 34:00 minutes on Thursday night and defensively held UConn to 273 yards of offense and just 4-of-12 on the third down.

Rosa ran for 99 yards on nine carries and a pair of scores. Fagnano completed 14-of-26 for 113 yards and was sacked twice in the loss.

Defensively, senior linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, Conn.) finished with 15 total tackles, 1.5 for a loss. Junior safety Durante Jones (Atlanta, Ga.) matched his career-high with 14 tackles, 10 solo.

Georgia State quarterback Darren Grainger ran for 142 yards and a score and threw for 144 and a touchdown to lead the Panthers to a 35-14 win over the visiting UConn Huskies at Center Pac Stadium in front of 15,186 fans.

The Panthers ran for 250 yards on the night led by Grainger and running back Marcus Carroll who had 107 rushing with three touchdowns.

After trading punts on the game's first two possessions, the Panthers struck for the game's first points as Grainger took the snap in shotgun and burst right through the middle of the Husky defense, going 65 yards untouched for a 7-0 lead at 8:40.

UConn's first chance at points came McFadden missed 48-yard field goal, wide left, with five seconds left in the first after the Huskies got a GSU turnover on the Panther's 47-yard line.

Georgia State got on the board twice in the second quarter, their first being set up by a muffed punt return on the UConn 46-yard line. Grainger need six plays to put his team up 14-0, hitting Robert Lewis at the right front pylon for a nine-yard score at 5:22. The Panthers closed out the half with a nine-play drive that covered 63 yards with Marcus Carroll scoring from two-yards out for a 21-0 lead into the locker room.

UConn starting quarterback Joe Fagnano (Williamsport, Pa.) was forced out of the game late in the second quarter with an injury and the Huskies would go to r-junior back-up Ta'Quan Roberson (Orange, NJ) the rest of the way. The Huskies struggled on offense in the first half and were outgained 247 to 88 in total yards. UConn ran it 22 times in the first 30 minutes but managed just 25 yards.

Out of the half, the Panthers forced a UConn punt on the opening possession, then Grainger engineered a 15-play drive that covered 92 yards and was capped by Carroll who scored his second of the night on a three-yard plunge to make it 28-0.

The Huskies put an end to their scoring drought with 9:16 left in the fourth quarter as Roberson hit Kevens Clercius (Montreal, Quebec) in the back of the endzone from 11-yards out for his first TD pass at UConn.

Carroll scored his third on the night with 6:26 to play, bursting through the middle for a 39-yard score, pushing him over the 100-yard mark for the night.

Roberson led a second UConn scoring drive, covering 80-yards in eight plays capped by a diving catch in the endzone by Brett Buckman (Park Ridge, NJ) for a 32-yard scored, cutting it to 35-14 with 3:57 left.

UConn finished with just 50 yards on the ground on 31 rushes on the night. Roberson finished 19-of-30 for 216 yards and a pair of touchdowns with an interception in the loss. Buckman caught nine balls for 93 yards and his first TD as a Husky.

Defensively, Noah Plack (Bridgeville, PA) posted 13 tackles, two for a loss. Linebacker Jackson Mitchell (Ridgefield, CT) made seven stops and had a half a sack.
