LIBERTY STORYLINES

- Liberty (3-0, 1-0 CUSA) will travel to FIU (3-1, 0-1 CUSA) Saturday evening for the Flames' first-ever CUSA road contest. Both teams enter the contest on three-game winning streaks.
- Liberty won its only previous meeting with the Panthers, posting a 36-34 home decision on Sept. 26, 2020. That is part of the Flames' 10-1 all-time record versus CUSA opponents and nine-game winning streak in CUSA matchups (at time of meeting).
- After defeating New Mexico State 33-17 in their inaugural CUSA game on Sept. 9, Liberty will try to become CUSA's first 2-0 team this season.
- Liberty is in search of its first regular-season win in Florida since Oct. 14, 1995, when the Flames edged Daunte Culpepper's UCF Knights by a 7-6 score.
- Liberty QB Kaidon Salter threw for a career-high 344 yards and accounted for 6 TDs (5 passing, 1 rushing) in the Flames' 55-27 win at Buffalo, their highest scoring output since 2021. As a result, he was named the Flames' first-ever CUSA Offensive Player of the Week.
- WRs CJ Daniels and Treon Sibley each recorded 106 receiving yards at Buffalo. It marked Daniels' second straight 100-yard outing and the first of Sibley's career.
- Liberty's tackles leader this season, LB Tyren Dupree (28 stops) came up with his first two career interceptions at Buffalo. Through three weeks, the Flames rank No. 1 nationally for interceptions (9), takeaways (10) and turnover margin (+8).

Work-Related Equipment Bags

Members of the media will be allowed to bring work-related equipment bags (laptop computers, radio/TV broadcast equipment, still and video cameras, etc.) through the Media entrance near the East Ticket Booth. Work-related equipment bags may be searched by Williams Stadium security.

Postgame Interviews

For home games, postgame interviews are held on the first floor of the Liberty Football Center. Todd Wetmore, Liberty Associate AD for Strategic Communications, will ask for requests during the fourth quarter of the contest. A virtual option will also be available to the media for those who are unable to attend the in-person media session.

Parking

Liberty University has designated the Pink Lot on Regents Parkway (located in front of the LaHaye Ice Center) as reserved media parking for home football games in 2023. Please contact the Liberty Strategic Communications Office to obtain a digital parking pass and information on how to access the lot on game day.

Photographers

Liberty University strictly enforces a photo credential approval policy designed to best allocate working credentials for photographers to maximize coverage in a safe, professional working environment. Unfortunately, it is not possible to accommodate all requests. Due to limited space, credentials will generally not be issued to freelance photographers without a specific assignment received in writing from the assigning organization. Photographers are to stay behind the white line that surrounds the playing field and are not allowed in the team box on either sideline at Williams Stadium and are prohibited from going on the field at any time. A photo/video workroom is available inside the Liberty Football Center for media outlets to use on game day to process their photo/video content.

“4 DOWNS” WITH FIU

1 Saturday night will mark several 'firsts' for the Flames. It will be their first-ever CUSA road game, their first-ever visit to FIU Stadium and their first regular-season contest in Florida since 2002 (at UCF). Liberty will be in search of its first road win in conference play since Oct. 28, 2017, when the Flames posted a 33-17 victory at Gardner-Webb.

2 Liberty is hoping to win its first two conference games of the season for the first time since 2016 (Big South Conference). Seven of the eight times the Flames started 2-0 or better in Big South play, they went on to win at least a share of the conference title. The last six CUSA champions have started conference play 2-0 or better. Both teams enter the matchup riding three-game winning streaks. FIU has won its three contests by a total of 16 points, while Liberty has won by an average of 18.0 points/game.

3 Liberty has scored 30+ points in three straight games for the first time since Nov. 27, 2020-Sept. 4, 2021. The last time the Flames eclipsed the 30-point mark in 4+ straight games was Oct. 10-Nov. 14, 2020. Kaidon Salter recorded his first 300-yard passing game at Buffalo and the first by a Flame since Malik Willis on Nov. 27, 2021 vs. Army.

4 The Flames have made it to four straight bowl games (3-1 record), three of which have been played in Florida. FIU Stadium will be the fourth different CUSA stadium Liberty has visited. The Flames are 3-0 on the road vs. CUSA opponents (at the time of meeting) with wins at WKU (2020), UAB (2021) and North Texas (2021).

- Liberty edged FIU in the Flames' 2020 home opener, a contest which saw two ties and three lead changes.
- After scoring nine straight points to overcome a fourth quarter deficit, Liberty stopped a FIU two-point conversion attempt with 4:30 left to hang on.
- QB Malik Willis paced the Flames' offense in his first home start, going 24-of-30 for 285 yards and two TDs while rushing for 85 yards on 13 carries.
- FIU's D'Vonte Price carried the ball 13 times for 148 yards and scored three total TDs.

ON THIS DATE: Liberty is 5-2 all-time when playing on Sept. 23, with all seven games being played on the road.

A LIBERTY WIN WOULD...

- Enable the Flames to start out 4-0 for the first time since 2020, when they opened the year at 8-0.
- Give the Flames their first 2-0 start in conference play since opening the 2016 Big South slate at 4-0.
- Help the Flames remain as CUSA's only unbeaten team and make Liberty the first squad with two CUSA wins in 2023.
- Keep the Flames unbeaten all-time against FIU at 2-0.
- Mark the Flames' 10th straight win over a CUSA opponent, improving their all-time record against CUSA foes to 11-1.
- Boost the Flames' record to 4-10 when playing in Florida and give them their first regular-season win in the Sunshine State since Oct. 14, 1995 (7-6 victory at UCF).
- Make Jamey Chadwell the second Liberty head coach ever to win his first four games with the Flames. Sam Rutigliano started 6-0 during the 1989 campaign, his first at Liberty.
- Snap FIU's three-game winning streak.

MILESTONE WATCH

12: Coming off a career-high 13-point outing at Bufalo, K Nick Brown is now within 12 points of 100 for his career.

69: RB Billy Lucas needs 69 rushing yards to reach the 2,000 mark for his career. He has totaled 142 yards during his first three games at Liberty and has posted seven 100-yard games for his career.

110/326: QB Kaidon Salter is 110 passing yards away from 2,000 for his career. A big 326-yard game at FIU would enable him to eclipse his single season high of passing yards already. Salter threw for a career-high 1,088 yards in 2022.

LIBERTY FOOTBALL BY THE NUMBERS

1: The 2023 season is Liberty's first as a member of Conference USA, giving the Flames a conference home for the first time in the FBS ranks.

3: Liberty is one of three teams (also Appalachian State and Marshall) to become bowl eligible in each of its first four seasons after transitioning from the FCS to FBS. The Flames are 3-1 in bowl games, winning the 2019 Cure Bowl, 2020 Cure Bowl and 2021 LendingTree Bowl titles.

6: The 2023 season is Liberty's sixth as an FBS member, following 30 seasons of competition at the FCS (1-AA) level.

8: Liberty won eight Big South Conference titles (2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016).

10: Ten Flames have been selected in the NFL Draft. Most recently, WR Demario Douglas was taken by New England in the sixth round of the 2023 Draft.

10: Jamey Chadwell is Liberty's 10th head coach in program history.

10: Liberty has won a program-record 10 games twice, going 10-2 in 2008 and 10-1 in 2020.

10: Ten Flames have been named CSC (formerly CoSIDA) Academic All-Americans.

17: The Flames have posted a .500 or better record for 17 consecutive years, going 131-71 since the start of the 2006 season.

17: 17 members of this year's team have completed bachelor's degrees and are currently working toward graduate degrees.

51: The 2023 campaign is Liberty's 51st football season.

25,000: The seating capacity of Williams Stadium was expanded to 25,000 for the 2018 season.

FAST START

Liberty is off to a 3-0 or better start for the third time in the last four years. In 2020, the Flames got off to their best start in program history, winning their first eight games.

This is the first time in program history in which Liberty has opened a season winning each of its first three games by double-digits. The last time Liberty posted four straight double-digit-margin victories was Oct. 3-24, 2020.

CUSA SUCCESS

Liberty, after playing the last five years as an FBS Independent, plays its first Conference USA away game on Saturday at FIU.

The Flames were members of the Big South Conference from 2002-2017, winning eight conference titles.

Liberty, which was voted second in the CUSA preseason coaches' poll, will aim to earn a spot in the 2023 Conference USA championship game, held on Dec. 1

Overall, Liberty is 10-1 all-time, including 3-0 on the road, against teams who were members of CUSA at time of meeting.

SUNSHINE STATE

Liberty is 3-10 all-time when playing in the state of Florida, including 1-9 in true away games and 2-1 in bowl games played inside the Sunshine State.

The Flames won the 2019 (vs. Georgia Southern) and 2020 (vs. Coastal Carolina) Cure Bowls in Orlando and fell to Toledo in the 2022 Boca Raton Bowl.

Liberty's last regular-season game in Florida was Sept. 28, 2002 at UCF, a 48-17 loss. The Flames' lone true road win in Florida came on Oct. 14, 1995, a 7-6 win at UCF where Liberty topped future NFL star quarterback Daunte Culpepper.

Liberty's current roster features 12 players from the state of Florida, including Miami natives C.J. Bazile, Jr. and Nick Days and Amari Williams from North Miami Beach.

TAKE ME AWAY

Liberty leads the nation with nine interceptions this season. The Flames are also tied for the FBS lead in both turnover margin (2.67) and total takeaways (10).

Liberty is one of 13 teams which have not thrown an interception in 2023.

THREE-WIN MATCHUPS

Liberty vs. FIU is one of nine FBS games in Week 4 where both teams have won three or more games. Liberty (3-0) at FIU (3-1)/BYU (3-0) at Kansas (3-0) Colorado (3-0) at Oregon (3-0)/UCLA (3-0) at Utah (3-0) Rutgers (3-0) at Michigan (3-0) Oregon State (3-0) at Washington State (3-0) Ohio State (3-0) at Notre Dame (4-0) Iowa (3-0) at Penn State (3-0) Memphis (3-0) at Missouri (3-0)

FIRST-YEAR HEAD COACH

Liberty is one of four FBS teams with a first-year head coach who are currently undefeated.

Liberty (Jamey Chadwell), Auburn (Hugh Freeze), Colorado (Deion Sanders) and Louisville (Jeff Brohm) are all 3-0 while under the leadership of head coaches in their first year leading their current program.

HEAD TO HEAD (COACH)

Liberty Head Coach Jamey Chadwell and FIU Head Coach Mike MacIntyre met on Oct. 19, 2013, as MacIntyre's Colorado Buffaloes won a 43-10 home decision against Chadwell's Charleston Southern Buccaneers. Both Chadwell and MacIntyre were in their first year as head coach at their respective institutions.

MacIntyre won the Grant Teaff National Coach of the Year in 2012, while Chadwell was named Grant Teaff National Coach of the Year in 2020.

Liberty sophomore LB Jerome Jolly, Jr. and FIU redshirt junior WR Kris Mitchell both went to Mandarin High School in Jacksonville, Fla.

Liberty junior DT Jay Hardy and FIU redshirt sophomore WR Eric Rivers both went to McCallie School in Chattanooga, Tenn.

Liberty senior WR Elijah Smoot and FIU redshirt sophomore OL Jackson Schultze both played at Northeastern Oklahoma A&M.

Liberty sophomore DE CJ Bazile, Jr. and FIU freshman RB Nate Henry both played at Miramar High School.

Liberty junior DT Amari Williams and FIU redshirt sophomore DB D'Mor Jean-Baptiste both played at North Miami Beach Senior High School.

Liberty junior DB Preston Hodge, FIU sophomore RB T.J. Snowden and redshirt sophomore OL Phillip Houston all played at Navarro College.

Liberty sophomore DE Bryan Whitehead II and FIU junior DL Marquez Tatum both played at Pearl River Community College.

Liberty senior LB Nick Days and FIU redshirt sophomore DB Reech Daniel both played at North Miami High School.

Liberty redshirt sophomore DE Grey Carroll and FIU sophomore QB Chaydeen Peery and redshirt sophomore Khaya Wright all played at Georgia Tech.

LAST MEETING RETURNEES

Current Liberty redshirt senior Noah Frith got Liberty on the board in the Flames' last meeting with FIU in 2020, catching a first-quarter touchdown pass. He caught three passes for 56 yards that day.

Additionally, Brendan Schlittler started at guard, while Tyren Dupree, Quinton Reese and Jerome Jolly, Jr. all recorded tackles versus FIU.

- Starting with this week's FIU game, Liberty will spend the next six games playing Conference USA contests, which will include four midweek conference matchups (one Thursday and three Tuesday games).
- Liberty played its first conference game since the 2017 season when the Flames defeated fellow CUSA newcomer New Mexico State, 33-17, on Sept. 9 at Williams Stadium.
- A stretch of 2,122 days took place between Liberty's last two conference games (2017 at the FCS level in the Big South Conference and 2023 in its Conference USA opener against New Mexico State).
- During its first four seasons of full bowl eligibility, Liberty has played in four-straight bowl games, winning its first three postseason FBS games (W in the 2019 Cure Bowl; W in the 2020 Cure Bowl; W in the 2021 LendingTree Bowl; L in the 2022 Boca Raton Bowl).
- Liberty has won eight or more games each of its four seasons and 14 times total in program history (2019: 8-5; 2020: 10-1; 2021: 8-5; 2022: 8-5).

Offense

- The Flames have racked up 500+ yards of total offense in their last two games, tallying 526 yards against New Mexico State and a season-high 569 yards against Buffalo.
- Liberty was efficient on offense against Buffalo, finishing with 569 yards on 65 plays, averaging a season-best 8.8 yards per offensive play.
- Following the performance at Buffalo, Liberty currently leads Conference USA and ranks No. 18 in total offense (494.7 yards per game).
- Liberty tallied 55 points against Buffalo last weekend, its highest point total since scoring 56 points against Eastern Michigan to win the 2021 LendingTree Bowl in Mobile, Ala.
- Liberty enters this week's matchup at FIU leading all CUSA teams and ranks No. 17 in the country in scoring offense (40.7 points per game).
- The Flames have scored points in 11 of the 12 quarters they have played during their three games in 2023. The only quarter Liberty has not scored in this year was during the fourth quarter of the Flames' 33-17 win over New Mexico State.
- Liberty ranks No. 1 in the country in fewest passes had intercepted. The Flames are one of 13 FBS teams nationally who have not thrown an interception in 2023.
- The Flames continue to excel on the ground, posting 200+ rushing yards for the third game in a row with a 225-yard performance at Buffalo.
- Liberty currently leads Conference USA and ranks No. 7 in the country in rushing offense (240.3 yards per game).
- Liberty finished the Buffalo game without committing a turnover, a first for the Flames since the 2021 season against North Texas (LU had gone 20 games in a row with at least one turnover).
- Liberty has committed just two turnovers in 2023 (both fumbles lost) and ranks No. 10 in the country in turnovers lost.
- The first time in 2023, Liberty lost the time of possession battle with Buffalo edging Liberty 31:25 to 28:35. Liberty currently ranks No. 16 in the country in average time of possession (33:08).
- The Flames recorded their first road win over 2023 at Buffalo despite committing a season-high 10 penalties for 90 yards.

- Liberty finished the Buffalo game with a season-high 344 passing yards, thanks to the career day by sophomore starting quarterback Kaidon Salter.
- Following Salter's career day that includes passes of 42, 56 and 75 yards, Liberty currently ranks No. 5 in the country in passing yards per completion (18.17).
- Liberty had a pair of receivers go over the 100-yard mark in the same game for the first time since 2018 with CJ Daniels finishing with four receptions for 106 yards and Treon Sibley recording a career-high 106 yards on three receptions.
- The Flames have done a good job protecting quarterback Kaidon Salter this year and currently rank No. 20 nationally in sacks allowed (1.00 per game – two sacks by Bowling Green; none by NMSU; one by Buffalo).

Defense

- Liberty remains one of 38 FBS teams in the country who have yet to suffer a loss in 2023.
- The Flames picked off two more passes during its 55-27 win at Buffalo, giving them a national leading nine interceptions through three games in 2023.
- Both of the interceptions were tipped passes that linebacker Tyren Dupree picked off. Dupree, along with fellow linebacker Jerome Jolly, Jr. and safety Brylan Green each have two interceptions in 2023 and rank No. 8 nationally in total interceptions.
- Liberty is +8 in the turnover margin in 2023 and is currently tied for Fresno State for No. 1 in the country in turnover margin (+2.67 turnovers per game).
- The Flames are tied with four other teams in the country in turnovers gained, joining Cal, Colorado, Fresno State and San Diego State with 10 turnovers gained in 2023.
- The Flames allowed a season-low 87 rushing yards to Buffalo on 30 carries, limiting the Bulls to 2.9 yards per carry.
- During its first two games in 2023, Liberty allowed Bowling Green (191 yards on 31 carries) and New Mexico State (170 yards on 24 carries) to combine for 361 total rushing yards.
- Buffalo scored 14 of its 27 points during the final eight minutes of the second quarter.
- On the season, Liberty's opponents have scored 38 of their 68 points (55.9 percent) during the second quarter (1st quarter points allowed: 7; 2nd quarter: 38; 3rd quarter: 17; 4th quarter: 6).
- Buffalo finished the game converting on 5-of-18 third-down plays. The Flames currently rank No. 32 in the country in third-down conversion defense (32.5 percent/13-of-40).

Special Teams

- Liberty's top returning scorer from 2022 is kicker Nick Brown, who led the Flames with 73 points scored on 11 field goals (11-of-19) and 40-of-41 extra point attempts.
- Nick Brown had a career day at Buffalo, finishing with a career-best 13 points against the Bulls (two field goals/7-of-7 extra point attempts).
- The Flames limited Buffalo to 40 return yards on four kick-offs (10.0 yards per return). Entering the FIU game, Liberty currently ranks No. 8 in the country in kickoff return defense (11.09 yards allowed per return).

WINNING TRADITION CONTINUES IN 2022

Liberty has won six or more games every year from 2006 through 2022.

Liberty is one of just seven Division I football teams to win six or more games each of the last 17 seasons. Ohio State would qualify, but vacated wins during that stretch.

Liberty joins Alabama, Clemson, Georgia, James Madison, Oklahoma and Oklahoma State as the only seven FBS teams to win six or more games each of the last 17 years.

The Flames have posted four straight seasons with eight or more wins, setting a new program record for consecutive eight-win seasons.

GOOD COMPANY

With its win at Gardner-Webb on Oct. 15, 2022, Liberty became bowl eligible for the fourth time in as many seasons as a full FBS member. The Flames are 3-1 in bowl games so far, putting them in select company.

Liberty is the third current FBS team to become bowl eligible in each of its first four seasons since transitioning from the FCS to FBS.

Marshall made bowl appearances each year from 1997-02, while Appalachian State has appeared in a bowl every season since joining the FBS in 2015.

Liberty won its first three bowl games (2019-2021), joining Appalachian State (2015-20) as the only two FBS teams to win bowl games in each of their first three (or more) seasons of FBS bowl eligibility after transitioning from FCS.

Appalachian State has not only made a bowl appearance every year since 2015, but the Mountaineers won their first six bowl appearances since transitioning to FBS before falling to Western Kentucky in the 2021 Boca Raton Bowl.

ALL FBS, ALL THE TIME

For the first time in program history, Liberty will face a full FBS schedule.

Liberty and UTSA are the only two teams outside of the Power 5 whose 2023 schedules feature only games against FBS competition.

In its first five years as an FBS opponent, Liberty went a perfect 8-0 against FCS opponents.

MIDWEEK ON THE MOUNTAIN

The 2023 season marks the debut of Conference USA's midweek scheduling model, primarily during the month of October, with CBS Sports Network carrying 10 games and ESPN carrying nine games this season during that timeframe on linear networks ESPN2 and ESPN.

The MAC will take over the midweek games starting on Oct. 31 and carrying through the month of November, as the MAC has played midweek games on linear networks since 2000.

Partly due to this agreement, at least eight out of Liberty's 12 games will air on linear networks this season. The Flames are 15-10 all-time when playing on linear networks, including 6-1 at home, 5-8 away and 3-1 on neutral sites. Liberty is 2-1 all-time on ESPN, 4-2 on ESPN2, 1-0 on ESPN2, 1-1 on ESPNNews and 4-2 on CBS Sports Network.

FUTURE DR. IN THE HOUSE

Liberty's Trey Lowe III and Auburn's Elijah McAllister are the only two active NCAA Division I FBS players who are currently pursuing doctoral degrees. Both players are studying toward Ph.D. programs.

Both Lowe (Southern Miss) and McAllister (Vanderbilt) transferred to their current institution after last season.

NEW STAFF

Jamey Chadwell was announced as the 10th head coach in program history on Dec. 4, 2022. For five of the last six seasons, Chadwell guided the rapid growth of the Coastal Carolina football program at the FBS level and in the Sun Belt Conference.

Coach Chadwell brought in an entirely new coaching staff to Lynchburg.

Among the new coaches is quarterbacks coach/co-offensive coordinator Willy Korn. At 34 years of age, Korn is the 11th youngest offensive coordinator in FBS football. Ben Arbuckle of Washington State is the youngest at 27 years old.

NEW TEAM

The Liberty football team features 56 newcomers this season, which is 10th most in the country. Colorado leads the way with 88.

Liberty also has the fifth fewest scholarship players returning from last year (38), 11th most transfers from last season to this season (23) and sixth most scholarship newcomers (42).

Additionally, Liberty (59) boasts the sixth fewest returning players from its 2022 roster.

NEW CONFERENCE

Liberty joins Conference USA along with fellow newcomers Jacksonville State, New Mexico State and Sam Houston. The Flames will have the opportunity to qualify for a conference championship game and benefit from conference bowl tie-ins for the first time.

After a successful 16-year run in the Big South (2002-17), which saw Liberty win eight conference titles and earn one FCS Playoffs berth, the Flames spent 2018 through 2022 playing as an FBS Independent.

IMPRESSIVE STATS

According to SportSource Analytics, Liberty rated fifth among all FBS programs in third-down efficiency, at 73 percent. They trailed only Alabama, Georgia, Western Michigan and Wyoming.

Liberty also won the explosive play battle in 73 percent of its games over the last three seasons, trailing only Alabama.

Coach Chadwell's offense at Coastal Carolina impressed on a national level the last three seasons, his teams averaged 7.86 yards per play in the first quarter, 7.25 yards per play on first down.

Chadwell's Chanticleers went a perfect 27-0 during his last four years at the helm when leading after three quarters.

RECENT UPGRADES

Situated at the north end of Williams Stadium, the Liberty Football Center underwent a \$20 million renovation project and reopened in March 2020. Renovations added 18,000 square feet to the building previously known as the Williams Football Operations Center, bringing the total usable space to 65,455 square feet. Highlights of the project include a new locker room, weight room, and recruiting room.

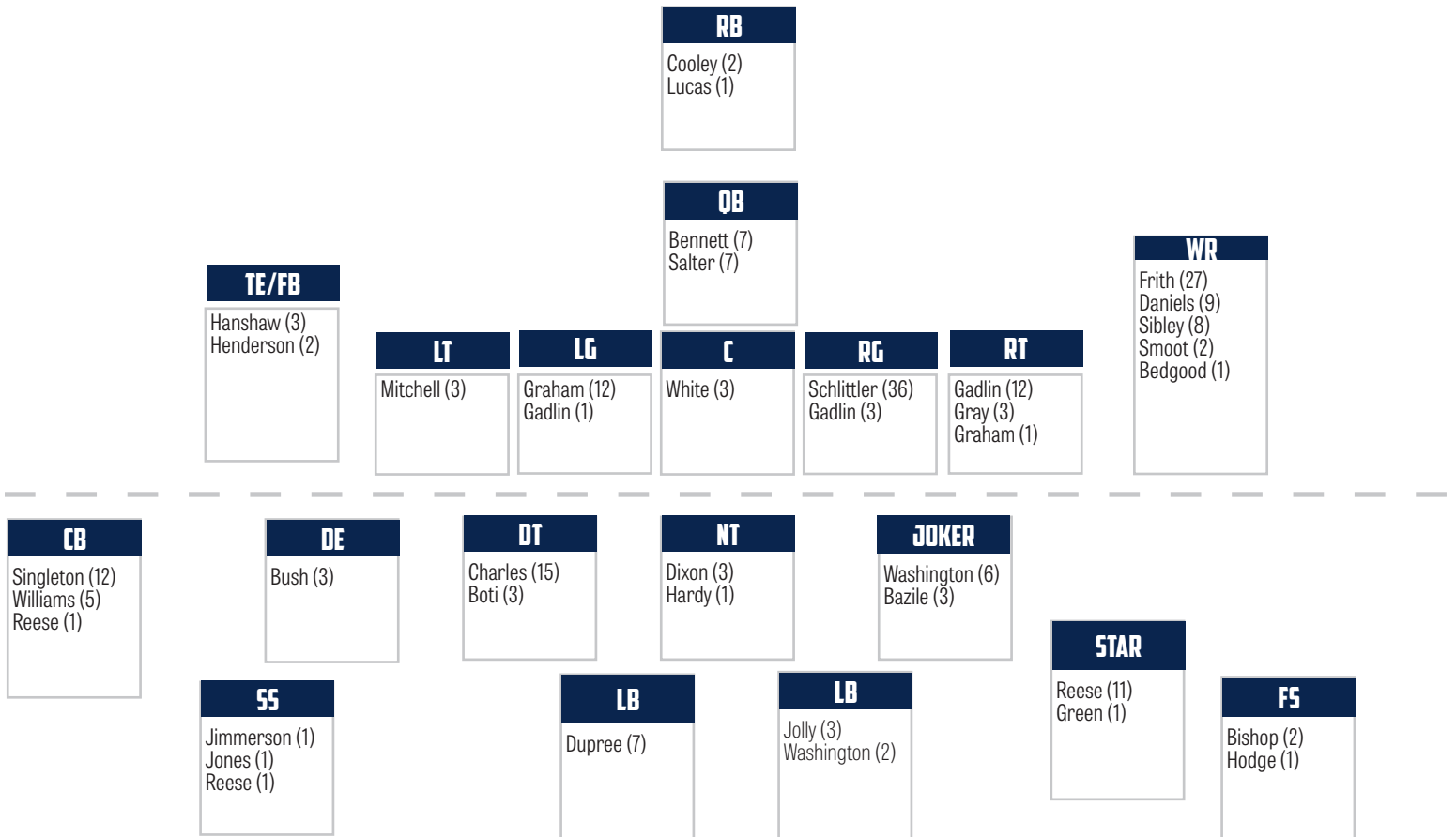
