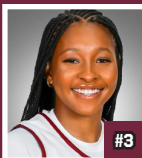

- WFUV joins the Rams in Amherst for the radio feed on YouTube Live with Tucker Austin and Joe Henry calling the action.

**Rams at a Glance**

- After winning four straight games heading out to the West Coast, the Rams (6-5) dropped back-to-back games at the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational last weekend, hosted by Cal, falling to the No. 24 Bears and Xavier.
- Posting consecutive losses for just the first time this season, the Rams went 11 games without allowing 70 points to open the season, and held seven of those teams below 60 points.
- Fordham hasn't allowed more than 56 points scored in any of their six wins on the year, holding LIU to a season-low 43 points on Dec. 8.
- Taylor Donaldson dropped 24 points in back-to-back games in The Golden State, bringing her to an average of 17.8 points per game on the season, the second-best average of any player in the conference and 63rd best in the country.
- Donaldson enters the weekend 12 in the nation in three pointers made per game at 3.11 and 70th in the nation with 28 total made treys. Donaldson also sits 39th in the nation in steals per game at 2.67.
- Irene Murua averaged 10.5 rebounds at the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational and is coming off her second double-double of the season after dropping 17 points and 12 rebounds, all on the offensive end. That offensive rebound total was the most by a Ram since 11 offensive boards by Kyshawn

Ruff against Xavier on Feb. 2, 2003.

**Leading the Herd**

- One of the top players in the A-10 once again this season, Donaldson also leads the league in three pointers made per game (3.11), ranks 10th in three point percentage (34.1), and fourth in steals per game (2.67).
- With the third most shot attempts of any Fordham player Irene Murua has shot an efficient 57.8 from the field, sinking 48-of-83 shots from the floor, to lead the team in addition to her 6.5 rebounds per game.
- Kaila Berry and Karissa Antoine have combined to average 7.8 rebounds per game with 4.0 and 3.8 per game respectively, while seven different Rams are averaging at least 3.0 rebounds per game.
- Taya Davis is dishing out 4.1 assists per game, the sixth best average of any A-10 player, placing 109th in the nation individually.
- Chae Harris has been consistent whether in the starting five or coming off the bench, making six starts while averaging 8.1 points per game and 2.4 rebounds per game.

**Stack 'em Up**

- Fordham has crashed the glass on both ends of the floor, but on the offensive end have pulled down 14.7 rebounds per game, third best in the A-10 and 33rd best in the nation.
- The Fordham defense also ranks 72nd in the nation in rebounding margin at +5.6 and 74th in scoring defense, allowing just 58.2 points per game to opponents.
- Sitting 67th in the nation in turnovers forced per game, the Rams are 4th in the league forcing 19.64 per game, helped in part by also averaging 9.6 steals per game, 92nd best in the nation and fifth best in the A-10.
- Closing out the non-conference calendar with a pair of games in California, Fordham University women's

**Consistency is T-D**

- In 34 of her 36 games played in a Fordham uniform, Taylor Donaldson has tallied at least 10 points, including each of her last eight games.
- Donaldson has recorded 15 games with at least 20 points scored in Maroon and White, with four such games this season, highlighted by a season-high 24 in each of her last two outings.
- Donaldson has also tallied at least one steal in 31 of her 36 games for the Rams, and has picked one or more in every game this season.
- The Newbury Park, Calif. native has never recorded a game without a made three-pointer since joining the Rams last season.

**This is Shooter's Tour**

- An efficient shooter throughout

non-conference play, Irene Murua has made 48-of-83 shots from the field, shooting 57.8% to lead the team.

**Conference Leaders**

- With just two games where she attempted fewer than five shots, Murua has shot 50.0% or better from the field in eight of 11 games played this season
- Sinking 6-of-7 shots for an 85.7% shooting night at Yale on Dec. 4, and tallied 17 points on 8-of-10 shooting last time out against Xavier for her best two performances of the campaign.
- The Maroon and White enter A-10 play already ranked in the top five in the conference in a number of categories, along with multiple Rams sitting amongst the top-10 players in the league individually. (Page 5)

**Murua Magic**

- With the third most shot attempts

of any Fordham player, Murua averaged 10.5 rebounds at the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational

- Coming off her second double-double of the season Murua dropped 17 points and 12 rebounds, all on the offensive end. That offensive rebound total was the most by a Ram since 11 offensive boards by Kyshawn Ruff against Xavier on Feb. 2, 2003.
- Murua's 12 are the most offensive rebounds in a single game currently on record, with complete Fordham game-by-game career records dating back to the 1995-96 season as of the start of the season. Fordham women's basketball began play during the 1970-71 season.
- For the season, Murua has led the Rams with 6.5 rebounds per game, including 3.5 per game on the offensive end.

A Half-Century of Wins

- Fordham's Dec. 4 victory at Yale not only marked the Rams' third in a row at the time, but also the 50th career win for Bridgette Mitchell as a collegiate Head Coach.
- Mitchell's Rams have posted a 14-6 record in games played at the Rose Hill Gym since she took over the reins ahead of last season, including a 4-1 record this year.
- In her first season at the helm of the Fordham program, Coach Mitchell led the Rams to 13 wins, the most wins by a first-year Fordham women's basketball coach since the 1993-94 season.
- Through her first two seasons at the helm, Mitchell has already tallied 19 victories, placing her fifth all-time for a Fordham Head Coach in their first two seasons.

Defensive Dominance

- Heading into league play Fordham has only allowed 60 or more points three times, while holding teams below 59 points in every other game this season, including all five victories.
- Against LIU the Rams allowed just 43 points, the fewest points allowed in a game since holding Saint Peter's to 46 points at the Rose Hill Gym last season.
- Six different Rams are averaging at least 3.0 rebounds per game this season, with Fordham averaging 39.5 per game as a team.
- Four different players are averaging at least 1.0 steals per game, while as a team, Fordham is averaging 9.6 steals per game as a team.

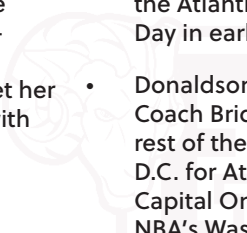
- Following a stretch of three games over the first week of December, the Rams had a 13-day break from play since defeating LIU back on Dec. 8, before two games in California Dec. 21-22.
- The meeting with LIU marked the only home game in December and final appearance at the Rose Hill Gym for Fordham before the ball drops in Times Square, with the Rams' next game at home coming on Jan. 2, 2025 against Richmond in the second game of A-10 play.
- Dec. 8 also marked the lone home game amidst a 40-day stretch for the Rams, last playing at home before that on Nov. 23 in a 90-51 win over Siena.

Calm Before the Storm

- Sunday's meeting with UMass follows a week-long hiatus after two games at the Raising the B.A.R. Invitational in California Dec. 21-22, and will set up Fordham's busiest months of the season, playing eight games in both January and February.
- The Rams will have a tough stretch to open 2025, playing four games over 10 days from Jan. 2-11, hosting defending A-10 champions Richmond to begin the New Year, along with George Washington on Jan. 8, and taking two road trips to Duquesne (Jan. 5) and Loyola Chicago (Jan. 11).

During the Streak

- Over their four wins from Nov. 23-Dec. 8, the Fordham offense lit up the floor, averaging 71.8 points per game, outscoring opponents by an average of 21.0 points per game.
- Shooting 46.2% from the field as a team, the Rams also pulled down 42.3 rebounds per game during the win



- streak, outpacing their opponents by 10.5 rebounds per game.
- Fordham averaged 9.8 steals per game and 4.3 blocks per game on the defensive end over that stretch.
- With a trio of Rams averaging double-figures, Donaldson tallied 15.8 points per game, ahead of Murua at 14.5, and Chae Harris at an even 10.0.
- Six players attempted more than 10 shots over the win streak, while posting a field goal percentage of 50% or better, with Murua leading the way on an efficient 71.9% shooting on 23-of-32 shooting from the field.

**Taya Takeover in New Haven**

- Scoring 23 points in the Dec. 8 victory at Yale, Davis shot 9-of-10 from the floor for an even 90% shooting percentage along with five points from the charity stripe.
- That performance was the highest field goal percentage by a Fordham player (min. 10 FGA) since Tiffany Stokes back in 2009 when she went 11-of-12 from the floor, shooting 91.7% on Nov. 13, 2009 against UAlbany.

- That night also tied a career best for Davis with nine makes from the floor being her most in a game since last season, sinking 9-of-12 shots on Feb. 18, 2023 at St. Bonaventure, when she also set her current career high in points with 25.

**1000-Point Club**

- Part of a 19-point performance in the Rams' Nov. 23 victory over Siena, Taylor Donaldson sank an and-one layup with 2:02 remaining in the first quarter to officially surpass 1,000 points for her collegiate career.
- Scoring 483 points just last season, Donaldson has already tallied 160 points in her second year in Maroon and White, bringing her to 643 points scored at Fordham.
- Donaldson tallied 461 points in her first three seasons at New Mexico State.

**Donaldson Named to First-Team in Preseason Coaches' Poll**

- Coming off her standout season on Rose Hill a year ago, Taylor Donald-

son was named a Preseason First-Team All Conference selection by the Atlantic 10 Conference at Media Day in early October..

- Donaldson and second-year Head Coach Bridgette Mitchell joined the rest of the league in Washington, D.C. for Atlantic 10 Media Day at Capital One Arena, home of the NBA's Washington Wizards.
- Earning Second-Team All-Conference honors to end her first season in the league a year ago, Donaldson also earned All-MET Second Team recognition as well, excelling on both ends of the floor.
- Leading the A-10 in points per game and ranking 56th amongst all Division I players, the Fordham senior paced the Rams' offense averaging 17.9 points per game, ending the year with just under 500 points scored.
- Donaldson excelled particularly from beyond the arc, ranking 12th in the nation in three pointers made per game, sinking an average of 2.65 treys each time on the floor.
- Donaldson would also finish second in the league and 57th in the country with 2.3 steals per game, gathering a team-high 62 steals.

# LEADING THE HERD

In her first season at Fordham, Mitchell coached graduate student Taylor Donaldson, who led the Atlantic 10 Conference in scoring with 483 points and earned A-10 All-Conference Second Team honors. Despite being picked to finish 13th in the preseason poll, the Rams surpassed expectations by finishing 9th and qualifying for the A-10 Conference Tournament. Mitchell's inaugural year in maroon and white concluded with a .444 winning percentage, showcasing her ability to foster improvement and resilience within the team.

Before her arrival at Fordham, Mitchell served as the head coach at Northeastern University from 2021 to 2023. In her second season, she guided the Huskies to a share of their first-ever CAA regular season title, achieving a 13-5 league record after being picked to finish eighth in the preseason poll. This remarkable turnaround included a program-record nine consecutive victories and a total of 19 wins overall. For her efforts, she was recognized as the CAA Coach of the Year. Mitchell's tenure at Northeastern was marked by significant milestones, including a win over Drexel that ended a 17-game losing streak against the Dragons and secured a top-three seed in the CAA Tournament for the first time since 2005-06.

In her inaugural season as a head coach in 2021-22, Mitchell took over a team that was projected to finish last in the conference and led them to a top-half finish. Under her guidance, the Huskies advanced to the Women's Basketball Invitational for only the second time in program history.

Mitchell's coaching career has been characterized by a series of successful stints, including her time as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at the University of Pittsburgh, where she played a key role in attracting top talent to the program. Her earlier coaching experience at James Madison University saw her contribute to a remarkable record of 78-26 over three seasons, resulting in multiple postseason appearances.

A former McDonald's All-American and New Jersey Gatorade Player of the Year, Mitchell enjoyed a stellar playing career at Duke University, where she contributed to a team that recorded an impressive 109-22 record and advanced to the NCAA Tournament four times. # RAMILY MATTERS - MEET THE '24-'25 RAMS

## SHE'S BAAACK

**Taylor Donaldson** stole the show the second she first donned a Fordham uniform, not only leading the Rams, but the entire Atlantic 10 in both points per game and second in the league in steals per game, earning Second Team All-Conference and All-MET honors at season's end. Following her stellar senior campaign, Donaldson elected to return for a fifth season, and will look to lead the Maroon and White once again this year.



Another key member of the Rams' backcourt last season, **Taya Davis** was often Coach Mitchell's first call off the bench when she wasn't in the starting five, utilizing her size to drive the paint and create space for her squad. Davis posted the most assists of any Ram last season, dishing out 3.4 assists per game, along with 3.3 rebounds per game and finished as one of five Rams to average over 1.3 steals for the year.

Posting 3.5 rebounds per game for the Rams last season, **Rose Nelson** provided key height under the basket creating opportunities for her teammates from beyond the arc as well, dishing out 26 assists for an even 1.0 per game.

Always a threat off the ball, **Kaila Berry** looks to make an increased impact on the floor this season, as despite averaging just 6.0 minutes per game over 22 games played, would post 2.0 points per game. She would shoot an efficient 65.4% from the floor, and pulled down 1.5 rebounds per game, splitting her boards evenly with 16 apiece on the offensive and defensive ends.

## NEW RAMS ON THE BLOCK

A rising junior out of Snellville, Ga. **Chaé Harris** arrives on Rose Hill after spending her first two years at Appalachian State. An athletic wing scorer that will provide a key offensive threat for the Rams at the forward spot, Harris averaged 7.6 points and 3.5 rebounds per game last season while averaging just 15 minutes of play.

Listed as a true-center at an even 6'0 tall, **Irene Murua** comes to Rose Hill as a graduate transfer from Detroit Mercy, where she spent the final three seasons of her undergraduate career after playing at LA Tech as a freshman. In just three seasons in Motown, Murua tallied over 1,000 career points, earning a reputation as a true back to the basket center. A career 51% shooter from the floor, she averaged 11.2 points per game and 7.4 rebounds per game a season ago.

Playing at home in The Bronx, **Emma Wilson-Saltos** will join the Rams as a junior transfer out of Monroe College, where she lit up the floor a season ago averaging a double-double with 14.4 points per game, and 11.9 rebounds per game. Scoring nearly 700 points in her two seasons with the Mustangs, she shot 46% over that span, while pulling down 574 rebounds, including more than 350 last season. At 5 '11 Wilson-Santos will provide further depth at the forward and center spots for the Rams, while also helping in the passing lanes, as she collected 99 steals in her two seasons, including 58 a year ago.



## RAMILY MATTERS - MEET THE '24-'25 RAMS

The No. 5 recruit out of South Carolina in the Class of 2023, **Amiyah Ferguson** joins the Rams after spending her rookie campaign at Cal State Northridge, finishing second on the team in scoring. Last season Ferguson would tally over 200 points, averaging 8.78 per game, while also dishing out 60 assists and 25 steals. She would record a career high 21 points, connecting on 6-of-8 three point attempts on the road at UCLA.

### HEY ROOKIES



A well decorated player out of Fayetteville, N.C. **Maya Giles-Jones** finished her high school career as a four-time conference Player of the Year, two-time district Player of the Year, four-time All-State honoree, four-time All-District First Team selection, and 910 Female Player of the Year as a sophomore. She wrapped a decorated high school career at Terry Sanford, culminating in being a McDonald's All-American nominee, entering the 2024-25 campaign as a redshirt freshman after missing last season rehabbing from an injury.

Crossing the pond from London, England, **Precious Omoshola** played her high school ball at two schools, first for Riverside Sixthform in Barking, UK, where she won a London Basketball Association (LBA) MVP and Gold in 2022. A 6'3" forward, Omoshola set her career-high with an impressive 69-point performance during the 2021 campaign, Omoshola spent the spring semester at Fordham, and represented her native Great Britain on the U-20 National Team at the FIBA Women's EuroBasket this summer.

An Under Armour Future 60 Selection, **Karissa Antoine** comes to Fordham from just north of the Empire State capital in Pattersonville, following a successful high school career that saw her play all four seasons on the varsity squad for the Schalmont Sabers. Antoine will be chasing the school's all-time points record of 2,023 points as she enters her senior campaign, currently sitting with 1,398 career points in her first three seasons. Winning a Varsity Women's Basketball State Championship during her tenure, Antoine was a three-time Class B All-Star selection, tallying over 1000 points in her career.

A 5'7" combo guard out of Kissimmee, Fla., **Camila De Pool** will join the Rams next season as a true freshman, known for her ability to drive and attack the basket on offense. Despite coming to the Big Apple as a freshman, De Pool has honed her game down in Puerto Rico, where she was born, and currently plays with the Puerto Rican National Team, where she has averaged 9.0 points per game, 3.0 rebounds per game, and 1.0 assists per game, and featured on the U-18 PR squad for the 2024 FIBA AmeriCup last summer.

Bringing more international talent to the Rams' lineup next season, **Anastasija Veljovic** checks in with some height at the guard spot, at 5'11" from Mississauga, ON, Canada. She arrives in the Five Boroughs as a two time selection to the BioSteel All-Canadian Games where she featured in the Nike Next Ones Up regional game, which features some of the top Canadian high school basketball players. Veljovic was Ontario Scholastic Basketball Association (OSBA) second team honoree following the 2021-22 campaign, and was a team MVP for her high school team, and a JUEL MVP with Monarchs Basketball
