Saint Francis battles conference foe Monmouth Saturday at DeGol Field kickoff is set for 1p.m.

FLASH FACTS

- Kyle Harbridge ranks second nationally in rushing despite going up against four of the Top 56 rush defense in the nation this season including the No. 11 ranked rush defense North Dakota State. Harbridge also ranks 24th nationally in scoring and fourth in all-purpose yards. Harbridge's 72 points are the third most in a single season by a member of the Red Flash. He is also just 103-yards away from setting the school single season rushing record. Harbridge leads the Northeast Conference in rushing over the past two weeks.

- Mike Dennis picked off the first pass of his career Saturday against CCSU. Jake

DeMedal caused a turnover for the third consecutive game as the defense allowed a season low 13 points.

- Anthony Bowman posted double-digit tackles for the eighth consecutive game Saturday making 13 stops against CCSU while also picking up a quarterback hurry. With two games to play Bowman sits just 21 tackles away from the SFU school

record. Bowman leads the FCS in total tackles and tackles per game averaging 13.44 stops a game. Only Luke Kuechly of Boston College (130) has more total tackles than the SFU sophomore at the DI level.

- Timmy Myers record a season high 14 tackles against CCSU.

- Jake DeMedal and Paul Print both picked up sacks for the Red Flash against CCSU after SFU enter the game with just six total sacks on the season.

- Thiel matched a career and school record long Saturday of 45-yards in near whiteout conditions against CCSU.

- The Red Flash will honor their nine outgoing seniors Saturday against Monmouth. The contest will also serve as the homecoming contest for the Flash.

SAINT FRANCIS VS MONMOUTH

Saint Francis and Monmouth have played each season since 1993 but since winning the first match up with the Hawks 25-14, the Red Flash hold a record of 1-16 against Monmouth. SFU last defeated the Hawks in 2005, both of the Flashes wins against the Hawks have come at home.

In 2010, Saint Francis fell to Monmouth 19-7, the Hawks posted the first 16 points of the game including 16 in the second quarter to earn the win. Eric Spillane connected on field goals of 46 and

18-yards while Sloan El and Mike Roeder provided the touchdowns. Omar Winston scored the Flashes only touchdown on a 10-yards pass from John Kelly with 2:06 left in the fourth quarter. Kyle Harbridge missed the 2010 meeting between the Hawks and the Flash due to injury. John Kelly posted 69 passing yards and 45 rushing yards. Anthony Howze led the team in receiving with 5 grabs for 43-yards.

The last time the two teams met in Loretto, Monmouth picked up a 24-10 win. In the 2009 meeting, freshman Kyle Harbridge rushed for 88-yards on just nine carries while John Kelly went 12-of-19 passing for 142-yards with one interception. Harbridge also racked up 113 yards on kickoff returns including a 59-yard return against the Hawks.

HARD RUNNING HARBRIDGE

Kyle Harbridge ranks as one of the top runners in the Football Championship Subdivision this season. The junior from Easton, Pa. has racked up 1,041 yards on the ground this season and averages 130.1 yards on the ground per-game.

Earlier this season, Harbridge totaled 346 yards on ground against Morehead State the fifth-highest total in FCS history. Harbridge also posted 457 all-purpose yards missing the FCS record by just 10 yards. The junior tailback also posted five touchdowns in the game to total more points than any other player in the FCS in the last four seasons.

Running plays are not the place, Harbridge ranks up yards. He also returns kick for the Red Flash and along with AJ Alexander form the most dangerous return duo in the NEC. Harbridge has totaled 290 return yards this season and averages 26.4 yards per return showing why PhilSteele.com named him a preseason all-conference returner. Both Alexander and Harbridge average over 22-yards per return and have two or more returns this season of 40 yards or more.

DENNIS NAMED NEC ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

Mike Dennis of the Saint Francis University football team earned Northeast Conference Rookie of the Week honors the league office announced, Monday.

Dennis earned the start at cornerback for a young SFU secondary that shut down Central Connecticut in a 27-13 win. In addition to making two tackles in a victory that snapped Saint Francis' five-game slide, the rookie cornerback picked off a pass and broke up another as part of an effort that limited CCSU to 81 yards through the air and a 34.7 completion percentage. His first career interception came late in the first quarter and put the Flash in prime position to score their third touchdown of the game to take a 21-0 lead. He broke up a third-down pass attempt in the second quarter, forcing the Blue Devils into a to punt.

THE TACKLE MACHAINE

Anthony Bowman leads SFU in tackles this season with 121, tackles for loss with six and half while also sitting second on the team in sacks with two. Bowman has recorded nine or more tackles in each game this season and has reached double-digit stops in the past seven games.

Bowman's 108 stops are the most by anyone in the Northeast Conference this season by a wide margin as no other player in the conference has more than 82. Bowman ranks first nationally in tackles per-game and first in total tackles. He also ranks as the only underclassmen in the nation averaging more than 12 or more stops per-game.

In addition to his tackles Bowman also has two quarterback hurries and a forced

fumble on the season.

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

AJ Alexander continues to impress in his first season with the Red Flash. Junior wide out, a transfer from Florida State, ranks second on the Red Flash in receiving with 343 yards on 19 catches.

Alexander posted career-high numbers against Youngstown State with 124 yards receiving including making two catches for 40-yards or more. Alexander also made his second catch of the season for more than 65-yards against YSU.

The Altoona, Pa. native has also shown multiple methods to hurt opposing defenses as he has racked up 25 yards on the ground on seven carries. Alexander started the Albany game at quarterback in a "wild cat" formation.

The return game has also been an impact spot for Alexander, who leads the team with 478 total kickoff return yards and is averaging 22.8-yards per kick return

ALL PURPOSE ATTACK

Kyle Harbridge and AJ Alexander ranks as two of the top players in the Northeast Conference when it comes to all-purpose yards. Harbridge ranks second in the NEC in all-purpose yardage per-game averaging 183.8 per-game. Alexander ranks seventh in the league in all-purpose yardage averaging 115.9 yards per-game.

ODD NOTES AND STATS

- Saint Francis and Monmouth enter Saturday's game ranked in the top four in the conference in time of possession, of the top four teams in the NEC in time of possession Monmouth is the only one without a losing record.

- Saint Francis leads the Northeast Conference in kickoff coverage averaging 37.3 yards of net kick average per game. Kevin Wood ranks second in the NEC kickoff average with a mark of 57.8. Monmouth ranks eighth in kick coverage with a 34.8 net average.

- Monmouth leads the conference in red zone defense allowing teams to score just 70.8 percent of the time inside the 20. Saint Francis brings in the fourth-best red zone offense in the NEC scoring 85.2 percent of the team they get into the red zone.

- The Hawks have allowed the second fewest first downs in the NEC this season while Saint Francis has ranked up the third most first downs in the league.

- Anthony Bowman leads the FCS in total tackles this season with 121, while the top two tacklers for MU, Dan Sullivan and Jose Gumbs have combined for just 108 tackles this season.

- Saint Francis and Monmouth enter Saturday's game, tied for second in the NEC in forced turnover both having gained 18 on the season. Monmouth's also ranks third in the league in lost turnovers while SFU leads the conference in giveaways with 22.

- Kyle Harbridge enter's Saturday's game with 1,228-yards rushing while as a team Monmouth has just 1,320 yards on the ground this season.

- Monmouth has just six passing touchdown on the season while the Flash have 10 total passing touchdown this season while John Kelly has eight by himself.

THE YOUNG SAINT FRANCIS SECONDARY

The Saint Francis secondary feature a plethora of young players featured in its secondary. Combined the SFU underclassmen in the secondary have seven interceptions, three forced-fumbles and a

field goal block.

Jake DeMedal leads the young secondary with 64 tackles, two interceptions, 3.0 tackles for loss, seven pass breakups and two forced fumbles. The sophomore strong safety is not the only safety making plays as freshman free safety Austin Miele ranks third on the team in tackles with 50. Miele also leads the team in interceptions with three, has a fumble recovering and four pass breakups.

Calvin Bain ranks second on the team in interceptions with two, while also recording 28 tackles and three pass break ups. Mike Dennis added to team's interception total with his first career pick against CCSU.

Saturday afternoon.

Kyle Harbridge (Easton, Pa./Easton Area) rushed for 187-yards and two touchdowns as the Red Flash (2-7, 1-5) knocked of the Blue Devils (2-7, 1-5), the preseason conference favorite, for the first time since 2005. On a day that featured several inches of snow and near whiteout conditions, Saint Francis posted 304-rushing yards and threw the ball just five times.

Saint Francis came out of the gates quickly scoring on its opening drive of the game going six plays and 61-yards. Harbridge found the endzone for the first time in the game with a run from 10-yards out. After SFU force the Blue

Devils into a three-and-out, the Flash once again marched down the field using the run-game. SFU ran the ball on its first 17 plays of the game but it was the passing that found the endzone for the Flash. John Kelly (Frederick, Md./Tuscarora) used a great play action fake to draw in the CCSU defense opening things up for a pass over the top to Ryan Zarnich (Rochester, Pa./Rochester Area), who scampered 32-yards for the second Red Flash touchdown of the game.

The Red Flash were once again on the move when the first quarter came to a close but CCSU appeared to have stopped the Red Flash on the one-yard line but head coach Chris Villarrial gambled and went for it on fourth-down. Harbridge made the gamble pay off with his second rushing touchdown of the game and pushing the SFU lead to 21-0. After both defenses stiffed up it appeared the Flash would take their 21-point advantage into halftime. However late in the half, SFU used some solid runs to get Josh Thiel (Leesburg, Va./Heritage) in position for a long field goal. The junior split the upright from 45-yards matching his personal-best and the school record, to give SFU a 24-0 halftime lead.

HEAD COACH CHRIS VILLARRIAL

Former National Football League All-Pro Offensive Lineman Chris Villarrial was named the 25th head coach of the Saint Francis University football program on December 20, 2009. After serving one year as the offensive coordinator under predecessor Dave Opfar, Villarrial will continue to bring his years of knowledge and experience to the Red Flash.

In his first full season with the Red Flash, Villarrial guided his team to a 1-10 overall record and a 1-7 mark in Northeast Conference play. With the largest home crowd since 2007 on hand, Villarrial's football squad captured its lone victory of the season in impressive, dominating fashion. In front of a national television audience, the Red Flash defeated conference foe Sacred Heart 41-0, which is tied for the largest margin of victory since 1971 and just the second shutout win for the Red Flash in 14 seasons. During the game, Saint Francis set a program record for interceptions in a game by pulling in seven. Additionally, two players under Villarrial's direction were named All-NEC and four were selected to this year's preseason PhilSteel.com All-Northeast team.

During his first season in Loretto prior to being named head coach, Villarrial designed and implemented a successful West Coast Offense that saw the Red Flash improve from 11.4 ppg in 2008 to 15.6 ppg in 2009, against the toughest schedule in school history. Saint Francis also averaged over 100 rushing yards per game (115.9) after averaging just 70.1 rushing yards per game in 2008. Villarrial had two players – senior offensive lineman Cody Kekipi (Waimanalo, Hawaii / Punahou) and senior wide receiver Antoine Rivera (Willingboro, N.J. / Willingboro) – named to the all-Northeast Conference first or second team. He also oversaw the development of freshman running back/kick return specialist Kyle Harbridge (Easton, Pa. / Easton Area), who was a finalist for Northeast Conference Offensive Rookie-of-the-Year honors after leading the team in all-purpose yardage (103.9 yards per game), which was good for seventh in the Northeast Conference.

Also during his first season in Loretto, Villarrial helped the Red Flash to an improved record after a winless season in 2008, and guided the Red Flash to the second-best single-game rushing total in school history, a 427-yard performance in a victory over in-state Northeast Conference rival Duquesne.

A native of Hershey, Pa., Villarrial spent 11 seasons in the NFL as an offensive lineman with the Chicago Bears (1996-2004) and the Buffalo Bills (2004-06).

Villarrial made an impression on NFL scouts prior by breaking the NFL Combine Bench Press Record, and was then drafted in the fifth round (152nd overall) by current Pittsburgh Panthers head coach Dave Wannstedt in April of 1996. As a member of the Chicago Bears from 1996-2004, Villarrial played six seasons under head coach Dick Jauron, and was a two-year All-Pro player, a member of the All-Madden Team, and a four-year Pro Bowl alternate. He paved the way for a 1000-yard rusher every season, blocked for Anthony Thomas, who was the NFL Offensive Rookie-of-the-Year in 2001, and was a member of an offensive line that gave up the fewest sacks in the NFL in 2001, when the Bears advanced to the NFC Divisional Playoff Game. He also received the Golden Bear Award, which is given to the rookie who has perfect attendance in the weight room.

Villarrial was one of the most sought out free agents in Buffalo Bills history for head coach Mike Mularkey, and continued his streak of 1,000-yard rushers every season with the Bills. He was a member of an offensive line that gave up the fewest sacks in franchise history. Villarrial, who also played two seasons in Buffalo under coach Jauron, finished his NFL career with 148 starts.

Following his professional career, Villarrial returned to Ebensburg, where he served two seasons as the offensive coordinator for the Central Cambria High School football team. He led the team to two district title games, and personally helped 13 players continue their playing careers at the collegiate level, while developing and implementing a successful strength and conditioning program.

Villarrial, who has been active in the community with Special Olympics and cancer research funding, played his collegiate football for head coach Frank Cignetti at Indiana University of Pennsylvania, where he studied Special Education, with a concentration in rehabilitation. While playing for IUP, Villarrial was a three-year All-American and three-year all-conference player. He played in the 1993 Division II national championship game, and received the Jim Langer Award for Best Lineman in Division II in 1996. Villarrial had his college jersey No. 75 retired by IUP.

Villarrial is a 1991 graduate of Hershey High School, where he played for head coach Bob "Gump" May. Hershey retired Villarrial's high school jersey No. 78 on May 5, 2001.

2011 COORDINATORS

ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH/SPECIAL TEAMS- A.J. ANDERSON

A.J. Anderson returns for his ninth season as a member of the Red Flash coaching staff. The most tenured member of the staff, Anderson serves as the team's associate head coach. He will also act as the team's director of football operations. Under Anderson's direction last season, senior linebackers Scott Lewis and Matthew Parker earned All-NEC honors. With his team leading 138 tackles last season, Lewis became the Northeast Conference's all-time leader in tackles with 524. Both Lewis and Parker tied for the team lead in tackles for loss with 13.5. Parker led the team with seven total sacks, as the Red Flash posted a 13-sack season. Prior to working with the defensive line, Anderson headed the linebackers, who had a breakout season in 2006.



OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR - RALPH DEL SARDO

Ralph Del Sardo returns for his fifth consecutive season and sixth overall as a member of the Red Flash coaching staff, and his second as the team's offensive coordinator. After spending one season at his alma mater, Morehead State, Del Sardo spent three seasons as the quarterbacks coach and passing game coordinator for the Red Flash. Under Del Sardo in 2010, the Red Flash averaged 16.1 points per game and picked up 146 first downs. Saint Francis put up 2,505 yards of combined total offense last season, 1,147 on the ground and 1,358 through the air. Scoring wise, Del Sardo led his offense to 23 touchdowns, 11 rushing and 12 passing. The offense's most productive game came at then-No. 20 Cal Poly where they put up 373 yards of total offense, 131 rushing and 242 passing.

DEFENSIVE COORDINATOR - JAKE NULPH

Jake Nulph enters his second season as a member of the Red Flash coaching staff. Nulph serves as the defensive coordinator and linebackers coach. Under Nulph's direction last season, senior linebackers Scott Lewis and Matthew Parker earned All-NEC honors. With his team leading 138 tackles last season, Lewis became the Northeast Conference's all-time leader in tackles with 524. Both Lewis and Parker tied for the team lead in tackles for loss with 13.5. Parker led the team with seven total sacks, as the Red Flash posted a 13-sack season. Before coming to Loretto, Nulph spent one season as the defensive backs coach at Allegheny College. Under Nulph in 2009, Allegheny's defense helped turn around a 5-5 team in 2008 to an 8-2 season in 2009. The Gators forced 20 turnovers in 2009 and recorded 29 sacks, averaging nearly three a game.
