TODAY AT DEGOL FIELD

The Bryant University football team returns to Northeast Conference as it travels to western Pennsylvania to take on Saint Francis U. It will be the first of two trips in a three-week span to western PA for the Bulldogs.

LAST TIME OUT

Bryant built a 21-0 lead with 42 seconds left in the second quarter but Maine outscored the Bulldogs 35-10 over the final 30 minutes, defeating Bryant 35-31 on October 1. It marked the second time this season the Bulldogs have built a 21-point first-half lead only to lose.

Senior QB Dalton Easton finished 27-of-53 for 318 yards and four touchdowns, tying him with Charlies Granatell for the most TD passes in school history with 56. Junior WR Matt Sewall finished the day with seven catches for 89 yards and a program record-tying three touchdowns. He hauled in two TDs in Bryant's 21-point first half and then put Bryant up 31-14 with his third TD reception in the third quarter. Freshman LB Jesse Nemerowicz finished the game with 14 tackles and the Bryant defense intercepted three passes.

Bryant forced a punt or a turnover on Maine's first seven drives before the Black Bears were able to score on five-straight drives. The Bulldogs finished the game with just 35 yards rushing on 25 attempts.

SCOUTING THE RED FLASH

Saint Francis is one of the top teams in the NEC this year and was picked to finish third in the preseason poll, the highest selection in school history. The Red Flash played each of their first four games of the season on the road, losing close games to Montana and No. 22 Albany.

All eyes are on preseason All-American KR/S Lorenzo Jerome who leads all active FCS players in non-offensive touchdowns and has 18 career interceptions. He currently ranks 5th nationally in kick return yards and has six interceptions this season. Solomon Leano is the leader of the defense and has posted 51 tackles and a league-leading six sacks this season.

On offense, senior Zack Drayer is in his third year as the starting QB. He has completed 86-149 passes for 1,151 yards, five interceptions and nine TDs. The Red Flash also rely on the legs of Marcus Bagley who has rushed for 582 yards and ranks 14th nationally. Kamron Lewis leads the team and the NEC with 590 receiving yards.

INSIDE THE SERIES

Bryant and Saint Francis U. will be meeting for the ninth time this afternoon. The Bulldogs own a 6-2 lead in the all-time series and have won each of the last two outings. Last year, Bryant raced out to a 26-3 lead in the third quarter but had to hold off a furious Red Flash rally. SFU scored with 1:31 left in the game but Charles Keenan broke up a potential game-tying two-point conversion.

BRYANT BUILDS

Bryant Builds is the largest and most transformative facilities initiative in Bryant history, adding more than 250,000 square feet both at the Smithfield campus and in Zhuhai, China.

The dramatic new facilities for the next generation of innovative leaders are made possible by more than \$15 million in leadership gifts to Bryant's capital campaign, Expanding the World of Opportunity: The Campaign for Bryant's Bold Future. Bryant has already raised more than \$46 million toward the \$75-million campaign goal, the largest fundraising effort in the University's history.

Under the leadership of University President Ronald K. Machtley, the historic Bryant Builds initiatives include:

- A new entrance, integrated landscape, and point of arrival;
- A 50,000-square-foot Academic Innovation Center to open in fall 2016;
- A Bulldog Strength and Conditioning Center completed in summer 2015;
- A 78,000-square-foot Indoor Practice Facility featuring a state-of-the-art indoor turf field with a full 100 yards of turf;
- Enhancements to the Elizabeth and Malcolm Chace Wellness and Athletic Center, including a Sports Medicine and Training Center;
- Bryant University Zhuhai, a joint venture with Beijing Institute of Technology Zhuhai campus. Bryant's Chinese partners have invested 100 percent of the capital for this project.

INTERVIEW POLICIES

Postgame Interviews: Bryant University locker rooms are closed to all media. A 10-minute cooling off period will be strictly enforced, after which the Bryant head coach and requested players will be made available to the media. Postgame interviews will be conducted outside each team's respective locker room. Requests for visiting coaches and players should be made through the opponent's sports information contact.

Player/Coach Interview Policy: Interviews other than those immediately following a contest must be requested and arranged through a member of the Bryant University athletic communications staff. Interviews will be arranged by the athletic communication staff at a time that will not interfere with the student-athlete's academic schedule. Requests should be made at least one day in advance to allow proper notification to the player or coach. At no time will the home or cell phone number of a coach or player be released to the media. In the case of telephone interview requests, arrangements will be made for the student-athlete to contact the requesting media member.

MEDIA POLICIES

Working Press Credentials: Press and photographer media credentials will be issued to members of the working media only. Credentials for all Bryant home games can be obtained by contacting the Athletic Communications Office in writing or by telephone. Credentials will be left at will call. Press pass requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to a home contest to ensure space availability.

Press Box: Only credentialed members of the media, coaches, league officials and designated administrators will be allowed in the press box area. The Bryant Athletic Communications Office will provide a game program, current press release, pregame statistics and game notes prior to each contest. A full boxscore, play-by-play, drive chart and other applicable game material will be distributed at halftime and at the end of the game.

Media Work Room: Ample work space with power outlets, telephones and internet access will be available for media members who need to file postgame reports. For men's and women's basketball contests, the Bulldog Room, located on the second floor of the Chace Athletic Center, will serve as a media workroom and postgame interview location.

Radio: Radio stations planning to broadcast Bryant home contests must make arrangements with the Athletic Communications Office at least two weeks prior to the requested game. Telephone lines will be supplied by the university, provided the requested notice is given. All calls must be made either on a collect or calling card basis.

BULLDOGS AGAINST THE NORTHEAST CONFERENCE

- Bryant has found great success since joining the NEC in 2009. Now in their eighth full season, the Bulldogs have posted a 28-23 record against league opponents. The 28 wins are the tied with Duquesne and Wagner for the most since 2009.
- The Bulldogs are now 5-3 in NEC openers since the beginning of the 2009 season.

WELCOME TO BEIRNE STADIUM

- Bulldog Stadium officially became the David M. '85 and Terry Beirne Stadium Complex on Saturday, Sept. 24 in a pregame ceremony.

BULLDOGS ON THE ROAD

- Bryant has struggled on the road since the start of the 2013 season, posting a 7-12 record in that span. The Bulldogs are a combined 2-7 the last two years.
- Four of Bryant's final six games are on the road.

CLOSE GAMES

- With their four-point loss in week 5, the Bulldogs are now 10-18 in games decided by one touchdown or less since the start of 2013.
- Further, Bryant has gone 3-8 in road games that have been decided by a touchdown or less.

TURNOVER TROUBLES

- The Bulldogs have turned the ball over 10 times this season, including a season-high 5 times in week 2.
- In week 5, Bryant intercepted three passes but lost for just the second time in four years when forcing 3+ turnovers.

THIRD DOWN CONVERSIONS

- Bryant went 9-for-14 on third downs in week 4 against Central Connecticut. It was Bryant's best mark since going 8-for-14 last September against Coastal Carolina.
- The Bulldogs lead the NEC and rank 26th nationally with a .433 (29-67) conversion rate on 3rd downs.

STINGY IN THE FIRST QUARTER

- The Bulldog defense has yet to allow a touchdown in the first quarter through five games. Bryant has allowed just a pair of field goals in the opening 15 minutes, outscoring opponents 53-6.

EASTON OFF TO STRONG START

- Senior QB Dalton Easton has completed 109-of-193 passes for 1,456 yards, 14 touchdowns and eight interceptions. Easton is averaging 291.4 yards per game and has a 56.5 completion percentage.
- He opened his senior season by going 13-for-20 for 223 yards, four touchdowns and no interceptions against Merrimack.
- He has posted 4 TDs or more in a game five times and the has completed 60+ percent of his passes and not thrown an interception seven times.
- In week 2, he set the single-game school record with 368 passing yards against Montana State, completing 26-of-44 passes.
- He set career-highs in completions (27) and attempts (53) in week 5. He threw for 318 yards and 4 TDs.
- He has thrown for 220+ yards in all five games this season and 13 of his last 16 games dating back to 2015.

EASTON SURPASSES 6,000 YARDS, TIES PROGRAM TD RECORD

- Easton became just the second QB in school history to throw for over 6,000 yards in a career and tie the program record for TD passes during week 5. In two-plus seasons, Easton has thrown for 6,064 yards, joining Charlie Granatell as the only QBs in school history to do so.
- Easton's 56 career TD passes also tied Granatell's program record that has stood since 2007.

WELCOME BACK DALTON

- Dalton Easton returns for his third season as the starting QB for the Bulldogs this fall. He has posted a 15-11 record as a starter 26 career starts. His string of 26-straight starts was snapped in week 5 at Maine.
- Easton is the first three-year starting QB for the Bulldogs since Mike Croce (2009-11).



300+ PASSING YARDS

- Easton threw for 300+ yards in a game for the 6th time in his career in week 5. Bryant is 3-3 when he does.
- It also marked the 17th time in 27 career games that Easton has thrown for over 200 yards (see right).

BARTHELETTE POSTS BACK-TO-BACK 100-YARD RECEIVING GAMES

- Senior WR Taylor Barthelette posted back-to-back 100-yard receiving games to open the season.
- He posted his first-career 100-yard receiving game in week 1, catching seven passes for 109 yards and three TDs. In week 2, he caught a career-high eight passes for a career-high 161 yards and a TD.
- He is just the seventh player in school history to post a 100-yard game (see right) and the first not named Jordan Harris or Chad Ward to do so since Matt Tracey in 2010.
- The three TDs also tied a program record last accomplished by Harris in 2013 against Sacred Heart.
- Barthelette also became the first WR in school history to open a season with back-to-back 100-yard games and the first receiver since Harris (6, 2012-13) to post back-to-back 100-yard games at any point.

SEWALL REGISTERS FIRST-CAREER 100-YARD RECEIVING GAME

- Junior WR Matt Sewall set career highs in receptions (8) and receiving yards (114) in week 3 vs. Brown. The 100-yard receiving game is the first of his career and he is just the eighth in program history to do so.
- He is currently second on the team with 19 catches for 243 yards and four TDs.

100-YARD RECEIVERS

- Sewall became the second different Bryant receiver to post a 100-yard game this season, joining Taylor Barthelette. It is the first time in program history that two different players have recorded 100-yard receiving games in the same season.

SEWALL HAS BIG DAY AT MAINE

- Sewall caught seven passes for 89 yards and three TDs in week 5 at Maine. His three TD receptions are a career-high and tie the single-game program record. Sewall is just the fourth player to have 3 in a game.
- In addition, Sewall also led the team in rushing with three carries for 19 yards. He is the first receiver in program history to lead the team in receiving and rushing in the same game.

THOMPSON HAULS IN THIRD TD

- Senior WR Keenan Thompson caught his third TD pass of the season in week 5, tying his career-high for TD receptions in a season. He has caught a TD in each of the last two games.
- Thompson had just one catch in 2015 due to injury but already has 10 for 172 yards this season.

BLACK POSTS SECOND-CAREER 100-YARD GAME

- Senior RB Ryan Black posted the second 100-yard game of his career in week 4, rushing for 128 yards on a career-high 27 carries.
- It was his first 100-yard game since Oct. 12, 2013 when he rushed for 137 yards, a span of 31 games.
- He is now averaging 3.6 yards per carry and 40.2 yards per game.

LAZO BLOCKS TWO FIELD GOALS IN WEEK 3

- Sophomore DL Kevin Lazo posted a career-high five tackles and also blocking two field goals in week 3. He blocked a 40-yard attempt in the first quarter and the Bulldogs picked it up and returned it for a touchdown.
- Lazo was named the NEC Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts.

NEMEROWICZ OFF TO OUTSTANDING START, POSTS 14 TACKLES AT MAINE

- True freshman LB Jesse Nemerowicz has started all five games and leads the Bulldogs with 37 tackles.
- He posted a season-high 14 tackles in week 5 at Maine, the most tackles by a freshman in program history.
- The 14 tackles were the most by any Bryant player since Max Machado made 14 at SFU in 2012.

THE CALIFORNIA KID

- Senior LB Patrick Kenney became the 10th player in program history to record 200 career tackles in week 1
- Kenney is eighth all-time with 216 career stops.
- He snapped a string of 37-straight appearances in week 4, missing the first game of his career.

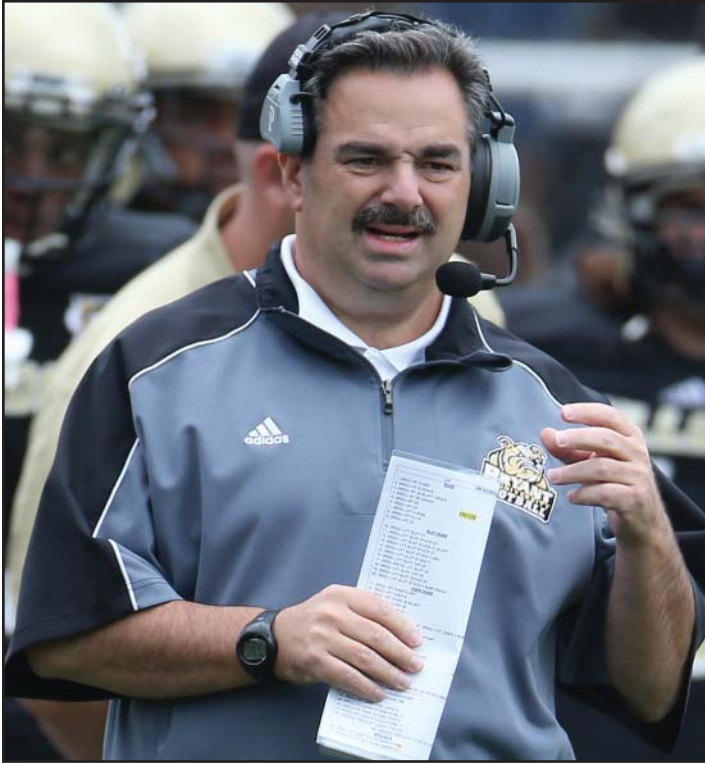

FINE'S CAREER HIGHLIGHTS

- Enters this weekend with 99 career victories and 77 victories at Bryant.
- Has posted seven winning seasons at Bryant and three 8-win seasons.
- Has coached 70 all-conference players and four All-Americans.
