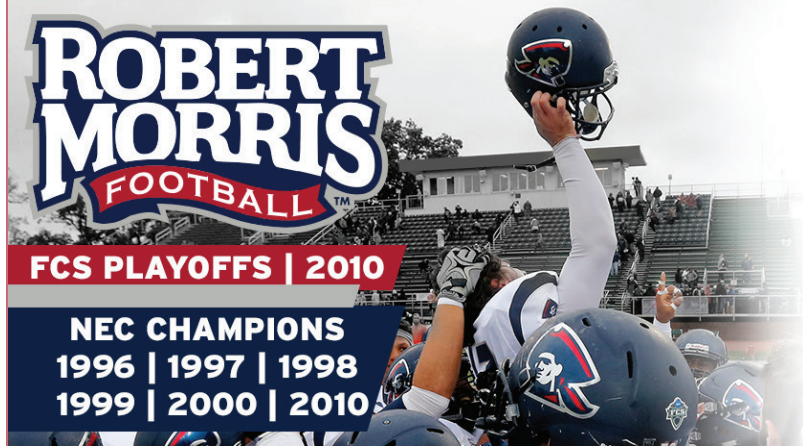

CAPSULE

The Robert Morris University football team invites Saint Francis University to Joe Walton Stadium for Homecoming this Saturday, Oct. 8, with kickoff slated for 3:00 p.m. The game will be available on ESPN3. The Colonials finished the non-conference slate at 1-4 notching a win over Malone. The Red Flash are 2-3 with losses against top-25 teams Montana and Albany. They are coming off a 52-10 win against Malone.

VS. SAINT FRANCIS U

- ▶ The Colonials lead the series, 15-6-1
- ▶ RMU is 8-2 at home against SFU
- ▶ The Red Flash have won the last four games
- ▶ One of three teams (CCSU, Wagner) that RMU has played 22 times

ABOUT THE RED FLASH

- ▶ Saint Francis enters the game with a 2-3 record
- ▶ They won at Columbia (13-9) and home against Malone (52-10)
- ▶ Losses came at #13 Montana and #22 Albany along with a loss at Towson
- ▶ Offensively, average 369.4 yards, 169.2 on the ground and 200.2 through the air
- ▶ Defensively, allow 338.6 yards with 133.4 rushing and 205.2 passing
- ▶ Have forced 12 turnovers
- ▶ QB Zack Drayer is 76-129 for 1,001 yards and has seven TDs and five interceptions
- ▶ RB Marcus Bagley leads team at 120.0 y/g
- ▶ 14 players have caught passes
- ▶ WR Kamron Lewis has 30 receptions and averages 108.6 y/g and 18.1 y/rec.
- ▶ LB Solomon Leaeno leads team in tackles (40), sacks (4.0) and fumble recoveries (3)
- ▶ FS Lorenzo Jerome has 36 tackles and four interceptions



WHO WAS ROBERT MORRIS?

The "Financier of the American Revolution," he isn't as famous as his friend George Washington, but without Robert Morris, the American colonies' bold attempt to throw off British rule never could have succeeded.

Born in 1734 in Liverpool, England, Robert Morris sailed to the United States with his father when he was 14 years old. Morris became a partner at the import-export firm of Willing & Morris where he made his millions. After, he became the

spokesman for opposition to the Stamp Act, smuggled arms for the new American army and navy, signed the Declaration of Independence, secured financing — often using his personal credit — to fight the Revolutionary War and served as a Pennsylvania state senator. He died in Philadelphia on May 8, 1806.

- ▶ RB Dante Satcher leads the nation in kickoff return average (43.0)
- ▶ The Colonials 29.91 yard kickoff return average is second in the nation
- ▶ RMU is 9th in the nation in red zone defense at 66.7% (allowed 14 scores on 21 trips)
- ▶ Defense is 20th nationally with 2.8 sacks/game
- ▶ RMU is 13th nationally in punt return def. (2.63)
- ▶ 14.36 yard punt return average puts RMU 20th in the nation

- ▶ Dante Satcher opened the season with a school-record 99-yard kickoff return
- ▶ On offense in week one, nine players, including six freshman, made their first career start
- ▶ RMU was picked sixth in the 2016 NEC Football Coaches Preseason Poll
- ▶ Sophomore WR Kyle Buss was a Preseason All-NEC First Team selection
- ▶ Seniors Marcellis Branch (DB) and Andy Smigiera (DB) were Preseason All-NEC picks on defense
- ▶ Head coach John Banaszak boasts a 43-40 career record in six seasons, 5-21 in his third season at RMU

- ▶ The trio brings the total number of football members in the Hall of Fame to 17

CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

- ▶ Senior DB Andy Smigiera was named a semifinalist for the National Football Foundation William V. Campbell Trophy
- ▶ The award is given to the best football player in the country for academic success, football performance and community service
- ▶ He is a Preseason All-NEC Selection
- ▶ Smigiera was a CoSIDA Academica All-District pick last season

WEATHER DELAY, PART DEUX

- ▶ Lightning in the Youngstown area forced RMU into a weather delay for the second consecutive game
- ▶ The YSU delay lasted 1:06 in the first quarter, from 4:39 p.m. to 5:45 p.m.
- ▶ The RMU-Dayton tilt was called with 9:37 left in the fourth quarter due to inclement weather
- ▶ It was the first time in team history RMU did not play a full 60-minute game
- ▶ Play was initially stopped at 3:17 p.m. for lightning
- ▶ Delay lasted until 5:06 p.m. when the remainder of the game was called by officials

ACADEMIC ACCOLADES

- ▶ Senior Andy Smigiera and 2016 graduate Nick Faraci were both named to the College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Academica All-District II honorees in 2015
- ▶ Faraci was also named to the CoSIDA Academic All-America Team

- ▶ It was the sixth time in the last six seasons a Colonial earned Academic All-America honors

FIRST TIME FOR EVERYTHING

- ▶ WR Warren Robinson is the first player in team history with two punt return TDs
- ▶ RB Dante Satcher is the first player in team history with two kickoff return TDs
- ▶ RB Sam Woods 52-yard TD pass to WR Eldin Anu vs. Youngstown State was the first passing TD by a non-quarterback in team history
- ▶ RMU has two first time opponents on its schedule this season - Alderson-Broadbudds and Malone
- ▶ The Colonials are 24-16-1 when playing an opponent for the first time
- ▶ RMU also had a game called - against Dayton - before the full 60 minutes was played for the first time in history

NFL EXPERIENCE FOR MILLER

- ▶ Offensive coordinator Mike Miller has spent 12 seasons in the National Football League
- ▶ Most recently, he was the offensive coordinator for the Arizona Cardinals in 2011 and 2012
- ▶ He spent six seasons with the Cardinals
- ▶ Miller was also an assistant with the Buffalo Bills (2004-05) and the Pittsburgh Steelers (1999-2003)
- ▶ He has also spent time in the press box as a public relations assistant with the Steelers, Indianapolis Colts and the Pittsburgh Penguins of the National Hockey League
- ▶ During his tenure as receivers coach with Arizona, he mentored Larry Fitzgerald, Anquan Boldin and Steve Breaston

BROTHER ACT

- ▶ Tyler Lamica joins brother Nic Lamica on the RMU roster in 2016
- ▶ The elder Lamica, Nic, is a redshirt-junior who started seven games at tight end last season
- ▶ The younger Lamica, Tyler, is a freshman linebacker currently seated in the two deep at outside linebacker
- ▶ Nic returns to LB at RMU after spending last



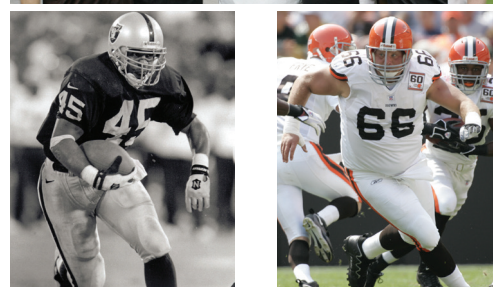

SCORE 30 OR MORE

- ▶ Since the inception of RMU football in 1994, RMU is 72-5 (.935) when scoring 30 or more points
- ▶ The Colonials are 29-0 when tallying 40 or more points

THE FOUNDING FATHER

- ▶ RMU had only one coach in its first 20 seasons of existence, Joe Walton
- ▶ Walton was a former NFL tight end and head coach (see sidebar, right)
- ▶ He was a four-time NEC Coach of the Year
- ▶ Under his guidance, RMU won two NCAA I-AA mid-major national titles
- ▶ Walton was inducted into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2013

— DEFENSIVE NOTES —

NATIONAL RANKINGS - TEAM

- ▶ RMU ranks in the top-25 in these categories:
 - ▶ 20th in sacks (2.8/game)
 - ▶ 9th in red zone defense (14-21, 66.7%)

NATIONAL RANKINGS - INDIVIDUAL

- ▶ Colonials rank in the top 50 in these categories:
 - ▶ LB Gee Stanley is seventh at 1.1 sacks per game
 - ▶ LB Adam Wollett is 29th in fumbles recovered

DREAD NAUGHT

- ▶ Freshman LB Gee Stanley has 5.5 sacks
- ▶ He is seventh in the nation in sacks
- ▶ The RMU freshman record for sacks is 7.5 by Matt Grayson (1998)
- ▶ He had a game-high nine tackles in his RMU debut vs. Alderson Broaddus
- ▶ Stanley is fourth on the team with 28 tackles
- ▶ He is second with 16 solo stops

PRIDE OF POLAND ... OHIO

- ▶ Sophomore LB Adam Wollett leads RMU with 41 tackles
- ▶ He also tops the team with 18 solo stops
- ▶ He made a career-high 12 tackles at Dayton
- ▶ He is second on the team with three pass break ups
- ▶ Has the team's only fumble recovery

HURRICANE WATCH

- ▶ Hurricane, W.Va., native Zach Cooper is third on the team with 34 tackles
- ▶ He has 1.5 sacks this season
- ▶ Cooper has two hurries and two pass break ups
- ▶ He has started 10 consecutive games at OLB

BRANCHING OUT

- ▶ DB Marcelis Branch is sixth on the team with 24 tackles
- ▶ He has started 17 consecutive games and is the active RMU leader with 36 starts
- ▶ He also has an interception, returning it 15 yards

- ▶ He had 35 solo and 28 assisted stops in 2015
- ▶ A Preseason All-NEC pick, he had one interception, three PBU's and four passes defended last season

GET IT BACK

- ▶ RMU has forced a total of six turnovers, five interceptions and one fumble
- ▶ Robert Morris forced four turnovers in week one vs. Alderson Broaddus
- ▶ Three came from interceptions by Marcelis Branch, Travon Stott and Roger Richardson
- ▶ LB Adam Wollett has the only fumble recovery

BOOM SACK-A-LACKA

- ▶ RMU ranks 20th nationally with 2.8 sacks per game
- ▶ Colonials collected four sacks against Alderson Broaddus and and Malone
- ▶ Freshman LB Gee Stanley has accounted for 5.5 of those sacks
- ▶ Eight different players have recorded at least a half sack
- ▶ DE Ryan Lewis has two sacks and LB Zach Cooper has 1.5
- ▶ RMU tied the team record with 34 sacks last season (34, 2006)
- ▶ Players who contributed for 24.5 of those sacks return to the roster this season
- ▶ Lewis had 4.5 sacks in 2015

SWISS STEVE

- ▶ In four starts this season, DT Steven Fiadewornu has 13 tackles
- ▶ In season opener vs. Alderson Broaddus, he made nine tackles
- ▶ He had five career tackles coming into the season
- ▶ Added 0.5 tackle for loss and forced a fumble
- ▶ Hometown is Zurich, Switzerland

SAFETY SMIGIERA

- ▶ WS Andy Smigiera returned to the lineup against Liberty making 5 tackles
- ▶ On the game's first play, he had a pass break up
- ▶ He is a Preseason All-NEC selection
- ▶ Smigiera had a total of 19 passes defended last season (8 PBU)
- ▶ He tied with Ryan Richards, Jr., for the team lead with three interceptions
- ▶ He finished with 62 tackles, 30 solo

25-7

- ▶ The defense ranked in the FCS top-25 in seven different statistical categories - and the top 15 in five categories in 2015
 - ▶ 7th - Sacks by (3.09/G)
 - ▶ 11th - Third down conversion pct. (.309)
 - ▶ 14th - Fourth down conversion pct. (.333)
 - ▶ 14th - Pass yards allowed (172.0/G)
 - ▶ 14th - Tackles for loss (7.7/G)
 - ▶ 18th - Passing efficiency defense (108.13/G)
 - ▶ 21st - Total defense (321.4/G)
- ▶ RMU has ranked in top 25 in total in defense in four of last five seasons
- ▶ 2015 tied the team record with 34 sacks



SENSATIONAL SECONDARY

- ▶ Colonials led the NEC in fewest yards allowed per attempt at 5.8 in 2015
- ▶ RMU had fewest passing yards allowed in league games last season (138.5)
- ▶ RMU had the second most pass break-ups in team history last season with 46

SEASONED SECONDARY

- ▶ The entire starting second from 2015 returns intact in 2016
- ▶ Redshirt senior Marcelis Branch, a two-time All-NEC player, was named to the preseason all-conference team
- ▶ Senior Andy Smigiera was also named to the Preseason All-NEC squad
- ▶ Junior Drew Allen started every game at corner back as a sophomore
- ▶ Ryan Richards, Jr., played all 11 games at strong safety

— OFFENSIVE NOTES —

TIM TIME

- ▶ Freshman WR Tim Vecchio has caught 13 passes in the last two games
- ▶ He hauled in eight passes for 64 yards against Malone
- ▶ Its the third most catches in team history and ranks 11th in the record book (10 - two players; 9 - eight players)
- ▶ He leads the team with 16 receptions for 136 yards

ROMANCHAK UNDER CENTER

- ▶ R-Freshman Andrew Romanchak made his quarterbacking debut in week one and his first start at Dayton
- ▶ He went 8-of-9 for 68 yards against Malone
- ▶ This season, he is 48-103 for 376 yards
- ▶ He finished 13-32 for 121 yards and one interception in week one
- ▶ Romanchak has tossed five interceptions

GOING TO THE WELLS

- ▶ Sophomore Malik Wells made his first career start at Liberty
- ▶ Wells had 17 carries for 73 yards vs. Flames
- ▶ He carried four times for 21 yards against Malone
- ▶ He had just two carries coming into the game
- ▶ Wells had a six-yard rushing TD

UN-DANTE-D

- ▶ Sophomore RB Dante Satcher has 66 touches on 207 offensive plays (31.8%) in his four games
- ▶ He has 59 rushes and seven receptions
- ▶ He set career highs for rushes, 20, and yards, 88, against Malone
- ▶ Satcher is averaging 56.2 yards of total offense and 115.0 all-purpose yards
- ▶ Satcher finished with 161 all-purpose yards, returning a kickoff 99 yards for a TD, against Alderson Broaddus

THIRD AND LONG

- ▶ Of the 67 third downs RMU has faced this season, 28 have been third-and-10 yards or more
- ▶ RMU is 10-23 when facing third-and-five yards or shorter
- ▶ Colonials are 1-44 when facing third and five or longer

12 TARGETS

- ▶ Twelve different players have caught passes for RMU this season
- ▶ WR Tim Vecchio leads the team with 16 receptions
- ▶ WR Warren Robinson added nine receptions
- ▶ RB Dante Satcher has six receptions and Reggie Green has caught five passes
- ▶ Robinson, Blake Skuratowicz and Eldin Anu each had a receiving touchdown

HELLO MR. ROBINSON

- ▶ WR Warren Robinson has nine receptions for 42 yards and one touchdown
- ▶ Hauled in a season-best three passes at Dayton
- ▶ He had two catches against both Alderson Broaddus and Youngstown State
- ▶ Also returns punts for the Colonials

WHO TO ANU?

- ▶ RB Sam Woods hit WR Eldin Anu for a 52-yard TD pass against Youngstown State
- ▶ It was the first touchdown pass by a non-quarterback in RMU history
- ▶ It was also the longest play from scrimmage for the team this season

BARR SET

- ▶ Sophomore QB Mathew Barr made his 2016 debut against Malone
- ▶ He was 5-of-13 for 24 yards and a TD
- ▶ In 2015, earned two of the last three NEC Rookie of the Week accolades in 2015
- ▶ He went 20-31 for 225 yards and two scores in week nine against East Tennessee State
- ▶ In season finale vs. Bryant, Barr completed 13 of 16 for 122 yards
- ▶ Barr started nine games last season, going 90-188 for 989 yards

OTHER SIDE OF THE WOODS

- ▶ Redshirt-Junior Sam Woods has moved to running back after spending two seasons as a defensive back
- ▶ Woods is responsible for the only passing TD by a non-quarterback in team history, hitting Eldin Anu for 52 yards at YSU
- ▶ Woods had 35 career tackles, 34 of which came in his redshirt freshman campaign of 2014

COLE SHORTAGE

2016 RMU ATHLETIC HALL OF FAME INDUCTEES

JASON HEMPSTEAD

1999-2003

A two-sport athlete, Hempstead was a four-year letterwinner in both football and track & field and during his career at Robert Morris and was a member of five Northeast Conference championship squads. Hempstead compiled career totals of 168 tackles and four interceptions as a defensive back for the Colonials and was part of a pair of teams (1999, 2000) that claimed both NEC championships and mid-major national titles according to Don Hansen's National Weekly Football Gazette. In track & field, Hempstead helped RMU claim NEC indoor championships in both 1999 and 2000 as well as the 2000 NEC outdoor title. Hempstead garnered All-NEC Second Team accolades in the triple jump six times over his career, including four consecutive indoor honors and two during the outdoor season. Hempstead is a native of Richmond, Va.

TYJUAN MASSEY

2002-05

Arguably the most exciting player in school history to don a Robert Morris uniform, Massey owns Robert Morris career records for receiving yards (2,119) and touchdown catches (21) while ranking third in receptions (112). His best season came as a senior in 2005, the first year the Colonials played in Joe Walton Stadium, as Massey established RMU single-season marks for receiving yards (899), touchdown receptions (10), 100-yard receiving games (4) and average yards per catch (23.1). A dual threat, Massey was also a force on special teams, compiling 1,221 yards on 46 kickoff returns, an average of 26.5 yards per return. Included in those totals was a 94-yard return for a touchdown against Stony Brook in 2003, which stood as the longest kickoff return in program history until being broken in RMU's 2016 season opener. Massey ranks third all-time at Robert Morris for career all-purpose yards (3,748) and was the first student-athlete to earn All-Northeast Conference honors at two different positions. He was named to the All-NEC First Team at return specialist and the All-NEC Second Team at wide receiver in 2005. Massey is a native of Orlando, Fla.

MYLES RUSS

2007-10

One of two former RMU student-athletes to be enshrined in the Class of 2016 on the first ballot, Russ is RMU's all-time leading rusher. He accumulated 4,271 yards and 21 touchdowns on 818 carries, an average of 5.2 yards per rush. Russ started 40 career games, a record for a Robert Morris running back, and also owns the program record for all-purpose yards (4,651). As a senior in 2010, Russ helped lead the Colonials to an overall record of 8-3 (.727), including a mark of 7-1 (.875) in the Northeast Conference. He rushed for 1,363 yards and 10 touchdowns en route to being named the 2010 NEC Offensive Player of the Year. Robert Morris also became the first NEC team to earn an automatic bid to the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Playoffs. Russ is a native of Boca Raton, Fla.

THIRD SEASON - EASTERN MICHIGAN 1975

3x Super Bowl Champion | 2013 AFCA FCS Assistant Coach of the Year

John Banaszak is the second head football coach in Robert Morris University history as he will lead the program in his third season in 2016.

Robert Morris showed signs of growth in Banaszak's second season at the helm in 2015 as RMU won three games in which it trailed in the second half while a school record eight Colonials won Northeast Conference (NEC) weekly honors, including true freshman quarterback Mathew Barr, who was a two-time honoree. Under Banaszak, Kyle Buss became the first Colonial to be named a finalist for National Freshman of the Year, as he was part of a program that achieved a three-win improvement from the season prior.

Multiple phases of the Robert Morris specials teams, which continues to be overseen by Banaszak, thrived in 2015. RMU scored a program record three touchdowns on special teams in 2015, including a 96-yard kickoff return for a touchdown, the longest in school history. Warren Robinson ranked second nationally in punt return average in 2015 by netting 18.2 yards per return, breaking RMU's single season school record in the process. The Colonials also broke the program record, and ranked second nationally, in kick return defense as the unit only allowed 14.7 yards per opponent return. The former defensive lineman also presided over a defense that tied the single-season school record in sacks (34) and ranked among the top 25 nationally in seven categories.

During the 2014 campaign, Banaszak led the Colonials to the largest comeback victory in school history while also turning the squad into one of the most disciplined in the country as RMU broke its program record for fewest penalty yards per game. He oversaw a youth infusion that saw a number of Colonials perform admirably in their first time on a collegiate stage. In fact, four distinct Colonials were named NEC Rookie of the Week during the course of 2014, setting a new school record while simultaneously tying a league record that had only been achieved once previously.

Banaszak officially became the RMU head coach in December 2013. He had been selected as Coach-In-Waiting in January 2012 at a press conference at the Charles L. Sewall Center, allowing for a simple transition following the 2013 campaign. He served as an assistant coach and assistant head coach for the Colonials for 11 consecutive years prior to taking over the top spot.

At the end of the 2013 season, not long before Banaszak was set to move into the head role, he was named as the Assistant Coach of the Year at the FCS level as selected by the American Football Coaches Association (AFCA). He was one of five coaches selected, each at different levels of college football, for dedication to their teams and communities. He was the first Robert Morris coach, as well as the first from the NEC, to claim this honor.

The 2013 season was Banaszak's sixth as assistant head coach for Robert Morris. Among his numerous duties with the program, he was responsible for tutoring the defensive line and the special teams unit.

Under Banaszak's guidance in 2013, Robert Morris led the NEC in net punting, punt return defense and punt return average while also placing second in the league in kickoff coverage. The Colonials actually ranked third nationally in punt returns as Banaszak guided Antwan Eddie to a single-season school record 405 punt return yards.

Banaszak was also a key component in instructing a RMU defense that finished second in the NEC in total defense within league play. Robert Morris finished its regular season ranked among the top 25 nationally in a number of defensive categories including third-down defense, first downs allowed, passing defense, red zone defense, passing efficiency defense, turnovers gained and total defense. He helped A.J. Holderman, a former fullback, enjoy a breakout campaign that saw him finish with 14.5 tackles for loss, the third-highest figure in RMU single-season annals.

With Banaszak's help in his assistant role, RMU led the NEC in total defense four times in 10 years (2004, 2006, 2009, 2010) and ranked among the top four spots nine times in 11 seasons.

Banaszak was a key component to a 2010 defense that led the NEC in total defense, allowing an average of 312.6 yards per game, and coaching a defensive line that recorded 13 of RMU's 21 sacks as the Colonials claimed the NEC's inaugural berth in the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) Playoffs.

In 2006, Banaszak helped tutor an RMU defense that led I-AA (now the FCS) in total defense, allowing an average of just 228.36 yards per game.

Ten of the 13 players in school history to earn All-NEC recognition on the defensive line have come under the tutelage of Banaszak, including Nolan Nearhoof (2009-12), who was named the 2012 NEC Defensive Player of the Year after breaking both the school and league records for career sacks.

Nearhoof would go on to earn All-America honors courtesy of The Sports Network, becoming the third Colonial defensive lineman to claim an All-America nod under Banaszak in a seven year span.

As much as Banaszak's presence has been felt on the defensive side of the ball, the same can be said on special teams. Eddie became the fifth different Colonial to win an award at return specialist in one decade's time. Under Banaszak's leadership, former Colonials Dante Settles (2000-04), Tyjuan Massey (2002-05), Mario Hines (2004-07) and Anthony Coleman (2008-11) garnered All-NEC honors at return specialist, the first players in RMU history to earn such a distinction.

Prior to RMU, Banaszak served as the 30th head coach in Washington & Jefferson football history, leading the Presidents to a record of 38-9 (.809) in his four seasons on the sidelines between 1999 and 2002. In each of those four campaigns, he was named the Presidents' Athletic Conference Coach of the Year and ranks third on the college's all-time victory list. He helped W&J qualify for the NCAA Tournament in each of his four years as the Presidents registered wins in three of those appearances.

A graduate of Eastern Michigan with a bachelor's degree in health, physical education and recreation, Banaszak signed as a free agent with the Pittsburgh Steelers prior to the 1975 season and was one of only three rookies to make the defending Super Bowl champion team out of training camp.

Primarily a special teams player on Pittsburgh's Super Bowl X championship team, Banaszak started five games the following season and then started at both right end and inside tackle in 1977 before suffering a knee injury that forced him to the injured reserve list.

Between 1978 and 1980, Banaszak started 45 regular-season games at defensive end as the Steelers won back-to-back Super Bowl championships. In Super Bowl XIII, Banaszak recorded six tackles, including a pair of sacks, and a fumble recovery in a 35-31 victory over the Dallas Cowboys, which garnered him Defensive Player of the Game honors. The following year in Super Bowl XIV, Banaszak finished with five tackles and a sack in a 31-19 victory over the Los Angeles Rams.

Banaszak and his wife, Mary, have three children. They reside in McMurray, Pa.
