OPENING TIP

• Columbia (1-1) travels to Loretto, Pennsylvania, to take on Saint Francis University (1-1) Saturday at 4 p.m. from DeGol Arena ... The two teams played their first series matchup last season in New York, a game which Columbia won, 82-78 ... Columbia outrebounded SFU 61-28 and came back from as many as 11 down to win ... The Lions opened the 2016-17 season at home and came back from 14 down to tie UMBC in the fourth quarter, but ultimately lost, 67-56 ... Sunday, the Lions traveled to Richmond and picked up their first victory, downing the Spiders, 65-58 ... It was the first victory in the head coaching career of Megan Griffith.

ZIMMERMAN NAMED PLAYER OF THE WEEK

• Junior Camille Zimmerman was named Ivy League Player of the Week on Monday ... Zimmerman averaged 20.0 points, 12.5 rebounds, and 2.5 blocks through Columbia's first two games ... The returning Second Team All-Ivy League selection went for team-highs of 22 points and 10 rebounds in Friday's season opener against UMBC ... Sunday, she led the Lions to their first victory, scoring a team-high 18 points, grabbing a game-high 15 rebounds and blocking a game-high three shots in a 65-58 road win over Richmond ... The player-of-the-week selection was the fourth of Zimmerman's career ... Through the early part of this season, Zimmerman ranks atop the Ivy League in rebounds, while also ranking No. 2 in scoring, No. 2 in offensive rebounds (5.5), No. 2 in defensive rebounds (7.0), No. 3 in blocks and No. 3 in minutes (38.0).

Breakout for Koerner

• Sophomore Paulina Koerner scored a career-high 18 points on 4-of-8 shooting and a 9-of-10 mark from the charity stripe in Sunday's victory at Richmond ... Koerner scored 14 of her 18 points in the second half, including nine in the fourth quarter to cement the victory ... Aside from points, Koerner also set or tied career-highs in field goals made (4), free throws made (9), 3-pointers made (1), free throw attempts (10), free throw percentage (90.0%), rebounds (5), blocks (1) and minutes (37) ... For her efforts, Koerner was recognized on the Ivy League Weekly Honor Roll.

COLUMBIA HOLDS OFF RICHMOND FOR FIRST WIN

Sunday, November 13, 2016

COLUMBIA 65 RICHMOND 58

RICHMOND, Va. – Behind Camille Zimmerman's double-double, a career-high 18 points from Paulina Koerner and 15 from Tori Oliver, the Columbia women's basketball team earned its first victory of the season, holding on to defeat Richmond, 65-58, Sunday afternoon at the Robins Center.

Columbia (1-1) jumped out to an 18-5 lead after the first quarter, ending the period with 12 unanswered points over the final 4:15. Richmond (0-1) cut the lead to seven at halftime, 31-24, and got within three on two different occasions in the fourth quarter, but the Lions were able to fend off each rally by shooting 56-percent in the final period. A late 6-0 run sealed the victory, putting Columbia in front by nine with less than a minute remaining.

The win was the first in the head coaching career of Megan Griffith, who took over the program in March.

"This was a great team win," commented Griffith. "Sticking to the game plan and jumping out early was big, and it put us in a good place. We were able to sustain that lead over four quarters, which shows a lot about our character."

The Lions maintained that lead with strong defense and an impressive showing on the glass. Columbia outrebounded Richmond 54-33, using 19 offensive rebounds to create 17 second-chance points. The defense limited Richmond to 27-percent from the floor, including a 9.5-percent showing from 3-point range.

Zimmerman highlighted Columbia with 18 points, 15 rebounds and three blocks for her second double-double in as many outings. The junior led Columbia in all three categories last season.

Koerner helped put the game away, scoring nine of her 18 points in the fourth quarter, including a 3-pointer off the glass with 8:02 left that put the Lions up eight. The sophomore shot 4-of-8 on the afternoon with a 9-for-10 mark at the foul line, also setting career marks in free throws made and attempted.

Oliver rounded out Columbia's double-figure scorers with 15. The senior shot 4-of-9 from the floor and knocked down seven of her 10 attempts at the charity stripe. She added eight rebounds, including seven on the defensive end. Oliver, Zimmerman and sophomore Josie Little (7) combined for 30 of Columbia's 54 boards.

For Richmond, Micaela Parson led all scorers with 20, but it came on just 3-of-13 shooting, scoring 14 of her points at the foul line. Preseason All-Atlantic 10 first teamer Janelle Hubbard scored 16.

Columbia's 12 consecutive points through the final minutes of the first quarter were scored by Zimmerman, Koerner and senior Devon Roeper. The three combined to shoot 5-of-8 during the run, which also included two free throws by Koerner. Zimmerman scored four points on offensive putbacks, including a bucket in the final 30 seconds that gave the Lions a 13-point lead.

After going without a 3-pointer the entire first quarter, the Lions buried two in the opening five minutes of the second. Sophomores Abby Lee and Emily Surloff knocked them down. helping the Lions maintain their double-digit lead. A 4-0 Richmond spurt through the last two minutes got the Spiders within single digits at the half.

Richmond cut Columbia's lead to a handful for the first time with a bucket on its first possession of the second half, but the Lions extended their lead back to 11 by scoring on three consecutive trips down the floor. Zimmerman scored off another offensive putback to start the run and Oliver scored on the next two possessions to force the Spiders to call timeout down 43-32 at the quarter's 3:47 mark.

Columbia carried a six-point lead into the fourth and fended off Richmond's multiple attempts to rally. Koerner's 3-pointer off the glass was answered by an and-1 from Parson and a Hubbard jumper to make it a 52-49 game with 7:10 left. Roeper scored the game's next three points, including a bucket in transition to pad the lead back to two possessions, but the Spiders were earning enough trips to the foul line to stay within striking distance.

Leading by three with less than four minutes remaining, Columbia clamped down on defense to put the game away. The Lions held Richmond to 0-for-9 shooting through the final minutes, with the team's only points coming at the foul line. Meanwhile, Columbia scored on baskets by Oliver and Koerner, which led to a 6-0 run that turned it back into a three-possession game.

Columbia has the week off before heading to St. Francis (PA) on Saturday. Tip is set for 4 p.m. at DeGol Arena.

NEW YORK - The Columbia women's basketball team (5-1) rallied when it mattered most on Tuesday afternoon as they came from behind once again to take down Saint Francis (Pa.), 82-78, in their Eighth New York City Education Day game.

Playing in front of a screaming crowd of over 1,800 fans, it was Columbia who would get on the board first as Alexa Giuliano drained a three from the corner. Unfortunately, the Red Flash would respond with seven unanswered points to take back the lead.

Still trailing, 7-5, Paige Tippet stepped up for the Lions as she got to the corner and hit one from downtown to put the Lions back on top.

With the help of a Paige Tippet three to give the lions back the lead, Columbia was able to hold the Saint Francis offense without a field goal for the final three and a half minutes, but six free throws allowed the Red Flash to cut the Columbia lead to 19-16 after the first quarter of play.

After battling back and forth through a second quarter that saw two ties and seven lead changes, it was the Red Flash who came out on top heading into the break with a 44-41 lead, holding the Lions without a field goal in the last three and a half minutes.

Leading 49-46, the Red Flash offense began to go to work as they rallied on a 10-2 run before Alexa Giuliano and Devon Roeper could team up for back-to-back buckets to cut the deficit to 59-52 with 4:38 to play in the third.

Coming out of the media timeout, however, it was all Columbia as the Lions rallied on a 13-3 run to pull to within a point, 62-61 with just under two minutes remaining in the quarter.

With the clock winding down, Alexa Giuliano drained a three from the corner to tie the game up at 65-65 and with the help of a Josie Little free throw, the Lions were able to take back the lead, 66-65, heading into the final 10 minutes of play.

Tied at 68-68, Camile Zimmerman stepped up for the Lions as she attacked the lane to hit a runner before Alexa Giuliano followed up, draining her sixth trey of the day to put Columbia ahead, 73-68.

While the Red Flash was able to pull to within three in the final minute, the Lions would not relinquish the lead as they went on to claim an 82-78 victory to improve to 5-1 on the year.

The Lions dominated on the boards, outrebounding the Red Flash, 61-28, with three different players picking up double-digit rebounds.

Giuliano led the Lions with 21 points after shooting 7-of-18 from the field and 6-of-14 from downtown, adding six rebounds and a pair of assists on the day. Devon Roeper picked up 19 points after an impressive 8-of-11 shooting from the field, picking up six rebounds while adding two assists.

Zimmerman picked up her third double-double of the season with 11 points and 12 rebounds after shooting 5-of-9 from the field while Josie Little added 11 rebounds and Tori Oliver rounded out the double-figure rebounding

The Lions will return to action this weekend as they head out West to Phoenix, Arizona, for the Arizona State University Tournament on Dec. 5-6.

Notes from Last Season

SOMETHING TO BUILD ON

• Along with the most non-conference wins in program history (11), Columbia's 12 overall wins last season places them third all-time since the program turned Division I back in 1986 ... Only the 2009-10 team (18-10) and the 2008-09 team (13-15) have achieved more wins, while six other teams have reached the 12-win mark.

COMPETING WITH UCONN

• For the majority of the season, the Lions led the nation in free-throw percentage, but were surpassed by the national champion UConn Huskies by season's end ... Columbia finished the 2015-16 campaign at 79.3 percent, while UConn came in at an even 80 percent ... The Lions were slightly better in Ivy League play at 79.7 percent, more than three full percentage points ahead of the next closest team, Brown, at 76.6 percent.

CAMILLE ZIMMERMAN IN THE 2ND HALF

• Camille Zimmerman was the go-to in the second half of play in Ivy League games last season, averaging 7.7 points and 3.8 rebounds per game in the final 20 minutes after shooting 51.4 percent (76-of-148) from the floor and 46.2 percent (6-of-13) from deep ... In the opening 20 minutes, Zimmerman leads the team with 7.1 points and 3.5 rebounds per game while shooting 43.2 percent (73-of-169) from the field and 34.4 percent (11-of-32) from deep.

NEWEST MEMBER OF THE 1,000-POINT CLUB

• With the help of a free throw in the second half of action against Princeton on Feb. 13, Tori Oliver became the 10th player in program history to reach the 1,000-point club, marking the first to cross that threshold since Lauren Dwyer (2007-2011) ... Oliver enters the 2016-17 season seventh all-time with 1,055 career points.

SPREADING THE OFFENSE

• Columbia went into the final weekend of last season with two players averaging double figures and three others that averaging at least 7.5. Camille Zimmerman led the way with 15.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game while shooting 46.7 percent from the floor and 37.8 from downtown ... Devon Roeper was also in double-figures with 10.0 points and 4.0 rebounds per contest ... As a team, the Lions shot 40.1 percent from the floor last season with three of the team's starters averaging over 40.0 percent from the field.

• Devon Roeper came alive against Stony Brook on Nov. 23, recording 23 points while picking up six boards in 25 minutes after shooting 10-of-16 from the floor ... Since then, she averaged 11.0 points and 4.5 rebounds while shooting 51.3 percent (97-for-189) from the field over a 24-game period ... With that momentum carrying, Roeper started four of the last five games for the Lions and averaged more than 24 minutes per game.


