### NOTES FROM CHATHAM

- Andre Wolford recorded a career-high 17 points off the bench. He shot 7-of-10 from the field and added two blocks.
- Wolford led six SFU players in double-figures.
- Isaiah Blackmon and Georgios Angelou each contributed with 14 points, with Angelou scoring 12 of his 14 points from three-point range. Angelou added a team-high nine assists in the victory.
- Keith Braxton finished with a career-high 13 points while Josh Nebo recorded 12 and Jammal King posted 10.
- SFU outscored Chatham 65-26 in the second half, shooting almost 65 percent from the field and 68 percent from three-point range.

### RECENT GRADS PLAYING OVERSEAS

Recent SFU graduates Greg Brown and Ben Millaud-Meunier signed professional contracts over the summer. Brown signed on to play for Campo Mourao in the top professional league of Brazil. Millaud-Meunier signed to play in Spain for Agustinos Leclerc. Millaud-Meunier is currently averaging 9.1 points per game on 44 percent shooting from three. Brown and Millaud-Meunier join Earl Brown as SFU grads that have gone pro. Brown has played in Iceland and is currently playing for the Cheshire Phoenix of the British Basketball League. Brown, a 2014 grad of Saint Francis is averaging 18 points and 8 rebounds per game.

## HEAD COACH ROB KRIMMEL



Fifth Season  
Saint Francis '00  
44-82 Overall  
Rob Krimmel enters his fifth season as the Saint Francis men's basketball coach in 2016-17. He was named the 21st coach in program history on

April 19, 2012.

In 2015-16, Saint Francis had several key moments including sweeping Robert Morris for the first time since the 2000-01 season. Ronnie Drinnon was just one of two players and seventh all-time to record a 20-point 20-rebound 5-assist game, doing so against CCSU on February 6th. The Flash also completed one of the biggest comebacks of the season last year when they erased a 17-point halftime deficit in a 73-65 triumph at Bryant.

Krimmel led the Red Flash to its most successful season in a decade in 2014-15 as the Red Flash had its first winning regular season since 2004-05. The Red Flash finished 16-16 overall as it appeared in its second consecutive NEC Tournament semifinals for the first time in program history. The Flash also hosted its first postseason game since 1991 when SFU hosted Bowling Green in the CollegeInsiders.com Postseason Tournament (CIT) in March.

### NEBO'S BLOCK PARTY

Sophomore forward Josh Nebo has become a force when it comes to protecting the rim. After posting 59 blocks as a freshman, Nebo added two more against both Duquesne and Chatham. His 63 career blocks are already good for eighth all-time at Saint Francis, one away from tying Will Felder (2009-11) for seventh place.

Nebo has also been a force on the glass this year, including a career-high 16 against the Dukes. He is 33rd in the nation in rebounds per game, averaging 10.

### BOMBS AWAY

Saint Francis hit on 9 threes against St. Bonaventure, 10 against Duquesne and 19 vs. Chatham. The Red Flash currently leads the nation with a 51.4 three-point percentage and ranks third, averaging 12.7 three-pointers per game. SFU's 19 against Chatham are the third-most in a Division I game this year.

Senior guard Georgios Angelou has hit a team-best 10 threes this year and ranks 23rd in the NCAA with a 58.8 three-point percentage. Sophomore Jamaal King has hit 6 threes, sophomore Isaiah Blackmon has five, while freshman Keith Braxton and sophomores Scott Meredith and Andre Wolford both have hit four.

### BALANCED ATTACK

Saint Francis placed six players in double figures in the 119-59 win over Chatham. The Red Flash has put at least four players in double figures in each game this season. SFU had five in double figures in the opener at Saint Bonaventure and four in the loss at Duquesne.

Nebo (13.3), Angelou (12), King (11), Blackmon (11), Wolford (11) and Braxton (10) are all averaging double-figures through three games, while Randall Gaskins Jr. is close behind, averaging 9 points per game.

### DROPPING DIMES

Boosted by a 30-assist performance against Chatham, the Red Flash is 10th in the nation in assists per game, averaging 21. With 63 total assists, SFU is assisting on 66.3 percent of its made shots.

### YOUTH MOVEMENT

Eleven of the eighteen players on the Saint Francis roster are freshman or sophomore eligibility. Of the 15 players who have appeared a game this year, 10 are freshmen or sophomores. Through three games, the group has combined for 221 of the team's 276 points (80.1 percent) and 463 of 600 minutes (77.1 percent).

## TEAM CAPTAINS

Senior guard Georgios Angelou, sophomore guard Jamaal King and sophomore forward Josh Nebo were selected Team Captains for the 2016-17 season. Angelou, one of three seniors on the roster, moves into a bigger role this year after being a key contributor off the bench last season, leading SFU with a 47.4 three-point percentage. King will provide leadership at the point guard spot, while Nebo made a big impact in his freshman campaign, starting 29 games.

## BIG SHOES TO FILL

- Saint Francis graduated three key players from their 2015-16 team in Greg Brown, Ronnie Drinon and Ben Millaud-Meunier
- Those three seniors combined for 53 percent of the team's points (1,132 of 2,110), 46 percent of the team's rebounds (504 of 1,093) and 55 percent of the team's assists (196 of 356)
- The Red Flash will look to Georgios Angelou (47 percent from three), Josh Nebo (2.0 blocks per game), and Isaiah Blackmon (10 ppg) to shoulder the load to start the 2016-17 season

## KRIMMEL NINTH PLACE ON WINS LIST

Head coach Rob Kimmel moved into ninth place on the Saint Francis wins list with his 43rd career victory over Central Connecticut on Feb. 6. Kimmel surpassed Kevin Porter with that win. Porter came back to coach the Flash from 1983-87 following an outstanding playing career in Loretto and in the NBA. John Loughran (1920-24) holds eighth place with 51 wins. Dr. Skip Hughes (1945-66) is the school's all-time wins leader with 293. He's the only Saint Francis coach to reach the 100-win plateau.

## HISTORY IN THE MAKING

History will be made when the Red Flash travel to Milwaukee to take on the Marquette Golden Eagles. Saint Francis is taking part in Marquette's 100 years of basketball celebration and their meeting on December 19th will be 59 years to the day from their last meeting. Saint Francis defeated Marquette 79-72 on December 19th, 1956.

## FIRST MEETINGS

Red Flash basketball dates back all the way to the 1905-06 season. In those 111 seasons, Saint Francis has never matched up with either Stony Brook or Texas A&M. That will change this season when the Sea Wolves come to Loretto on December 17th and SFU makes the trip to College Station on December 21st.

## ABOUT LONGWOOD

The Lancers are off to a 1-2 start this season, with a 87-74 win over Salem International. Chatham will take on Capital University on Friday night before facing the Red Flash.

Longwood placed four players in double-figures in its first win of the season. Khris Lane led the team with a career-high 26 points and added 14 rebounds. Lane finished the game 12-of-15 from the field in the win. Darrion Allen recorded 16 points while Isaiah Walton added 12 and Bryan Gee had 10.

The Lancers shot 48.4 percent (31-of-64) from the field and 29 percent (6-of-21) from three, while out-rebounding Salem International, 39-32. Longwood dominated the paint, outscoring Salem International, 48-26.
