



Game 11 | Dec. 19 | Marquette (7-3, 0-0 BIG EAST) vs. St. Francis (PA) (3-5, 0-0 Northeast)

The Marquette University men's basketball team (7-3, 0-0 BIG EAST) continues its season-long, five-game homestand at 6 p.m. CT on Monday, Dec. 19 when the squad hosts St. Francis (PA) in non-conference action at the BMO Harris Bradley Center. FS1 will feature Marquette's 11th national television broadcast of the campaign, with Brian Anderson (play-by-play) and Dickey Simpkins (analyst) calling the action. Following Monday's matchup, the Golden Eagles will conclude the non-conference portion of their 2016-17 campaign versus SIU-Edwardsville on Dec. 21. SIUE is coached by former Marquette player Jon Harris.

MU Renews Series With St. Francis After 60 Years

The Golden Eagles will be meeting St. Francis (PA) on the 60th anniversary of the last matchup between the two programs.

The Red Flash claimed a 79-72 victory over Marquette in Milwaukee on Dec. 19, 1956 in the most recent outing. That team was coached by Jack Nagle and Mike Moran was the squad's leading scorer at 20.4 points per game.

The game with the Red Flash has special meaning to those familiar with the program, which is celebrating 100 years in 2016-17. Marquette defeated St. Francis (PA), 75-64, on March 22, 1952 to claim the National Catholic Tournament title in Troy, N.Y. MU also earned wins over Iona and St. Francis (N.Y.) in that tourney.

The team was coached by Tex Winter, who went on to claim nine total NBA championships with the Bulls and Lakers and is widely known for developing the triangle offense. Winter spent two seasons (1951-53) as head coach at Marquette and at the time was the youngest program mentor in the nation.

MU Offense Performing At A Record Rate

Through the first 10 games of the season, the Golden Eagles are averaging an impressive 86.4 points per game (18th in nation through games of Dec. 14) thanks in large part to impressive shooting from all areas of the court.

Marquette is currently knocking down 49.9 percent (17th in nation) of its shots from the field overall, including a 40.1 percent effort from behind the 3-point line. MU is also tops in the BIG EAST and third in the nation in free throw percentage (.813).

MU has only averaged over 80.0 points per contest for a season on three previous occasions, most recently during the 1970-71 campaign (81.7 ppg.). Should Marquette be able to maintain its current level of production, it would break the program's single-season mark of 84.2 points per game in 1954-55.

Howard Nets Career Best In First Rivalry Game

Freshman guard Markus Howard enjoyed his best offensive performance to date in the team's matchup with Wisconsin on Dec. 10.

The Chandler, Arizona, native finished with a personal-best 22 points on 6-of-12 shooting from the floor, including a 3-of-6 effort from behind the 3-point line. He knocked down 7-of-8 from the charity stripe and also chipped in three rebounds and an assist in 34 minutes of action.

For the season, Howard is chipping in 10.2 points, 2.0 assists and 2.0 rebounds per game in an average of 19.5 minutes per night.

Reinhardt, Rowsey Provide Bench Scoring

Senior Katin Reinhardt and junior Andrew Rowsey, who have started a majority of the games in their respective careers, are starting to settle into their roles off the bench for Marquette.

The duo combined for 31 points against Wisconsin, shooting 8-of-15 from the floor and 7-of-11 from long distance. Both players have been nearly perfect from the free throw line this season, as evidenced by the combined 8-of-9 effort from the tandem against the Badgers.

Hauser Leads 3-Point Attack In Wins Over Georgia, Fresno

Freshman forward Sam Hauser has quickly become a fan favorite thanks to his ability to contribute offensively, especially from behind the 3-point line.

In outings against Georgia and Fresno State, both of which resulted in personal-best 19-point efforts, he combined to shoot 70.6 percent (12-of-17) from the field and 8-of-13 (61.5 percent) from long distance. In a pair of starting assignments, he also chipped in 5.5 rebounds per game in an average of 27.0 minutes per night.

In the Dec. 6 win over Fresno State, the Stevens Point, Wisconsin, native was 4-of-6 from behind the arch and also knocked down several key free throws in the closing moments. He has made two-or-more treys in 8-of-10 outings on the year.

Johnson Finally Able To Double Up

Senior guard Jajuan Johnson, Marquette's most experienced player, took the court for his 92nd game in the win over Georgia and recorded a first-ever accomplishment while wearing the Blue & Gold.

The Memphis, Tennessee, native finished with 16 points and 10 rebounds to collect his first career double-double. In 30 minutes of action, he also found time to chip in five steals and three assists. Of his boards, five came at the offensive end and a trio of his thefts came on three-consecutive possessions early in the second half.

He followed Sunday's effort up with a 14-point, eight-rebound game against Fresno State on Dec. 6 and led the roster in boards.

Johnson narrowly missed a double-double during the 2014-15 campaign, finishing with nine points and 10 rebounds vs. Providence on Jan. 3, 2015.

Fischer One Of Nation's Most Efficient Scorers

Senior center Luke Fischer collected his sixth career double-double (22 points, 11 rebounds) in the win over Houston Baptist on Nov. 26, thanks in large part to an efficient 9-of-10 effort from the field.

Through games of Dec. 14, Fischer is ranked second in the BIG EAST and fifth in the nation in field goal percentage (.747). He has also collected enough career field goal attempts to qualify for the program's career mark in that category and right now would own the top position all-time in field goal percentage (.629). The Germantown, Wisconsin native knocked down 60.8 percent of his shots in 2015-16, the second-best single-season effort in MU history.

Ric Cobb (1968-70) converted on 58.8 percent of his chances during his career in a Marquette uniform and is first in school history.

Hauser, Howard Dialing Long Distance Early in 2016-17

Freshmen Sam Hauser and Markus Howard have played significant roles on the team early in 2016-17, thanks in large part to their ability to knock down long-range shots.

Hauser and Howard are currently ranked fifth (51.1 percent) and seventh (50.0 percent), respectively, in the BIG EAST in 3-point field goal percentage through games of Dec. 14. The newcomer duo has combined to knock down 44-of-87 (50.6 percent) of its opportunities from 3-point land.

Cheatham Chipping In All-Around Game

Sophomore guard Haanif Cheatham has picked up where he left off last season, when he was voted one of the league's top freshman by the head coaches.

Through games of Dec. 14, he is ranked among the league leaders in seven different categories. The Fort Lauderdale, Florida, native is 25th in scoring (12.1 ppg.), 24th in rebounding (4.6 rpg.), ninth in assists (3.3 apg.), eighth in free throw percentage (.879), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.3), 14th in steals (1.2 spg.) and 14th in defensive rebounds per outing (3.9).

Marquette Reaches Century Mark, Again

Freshman Markus Howard's 3-pointer in the closing seconds of the win over Houston Baptist on Nov. 26 allowed the team to eclipse the century mark in points for the second-straight game.

Marquette downed IUPUI 104-79 on Nov. 22 prior to the 101-79 victory over the Huskies on Nov. 26. The last time the Golden Eagles netted 100-or-more points in back-to-back outings came in 2008-09. MU defeated Chicago State (106-87) and Milwaukee (100-80) at the BMO Harris Bradley Center in the first year under head coach Buzz Williams.

In the program's storied 100-year history, the team has never scored at least 100 points in three-consecutive outings. Marquette was on pace to make it three-straight versus Western Carolina, but fell just short in the 90-44 victory.

2017 Recruiting Class Adds Size To Front Line

The Golden Eagles announced the addition of three players to the roster for the 2017-18 campaign on Nov. 9, the first day of the early signing period.

The trio, which features three players who measure at least 6-7, includes Jamal Cain (Pontiac, MI/Cornerstone Health & Technology HS), Ike Eke (Detroit, MI/Univ. of Detroit Jesuit HS) and Theo John (Minneapolis, MN/Champlin Park HS).

Cain (6-7, 180), rated as high as 77th in the nation by Rivals.com, has spent each of the last two seasons at Cornerstone Health & Technology in Detroit, Michigan. He has combined to average 24.8 points, 15.5 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 3.0 blocks per game since joining the program and helped the team to a 27-14 overall record.

Eke (6-9, 220) helped University of Detroit Jesuit High School to the state title as a junior under head coach Patrick Donnelly, chipping in 9.8 points, 8.7 rebounds and 2.1 blocks per game while shooting 65.0 percent from the field. The Cubs were the fifth team in state history to finish the season undefeated.

A three-year letterwinner at Champlin Park High School, John (6-9, 230) has helped the Rebels to a 77-11 record during his tenure and three conference championships. He averaged 14.0 points, 8.6 rebounds and 3.3 blocks per game as a junior and claimed all-conference accolades for the second-straight year.

Fischer Claims Preseason All-League Accolades

Senior center Luke Fischer was selected to the Preseason All-BIG EAST Second Team at the league's annual media day, the lone Marquette player to earn a spot.

The Germantown, Wisconsin, native finished 19th in the league in scoring (12.1 ppg.) and 14th in rebounding (6.2 rpg.) as a junior and was also third in the conference in field goal percentage (.608). His field goal efficiency was the second-best season mark in program history.

For his career, Fischer has started 60 of the 66 career games in which he has played for Marquette and contributed 12.0 points and 5.7 boards per outing. He spent the first semester of his freshman season at Indiana before transferring to MU.

Marquette Celebrating 100 Years Of Hoops In 2016-17

Marquette, which owns a wealth of tradition and success in men's basketball, will be celebrating its 100th year of basketball all season long in 2016-17.

The three major events scheduled include a 40th celebration of the 1977 national championship (Dec. 9-10), an all-player and staff reunion (Feb. 17-18, 2017) and The Centennial Hoopla dinner at the BMO Harris Bradley Center on June 23, 2017.

Marquette is ranked in the top-50 all-time in overall victories and is top-40 in winning percentage. The program is one of 18 schools to claim an NCAA (1977) and NIT (1970)

championship and has made 47 total postseason appearances, a top-10 mark among NCAA Division I programs. Over the years, MU players have earned 29 All-America selections and 57 individuals have been selected in the NBA Draft.

Consistent postseason success has resulted in 31 NCAA tournament trips, 16 visits to the Sweet 16 and a trio of Final Four appearances.

Marquette Making Strides Off The Court

Under Director of Sports Performance Todd Smith, the Golden Eagles have been making tremendous strides in the weight room across-the-board.

While each player on the roster features improvements in multiple measurement areas, highlights include the following individuals. Sophomore guards Haanif Cheatham and Traci Carter were the two most improved players over the course of summer workouts and classmate Sacar Anim claimed the team competition points award. Cheatham posted the top 25-yard dash time (2.93 seconds) and senior Luke Fischer is tops on the roster in bench press (280 pounds) and 185-pound reps (19).

Freshman Sam Hauser has added nearly 10 pounds of muscle (decreased body fat three percent) since arriving on campus in July. All of the individual improvements have led to team increases across-the-board. The average deadlift moved from 290 pounds to 372 pounds and chin-ups went from 13 to 22 reps.

Freshmen Learned On The Job In BIG EAST Play In 2015-16

According to KenPom.com, Marquette featured the eighth-youngest roster in all of collegiate basketball and the third youngest among the top-five RPI leagues in 2015-16.

The experience value is in terms of years of college experience where a player's eligibility class is assumed to determine this. The experience calculation weights the experience of each player on the roster based on minutes played.

In BIG EAST play, MU's first-year players accounted for a league-high 47.3 percent (1726-of-3650) of the team's total minutes. Forward Henry Ellenson led the way with 35.7 minutes per game and Haanif Cheatham (31.9 mpg.) and Traci Carter (23.8 mpg.) combined to collect a majority of the playing time. For the season overall, freshmen accounted for over 45.6 percent of the team's minutes, the 12th-highest percentage in the nation (Stats, Inc.).

While the 2016-17 roster features just one senior (Jajuan Johnson) in his fourth year with the program, the team is significantly more experienced. MU players own a total of 19 letters entering the campaign, one season after collecting just six as a group and having only one walk-on senior (Michael Mache).

Coaching Staff Owns Impressive Playing Credentials

The playing credentials of the Marquette men's basketball staff, and competitive nature of their pickup games in Kasten Gym, are difficult to match and feature multiple examples of All-America recognition and postseason success.

Steve Wojciechowski (Duke), Chris Carrawell (Duke), Brett Nelson (Florida), Travis Diener (Marquette), Justin Gainey (N.C. State), Stan Johnson (Southern Utah) and Jake Presutti (Syracuse) all competed as players at the NCAA Division I level.

Along with a plethora of individual accolades and team accomplishments, the group combined for over 6,000 points, 2,000 assists and 800 steals in nearly 800 career games at the collegiate level.

Steve Wojciechowski

Head Coach I Third Season
Duke, 1998

The 2016-17 campaign will mark the third at Marquette University for head coach Steve Wojciechowski, who has enjoyed a wealth of success in collegiate basketball as both a player and a coach.

Wojciechowski (pronounced woe-ju-HOW-skee) was introduced as the program's 17th head coach on April 1, 2014 by Marquette University President Dr. Michael R. Lovell.

From the moment he arrived on campus, Wojciechowski established his "Win Every Day" philosophy as the foundation for the Marquette program. That approach has been extremely successful on the recruiting trail, where the MU staff has been able to assemble a back-to-back nationally ranked recruiting classes in 2015 and 2016.

The Golden Eagles collected a 20-win campaign in 2015-16 under Wojciechowski and advanced to the quarterfinals of the BIG EAST Conference Tournament. The team's on-court success was led by Henry Ellenson, the league's freshman of the year and eventual NBA first-round pick by the Detroit Pistons. Ellenson was the program's first McDonald's All-America honoree in over 30 years and a top-10 rated prospect.

The Golden Eagles claimed their first win under Wojciechowski in the season opener in 2014-15. The 79-63 win over UT Martin at the BMO Harris Bradley Center was his first as a head coach at the NCAA Division I level. The season also produced wins over Georgia Tech, Tennessee and Arizona State.

Wojciechowski, 40, had previously served as an assistant coach at Duke since the 1999-2000 season and was promoted to associate head coach in the summer of 2008. As a player

and coach, he was a part of Duke's winning tradition, serving on the coaching staff for two NCAA tournament champions. During his tenure, the Blue Devils posted an incredible 441-92 record and competed in the NCAA tournament every year.

Wojciechowski also served as court coach and scout for the USA Basketball Men's National Team. He helped lead on-court duties as well as game preparation from 2006-12, including the program's gold-medal performance at the 2008 Beijing Olympics and 2012 London Olympics. The Olympic teams included NBA greats such as Marquette alumnus Dwyane Wade, Kobe Bryant and LeBron James.

Earning national titles

In 2001, in his second year as an assistant at Duke, Wojciechowski and the Blue Devils won the national championship. The team also captured the Atlantic Coast Conference regular season and tournament crowns and posted a 35-4 record.

Wojciechowski saw one of his former teammates and pupils, Shane Battier, earn the consensus National Player of the Year award in 2001 as well as National Defensive Player of the Year for the third consecutive season.

Wojciechowski achieved repeated success at the highest level with an NCAA title in the

2009-10 season as associate head coach. On the road to the championship, the Blue Devils also won the ACC Tournament, the ACC Regular Season and NIT Season Tip-Off titles. Defense and rebounding were key for the Blue Devils who had one of the nation's top defenses, holding opponents to 61.0 points per game, and ranked 14th out of 334 teams in rebounding margin.

As a player, Wojciechowski was named the top defensive player in the country his senior year, a two-time All-ACC choice and honorable mention Associated Press All-America. He appeared in 128 career games for the Blue Devils and earned 88 starting assignments.

Wojciechowski is a native of Severna Park, Md., and a first-generation college student, having earned a bachelor's degree in sociology from Duke in 1998.

He and his wife Lindsay have two sons, Jack and Charlie.
