### QUICK HITTERS

> The Mount and Saint Francis U are set to meet for the 64th time in series history on Saturday with the Red Flash holding a 34-29 advantage, including an 18-10 mark on their home court.

> The two teams split their pair of matchups last season. SFU posted a 97-88 victory in the first meeting in Emmitsburg, but the Mount responded with a 66-58 victory in Loretto in the second matchup behind Ashlee White's 20-point performance.

> Junior guard Juliette Lawless has registered double-digit points in ten of the last 12 games. The junior leads the squad with 14.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per game in conference tilts.

> The Mountaineers rank fourth in the conference in points per game (63.2), and are currently on pace for their highest scoring average since the 2013-14 season.

### LAST TIME OUT

>>> A late fourth-quarter comeback attempt from Mount St. Mary's fell just short in a 53-48 loss at LIU Brooklyn on Monday afternoon. The Mountaineers, who trailed by as many as 13 in the fourth, whittled the deficit down to just two points in the final minutes, but LIU was ultimately able to escape with the victory.

>>> Juliette Lawless paced the Mount with a team-high 13 points while just missing out on a double-double for the second consecutive game, finishing with nine rebounds in the contest. Caroline Hummell added nine points and four rebounds, while Katrice Dickson and Kayla Agentowicz chipped in with eight points each.

### SERIES BITS

>>> The Mount and Saint Francis U are set to meet for the 64th time in series history on Saturday with the Red Flash holding a 34-29 advantage, including an 18-10 mark on their home court.

>>> The two teams split their pair of matchups last season. SFU posted a 97-88 victory in the first meeting in Emmitsburg as three players dropped 20-plus points, led by Jessica Kovatch's game-high 27. In the second meeting in Loretto, Mount St. Mary's grinded out a 66-58 victory behind Ashlee White's 20 points, five rebounds and four assists. Caroline Hummell chipped in with 13 points and seven boards in the contest.

### SCOUTING THE RED FLASH

>>> Saint Francis U sits in second place in the conference with a 4-1 league mark and a 9-8 record overall. The Red Flash suffered their lone NEC loss last time out, as Robert Morris downed SFU by a 63-62 margin on a last-second three-pointer from Megan Smith, spoiling Jessica Kovatch's 42-point effort.

>>> The Red Flash are leading the league by a wide margin in points per game, averaging 79.4 per contest. Kovatch ranks first in the NEC with 23.8 points per contest, and has hit a league-high 67 three-pointers on the year.

### CHANGE OF PACE

>>> The Mountaineers, who play a much more up-tempo pace than previous seasons, currently rank fourth in the Northeast Conference in scoring, averaging 63.2 points per game.

>>> The Mountaineers are on pace for the program's highest scoring average since the 2013-14 season, when they earned a selection to the WNIT.

### ABIDE THE LAWLESS

>>> Junior guard Juliette Lawless has registered double-digit points in 10 of the last 12 contests. The Mountaineers are 8-6 in Lawless' career when she reaches double-figures.

>>> Lawless is enjoying a breakout season, currently averaging 10.6 points per game, which is more than double her previous career high (4.4 ppg last year).

>>> The Mahopac, N.Y. native has also more than doubled up on her previous bests in rebounding and assists. Lawless leads the squad with 5.2 rebounds and 2.9 assists per contest.

## MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

### STEPPING UP-PERCLASSMEN

>>>> With leading scorer Ashlee White out of the lineup since the beginning of conference play, upperclassmen Juliette Lawless and Caroline Hummell have stepped up in the scoring department.

>>>> Lawless leads the team with 14.0 points and 5.5 rebounds per contest in league games, while Hummell is averaging 11.2 points and 4.5 rebounds. For the season, both players rank among the top-10 in the league in field goal percentage.

### ROOKIE SHARPSHOOTER

>>>> Freshman guard Daly Sullivan currently ranks sixth in the conference in three-pointers made per game, averaging 2.3 a contest.

>>>> Sullivan leads the Mount with 39 three-pointers, having registered three or more in six games on the year.

### SHARING THE WEALTH

>>>> The Mountaineers have combined for 41 assists in the last three contest. They compiled 15 helpers in the contest vs. Fairleigh Dickinson on January 8, and followed it up with 18 assists last Saturday at St. Francis Brooklyn.

>>>> The games with 15 and 18 assists were the Mount's two-highest assist totals of the season.

### CASHING IN FROM THE LINE

>>>> Mount St. Mary's ranks second in the Northeast Conference with a 70.7 percent mark from the free throw line.

>>>> The Mountaineers have six players currently shooting 70 percent or better from the charity stripe, led by sophomores Kayla Agentowicz (.917) and Ashlee White (.811).

### SHOWING THE STAMINA

>>>> Katrice Dickson ranks second in the Northeast Conference in minutes played, averaging 34.4 per game.

>>>> The senior captain has played 35-plus minutes in 10 games on the year.

### WHAT A START

>>>> Mount St. Mary's opened Northeast Conference play with a pair of road victories at Central Connecticut and Bryant to start the league slate at 2-0 for the first time since 2011-12. Following a loss to Sacred Heart, the Mount rebounded to defeat FDU the next time out to move to 3-1 in league play.

>>>> The hot start for first-year Head Coach Maria Marchesano at 3-1 was tied for the team's best opening to conference play in the last 12 seasons. The other two occasions that the Mount started 3-1 in NEC play in the last 12 seasons were during the 2012-13 and 2014-15 campaigns.

### DALY COLLECTS THE WEEKLY

>>>> Following her career performance in the win over Eastern Shore on Dec. 19, Daly Sullivan was named the Northeast Conference Rookie of the Week. Sullivan dropped a career-high 23 points on 8-of-19 shooting and a 6-for-13 mark from long range, with 20 of her 23 points coming in the second half.

>>>> Her six three-pointers are tied for eighth most in a game by a Mountaineer in program history.

>>>> Sullivan became the second Mountaineer to earn an NEC weekly award this season, joining sophomore Ashlee White, who was named the NEC Co-Player of the Week on December 11.

### CAREER NIGHT FROM WHITE

>>>> On December 9 against Rider, sophomore guard Ashlee White scored a career-high 36 points, including 26 in the second half, to power Mount St. Mary's to an 82-78 win. White's 36-point output came on 9-of-17 shooting from the floor, a 5-of-8 mark from three-point range and a 13-for-15 mark from the line, as she set new career highs

in points (36), field goals (9), three-pointers (5), free throws (13) and minutes (39).

>>>> The 36 points are tied for the third-most in a game for a Mount player since the program moved to Division I prior to the 1988-89 season.

>>>> White's performance marked the most points by a Mountaineer in a game since Myriam Baccouche also dropped 36 against Radford back in 2003.

### ALL ABOUT AGENTOWICZ

>>>> Kayla Agentowicz' streak of three straight 20-plus point performances in late November were the three highest scoring games of her career.

>>>> The sophomore began the stretch by setting new career highs in points (24), field goals (10), three-pointers (4) and minutes (40) on November 21 at Fairfield, as she became the first Mountaineer with 10-plus field goals in a game on the road since Sydney Henderson made 11 at American back in 2013.

>>>> Agentowicz followed up her career performance with a pair of 20-point outings at Morgan State and Lehigh in the next two games.

### MONTH-BY-MONTH

>>>> After going winless in the month of November, the Mount made a turn in the right direction with a 5-2 mark in December, collecting wins over Loyola, Rider, Maryland Eastern Shore, Central Connecticut and Bryant. The Mount currently owns a 1-3 record in the month of January.

### HOME SWEET HOME

>>>> The Mount owns a 257-142 all-time record at Knott Arena, including a 3-2 mark this season. The Mount has posted a 95-61 mark in Northeast Conference games on its home court.

>>>> The Mountaineers have registered double-digit wins at home in 11 different seasons.

### PLAYOFF PEDIGREE

>>>> The Mountaineers finished the 2016-17 campaign at 12-18 overall and 10-8 in conference play as they earned their sixth straight NEC playoff appearance.

>>>> The Mount leads all Northeast Conference teams with nine regular season titles, and is tied for third-most NEC Tournament titles, with three.

### FINISHING NON-CONFERENCE STRONG

>>>> After opening the season with six straight losses, the Mount turned things around beginning in early December and won three of its final five non-conference games.

>>>> The three non-conference victories were the most for the Mountaineers since the 2013-14 campaign, when they registered six wins and finished at 19-14 overall en route to earning a trip to the WNIT.

### ON THE MARCH

>>>> On May 1, Mount St. Mary's introduced Maria Marchesano as the sixth head coach in Mount women's basketball program history

>>>> Marchesano came to the Mount following a one-year stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season.

>>>> Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure.

## PRESEASON COACHES POLL

>>> The Mount was picked to finish eighth in the Northeast Conference Coaches Poll for the second straight season.

>>> Last year, the Mountaineers outperformed their preseason ranking and finished as the No. 5 seed in the league.

## COACHES CONNECTION

>>> Assistant Coaches Ciara Geiger and Kelsey Funderburgh each have a connection to Head Coach Maria Marchesano prior to Mount St. Mary's.

>>> Geiger was a player under Marchesano at Urbana University, and went on to coach alongside Marchesano at Walsh University during the 2015-16 season.

>>> Funderburgh played for Marchesano at Walsh University for three seasons from 2013-16.

## A FAMILIAR NAME

>>> First-year Assistant Coach Julie Kaufman is the older sister of former Mount St. Mary's standout, Jessie Kaufman.

>>> Jessie, who played for the Mountaineers from 2010-14, ranks sixth all-time in program history in three-pointers made (158), ninth in blocked shots (67) and 33rd in career points (837).

## KEY RETURNEES

>>> The Mount brought back nine of 13 players and 57.7% of its scoring from last year's squad. Three starters from last year returned in sophomore Ashlee White and seniors Katrice Dickson and Caroline Hummell.

>>> Hummell led the squad with 10.3 points per game and ranked second in rebounding with 5.2 per game last year. Dickson and White ranked fourth in fifth on the squad in scoring, respectively, and White topped the team in assists.

## FRESH FACES

>>> The Mount brought in six new freshmen to help bolster this year's squad: Bridget Birkhead (Doylestown, Pa.), Rebecca Lee (Severn, Md.), Hunter Rowson (Upper Marlboro, Md.), Jatarrikah Settle (Odenton, Md.), Daly Sullivan (South Bend, Ind.) and Aryna Taylor (Ashland, Va.).

>>> The recruiting class was ranked among the top-67 in the nation by BlueStar report and the No. 1 class in the Northeast Conference by The Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.

>>> Guard Daly Sullivan was ranked the 77th best recruit in the country by Prospects Nation, 154th by BlueStar Report and 190th by The Collegiate Girls Basketball Report.

>>> Head Coach Maria Marchesano named seniors Katrice Dickson and Caroline Hummell, junior Juliette Lawless and sophomore Kayla Agentowicz team captains prior to the start of the season.

## MARIA MARCHESANO BIO

Maria Marchesano was named the sixth head coach in Mount St. Mary's women's basketball history on May 1, 2017.

Marchesano came to the Mount following a stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season. During the campaign, the Jags collected seven wins versus RPI top-100 teams and earned their highest RPI ranking in program history (53). Marchesano coached three All-Summit League honorees and one Academic All-Summit League member during her season with the Jags.

Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University in North Canton, Ohio. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure at the helm.

In her final season at Walsh, she guided the Cavaliers to a 20-9 overall record and 16-6 mark in GLIAC play, as they earned home-court advantage for the first time ever in the conference tournament. During the regular season, the Cavaliers registered an upset-victory over third-ranked Ashland University, which was the highest-ranked opponent Walsh had ever defeated as a Division II program.

Marchesano got her first experience as a head coach at Urbana University in Urbana, Ohio midway through the 2011-12 season. She inherited a 2-8 team in January, before turning the season around, guiding the Knights to a 12-7 record after taking over the helm, which included an eight-game winning streak at home. The team qualified for the D-II Ohio Independent Championships, and Marchesano was named the D-II Independent Coach of the Year. The following season, Marchesano led the Knights to a G-MAC Conference Tournament Championship.

Before her time at Urbana, Marchesano served as an assistant coach for both the women's basketball and softball programs at Manchester College in North Manchester, Indiana from 2010-12.

During her collegiate career, Marchesano was a four-year letter winner at Butler University in women's basketball, and also played one season on the softball team. The Fort Wayne, Indiana native was named the Butler Freshman Female Athlete of the Year, earned Horizon League All-Newcomer Team honors, and was a recipient of the Butler Team Community Service Award. Marchesano finished her career as the second-best three-point shooter in program history. Following her collegiate career, she went on to sign three professional basketball contracts and five professional softball contracts in the Italian Federation.
