BULLDOGS CLOSE ROAD SWING IN LORETTO

- The Bryant University football team wraps up its three-game road trip Saturday in Loretto.
- Saturday will be Bryant's final road conference game of the season.
- Saturday's game will stream live on NECFrontRow.

OPENING DRIVE: BULLDOGS FALL TO SACRED HEART

- Bryant was unable to stop the running attack of Sacred Heart in a 49-26 loss last Saturday.
- The Pioneers racked up 538 rush yards and scored seven rushing touchdowns.
- Bryant also posted a season-high of 256 rush yards, led by a career-high 133 from Brenden Femiano.
- Thomas Costigan made 12 tackles in the game, giving him a program record 257.

BEIRNE STADIUM UNDERGOES RENOVATION

- Beirne Stadium underwent a major face lift over the last 10 months as FieldTurf and lights were added to the 20-year old field.
- The additions makes Bryant the only one of three DI football programs in the state of Rhode Island to have a turf field and permanent lights.
- Bryant played its first-ever home night game on Sept. 15 vs. Marist.

- The Bryant football program was formed in 1998 and played its first varsity season in 1999.
- Bryant has won 112 games and has made a pair of DII NCAA appearances in the previous 19-plus seasons.

HOME SWEET HOME

- The Bulldogs are now 19-5 at home since 2014.
- In 19-plus seasons, the Black and Gold are 71-35 (.676) at home.

THE SERIES WITH SAINT FRANCIS U

- Bryant and Saint Francis U will be meeting for the 11th time on Friday. Bryant leads, 6-4.
- SFU has won each of the last two meetings, including a 30-14 victory last season at Bryant.
- The Bulldogs won the first four meetings but SFU has won four of the last six.
- Bryant is 3-2 all-time in Loretto.

A BIT ABOUT THE RED FLASH

- SFU enters Saturday at 3-5 overall and 1-2 in NEC play following a win over Robert Morris.
- All five of the Red Flash losses have come by one score or less.
- SFU leads the league in scoring defense (20.6) and total defense (292.5).
- The Red Flash also average 30 points per game but a league-low 323 yards per game.
- Kamron Lewis and Cyrus Holder rank 2-3 in the NEC in receiving yards/game and have combined for 9 TD receptions.
- Defensively, Da'Jon Lee has seven sacks and 15.5 tackles for a loss.
- The Red Flash allow just 182 passing yards per game and feature 3 of the top 5 in pass breakups in the NEC.

INTERVIEW POLICIES

Postgame Interviews: Bryant University locker rooms are closed to all media. A 10-minute cooling off period will be strictly enforced, after which the Bryant head coach and requested players will be made available to the media. Postgame interviews will be conducted outside each team's respective locker room. Requests for visiting coaches and players should be made through the opponent's sports information contact.

Player/Coach Interview Policy: Interviews other than those immediately following a contest must be requested and arranged through a member of the Bryant University athletic communications staff. Interviews will be arranged by the athletic communication staff at a time that will not interfere with the student-athlete's academic schedule. Requests should be made at least one day in advance to allow proper notification to the player or coach. At no time will the home or cell phone number of a coach or player be released to the media. In the case of telephone interview requests, arrangements will be made for the student-athlete to contact the requesting media member.

MEDIA POLICIES

Working Press Credentials: Press and photographer media credentials will be issued to members of the working media only. Credentials for all Bryant home games can be obtained by contacting the Athletic Communications Office in writing or by telephone. Credentials will be left at will call. Press pass requests should be made no later than 24 hours prior to a home contest to ensure space availability.

Press Box: Only credentialed members of the media, coaches, league officials and designated administrators will be allowed in the press box area. The Bryant Athletic Communications Office will provide a game program, current press release, pregame statistics and game notes prior to each contest. A full boxscore, play-by-play, drive chart and other applicable game material will be distributed at halftime and at the end of the game.

Media Work Room: Ample work space with power outlets, telephones and internet access will be available for media members who need to file postgame reports. For men's and women's basketball contests, the Bulldog Room, located on the second floor of the Chace Athletic Center, will serve as a media workroom and postgame interview location.

Radio: Radio stations planning to broadcast Bryant home contests must make arrangements with the Athletic Communications Office at least two weeks prior to the requested game. Telephone lines will be supplied by the university, provided the requested notice is given. All calls must be made either on a collect or calling card basis.

BULLDOGS PICKED THIRD IN NEC PRESEASON POLL

- Bryant was picked third and received one first-place vote in the NEC Coach's Preseason Poll.
- The Bulldogs finished second in the NEC in 2017.
- Defending champ Central Connecticut was picked first and Duquesne was slotted second.

RECORD SIX BULLDOGS NAMED PRESEASON ALL-NEC

- Bryant placed a program-record six players on the Preseason All-NEC team that was announced at the annual #NECFB Social Media Day at MetLife Stadium.
- Tom Kennedy was selected as wide receiver, while Jean Constant and Gavin Rowley were both picked as specialists.
- On defense, Thomas Costigan, Dillon Guthro and Kevin Lazo all received recognition.

COSTIGAN AND CONSTANT NAMED PRESEASON ALL-AMERICANS

- Costigan and Constant were both named Second Team Preseason All-Americans by STATS FCS.
- They are the first players in program history to earn the recognition from STATS FCS and the first Preseason All-Americans since Jeff Covitz in 2015.
- Costigan and Constant are also two of only five from the NEC to make the list.

COSTIGAN NAMED TO BUCK BUCHANAN AWARD WATCH LIST

- Following a dominant junior season, Costigan opens the season on the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List, given to the top defensive player in the FCS.
- Costigan joins Jeff Covitz as the only Bryant players to be added to the prestigious list.
- He is one of 25 players across the country on the initial list.

HOME OPENER SUCCESS

- Following its win over New Haven, Bryant is now 17-3 all-time in home openers.
- The Bulldogs have won each of their last six and are 10-1 in home openers at the DI level.
- In total, Bryant is 19-5 at home over the last four-plus years.

BULLDOGS SET PROGRAM RECORD AT FORDHAM

- The Bulldogs posted a program-record 628 yards of total offense at Fordham last week.
- It is just the second time in program history that Bryant has put up 600+ yards of offense.
- The previous record was 608 and came last season against Fordham as well.

LONG START STREAKS

- Bryant has several players that have started in each of the last 29 games.
- That list includes Thomas Costigan, Kevin Lazo and Shawn Gholson.

OFFENSIVE GAME NOTES

PRICE IS RIGHT

- Redshirt senior QB Price Wilson enjoyed a record-breaking season in 2017, throwing for a program-record 3,311 yards.
- Wilson also set program records for completions (257), attempts (431) and total offense (3,263).
- Wilson posted 24 touchdowns and 18 interceptions, completing 59.6 percent of his passes.

MR. WILSON

- Wilson is off to a strong start in 2018, completing 181-of-300 attempts (60.3) for 2,076 yards, 18 touchdowns and seven interceptions.
- He's thrown for over 250 yards in five of the eight games, including a season-high 380 passing yards in week 8 at Fordham.
- Wilson is 12th nationally in TD passes, 15th in yards, 10th in completions per game, 18th in yards per game and 28th in points responsible for.

COMPLETIONS PILE UP

- A year after completing a program record 257 passes (23.4 per game), Wilson is well ahead of that pace in 2018.
- His 22.63 completions per game rank 10th nationally.
- He completed 32 passes vs. Marist, the third-most in a single game in program history, and 30 against Fordham.
- Wilson has recorded the only four 30+ completion games in program history.

REACHING 4,000...AND 5,000

- Wilson surpassed a milestone in week three vs. Marist, becoming the fifth QB in school history to record 4,000+ passing yards in a career.
- He became just the fourth to surpass 5,000 passing yards in week 8.

CONSTANT DOES IT ALL

- Jean Constant was one of the top all-purpose players in the country in 2017, finishing the season fifth nationally with 148.45 AP yards per game.
- He posted 140 or more AP yards in seven of the 11 games last season.
- Constant finished with 48 catches for 594 yards and seven touchdowns, and added a program-record 989 kick return yards.

TO THE HOUSE

- Constant tied the program record with two kick return scores last fall.
- He posted a program-record tying 100-yard return at Wagner and added a second score at Robert Morris.
- Constant opened the 2018 season with a 100-yard kick return score.
- His three return scores are tied with Jose Depadua for the school record.

CONSTANT-LY WORKING

- Constant posted a career-high 218 all-purpose yards in the 2018 opener.
- He set career highs in receptions (10), receiving yards (118) and TDs (3).
- Constant added six catches for 95 yards and two scores in week three.
- Constant added a rushing TD in week 8, giving him 20 career TDs.

CONSTANT SURPASSES 1,000 RECEIVING YARDS

- Constant reached a milestone in week three, becoming just the ninth player in program history with 1,000+ career receiving yards.
- He has caught 93 passes for 1,199 yards and 14 touchdowns.

KENNEDY RETURNS TO THE LINEUP

- Tom Kennedy, Bryant's leading receiver last year, returned to the field at Duquesne after missing the first four games.
- He carried the ball twice and also caught two passes in his 2018 debut.

HEY, TK!

- Kennedy enjoyed one of the best games in program history at Fordham, making 13 catches for 221 yards.
- The 13 catches are the most in a single-game in program history, while the yardage was three shy of the single-game record.
- He is the first player since 2012 (Jordan Harris) to post 200+ receiving yards.

NISIVOCIA EMERGES

- Vinny Nisivoccia hadn't played in a varsity contest prior to last season. He went on to play in all 11 games and finished fourth on the team with 29 catches for 381 yards and a touchdown.
- Nisivoccia was Bryant's best third down wide receiver, making eight first-down catches on third down plays.
- At Stony Brook, he caught four passes for 61 yards and 2 TDs, while posting a

career-high 186 all-purpose yards.

- He posted his second-career 100-yard game in week 4, making a career-high eight catches for 115 yards.
- Nisivoccia added a 51-yard TD reception in week 6 at Duquesne.
- In week 8, Nisivoccia caught a career-high 9 passes for 104 yards and two TDs.

MULTIPLE 100-YARD RECEIVERS

- Kennedy and Nisivoccia both finished the Fordham game with 100+ receiving yards.
- They were also the last duo to accomplish the feat, doing so in the 2017 finale vs. Duquesne.

FEMIANO POSTS MULTIPLE 100-YARD GAMES

- Senior Brenden Femiano rushed for 106 yards on 19 carries in week 2 at Stony Brook.
- It was the first time in his career that he has surpassed the century mark.
- Femiano became the first Bulldog since 2015 to post multiple 100-yard games when he set a career-high with 133 at Sacred Heart in week 9.

FEMIANO SURPASSES 1,000 CAREER YARDS

- Femiano became the seventh player in DI program history to record 1,000+ career rushing yards in week three.
- He ranks 9th all-time with 1,348 career rushing yards.

YOU CAN CALL ME ALFRED

- Redshirt sophomore Alfred Dorbor posted his first-career 100-yard game at Fordham, rushing for 116 yards and two scores.
- Dorbor added 87 yards on a career-high 20 carries in week 9 at Sacred Heart.
- Dorbor has rushed for a TD in five of the eight games this season and has a team-high six.

ADEBOBOYE STEPPING RIGHT IN

- True freshman Daniel Adeboboye is quickly making a name for himself, rushing for 186 yards and two TDs on 42 carries (4.4 per carry).
- Adeboboye posted a season-high 54 yards on just five carries in week four, including a 29-yard TD run.
- Adeboboye has also caught nine passes for 48 yards.

MCCRAY RETURNS

- Sophomore Isaac McCray returned to the field in week three vs. Marist.
- McCray had missed the last eight games dating back to last year.
- He carried the ball six times for 26 yards in the contest.
- McCray followed that up with a team-high 13 carries for 53 yards and a TD in week 4.
- McCray has rushed for 164 yards and two TDs on 41 carries.

RUN GAME SUCCESS

- Bryant has rushed for 150+ yards five times this season, including a season-high 257 at Sacred Heart.
- Bryant has rushed for 200+ yards in back-to-back games for the first time since 2014.

MCNEAL MAKING IMPACT

- Redshirt freshman Shelton McNeal has posted 16 catches for 215 yards and two TDs on the season.
- He had a season-high 81 receiving yards vs. Marist on his way to NEC Rookie of the Week honors.

BURT BREAKS OUT

- Sophomore Declan Burt posted four catches for 92 yards and two TDs vs. RMU.
- The TDs were the first two of his career, while the 92 yards are a career-high.

HINDLE MAKES FIRST-CAREER START

- Redshirt freshman Chris Hindle made his first-career start last week.
- Hindle led the Bulldogs on a scoring drive to open the game and finished 4-of-6 for 27 yards and also rushed twice for 21 yards.
- Hindle became the first freshman to start at QB since Charlie Granatell in 2004.

SAMPERI FOR THE WIN

- Sophomore Luke Samperi kicked a game-winning 42-yard field goal at Fordham.
- The field goal came as time expired, making it the first walk-off win in program history.

DEFENSIVE GAME NOTES

COSTIGAN ENJOYS MEMORABLE 2017

- Thomas Costigan picked up NEC and ECAC Defensive Player of the Year honors in 2017 after posting 103 tackles, 11.5 sacks, 17 tackles for a loss and four forced fumbles.
- He joins Jeff Covitz as the only Bulldogs to win NEC Defensive Player of the Year honors.
- Costigan was just the second player in program history with 100+ tackles in a single season and he tied the single-season sack record.
- He posted 10+ tackles on five occasions, including a career-high 16 in the season finale.

WHAT A STRETCH FOR COSTIGAN

- Costigan has absolutely dominated over the last 23 games dating back to 2016.
- Starting with a Oct. 29 game at Duquesne in 2016, Costigan has posted 220 tackles (9.6 per game), 19 sacks, 35.0 tackles for a loss and nine forced fumbles.

FORCED FUMBLES

- Costigan has been one of the best in the country at forcing fumbles the last two-plus seasons.
- He ranked eighth nationally with 0.36 forced fumbles per game in 2016 and fourth nationally with 0.36 in 2017.
- Costigan leads all active FCS players with 12 forced fumbles.

- Costigan became Bryant's all-time leading tackler in week 9 at Sacred Heart.
- He now has 257 in his career, one more than Marquise Watson.

- Junior Tomas Wright has been one of the Bulldogs top defensive ends since stepping on campus.
- He has played in all 30 games over his first two-plus seasons, posting 71 tackles and 18.5 sacks.
- Wright's 18.5 sacks rank 7th in program history.

WRIGHT ONE OF THE TOPS IN THE NATION

- Wright currently ranks second nationally in sacks per game (1.19) and third in TFLs/game (1.9).
- He has posted 9.5 sacks and 15.5 TFLs through the first eight games.

- After a monster 3-sack, 4.5-TFL outing at Duquesne, Wright has posted 7.5 sacks and 11.5 TFLs in his last five games.

WRIGHT WINS GOLD HELMET, NEC DEFENSIVE POTW HONORS

- Wright became the first Bulldog to win the New England Gold Helmet since 2016 after he posted 2.5 sacks, 4 TFLs and two forced fumbles vs. RMU.
- He is the first defensive lineman to win the Gold Helmet since Covitz in '14.

BRACKETT BACK AFTER STRONG ROOKIE SEASON

- Andre Brackett was named the NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year last fall, becoming the second player to earn the honor in program history.
- Brackett posted 24 tackles and tied for the team lead with two interceptions.
- Both interceptions came in the final two games of the season.
- He's opened 2018 with 32 tackles and a team-leading seven pass breakups.

NEMEROWICZ ROARS BACK

- Junior Jesse Nemerowicz missed the first five games in 2017 and then made up for the lost time by dominating the final six weeks.
- He made 61 tackles over the final six games, leading the NEC in tackles per game in NEC-only contests.
- Nemerowicz posted 10+ tackles in three of the six games, including a career-high 16 in his first game back.

NEMEROWICZ MAKING THE HITS

- Nemerowicz has played in all 24 games he's been healthy for in his first two-plus seasons.
- He led the Black and Gold with 91 tackles as a true freshman and now has 203 tackles in his career.
- Nemerowicz ranks eighth among active FCS players with 8.5 tackles per game.

- Nemerowicz became the 12th player in program history to record 200 career

tackles in week 9 at Sacred Heart.

- Nemerowicz still has one full season of eligibility remaining.

- Kevin Lazo is also back for his fifth year in Smithfield. Lazo has appeared in all but one game during his Bryant career.

BROWN'S BIG DAY VS. RMU

- Junior Robert Brown made a career-high 11 tackles in week 4 vs. RMU.
- He now ranks third on the team with 49 tackles this season.

HEAD COACH JAMES PERRY

James Perry begins his second season as the head coach of the Bryant football program in 2018. Perry was hired as third head coach in program history on January 3, 2017.

Perry wasted little time getting the Bulldogs back on track, closing the 2017 season on a four-game winning streak to a post a 6-5 record on the year. In NEC play, Bryant went 4-2, finishing in a tie for second in the final league standings after being picked sixth in the preseason poll.

Bryant's offense thrived under Perry's watchful eye, averaging nearly 100 more yards per game and finishing the year with an average of 30.3 points per game. The Black and Gold also shattered the program's passing record in 2017 as Price Wilson became just the second QB in NEC history to throw for over 3,000 yards (3,311) in a single season.

Wilson would go on to earn All-NEC Second Team honors, marking the fifth-straight year that Perry mentored an all-league signal caller. In total, Perry coached eight All-NEC selections, the NEC Defensive Player of the Year, NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year and two All-Americans in his first season in Smithfield.

Prior to arriving in Smithfield, Perry spent the past seven seasons as the offensive coordinator at Princeton University.

An outstanding quarterback during his playing days, Perry has instilled an offensive mentality of "Fast and Physical" football to each of his coaching

stops. He has led Princeton to Ivy League titles in 2013 and 2016, coaching three All-Ivy League quarterbacks over the past four seasons and guiding the Tigers into one of the program's most impressive offensive eras.

This past fall, Perry's Tiger offense ranked atop the Ivy League in scoring (34.6 points per game), total offense (415.5 yards per game) and rushing offense (183.2 yards per game) on its way to the program's second Ivy League Championship in four years. He guided quarterback John Lovett to a First Team All-America recognition in 2016 after the junior paced the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) with a Princeton-record 20 rushing touchdowns. Lovett also became the second quarterback under Perry to win the Bushnell Cup as the Ivy League's Offensive Player of the Year.

In the 2013 championship season, Perry guided the Tigers to a pair of Ivy League-record offensive trends, averaging 43.7 points and 511.6 yards per game. Perry's unit finished second nationally in scoring offense, sixth in turnover margin and eighth in total offense. Under Perry's tutelage, quarterback Quinn Epperly was named the Ivy League Offensive Player of the Year and a finalist for the 2013 Walter Payton Award, given to the top offensive player in the FCS.

In total, Perry coached 36 All-Ivy League offensive selections in his seven seasons at Princeton.

A 2000 graduate of Brown University, Perry is no stranger to the Ocean State, spending three years at his alma mater as an offensive assistant before joining the Princeton staff in 2010. He coached the quarterbacks and served as recruiting coordinator for the Bears, helping them win an Ivy League crown in 2008. Michael Dougherty thrived under Perry, graduating eighth all-time in league history with 487 career completions and 11th all-time with 5,763 career passing yards while also setting a still-standing Ivy League record for total offense in a game (538 yards in 2008).

Prior to his tenure at Brown, Perry made coaching stops at the University of Delaware (2006, running backs), the University of Maryland (2004-05, offensive graduate assistant), Williams College (2002-04, quarterbacks/recruiting coordinator) and Dartmouth College (2001, quarterbacks/wide receivers assistant). While at Delaware, Perry helped shape the Blue Hens into a I-AA leader in passing offense, total offense and scoring offense.

As a quarterback at Brown, Perry led the Bears to the 1999 Ivy League Championship, finishing the season with 3,255 passing yards and 27 touchdowns. He was named a finalist for the Walter Payton Award and was the recipient of both the Bulger Lowe Award as the Outstanding Offensive Player of the Year in New England and the New England Football Writers Gold Helmet of the Year. He was a three-time First Team All-Ivy League pick and earned the 1999 Ivy League Player of the Year.

In addition to his numerous accolades, Perry set virtually every school and Ivy League passing record during his playing career. He graduated as the all-time leader in total offense in a career (9,236), passing yards in a career (9,294) and season (3,255), completions in a career (789) and season (309), and touchdown passes in a career (74) and game (6), still holding the Ivy League mark in the final three. Perry threw for over 400 yards in a game seven times in his career.

Following his collegiate career, Perry spent the 2001 season playing professionally in NFL Europe and the Arena Football League.

A native of Andover, Mass., Perry graduated from Brown with a Bachelor of Arts in Economics and went on to earn a Master's in Education Policy and Leadership from the University of Maryland in 2006. He attended Malden Catholic High School in Malden, Mass., where he was named the 1996 Boston Globe Massachusetts High School Athlete and Scholar-Athlete of the Year.

He and his wife, Abby, have two sons, Samuel and Nathaniel, and a daughter, Rosemary.

How it happened

- Bryant received the opening kickoff and went 75 yards in four plays to take the early lead. Tom Kennedy made a 51-yard catch on third-and-long and Vinny Nisivoccia followed with a 25-yard TD reception to make it 7-0 just 56 seconds in.
- After a three-and-out by Fordham, Bryant drove 59 yards in six plays to make it 14-0. Back-to-back runs from Alfred Dorbor put the ball at the Fordham 25 and Brenden Femiano scored on the next play.
- The Rams got on the board with a field goal but Bryant quickly answered with a three-play, 68-yard drive to make it 21-3 with 7:06 left in the first quarter. Dorbor opened the drive with a 36-yard run and then broke free of three tacklers for a 32-yard TD run.
- Fordham then rattled off the next 24 points to take a 27-21 lead with 10:05 left in the third quarter. Austin Longi and Isaiah Searight posted TD receptions to make it a one-point game at the break and Tyriek Hopkins' 14-yard run gave the Rams the lead in the third.
- Bryant answered with a seven-play, 75-yard drive to tie the game. Kennedy made a great diving catch for a 29-yard gain to the Fordham 36 and Price Wilson hooked up with Nisivoccia for a 15-yard touchdown two plays later.
- The Rams turned an interception into a lead four minutes later. Noah Fitzgerald returned the interception to the Bryant 8 and Tim DeMorat threw a TD pass to Longi on the first play to make it 34-27.
- The Black and Gold responded with a 12-play, 75-yard drive. Wilson and Nisivoccia connected for 13 yards to convert on third down and Jean Constant capped the drive with a nine-yard TD run. The PAT was blocked, however, putting Bryant down one.
- Fordham extended the lead to eight on an eight-yard TD reception by Hunter Harris with 10:42 left in the game.
- The score was the same when Fordham pinned the Bulldogs at their own 1 with 6:30 left in the game. Bryant drew the Rams offside on 4th-and-3 from the Bryant 19 before back-to-back 16-yard plays put the ball in Fordham territory. Wilson then completed passes of 15 and 25 to Constant and Kennedy to put the ball inside the 10. After a holding call, an 11-yard reception by Kennedy put the ball at the 2 and Dorbor pounded it home. Bryant's two-point conversion failed.
- Bryant's defense then forced a three-and-out, giving Wilson the ball back with 1:24 left. Wilson completed four passes to Kennedy, three to Declan Burt and one to Constant. Burt was able to get out of bounds with 20 seconds left and Wilson followed with completions of 11 and 16 to Kennedy and then spiked the ball with four seconds left. Luke Samperi then stepped up and drilled the game-winning field goal as time expired.

How it happened

- Bryant recovered an errant snap on Sacred Heart's first possession and needed just four plays to take the lead. Alfred Dorbor capped the short drive with a one-yard plunge.
