THE STARTING NINE

- 1 Head Coach Jess O'Donnell is in her first year at SFU, O'Donnell replaces Jennifer Patrick-Swift who left Saint Francis after six seasons for North Carolina State
- 2 The Red Flash return four of their top five run producers from a season ago, Saint Francis led the NEC and was 35th in the NCAA with 5.6 runs per game in 2018
- 3 The Red Flash picked up where they left off in 2018, averaging 6.5 runs through 9 games, tops in the NEC and 31st in the NCAA
- 4 Reigning NEC Player of the Year Cheyenne McKee is among the SFU returners, McKee is now 4th all time at SFU with 192 hits, 27th on NCAA active list
- 5 McKee is also #2 on the NCAA active career leaderboard with 57 hit-by-pitches, McKee was third in the NCAA last year, getting hit 25 times
- 6 Senior Hayley Norton has gotten off to scorching start, hitting .568 so far this season and is 4th in the NCAA with 25 hits
- 7 Norton moved to second all-time on the SFU career hit list (196) and homers (47), she is six hits shy and one homer shy of tying both records
- 8 Additionally, Norton leads the NCAA in total bases with 49 and sixth in RBI with 22, her 47 career homers are 4th on the NCAA career list as are her 175 RBI
- 9 The Red Flash will turn to freshmen Lauren Bertig, Christina Clark and Meadow Uncapher as well as senior utility player Mikayla Bower to handle pitching duties

The dawn of a New Era

2019 will start the Jess O'Donnell coaching era at Saint Francis as she was named the 12th coach in school history in the fall. O'Donnell takes over from Jennifer Patrick-Swift who took over at NC State after winning back-to-back Northeast Conference titles.

50 Year Celebration

2018-19 marks the 50 year anniversary of women's athletics at Saint Francis. Saint Francis softball's modern era enters its 33rd season in 2019. The Red Flash first took the field in 1986 under the direction of head coach Tom "Huck" Cicero. They earned their first victory in their second game, a 5-4 triumph over Juniata and their first D-I win, a 4-3 victory over Robert Morris during that season.

We're Going Streaking

The Red Flash currently own a 38-game conference winning streak after going 16-0 each of the past two regular seasons and 3-0 in each NEC tournament. Saint Francis last NEC regular season loss came on May 5, 2016, a 5-4 setback to Central Connecticut and last loss in tournament play came on May 13, 2016 to RMU in the NEC tournament. The 38-game conference win streak is the longest current streak in the NCAA and fourth-longest all-time

Closing Strong

Saint Francis has closed games strong so far this season, last season and made the NEC tournament. The Red Flash are a perfect 7-0 when leading after seven innings.

EXTRA EXTRA

The Red Flash have connected on 43 extra base hits this season (19 doubles, 8 triples, 16 home runs). That accounts for 38 percent of the Red Flash hits this season. Saint Francis is 27th in the nation in slugging percentage so far this season and 23rd in total bases. SFU is also a perfect 5-0 when hitting at least two homers in a game.

Scouting the Weekend

Saint Francis has only faced Michigan State in program history, ending up on the wrong end of a 16-0 contest back in 2003.

The Red Flash will see a familiar face in junior pitcher Abby Trahan when SFU faces the Golden Eagles. Trahan was the NEC Rookie of the Year and Co-Pitcher of the Year in her two seasons in Loretto. Southern Miss was picked ninth in the Conference USA but Trahan was named to the top-100 College Softball list and catcher Samantha Papp was named Pre-season All-Conference.

The Spartans are off to a 3-10 start to the season and are coming off a 0-4 weekend at the Purple Classic hosted by Grand Canyon. Charla Echols leads the team with a 400 average while Ebenee Echols has a pair of homers and nine driven in. In the circle, Jordan Watson has one of the three victories as well as a Spartan-best 2.94 ERA.

#6 Alabama has had little trouble with their early-season slate, running off 15-straight wins to start the season and rising to #6 in the USA Today Top-25. Bailey Hemphill and Kaylee Tow are living up to their pre-season accolades as All-NEC selections. Hemphill leads the Tide with 23 RBI while Tow is hitting .389 with 19 runs scored. In the circle, Alabama is sporting a 1.86 team ERA with six shutouts. Leading the way is Montan Fouts who is 6-0 with a 0.54 ERA and 48 strikeouts in 39 innings against just three walks.

The two-time defending conference champion Saint Francis softball team was picked to finish third in the Northeast Conference pre-season poll as voted on by the conference coaches.

Sacred Heart was the unanimous choice amongst the conference coaches. The Pioneers return their top two pitchers from a staff that held a 1.90 earned run average last season and made the NEC tournament. The Red Flash are a perfect 7-0 when leading after seven innings. LIU Brooklyn rides a runner-up finish in last year's NEC tournament to a second-place showing in this year's poll. The Blackbirds will be led by reigning NEC Rookie of the Year Ryleigh Bermea and Patricia Griffin, headlining an offense that hit .299 as a team last season.

Following the Red Flash, Central Connecticut, Bryant, Fairleigh Dickinson, Mount St. Mary's, Wagner and Robert Morris round out the poll.
