SAINT FRANCIS UNIVERSITY RED FLASH FOOTBALL

Offense

Jeff Hoenstine improved to 2-1 as a starter on his way to a second Northeast Conference Rookie of the Week honor. He leads the Red Flash with 424 passing yards, three passing touchdowns and adds a 58.8 completion percentage. Markell Holman took the team lead with 336 rushing yards (fifth in the NEC) after his 182-yard performance at Delaware State. It was the most rushing yards by a Red Flash player since a 220-yard performance by Marcus Bagley on Sept. 17, 2016. DeMarcus McElroy ranks sixth in the NEC with 319 rushing yards. Gavin Thomson ranks 36th in the FCS with 69.3 receiving yards per game and has led Saint Francis in receiving in three of his four games played.

Defense

Saint Francis remains eighth in the FCS with 279 total yards of offense against and ranks 11th with 96.6 rushing yards against per game. Trey McLeer and Pierre Royster lead the unit with 32 total tackles. Paul Tangelo is second in the NEC with 6.0 tackles for loss and 4.0 sacks, followed by Eyan Thomas' fourth-ranked 5.0 tackles for loss. Eight different Red Flash players have one sack this season.

Special Teams

Mac Plummer had a successful onside kick attempt that was recovered by Mason Frye with 5:38 remaining in the game against Delaware State. Plummer kicked the ball towards the sideline at the Delaware State 35-yard line with a bounce that stayed in. Aidan Cirulli is tied for third in the NEC with eight punts inside the 20-yard line.

Last Time Out

Saint Francis used a fourth-quarter rally to defeat Delaware State 28-17. The Red Flash started the scoring on a seven-yard touchdown pass to McElroy before the extra point was blocked. Delaware State responded with the next 17 points scored on a two-yard rushing touchdown, 34-yard field goal and 23-yard rushing touchdown. With under six minutes remaining in the game, trailing 17-6, Thomson scored a one-yard touchdown and converted the two-point attempt and cut the deficit to 17-14 with 5:38 remaining. Plummer had a successful onside kick attempt after, and Holman scored two plays later on a 30-yard rush after hurdling a defender to open a 21-17 lead with 4:51 remaining. After a defensive stop, the Red Flash offense drained the clock before Holman had a 55-yard rushing touchdown with 1:08 remaining to seal the victory.

NOTES**Saint Francis Makes History, Earns First Victory Over FBS Program**

The Red Flash took down FBS member Kent State 23-17 on Sept. 7 to mark its first win over an FBS opponent in program history. The Red Flash opened a 17-0 lead in the game and led by nine points most of the second half until a Kent State field goal in the final two minutes made it a six-point game. Kicker Mac Plummer was named Stats Perform FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week for his 50, 46 and 33-yard field goal conversions. Saint Francis had played four FBS opponents since its first in 2021 and led at halftime in two of the four games. The other Saint Francis lost 30-23 in overtime at Akron in 2022. The victory, at the time, was the second FCS-over-FBS win of the 2024 season. Saint Francis also became the second NEC program to defeat an FBS opponent joining Duquesne who defeated Ohio 28-26 on Sept. 11, 2021.

2023 Season in Review

Saint Francis finished the 2023 season 4-6 overall and 4-3 in NEC play. It marked the third consecutive season Saint Francis finished above .500 in conference play. The Red Flash earned two All-American selections, led by Seth Osborne's Associated Press FCS Third Team nod. He became the third AP All-American in program history, joining Lorenzo Jerome and Kameron Lewis. Saint Francis totaled eight All-NEC honors last season. The Saint Francis offense led the NEC with 360.1 total yards and 27.2 total points per game. The defense ranked third with 354.4 yards against and tied for third with 26.4 points against per game.

Saint Francis to Host Duquesne Exclusively on ESPN+

The Northeast Conference announced Saint Francis will host Duquesne on Saturday, Oct. 12 at 12 p.m. and will air exclusively on ESPN+. The game is one of two NEC football games to air exclusively to ESPN+ this season – Robert Morris vs. Mercyhurst is the second. Saint Francis and Duquesne have won each of the last two NEC titles and the Dukes hold a 5-4 advantage over the Red Flash since 2014. Seven of the nine games were settled by 10 points or less. Last season Saint Francis trailed 38-14 with 11:48 remaining in the game and had a near comeback in a 38-35 loss.

Craig Rejoins Staff as Defensive Coordinator

Jacob Craig rejoined the Saint Francis staff in February 2024 as the program's defensive coordinator. He was part of the Red Flash coaching staff working with the defensive line and outside linebackers from 2017-19. He spent the last two seasons at NCAA Division II member California (Pa.) as the special teams coordinator and defensive line coach. The Vulcans went 13-8 during his two seasons. The program ranked second in Division II in run defense with 57.7 yards against per game and were top 15 in sacks during both seasons. He spent the 2021 season at NCAA Division III member Saint Vincent. As a player, Craig walked on at Pitt in 2012 before he earned a scholarship in 2014 as a defensive signal caller. He spent the final two seasons of his career at Clarion University where he recorded 119 total tackles (56 solo).

Casey Joins Staff as Offensive Line Coach

Cullen Casey joined the Saint Francis staff in March 2024 as the offensive line coach. He spent the 2023 season at Wisconsin as a graduate assistant when the Badgers went 7-6 and earned a spot in the ReliaQuest Bowl against LSU. He spent the prior two seasons at Liberty as a graduate assistant and he signed five players during his stint. Liberty owned a 16-10 record as an FBS Independent during the 2021-22 seasons. He also held roles at Georgetown and Gonzaga College High School prior to Liberty. He helped develop Olu Fashanu, who went to Penn State and was selected No. 11 overall by the New York Jets in the 2024 NFL Draft. He attended Old Dominion, where he was a four-time Conference USA Honor Roll Student-Athlete.

Mercyhurst, Robert Morris Join NEC Football

Mercyhurst officially began its transition from Division II to Division I in the summer of 2024 and joined the NEC as a full-time member. Robert Morris rejoined the NEC as a football-only affiliate after the Colonials spent the 2023 season in the Big South-OVC and the 2020-22 seasons in the Big South. Robert Morris is immediately eligible for the NEC's automatic bid to the FCS Playoffs. Mercyhurst starts its four-year transition before it becomes eligible for the FCS Playoffs. The Lakers will not count as a conference game in 2024 due to only scheduling four of the seven NEC opponents.

Hoenstine Earns Second NEC Rookie of the Week

Quarterback Jeff Hoenstine earned his second NEC Rookie of the Week nod on Oct. 7. He went 10-of-18 for 117 yards and two touchdowns in a comeback victory 28-17 over Delaware State. The Red Flash put up 22 points in the final 5:38 of the game.

Plummer Named FCS National Special Teams Player of the Week

Kicker Mac Plummer was named Stats Perform FCS National Player of the Week on Sept. 9. The award comes after he converted field goals from 50, 46 and 33 yards to help lead Saint Francis to its first win over an FBS program 23-17 at Kent State. His 50-yard field goal was the fifth in Saint Francis program history and is tied for the second-longest.

Hoenstine, Plummer Headline Week Two NEC Honors

Quarterback Jeff Hoenstine earned both NEC Offensive Player and Rookie of the Week and Mac Plummer earned NEC Special Teams Player of the Week. Trey McLeer, Mercury Swaim and Gavin Thomson joined the two as NEC Prime Performers. After the first two weeks of the season, Saint Francis has at least a share of all-four major NEC weekly honors.

Tangelo Tabbed NEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week

Outside linebacker Paul Tangelo was named NEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 2 after his week one performance. He had two sacks, an addition tackle for loss and two forced fumbles against Dayton. He became the first Red Flash player since 2019 to have two forced fumbles in one game. He achieved the feat with strip sacks on back-to-back plays. Tangelo was also named an honorable mention for Stats Perform FCS National Defensive Player of the Week.

Three Earn Preseason All-NEC Recognition

Mason Imbt, Eddie Bierals and Mercury Swaim all earned recognition on the 2024 Preseason All-NEC Team. Imbt was selected on the offensive line after he is set to return to guard position in 2024. He scored four touchdowns last season as a hybrid player for the Red Flash offense – two rushing, one receiving and one fumble recovered in the end zone. Bierals was selected on the defensive line and was the only player on the list who earned All-NEC honors in 2023. Swaim was selected as a linebacker to round out the preseason recognition.

Saint Francis Selected Second in NEC Preseason Poll

The Red Flash were selected to finish second in the NEC Preseason Poll and earned one first-place vote. Duquesne was picked atop the standings with five first-place votes. Robert Morris, LIU (one first-place vote), Stonehill, Wagner and Central Connecticut followed Saint Francis in that order.

Scouting Duquesne

The Dukes enter Saturday's game with a 3-2 record and are coming off a 47-21 victory over LIU in its conference opener. Duquesne is receiving votes in national top 25 polls heading into the weekend. Darius Perrantes leads the program with 574 passing yards and eight touchdowns with a 59.1 completion percentage. He is coming off a five-touchdown game against LIU. JaMario Clements leads the NEC with 493 rushing yards and his 98.6 rushing yards per game ranks 17th in the FCS. Tedy Afful sits atop the program with 217 receiving yards and four touchdowns, followed by John Erby's 215 receiving yards. Luke Miller paces the defense with 27 total tackles and is one of four players with an interception. Jack Dunkley is top 10 in the NEC with a team-high 3.0 sacks and 4.0 tackles for loss.

HEAD COACH CHRIS VILLARRIAL



Former National Football League All-Pro Offensive Lineman Chris Villarial was named the 25th head coach of the Saint Francis University football program on December 20, 2009. He served one year as the offensive coordinator under predecessor Dave Opfar before he became the head coach.

With 64 career wins, Villarial is the winningest coach in Saint Francis football history. He passed Art Martynuska (1969-79, 81 - 45 wins) with a 35-21 win at Delaware State on Nov. 23, 2019.

Villarial is a three-time NEC Coach of the Year, winning the award in 2015, 2016 and 2022. He was one of 16 finalists for the Eddie Robinson Award, which is presented to the FCS National Coach of the Year, in 2022. Villarial was the Metropolitan New York Football Writers' Bob Ford Coach of the Year in 2015 and the ECAC Coach of the Year in 2016.

Saint Francis went 4-6 overall and owned a 4-3 conference record during the 2023 season. Saint Francis defeated Stonehill in its first road conference game of the season 15-10 on Sept. 30. The Red Flash then defeated Wagner at home 31-7 on Oct. 12 in the first-ever NEC football game televised on CBS Sports Network. Saint Francis also defeated Merrimack 28-21 on Oct. 28 after completing a 15-point comeback. The Red Flash ended the 2023 season with a 49-14 road victory over Central Connecticut.

The Red Flash earned two All-American nods with offensive lineman Seth Osborne named Associated Press FCS Third Team All-American and linebacker Carter Glassmyer named Stats Perform FCS Freshman All-American. Glassmyer was also named a Jerry Rice Award Finalist, which is presented to the top freshman in the FCS.

Under Villarial's guidance, Glassmyer earned ECAC and NEC Defensive Rookie of the Year. The Red Flash earned seven total All-NEC selections, with five on the first team and two on the second team.

Saint Francis went 9-3 overall and 7-0 in conference play to earn its second NEC title in program history during the 2022 season. The undefeated conference season was the ninth in NEC history. In its second game against an FBS opponent in program history, Saint Francis took Akron to overtime and dropped the game 30-23. Saint Francis rattled off nine consecutive wins after starting 0-2, which included beating all-seven conference opponents by an average of 34.6 points per game.

He led the Red Flash to its first ever NEC Title and FCS Playoffs berth in 2016 with a 7-5 overall record and 5-1 mark in the NEC. The 2016 season also included Saint Francis' first ever appearance in a Top 25 poll, when it was ranked 25th in the STATS FCS Media Poll on November 14. SFU met Villanova in the first round of the FCS Playoffs, but fell 31-21.

In 2022: Quarterback Cole Doyle was named a Walter Payton Award Finalist, awarded to the top offensive player in the FCS. Wide receiver Makai Jackson was named a Jerry Rice Award Finalist, presented to the top freshman in the FCS, and finished third in voting. Colt Jennings was named a Doris Robinson Award Finalist, presented to an FCS student-athlete who excels on the field, in the classroom, in the community and beyond. Donnell Brown earned FCS Third Team All-America honors from Stats Perform. Saint Francis totaled two Sophomore All-American and four Freshman All-American honors from Stats Perform and HERO Sports. Doyle was named NEC Offensive Player of the Year, Brown was NEC Defensive Player of the Year and Jackson was NEC Offensive Rookie of the Year. Saint Francis earned a program-record 10 All-NEC First Team selections and added three All-NEC Second Team honors.

Da'Jon Lee was a Buck Buchanan Award Finalist in 2019, awarded to the best defensive player in FCS, while Harbridge, Dickson and Lewis were on the Walter Payton Award Watchlist. Khairi Dickson (2014) and Kamron Lewis (2016) received NEC Offensive Player of the Year under Villarial, while Anthony Abeid (2012) and Marcus Bagley (2014) earned Offensive Rookie of the Year. Lorenzo Jerome (2013), Jalen Brown (2018), Terrell Smith (2019) and Gregory Reddick (2021) won Defensive Rookie of the Year.

Nine players have gone on to professional opportunities, most recently Jermaine Ponder who played in preseason games for the Cleveland Browns, Pittsburgh Steelers and Houston Texans. He recorded an interception in the Texas final preseason game of 2019. Lorenzo Jerome became the first Saint Francis player to play in an NFL game, making his debut with the San Francisco 49ers. Jerome signed a deal with the 49ers in 2017 and has spent time with the 49ers, Seattle Seahawks and Calgary Stampeders organizations.

Villarial's teams have shown the ability to compete with the best programs in the country. The Red Flash recorded its first win over a nationally-ranked opponent in 2014, defeating No. 22 Sacred Heart 30-27. The Red Flash also defeated No. 22 Liberty 13-9 in 2017, two weeks after the Flames had defeated Baylor. Liberty transitioned to FBS the following season.

A native of Hershey, Pa., Villarial spent 11 seasons in the NFL as an offensive lineman with the Chicago Bears (1996-2004) and the Buffalo Bills (2004-06).

Villarial made an impression on NFL scouts prior by breaking the NFL Combine Bench Press Record, and was then drafted in the fifth round (152nd overall) by Dave Wannstedt in April of 1996. As a member of the Chicago Bears from 1996-2004, Villarial played six seasons under head coach Dick Jauron, and was a two-year All-Pro player in addition to being named to the All-Joe Team. He paved the way for a 1,000-yard rusher every season, blocked for Anthony Thomas, who was the NFL Offensive Rookie-of-the-Year in 2001, and was a member of an offensive line that gave up the fewest sacks in the NFL in 2001, when the Bears advanced to the NFC Divisional Playoff Game. He also received the Golden Bear Award, which is given to the rookie who has perfect attendance in the weight room.

Villarial was one of the most sought out free agents in Buffalo Bills history for head coach Mike Mularkey, and continued his streak of 1,000-yard rushers every season with the Bills. He was a member of an offensive line that gave up the fewest sacks in franchise history. Villarial, who also played two seasons in Buffalo under coach Jauron, finished his NFL career with 148 starts.

Following his professional career, Villarial returned to Ebensburg, where he served two seasons as the offensive coordinator for the Central Cambria High School football team. He led the team to two district title games, and personally helped 13 players continue their playing careers at the collegiate level, while developing and implementing a successful strength and conditioning program.

Villarial, who has been active in the community with Special Olympics and cancer research funding, played his collegiate football for head coach Frank Cignetti at Indiana University of Pennsylvania, where he studied Special Education, with a concentration in rehabilitation. While playing for IUP, Villarial was a three-year All-American and three-year all-conference player. He played in the 1993 Division II national championship game, and received the Jim Langer Award for Best Lineman in Division II in 1996. Villarial had his college jersey No. 75 retired by IUP.

Villarial is a 1991 graduate of Hershey High School, where he played for head coach Bob "Gump" May. Hershey retired Villarial's high school jersey No. 78 on May 5, 2001.
