**FRIARS VERSUS BOSTON COLLEGE...** On Saturday, the Friars will play ninth-ranked Boston College at the Conte Forum in Chestnut Hill, Mass. The Friars and the Eagles have met 90 times in the all-time series with the Friars holding a 52-38 lead. PC is 33-11 all-time at home against Boston College, 17-24 on the road and 2-3 on neutral courts against the Eagles. The two teams first met on February 16, 1942 when the Friars earned a 64-37 win at the Rhode Island Coliseum. Last season, the two teams split the home-and-home series with each team winning at home. BC defeated the Friars, 67-62, on January 8, 2000 at the Conte Forum and the Friars earned a 45-40 win over the Eagles at the Providence Civic Center on February 26, 2000. Providence leads the all-time series in BIG EAST regular-season play, 22-17.

**SCOUTING THE EAGLES...** The Eagles enter the game with an 18-3 mark overall and a 9-2 record in BIG EAST play. In their most recent game, Connecticut defeated the Eagles, 82-71, on February 13 at Hartford, Conn. BC's only other BIG EAST loss was at St. John's (73-71) on January 10. Boston College is led by 6-1 sophomore guard Troy Bell (Minneapolis, Minn.). Bell leads the team in scoring, averaging 20.5 points per game. Senior Kenny Harley (Bronx, N.Y.) also is having a strong season for the Eagles, averaging 11.5 points per game. Harley is leading the team in rebounding, averaging 6.0 rebounds per game.

**FRIARS VS. RANKED TEAMS...** The Friars have recorded a 2-1 mark against ranked teams this season. On February 10, the Friars defeated No. 15/12 Georgetown, 103-79, for the squad's second win against a ranked team in 2000-01. PC's 81-68 win over No. 13/12 Connecticut on January 13 was the Friars' first victory against a ranked opponent since PC upset No. 18 Syracuse on January 12, 1999. The win over UConn also marked PC's first victory over a top-20 opponent at home since the Friars defeated No. 8 Purdue, 87-82, on December 27, 1998. PC's game against nationally ranked Seton Hall (No. 11/11) on January 3 was the Friars' first contest this season against a ranked team.

# 2000-01 PROVIDENCE COLLEGE BASKETBALL

## FRIARS EARN SECOND WIN OVER ST. JOHN'S...

On February 14, the Friars defeated St. John's, 64-53, at Alumni Hall in Jamaica, N.Y. The victory marked only the second time ever that the Friars earned two BIG EAST regular-season wins over the Red Storm in the one season. PC's victory ended a 27-game winning streak for the Red Storm at Alumni Hall. PC held a 32-31 lead at halftime. The Friars gradually built on their lead in the second half and led by 12 with 8:21 remaining when freshman Chris Anrin (Varmdo, Sweden) hit a three-point basket for PC. St. John's cut the Friars' lead to six points at 4:08 but could not get any closer. Junior John Linehan (Chester, Pa.) was strong down the stretch for PC, finishing the game with a team high 13 points. He also was 8-8 from the free-throw line. Sophomore Abdul Mills (Brooklyn, N.Y.) was the only other Friar to score in double figures as he recorded 12 points and four assists. Senior Karim Shabazz (Far Rockaway, N.Y.) had a game-high eight rebounds.

## PC OFF TO BEST START EVER IN BIG EAST ACTION...

The Friars have posted a 9-3 mark in BIG EAST play this season. For the Friars, it marks the team's best start ever in BIG EAST play. It also marks the first time ever the team has been six games over .500 in BIG EAST play.

## PC ENDS ST. JOHN'S 27-GAME WIN STREAK AT ALUMNI HALL...

PC's 64-53 win over St. John's on February 14 ended the Red Storm's 27-game winning streak at Alumni Hall. PC's victory ended the Red Storm's second longest winning streak at Alumni Hall. St. John's longest winning streak ever at Alumni Hall was 30 games, which the Friars ended on February 14, 1987 with a 79-78 win.

## FRIARS SWEEP RED STORM...

On Wednesday, PC defeated St. John's, 64-53, for its second win of the season against the Red Storm. It marked only the second time ever that the Friars earned two BIG EAST regular-season wins against the Red Storm in one season. The 1986-87 PC squad is the only other Friar team to accomplish the feat. The 1986-87 team also earned a third win against St. John's in the BIG EAST Tournament.

## FRIAR FIRSTS VERSUS HOYAS...

PC's 103-79 victory against the Georgetown Hoyas on February 10 marked the first time ever Georgetown allowed 100 or more points

in a BIG EAST game. Also, the 24-point Friar win was the largest deficit ever for the Hoyas in a BIG EAST loss.

## FRIARS ESTABLISH BIG EAST MARK FOR POINTS IN THE FIRST HALF...

In PC's 103-79 win over 12th-ranked Georgetown on February 10, the Friars established a BIG EAST record for points in the first half with 61. The previous record was 57 points scored by Syracuse against Boston College on February 19, 1983.

## PC SETS A TEAM RECORD FOR THREE-POINT PERCENTAGE...

In the Friars' 103-79 win over Georgetown on February 10, the Friars were 14-19 from three-point territory. The team's 73.7 percentage from behind the three-point arc established a PC record for three-point percentage in a game. The previous record was .706 (12-17) against Villanova on January 10, 1987.

## FRIARS HIT CENTURY MARK FOR FIFTH TIME IN TEAM HISTORY...

The Friars' 103-79 victory over Georgetown marked the first time since 1991 the Friars scored 100 or more points in a BIG EAST game. It also marked only the fifth time in the team's history the Friars scored 100 or more points in a BIG EAST game.

## FRIARS IMPRESSIVE ON THE ROAD...

The Friars have recorded the best overall road record of any BIG EAST team with a 7-2 mark. The team is tied with Notre Dame for the top BIG EAST road mark with a 4-2 record. On January 28, PC defeated Miami, 80-70, to earn its third consecutive BIG EAST road win. For the Friars, it marked only the third time in the history of the program that the team had won three consecutive BIG EAST road games. The Friars also accomplished the feat in 1988-89 and 1989-90. In road games last year, Providence posted a 3-7 mark overall and a 2-6 record in conference games.

## FRIARS 11-2 AT THE PROVIDENCE CIVIC CENTER...

The Friars have recorded an 11-2 mark at the Providence Civic Center this season. PC opened the season with a 63-57 win over Holy Cross on November 18. The Friars have lost only two games this season at home. The two losses were against Maine (80-71) and Miami (78-64). In PC's most recent victory at the Civic Center, the Friars defeated 12th-ranked Georgetown, 103-79, on February 10.

# 2000-01 PROVIDENCE COLLEGE BASKETBALL

**FRIARS LEAD IN FREE THROWS...** Providence is tied for lead in the BIG EAST in free-throw percentage in overall action. Providence and Syracuse are both shooting .725 percent from the free-throw line. The Friars have made 408 of 563 attempts in 24 games. In BIG EAST action, PC is second in the league in free throws with a .750 percentage. The Friars are 222 of 296 from the charity stripe. Syracuse leads in league action with a .752 percentage from the free-throw line.

**PC 16-3 IN THE LAST 19 GAMES...** The Friars have posted a 16-3 mark in their last 19 games. Providence opened the season with a 2-3 record in its first five games. The Friars then earned seven consecutive victories before being defeated in their BIG EAST opener at Seton Hall (87-80) on January 3. Since the loss to Seton Hall, PC has registered a 9-2 mark.

**LINEHAN LEADS BIG EAST IN STEALS...** Junior John Linehan (Chester, Pa.) leads the BIG EAST in steals this season with 41 in 12 conference games (3.42). He also leads the league in steals in overall action, averaging 3.32 thefts per game (63 steals in 19 games). Linehan ranks second all-time in steals at Providence with 228 in 84 games (2.71). In 1998-99, he led the BIG EAST in steals with 60 and was tied for fourth in the nation with a 3.3 thefts per game average.

**FRIARS SHOOT FOR THREE...** Providence College has been successful this season from behind the three-point arc. PC is 11-4 when the team has made 40 percent or more of its three-point attempts in a game. The Friars have made 195 of 489 (.399) attempts from three-point territory. On February 10, PC shot 14-19 (73.7 percent) from three-point territory in a 103-79 win against Georgetown and established a team record for three-point percentage in a game. Freshman Maris Laksa (Ventspils, Latvia) has been the team's most prolific three-point shooter, connecting on 35 of his 74 attempts (.473).

**STARTING LINEUP...** Providence College's starting lineup of sophomore forward Romuald Augustin (Montreal, Quebec), senior forward Erron Maxey (Lake Elsinore, Calif.), senior center Karim Shabazz (Far Rockaway, N.Y.), sophomore guard Abdul Mills (Brooklyn, N.Y.) and junior guard John Linehan (Chester, Pa.) have started the last 18 games for the Friars and have posted a 15-3 record as starters.

**DEFENSE IS THE KEY...** Providence College has posted a 16-1 mark this season when opponents have scored 75 or fewer points in a game. Opponents have shot 50 percent from the floor against the Friars in just two of PC's 23 games this season (Miami on January 16 and Villanova on January 31).

**FRIARS STRONG WITH THE LEAD...** Providence College has registered a 14-1 mark this season when leading at halftime. PC's only loss this season when leading at halftime was against Creighton at the Energia Systems Thanksgiving Tournament in Kansas City, Mo. In addition, Friars are 18-1 when leading with 10 minutes remaining in a game and 18-0 when leading with five minutes remaining in a game.

**PROVIDENCE ALL-TIME...** In 74 seasons of Friar basketball, the team has posted a 1,140-720 (.613) mark. The team's all-time record at the Providence Civic Center is 355-140 (.717).

**WHAT A DIFFERENCE A YEAR MAKES...** Last year, Providence College finished the season with an 11-19 mark overall and a 4-12 record in BIG EAST play. This season, the Friars have posted an 18-6 record overall and surpassed last year's win total. Through 12 BIG EAST games, the Friars have eclipsed last year's league win total with a 9-3 mark. This year, Providence College was picked to finish sixth of seven teams in the BIG EAST East Division in the Preseason Coaches' Poll.

## 2000-01 PROVIDENCE COLLEGE BASKETBALL

**FRIARS FORCE TURNOVERS...** PC has posted a 10-0 mark this season when opponents have committed 20 or more turnovers in a game. Entering Saturday's game, opponents are averaging 17.5 turnovers per game against the Friars. In conference action, opponents are averaging 18.7 turnovers per game. In PC's nine BIG EAST wins this season, the Friars have forced a combined 189 turnovers (21.0 turnovers per game) in victories over Villanova (twice), Connecticut, Virginia Tech, Pittsburgh, Miami, St. John's (twice) and Georgetown.

**FRIARS WIN FIVE STRAIGHT BIG EAST GAMES...** On February 3, Providence defeated St. John's, 75-63, for its fifth consecutive BIG EAST win. It marked only the fourth time ever that the Friars have earned five straight BIG EAST wins. PC also earned five consecutive league wins in 1996-97, 1993-94 and 1986-87. During the 1986-87 season, PC earned six straight BIG EAST wins, the only Friar squad to ever accomplish that feat.

**A NEW LEADER EVERY GAME...** One of the trademarks of the Friars this season has been that a different player has led the team in scoring almost every game. Only four times in the team's 24 games this season has the same player led the team in scoring in consecutive games. In addition, seven different players have led the team in scoring in the squad's 18 wins this season. The Friars do not have a player averaging more than 11.2 points a game this season.

**LINEHAN LEADS FRIARS OVER SJU...** PC's defensive specialist junior John Linehan (Chester, Pa.) led the Friars to a 64-53 win over St. John's on February 14 with a team-high 13 points. He also was 8-8 from the free-throw line. Linehan recorded his first double-double of the season as he scored 18 points and dished out 10 assists in the Friars' 103-79 win against Georgetown on February 10. He also had a game-high six steals and was 4-4 from three-point territory. On January 31, Linehan had a strong game for the Friars as he scored a career-high 20 points and was 6-7 from the three-point arc in PC's 84-64 win against Villanova. He also had three steals and three assists in the contest. On February 3, Linehan continued his fine play with 14 points, two steals and five assists in PC's 75-63 win over St. John's. Linehan also tied his career high for free throws made (connecting on 10 of 12 free throw attempts) and rebounds (six). Linehan was respon-

sible for guarding Omar Cook and helped force the freshman guard into making four turnovers and held him to a season-low five points (11 points below his average). For the season, Linehan is third on the team in scoring, averaging 10.5 points per game. Linehan has been an integral part of the Friars' success this season. With Linehan in the lineup, the Friars have posted an impressive 16-3 record. Linehan missed five games this season with a hamstring injury which he suffered in the first game. The Friars posted a 2-3 record without Linehan. Linehan was named BIG EAST Player of the Week on Monday, January 15. Linehan was named Player of the Week after leading the Friars to two BIG EAST wins with his impressive defense. On January 9, Linehan had six steals, six assists and six rebounds in PC's 76-67 win at Villanova. On January 13, the 5-9 guard scored 19 points and registered five steals as the Friars upset 13th-ranked Connecticut at the Providence Civic Center. In the win over UConn, Linehan was an impressive 3-4 from behind the three-point line and 8-8 from the free-throw line. In the two games, Linehan averaged 12 points, 4.5 assists, 5.5 steals and four rebounds. He also was an impressive 13-14 from the free-throw line in the two games. Linehan leads the Friars in steals with 63 in 19 games (3.32 steals per game) this season.

**SHABAZZ PLAYS STRONG...** Senior Karim Shabazz (Far Rockaway, N.Y.) scored seven points and grabbed eight rebounds in PC's 64-53 win over St. John's on February 14. Shabazz registered his third double-double of the season when he scored a BIG EAST career-high 22 points and grabbed 11 rebounds in the team's 103-79 victory against Georgetown on February 10. Shabazz has scored 11 or more points six of the last seven games. On February 3, he led the Friars to a 75-63 win over St. John's. Shabazz scored 11 points and recorded nine rebounds. On January 23, Shabazz scored 17 points with a career-best 7-7 effort from the floor in PC's 77-61 win against Pittsburgh at the Providence Civic Center. He also was 3-4 from the free-throw line and grabbed eight rebounds. On January 28, Shabazz recorded his second double-double of the season when he scored 11 points and had a game-high 12 rebounds in the Friars' 80-70 win at Miami. He also recorded six blocks and three assists in the game. Shabazz recorded his first double-double of the season (14 points and 13 rebounds) in the Friars' 93-80 win over George Washington on

December 11. On December 2, he returned to the Providence lineup against the URI Rams and tied his career high with 10 blocks. Shabazz had 10 blocks in PC's 79-63 win over Long Island on December 27, 1999. Shabazz had injured his knee in PC's 60-53 win over UMKC on November 24. The senior center missed three games due to the injury. For the season, he is averaging 8.6 points. He leads the team in rebounding, averaging 7.2 boards per game. The 1999-00 season was his first year at PC. Shabazz transferred to Providence in January 1999 from Florida State. The Far Rockaway, N.Y. native is the tallest player in the history of PC basketball.

**AUGUSTIN STRONG IN LEAGUE PLAY...** Sophomore Romuald Augustin (Montreal, Quebec) is second on the team in BIG EAST scoring, averaging 11.3 points per game in league play. Augustin recorded a career-high 22 points in PC's 83-68 loss to Connecticut on February 6. Augustin was 4-6 from behind the three-point arc in the loss. Augustin has scored 10 or more points in eight of the last 14 games. He has led the team or has been tied for the team lead in scoring in seven of the squad's 24 games. For the season, he is fourth on the team in scoring, averaging 9.9 points per game. He is one of the team's top three-point shooters, connecting on 38 of his 92 attempts (.413). On January 31, Augustin recorded a career-high six assists against Villanova on January 31. In PC's 78-64 loss to Miami on January 16, the sophomore forward had a game-high 20 points and was 8-9 from the free-throw line. On January 9, he registered season highs in three pointers (five), assists (five) and minutes played (35) while scoring 21 points and leading the Friars to a 76-67 win over Villanova.

**MILLS SCORES 12 VS. SJU...** Sophomore Abdul Mills (Brooklyn, N.Y.) scored 12 points and registered four assists in PC's 64-53 win at St. John's on February 14. Mills registered a career-high five three pointers and finished with 15 points in the Friars' 103-79 win against Georgetown on February 10. Mills is second on the team in scoring, averaging 10.8 points per game. He also ranks second on the team in steals with 36. On January 20, he scored 14 points in PC's 75-60 victory at Virginia Tech. Mills has been one of the Friars' most consistent scorers this season, recording double figures in 14 of the team's 24 games. Mills recorded a career high with 25 points in PC's 93-80

win against George Washington on December 11. On December 7, Mills had 16 points in the Friars' 85-70 win against UMass. He scored 19 points in the Friars' 80-71 loss to the Maine Black Bears on November 21. On November 29, Mills registered 16 points against FIU.

## ANRIN STRONG OFF THE BENCH...

Freshman Chris Anrin (Varmdo, Sweden) has become a very productive scorer off the bench for the Friars. On January 31, he scored nine points, including two three pointers, in PC's 84-64 victory over Villanova. On January 16, the 6-7 freshman forward scored a career-high 18 points and tied his career high with four three-point baskets in the Friars' 78-64 loss to Miami at the Providence Civic Center. On January 20, Anrin scored 11 points and was 3-5 from three-point territory in PC's 75-60 win at Virginia Tech. For the season, he is averaging 6.2 points per game. He also is shooting 37 percent (32-87) from three-point territory.

## LAKSA FOR THREE...

Freshman Maris Laksa (Ventspils, Latvia) is the team's top three-point threat. Laksa leads the squad in three-point shooting percentage (.473), connecting on 35 of his 74 attempts. In PC's 103-79 win over Georgetown on February 10, Laksa scored 14 points and was 3-5 from three-point territory. On February 3, Laksa registered 13 points in PC's 75-63 win over St. John's. For the season, Laksa is averaging 9.6 points and 3.3 rebounds per game. In the Friars' 77-61 victory against Pittsburgh on January 23, Laksa scored 15 points while shooting 4-5 from the floor, including 3-3 from three-point territory. He also had six rebounds in the game. Laksa led the Friars to a 73-48 win against Boston University on December 28 at the Providence Civic Center. In the win, Laksa had a career-best game for the Friars as he scored 24 points and was 4-4 from behind the three-point line (7-8 from the floor) and was 6-6 from the foul line. He registered 18 points in PC's 93-80 win against George Washington on December 11. Laksa was 3-5 from behind the three-point line and shot 3-3 from the free-throw line. He had 17 points in 33 minutes of action in the Friars' 74-55 win against Florida International on November 29.

## MAXEY LEADS FRIARS IN SCORING...

Senior Erron Maxey (Lake Elsinore, Calif.) leads the Friars in scoring, averaging 11.2 points per game. He also is second on the

team in rebounding, averaging 6.7 rebounds per game. On February 10, Maxey scored 14 points in PC's 103-79 win over Georgetown. It marked the 14th game this season that Maxey scored 10 or more points. Maxey recorded his third double-double of the season with 13 points and 11 rebounds in PC's 75-63 win over St. John's on February 3. On January 31, Maxey tied his season-high as he scored 19 points in the Friars' 84-64 victory over Villanova. On January 23, Maxey scored 15 points and grabbed eight rebounds in PC's 77-61 win against Pittsburgh. He recorded his second double-double (17 points, 12 rebounds) of the season on December 7 when he led the Friars to an 85-70 victory against Massachusetts. Maxey scored a season-high 19 points and grabbed a team-high eight rebounds in 24 minutes of action in the Friars' 95-72 win over in-state rival Rhode Island on December 2. Maxey became the 35th player in Friar history to record 1,000 points when he scored 14 points in PC's 80-69 loss to Auburn on November 26. He has played in 113 career games and has scored 1,222 points. On November 21, he recorded his first double-double of the season in PC's 80-71 loss to Maine. He had 11 points and 11 rebounds in the loss. Last season, Maxey led the team in scoring, averaging 14.8 points and 8.0 rebounds per game.

## DOUTHIT AT CENTER...

Freshman center Marcus Douthit (Syracuse, N.Y.) is second on the team in blocks with 39. On February 14, Douthit scored eight points and blocked three shots in PC's 64-53 win at St. John's. Douthit scored 12 points and recorded eight rebounds in PC's 87-80 loss to 11th-ranked Seton Hall on January 3. On December 26, Douthit was named BIG EAST Rookie of the Week. He became the first Friar to earn Rookie of the Week since Sean Connolly received the accolade on November 30, 1998. Douthit earned the honor after he led the Friars to a 110-59 win over cross-town rival Brown on December 23. The 6-10 rookie center recorded career highs in points (22), rebounds (11) and field goals (11-14) while registering his first double-double. This season, he is averaging 5.4 points and 4.3 rebounds per game. On December 30, Douthit made a career-high five blocks in PC's 60-55 win against South Carolina. On December 2, the rookie scored 14 points in the Friars' win over Rhode Island.

## GAME 1
