

2019 WOMEN'S CROSS COUNTRY

Finishes: 4th at BIG EAST Championships, 10th at NCAA Northeast Regional and 1st at ECAC/IC4A Championships

Head Coach: Ray Treacy

- Senior Abbey Wheeler repeated as champion at the UNH Tri Meet 5K (17:31.02) and the Coast-to-Coast Battle in Beantown 5K (17:03). Wheeler also placed first at the ECAC/IC4A Championships (17:29).
- The Friars finished fourth at the BIG EAST Championships. Junior Maria Coffin placed fourth (21:56.5), senior Abbey Wheeler finished seventh (22:09.3) and freshman Lilly Tuck crossed the line in 11th place (22:19.0). The trio earned All-BIG EAST Honors for their finishes.
- Providence finished 10th at the NCAA Northeast Regional Meet. Senior Abbey Wheeler and freshman Lilly Tuck earned All-Region Honors after finishing 15th (19:55.6) and 23rd (20:12.7), respectively.
- The Friar women ended the season winning the ECAC/IC4A Championships. Wheeler (17:29), Coffin (17:34) and Tuck (18:01) took the top three spots in the race.
- Abbey Wheeler and Lilly Tuck were named USTFCCCA Cross Country All-Academic Athletes after finishing in the top-25 at the NCAA Regional Championship in Buffalo, N.Y. and having a cumulative GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale.
- The women's cross country team held the highest grade-point average of any varsity athletic program at Providence College for the 2019 fall semester.
