TEAM NOTES

- » Today's win marked the second time in three trips to Louisville that the Seminoles have comeback from 21-7 halftime deficits. In 2014, Heisman Trophy winner Jameis Winston and Dalvin Cook led FSU to a 35-10 second half to win 42-31.
- » FSU forced its seventh and eight turnovers of the season in the fourth quarter both setting up and sealing the come-from-behind victory.
- » FSU's four team sacks tied a season high. FSU's defense has at least three sacks in four of five games this season.
- » Florida State tied its season long touchdown drive in terms of yards (75) and had its quickest scoring drive in terms of plays (1) and time (9 seconds).
- » FSU's seven tackles for loss tied a season high (also vs. Virginia Tech and Syracuse).
- » FSU converted its first two fourth-down tries of the season on the same drive in the fourth quarter. The drive ended with Francois' third touchdown pass of the game, tying a career high.

PLAYER NOTES

- » Tight end Gabe Nabers made his first career start.
- » Redshirt freshman DeCalon Brooks recorded his first career sack and forced fumble on Louisville's first drive. The third-down sack pushed the Cardinals out of field goal range.
- » Redshirt senior Johnathan Vickers added a forced fumble on a Louisville kick return in the first quarter, the first of his career.
- » Freshman Tre'Shaun Harrison took his first career rush 10 yards for a first down.
- » Senior Nyqwan Murray caught a 17-yard touchdown from Deondre Francois to tie the score in the first quarter. It was Murray's team-high 10th career touchdown. He then added number 11 on the game-winning score on a 58-yarder from Francois.
- » Redshirt freshman Tamorrion Terry caught a 58-yard touchdown in the third quarter. Along with a 78-yard touchdown last week, Terry has two of FSU's three longest offensive scores on the season and has four touchdowns on 11 catches this year.
- » Terry's four touchdown catches are the most for a Seminole freshman since Travis Rudolph also had four in 2014.
- » Francois' 30 career touchdown pass move him into 16th place in FSU history. His four TD passes set a career-high (he has had three in a game four times).
- » Francois completed his first 8 passes of the second half for 132 yards and two touchdowns. He finished the second half 11-15 for 218 yards and three TD's.
- » Dontavious Jackson forced a fumble that was recovered by Brian Burns and returned 14 yards. It was Jackson's first career forced fumble and the second fumble recovery (first in 2018) for Burns.
- » Burns later sacked Louisville quarterback Jawon Pass and forced a fumble, the fifth of his career. Burns has 5.0 sacks on the season and 10.9 for his career.
- » Punter Logan Tyler cranked a 61-yard punt in the third quarter, tying a career high (at Duke, 2017).

At the end of fall camp, head coach Willie Taggart named senior center Alec Eberle, junior defensive end Brian Burns and junior kicker Ricky Aguayo FSU's 2018 captains.
