FINAL: FSU 45, ULM 44 (OT)

- » Florida State improved to 3-3 all-time in overtime games and 3-0 at home with its 45-44 victory over Louisiana Monroe...it was the Noles first overtime game since their 23-17 win over Clemson on Sept. 20, 2014...FSU's first overtime win came on Nov. 15, 2003 against NC State, a 50-44 double-overtime triumph.
- » The 45 points are a single-game high under coach **Willie Taggart...**the Noles converted 6-of-6 red zone visits with 5 TDs and a FG...FSU's 1-point victory was just the 13th in program history and the second under Taggart, following last season's 22-21 home victory over No. 22 Boston College.
- » **TB Cam Akers** set a school record with 36 carries; the last of which was a 4-yard touchdown run in overtime. The previous record for carries in a game was 34, shared by **Mike Sellers** (11/25/50) against Tampa and **Travis Minor** (8/31/98) vs. Texas A6M.
- » Akers finished with 193 rushing yards and 55 receiving yards, accounting for 248 of the Seminoles' 501 total yards. The junior back also scored three touchdowns, including a 44-yard pass from James Blackman in the fourth quarter, which erased a 35-31 deficit. It was Akers' second consecutive and seventh career 100-yard rushing game, and his third in four games. Akers' seventh 100-yard game ties him for 11th on FSU's all-time list with Devonta Freeman and Sean Jackson. His two rushing TDs give him 16 for his career and move him into a tie for 19th on the all-time rushing TD list.
- » Akers became the 16th Florida State back to eclipse 2,000 career rushing yards and with 2,039 he is closing in on Leon Washington (2,078) for No. 15 on the all-time rushing list.
- » **QB James Blackman** completed 30-of-40 pass attempts for 282 yards and three touchdowns. The 30 completions are a single-game career-high for the redshirt sophomore. Blackman connected with **Tre'Shaun Harrison** (19 yards), **D.J. Matthews** (7) and **Akers** (44) and has six TD passes on the season to six different receivers.
- » Blackman authored his second consecutive near-perfect first quarter of the season, completing 10-of-11 attempts for 100 yards and a TD against ULM, including his first eight attempts. That followed his 7-of-8 first quarter against Boise State, when he totaled 127 yards and 2 TDs.
- » Blackman recorded the first rushing touchdown in 19 career games, scampering into the end zone from 6 yards out on the opening possession of the second quarter as the Noles pushed their lead to 21-0.
- » **Keyshawn Helton's** 49-yard kickoff return on the Noles' final possession of the half was the longest of his career and the longest by a Nole since **Keith Gavin's** 81-yard return against Wake Forest in 2017. It sparked a 9-play, 31-yard drive as the Noles closed the half with Ricky Aguayo's 36-yard FG for a 24-7 lead.
- » Leading 21-0 in the second quarter, FSU's defense came up with a goal line stand and its first fourth-down stop of the season. ULM ran four plays inside the Noles' 5-yard line and came away empty-handed. The Warhawks' final two snaps came from the 1-yard line. **Marvin Wilson** stuffed Josh Johnson for no gain on third down and QB Caleb Evans' fourth-down pass was incomplete.
- » ULM did not complete its first pass of the game until the 13:11 mark of the second guarter as Evans was 0-for-7 to start the game.
- » Tommy Martin's career debut as the Noles' punter included a 58-yarder, that was covered by Asante Samuel Jr. at the 1-yard line, where ULM began its first possession of the second half. He averaged 42.8 yards on five punts.
- » Jaiden Lars-Woodbey's third quarter fumble recovery the third of the season forced by Hamsah Nasirildeen was the Noles' third fumble recovery of the season, equaling their 2018 season total...Nasirildeen led the Noles in tackles with 10.
- » Junior **DB Cyrus Fagan** made his first career start...redshirt sophomore **K Parker Grothaus** and classmate **P Tommy Martin** made their first career appearances.
