## FINAL: #25 VIRGINIA 31, FSU 24

- » James Blackman threw for three touchdowns, his fifth straight start with at least three touchdown passes. That ties the longest streak in program history, matching Bill Cappleman's school-record set in 1968. Blackman's touchdown passes to **Gabe Nabers** (10 yards), **Cam Akers** (3) and **Keyshawn Helton** (17). It was all three players' second touchdown reception of the season.
- » Blackman finished 22-for-37 with 234 yards and now ranks 17th in FSU history in passing yards with 3,583. His 281 tie him with Chip Ferguson for 16th in school history and his 33 touchdown passes tied him with Peter Tom Willis, also for 16th place.
- » Akers ran for 78 yards on 18 carries. He ranks 13th in school history with 2,117 rushing yards.
- » **Asante Samuel, Jr.** intercepted Bryce Perkins on the first drive of the game. It was Samuel's first interception of his career. He also led FSU with eight tackles, a career high.
- » Senior Levonta Taylor intercepted Perkins in the second quarter, the fourth of his career and Florida State's third of the season.
- » Linebacker **Emmett Rice** and Edge defender **Joshua Kaindoh** made their first starts of the season. Offensively, left tackle **Abdul Bello** and receiver **Keyshawn Helton** also made their first starts of 2019.
- » Freshman Jarvis Brownlee made the first appearance of his career. Linebacker Adonis Thomas made his first appearance of the season in the second quarter.
- » Running back Khalan Laborn broke off a 36-yard run in the second quarter, the longest of his career.
- » Tight end **Tre' McKitty** caught a pair of passes on FSU's second touchdown drive and caught four in the game. Six of McKitty's seven catches on the season have gone for first downs.
- » The Noles 87-yard touchdown drive in the second quarter was the longest scoring drive of the year and the second of more than 80 yards.
- » Defensive tackle Cory Durden had 1.5 sacks for 7 yards lost against the Cavaliers and has 4.5 for his career.
- » Kicker **Ricky Aguayo** made a career-long-tying 53-yard field goal in the third quarter, matching his kick against Miami in 2018. Aguayo is now 4-for-5 in his career on 50-yard field goal attempts.
- » Aguayo scored six points against the Cavaliers and has 289 in his career, passing Dalvin Cook (2014-16) for ninth-most in FSU history.
- » Punter **Tommy Martin** booted a 59-yard punt in the second quarter, the longest of his career in just his second game. Martin boomed a 58-yard punt last week against ULM.
- » Florida State finished 3-for-4 in the red zone and is 11-for-12 in the red zone on the season.
