FINAL: FSU 35, LOUISVILLE 24

- » Saturday's win was Florida State's 300th victory in Doak Campbell Stadium, which opened in 1950. The Seminoles are now 300-96-4 (.755) at Doak and 308-100-4 (.752) all-time in Tallahassee.
- » **Cam Akers'** 1-yard touchdown run with 1:37 remaining his career-high third rushing score of the game sealed the Seminoles' 35-24 come-frombehind victory. The Seminoles evened their record at 2-2 (1-1 ACC) by handing Louisville (2-2, 0-1 ACC) its ninth consecutive conference loss.
- » Akers, who entered the game ranked fifth nationally in rushing, recorded his third 100-yard game of the season (29-112)...his eighth career 100-yard rushing game ties him for eighth all-time among Noles...the junior has 2,229 career rushing yards and ranks 11th all-time after moving up two spots, past Sean Jackson and Mark Lyles...with 19 career rushing TDs, he is tied for 13th all-time with Jermaine Thomas.
- » Grad transfer quarterback **Alex Hornibrook** wiped out a 24-21 deficit with a 60-yard TD pass to **Tamorrion Terry** with 7:25 remaining. It was Hornibrook's second TD pass of the game. His first pass attempt as a Seminole was a 44-yard TD pass to **Keyshawn Helton** in the opening quarter when he spelled starter **James Blackman**. The last FSU quarterback to throw a TD on his first pass attempt was **Clint Trickett**, who hooked up with **Rashad Greene** for a 28-yard score against Louisiana Monroe on Sept. 3, 2011.
- » Hornibrook, who took over full-time duties when Blackman was injured in the third quarter, completed 15-of-20 attempts for 255 yards.
- » **Terry's** 60-yard TD reception was his first catch of the game, the 50th of his career and 10th receiving score. His 10 TD receptions cover 448 yards (44.8 per TD). He finished with two receptions for 73 yards to push his career total to 51 receptions for 1,051 yards.
- » FSU has now scored 24 points in its first four games for just the fifth time since the 2000 season and the first time since 2013.
- » FSU piled up a season-best 522 total yards, which is the highest total in 16 games under coach Willie Taggart.
- » The Seminoles posted their second 21-point first quarter of the season when **Akers** scored on the final play of the period and **Ricky Aguayo** tacked on the PAT for a 21-0 lead. Through four games, the Noles have outscored their opponents 56-9 in the opening quarter.
- » FSU's defense put the clamps on Louisville in the first half, limiting the Cardinals to just 112 yards on 38 plays (2.9 ypp); their lowest first half output of the season. The Noles stopped Louisville on six of 10 third-down attempts, largely because of their ability to stop the run.
- » The Cardinals came into the game leading the ACC with 260.3 rushing yards per game, but FSU held them to 124 yards on 47 carries (2.6 ypc).
- » Defensive back **Cyrus Fagan** grabbed his first career interception with 9:39 remaining in the fourth quarter to stop a Louisville drive as the Cardinals led 24-21...the Noles countered with a 6-play, 86-yard scoring drive to regain the lead.

- » With his fifth PAT of the game, **Ricky Aguayo** pushed his career scoring total to 294 points, which ties him for eighth on the all-time scoring list with running back **Warrick Dunn** (1993-96).
- » Defensive tackle **Marvin Wilson** recorded a career-high 10 tackles to lead the defense, including a single-game-best 3.5 tackles for loss. He also matched his single-game high with 2.0 sacks and recorded the first fumble recovery of his career on the final play of the game.
- » Florida State sacked Louisville quarterback **Malik Cunningham** six times for minus-27 yards...**Levonta Taylor** recorded his first career sack... **Janarius Robinson** registered a career-high 1.5 sacks and also forced the first fumble of his career...the six sacks tied the most for FSU under **Willie Taggart**.
- » FSU had 11 tackles for loss, its most since notching 13 at Miami last season.
- » The Noles were plus-two in takeaways and did not commit a turnover. On the season, FSU has recovered four fumbles, already topping its 2018 total (3). The defense also has four interceptions on the year.
- » FSU's defense forced seven 3-and-out series' by the Louisville offense, which had 13 possessions.
- » Personnel notes: **Mike Arnold** made his first start of the season at right guard...in addition to Hornibrook, redshirt junior linebacker **Joe Garcia** made his first career appearance on the kickoff team.
