## FINAL: WAKE FOREST 22, FSU 20

- » Running back **Cam Akers** ran for 98 yards in the first half and 157 total, his ninth career 100-yard rushing game and fourth of 2019. Akers is tied for 7th with Greg Jones in career 100-yard rushing games at FSU.
- » Akers added a two-yard rushing touchdown and a 19-yard receiving touchdown. It was Akers' second career game with a rushing and receiving touchdown (ULM in September). Akers leads the ACC and ranks in the Top 10 nationally in total touchdowns this year with 11.
- » Akers' 21 career rushing touchdowns rank 11th in FSU history, breaking a tie with James Wilder, Jr. and Mark Lyles.
- » For his career, Akers' 2,503 rushing yards rank eighth in FSU history.

- » Akers' long run against Wake Forest went for 32 yards. As a team, FSU has six rushes of at least 30 yards in 2019. In 2018, FSU had just four rushes of at least 30 yards.
- » Akers' 157 rushing yards were also the third-most for a Seminole against Wake Forest in the 38-game series between the teams.
- » Wide receiver **Tamorrion Terry** led FSU with 55 receiving yards and a 36-yard touchdown in the fourth quarter. For the season, Terry leads FSU with 27 catches, 522 yards and 6 receiving touchdowns. For his career, Terry has 14 touchdown catches that have averaged 42.9 yards per TD reception.
- » Tight end **Gabe Nabers** caught a pair of passes against Wake Forest a four-yard catch on 4th-and-2 and a career-long 27-yard pass in the second quarter. For the game, FSU was 2-for-3 on fourth-down attempts.
- » Quarterback **James Blackman** threw a pair of touchdowns and now ranks 15th in FSU history with 35 for his career. He also ranks 13th in completions with 328 and 16th in passing yards with 4,056.
- » Linebacker **Emmett Rice** made his fourth career start and set a career high with 14 tackles (eight in the first half). His previous high for a game was five against Boston College as a freshman in 2016.
- » Freshman safety **Akeem Dent** made the first start of his career. Freshman offensive lineman **Darius Washington** made his first career appearance at left tackle midway through the second quarter.
- » The Florida State defense did not allow a passing touchdown for the first time since the Delaware State game in 2017. Wake Forest entered the game sixth nationally in touchdown passes and had thrown at least one in 13 straight games.
