FINAL: GT 16, FSU 13

» The Seminoles blocked three kicks on special teams (2 field goals, 1 PAT), tying for the most they've recorded in a game. It's also their most since blocking three kicks vs. North Carolina in 1996 (2 punts, 1 PAT).

» **Marvin Wilson** blocked a pair of field goal attempts, the first two blocked kicks of his career. He joins B.J. Ward - 2003 vs. Duke - as the only Noles with two blocked field goals in a game.

» **Janarius Robinson** preserved a 13-13 tie with a blocked PAT in the fourth quarter, the first time FSU has blocked an extra point since 2018 (at Notre Dame).

» **Asante Samuel Jr.**'s second career INT on Georgia Tech's opening drive marked the second straight year FSU has forced a turnover on the opposing team's season-opening drive. Last year against Boise State, **Janarius Robinson** recorded a fumble recovery on the Broncos' first possession.

» **Asante Samuel Jr.** recorded his second pick of the game with 7:55 left in the second quarter. It's the first two-pick game by a Seminole since Kyle Meyers had two INTs vs. Samford in 2018. Samuel also had two pass breakups, giving him 25 for his career, the most among active players in the ACC.

» **Keyshawn Helton** caught a three-yard touchdown on FSU's opening drive, the fifth of his career. Helton was playing in his first game after suffering a season-ending injury midway through 2019.

» **Parker Grothaus** made his first career FG attempt to give FSU a 10-0 lead in the first quarter, making a 37-yard attempt. He added a 53-yard make to give FSU a 13-7 lead in the third. The field goal is the longest by FSU since Ricky Aguayo made a 53-yarder at Virginia last season.

» **James Blackman's** first-quarter TD pass to Keyshawn Helton was the 42nd of his career, moving into a tie for 10th in program history with Casey Weldon (1987-91).

» **Amari Gainer** led all players with 10 tackles (5 solo). It marks the second-most tackles in his career, only behind his 12 stops at Boston College last year.

» First career starts - running back **La'Damian Webb**, wide receiver **Warren Thompson**, tight end **Camren McDonald**, linebacker **Kalen DeLoach** and free safety **Renardo Green**.

» Cornerback **Jarrian Jones** made his second career start (Mississippi State) and first at Florida State; right tackle **Devontay Love-Taylor** made his first start for the Seminoles and 17th in his career (FIU). Running back **Jashaun Corbin** made his third career start after a pair at Texas A&M in 2019.

» First appearances at FSU - **Corbin, Jones, Webb, Love-Taylor, Fabian Lovett, Travis Jay, Wyatt Rector, Stephen Dix Jr., Josh Griffis, Garrett Murray, Preston Daniel, Malcolm Ray, Lawrance Toafili, Alex Mastromanno and Deonte Williams**.
