

2020 FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL

3 NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS | 15 ACC CHAMPIONSHIPS | 45 FIRST-ROUND PICKS

FINAL: FSU 41, JSU 24

» Redshirt sophomore QB **Jordan Travis** finished with a career-best 210 yards passing (12-of-17) with 1 TD. He added 48 yards rushing and another TD on the ground.

» **Travis'** 41-yard TD pass to **Keyshawn Helton** in the second quarter marked the first career scoring pass at FSU and second of his career.

» **Travis'** 1-yard scoring plunge with 39 seconds left in the second quarter was his fourth rushing touchdown in seven games as a Seminole.

» FSU outgained Jacksonville State 506-229 after the first quarter.

» Florida State finished with 268 passing yards and 263 rushing yards, the first time FSU had at least 250 passing and rushing yards in a game since Nov. 19, 2016 at Syracuse.

» In the second half, FSU averaged 6.8 yards rushing (33 carries, 225 yards) while holding Jacksonville State to just 10 yards on the ground (1.3 yards per carry).

» The Seminoles scored a touchdown on five consecutive drives Saturday, their first time doing that since scoring touchdowns on six straight drives Nov. 18, 2017, in a 77-6 win over Delaware State.

» **Asante Samuel Jr.** is the first Seminole since Nate Andrews in 2014 with at least three interceptions and a fumble recovery in a season. He made his third INT of the year with 8:41 left in the game. It was his fourth takeaway this season. He is the seventh Seminole since 2000 with at least three INTs and a fumble recovery in a season.

» **Asante Samuel Jr.** led the game with a career-high nine tackles. His previous was eight at No. 25 Virginia and at No. 2 Clemson in 2019.

» Florida State scored five rushing touchdowns Saturday, from four different players, including **La'Damian Webb (2)**, **Lawrance Toafili (1)**, **Jashaun Corbin (1)** and **Jordan Travis (1)**. It was the first game FSU had four different players score a rushing touchdown since 2016 (four at USF).

» **Lawrance Toafili** finished the day with 99 yards on the ground and one score, the first of his FSU career, on a 13-yard run in the third quarter. His 99 rushing yards are the most by an FSU true freshman since Cam Akers had 117 yards vs. ULM on Dec. 2, 2017.

» **La'Damian Webb's** 15-yard acrobatic rushing TD in the third quarter was the first of his FSU career. He added a 6-yard rushing game with 35 seconds left in the third quarter.

» Redshirt junior WR **Ontaria Wilson** set a career high with six catches. His 77 yards were tied with **Tamorrion Terry** for the game high. Wilson's previous high was four catches vs. NC State and at Wake Forest in 2019.

» **Terry's** six catches and 77 yards were both season-highs. Terry's 48-yard catch on the first play of the third quarter was the longest offensive play for the Noles this season and made him the 15th player in school history with 2,000 career receiving yards. He has 2,061 career yards receiving, ranking 14th all-time at FSU.

» **Keyshawn Helton** totaled 109 yards on four kickoff returns, including returns of 37 and 35 yards. It is the second time this year a Seminole had a pair of 30+-yard kickoff returns in the same game (**Travis Jay** vs. Georgia Tech). Before 2020, no Seminole had done it since Kermit Whitfield in the 2015 season opener against Texas State.

» On offense, true freshman **Tate Rodemaker** made his first career start. He is the fourth true freshman in program history to start a game at quarterback (**James Blackman, 2017**; Chip Ferguson, 1985; Billy Prescott, 1973).

» Tight end **Preston Daniel** and right tackle **Robert Scott Jr.**, both true freshmen, also made their first career starts.

» Defensively, nose guard **Fabien Lovett** made his first start as a Seminole. He started all 13 games for Mississippi State in 2019.

» **Meiko Dotson (DB)** and **DJ Lundy (LB)** made their first career appearances at Florida State.

» Florida State moves to a perfect 26-0 against FCS opponents since the NCAA split Division I into two football subdivisions in 1978.
