

2020 FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL

FINAL: #5 NOTRE DAME 42, FSU 26

- » FSU tallied 405 yards of total offense; 153 yards rushing and 252 yards passing. It was the first time since Oct. 8, 2016 at No. 10 Miami the Noles produced at least 400 yards of offense against a ranked team on the road.
- » On the second play of the game, linebacker **Amari Gainer** forced a fumble, recovered by cornerback **Asante Samuel, Jr.** It was the third forced fumble of Gainer's career, tied with **Hamsah Nasirildeen** for most on the team.
- » Samuel is the second player in FBS over the past 21 seasons with at least three INTs and two fumble recoveries in his team's first four games (Derrick Johnson, Texas, 2003).
- » For Samuel, it was his fifth takeaway of the season (three interceptions, two fumble recoveries). He has accounted for five of FSU's seven takeaways on the season. He is just the third Seminole since 2000 with at least three interceptions and two fumble recoveries in a season (Nate Andrews, 2014; Telvin Smith, 2013).
- » Samuel is also the first Seminole since Tarvarus McFadden in 2016 with a takeaway in four straight games.
- » Florida State's **Jordan Travis** started at quarterback for FSU, becoming the third different Seminole to start at QB over the past three games.
- » The only other time in program history FSU started three different quarterbacks in three straight games was 2002 (Adrian McPherson at NC State, Chris Rix vs. Florida, Fabian Walker in Sugar Bowl vs. Georgia).
- » This is the eighth time FSU has started at least three different quarterbacks in a season (4 in 1985; 3 in 2002, 1986, 1983, 1974, 1973 and 1970).
- » Travis scored on a four-yard run in the first quarter, the fifth TD run of his career. He finished the game leading FSU in rushing with 96 yards, which was a career high. Travis was 13-24 with 204 yards passing.
- » **Tamorrion Terry** caught his first touchdown of the season on a 48-yard pass from Travis. It was the second straight week the pair connected for a 48-yard completion (longest of Travis's career). Terry's 146 receiving yards were the most for a Seminole this season and was his sixth career 100-yard receiving game. His nine catches tied a career high.
- » For his career, Terry is averaging 49.00 yards per touchdown (882 yards/18 TD).
- » For Terry, he now ranks 10th in FSU history with 2,207 career receiving yards. His 18 touchdown receptions are tied with Travis Rudolph and Craphonso Thorpe for No. 13 on FSU's all-time list.
- » Also in the first quarter, **Deonte Sheffield** recovered a muffed punt. It was his first career takeaway and FSU's second special teams takeaway this season.
- » Placekicker **Ryan Fitzgerald** set a career-high with eight points scored. His 42-yard field goal in the first quarter was a career long.
- » Freshman tailback **Lawrance Toafili** made the first start of his career. His 31-yard catch in the first quarter was a career high.
- » Tailback La'Damian Webb scored his team-high third rushing touchdown of the season in the third quarter. He led FSU running backs with a career-high 59 rushing yards, including two runs of 16 yards, which were his longest of the season.
- » Gainer led the game with 11 tackles, the third time he has led FSU in tackles this season and the third time he has reached double-digit tackles.
