

2020 FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL

FINAL: FSU 31, #5 UNC 28

» Florida State defeated No. 5 North Carolina 31-28, giving the Seminoles their first win over a top-5 team since Oct. 18, 2014 (31-27 vs. No. 5 Notre Dame). The Noles move to 16-3-1 in the all-time series vs. the Tar Heels, including 8-2-1 in Tallahassee.

» The last time an unranked Florida State team defeated a top-5 team was Nov. 3, 2007 (27-17 at No. 2 Boston College)

» The last time an unranked Florida State team defeated a top-5 opponent in Doak Campbell Stadium was Oct. 16, 1965 (10-3 vs. No. 5 Georgia)

» FSU is now 110-33 (.769) in night games (7 p.m. start or later) at Doak Campbell Stadium since 1968.

» Florida State's 31-7 lead at the half was its largest lead over a ranked team since a 27-0 advantage over No. 21 vs. NC State in 2000. The 31 points in the first half were the most against a ranked team since scoring 35 vs. No. 22 Georgia Tech in 2009.

» The Noles have scored on seven of their 10 opening drives of a half this season, scoring 40 total points.

» The Seminoles blocked a single-game school record two punts, both in the first quarter. It was the first time since 2005 vs. NC State FSU blocked two punts in a game.

» Special teams has accounted for two takeaways and five blocked kicks this season. FSU entered the weekend tied for the national lead with three blocks on the season.

» Running back **Ja'Khi Douglas** blocked his first career punt after North Carolina's first drive of the game. Linebacker **DeCalon Brooks** picked it up and returned it 18 yards, setting up FSU's first touchdown of the game.

» Defensive tackle **Marvin Wilson** accounted for the second blocked punt in the first quarter. It was Wilson's third blocked kick of the season and first career blocked punt. His three blocks are the most in a season by a Seminole since B.J. Ward had four in 2003. Wilson also entered the game tied for the national lead.

» On the first offensive play of the game, quarterback **Jordan Travis** rushed for his third touchdown of the season. The Seminoles last scored on the first play of the game vs. Alabama State in 2019. Travis added a 1-yard score in the second quarter, tying his career-high of two rushing touchdowns in a single game. He has seven rushing TDs in his career.

» Defensive end **Joshua Kaindoh** intercepted Sam Howell in the second quarter and returned it 25 yards for his first career touchdown. He is the first FSU defensive lineman to register a pick-six since Markus White returned one 31 yards Sept. 7, 2009 vs. Miami.

» Walk-on tight end **Preston Daniel** caught his first career pass on the last play of the first quarter. His 36-yard catch is the longest by an FSU tight end this season.

» Wide receiver **Ontaria Wilson** caught a 58-yard pass to start the second quarter. It was the longest of his career and longest career pass for Travis. It is also the longest play for the Noles this season.

» Running back **La'Damian Webb**'s 54-yard run to start the second half was the longest of his career and the longest rush by the Seminoles this season. He finished with 109 yards on 12 carries.

» Webb's 109 yards and Travis' 107 marks the first time since ULM in 2017 FSU had two rushers over 100 yards. Jacques Patrick rushed for 155 and Cam Akers tallied 117.

» FSU's defense accounted for eight TFLs for 40 yards, including four sacks for 28 yards. Defensive end **Janarius Robinson** had a career-high two sacks, including one on North Carolina's final drive. Robinson finished the game with three tackles, all for loss.

» Defensive tackle **Cory Durden** and linebacker **DJ Lundy** combined on a sack in the first quarter. It was the first TFL of Lundy's career.

» Linebackers **Amari Gainer** and **Emmett Rice** came up big on a fourth-down stop on FSU's 25-yard line in the second quarter. The offense took over and produced a nine-play, 75-yard touchdown drive to go ahead 17-0.

» **Dennis Briggs Jr.** made his first appearance on the defensive line. He accounted for three tackles

» Defensive back **Jarvis Brownlee Jr.** and **Stephen Dix Jr.** made the first starts of their career. Brownlee registered the first sack of his career and Dix led the Noles with a career-high nine tackles.

» Defensive back **Jadarius Green-McKnight** made his first appearance of the season.
