## FINAL: LOUISVILLE 48, FSU 16

- » Florida State finished the game with 406 yards of total offense, marking the first time the Seminoles recorded at least 405 yards of total offense in three straight ACC games since 2016 (595 vs. North Carolina, 407 at Miami, 442 vs. Wake Forest, 449 vs. Clemson). FSU posted 405 at No. 5 Notre Dame and 432 vs. No. 5 North Carolina.
- » **Camren McDonald**'s 30-yard catch on the first play of the game was a career long. He finished with two catches for 48 yards on the day.
- » Quarterback **Jordan Travis** led FSU on a 65-yard touchdown drive to open the game. In 2020, FSU has scored on eight of its 12 opening drives of a half and scored a total of 47 points on those drives.
- » Travis ran for a 15-yard touchdown in the first quarter. He has a rushing touchdown in four straight games and a team-high five on the season. For his career, Travis has eight rushing touchdowns in 10 games.
- » Wide receiver **Ontaria Wilson** caught his first touchdown of the season, a four-yard touchdown on fourth-and-goal. It was Wilson's second career touchdown.
- » Running back **Ja'Khi Douglas** returned seven kicks for 137 yards. They were the first kick returns of his career.
- » Douglas later recovered a fumble off a punt late in the fourth quarter. It was FSU's third special teams takeaway this season.
- » Wide receiver **Jordan Young** and defensive back **Raymond Woodie III** made the first starts of their careers. Young caught three passes, setting a new career high, for 27 yards. Woodie made seven tackles, which is a new career high. He also registerd a PBU and a TFL.
- » Running back **Jashaun Corbin** ran for 61 yards, with a long of 24 yards in the third guarter. That 24-yard run tied his season high.
- » Running back **Lawrance Toafili** led FSÜ in rushing with 76 yards on six carries. His rush of 49 yards in the fourth quarter was a career long.
- » Linebacker Emmett Rice had a season-high eight tackles, including a safety on QB Malik Cunningham in the third quarter. It was FSU's first safety since 2017 against NC State.
- » To go along with his sack, Rice added a QB hurry and a pass breakup.
- » Quarterback **Chubba Purdy** and tight end **Austin White** made their debuts in the fourth quarter.
