- » Quarterback Jordan Travis broke Florida State's program record for a quarterback with his fifth straight game with a rushing touchdown. He scored on an 88-yard rush in the first quarter, breaking a tie with Charlie Ward (1992) and Christian Ponder (2008), who each had four.
- Travis' 88-yard rush was:
- the longest TD run by a QB in school history, topping his 66-yard TD run at Boston College last season.
- the 5th-longest TD run in school history, tying Sean Jackson (vs. Wake Forest in 1992).
 - the longest run for FSU since Dalvin Cook's 94 yarder in 2015 at Wake Forest.
 - the 3rd-longest nationally by any player this season (entering Saturday).
- » Travis has 472 rushing yards this season, the 2nd-highest single-season rushing yards total for a quarterback in program history. Charlie Ward's 504 rushing yards from 1992 is the school record.
- Travis' 83 rushing yards were the most given up by Pitt to a single player this season, topping the 78 yards gained by Louisville's Javian Hawkins on Sept. 26.
- The Seminoles' 146 rushing yards were the most allowed by Pitt this season, bettering the 116 rushing yards gained by Louisville on Sept. 26.
- Florida State has scored on nine of its 14 opening drives of a half this season and scored a total of 54 points on those drives.
- The FSU defense recorded 8.0 tackles for loss, matching its season high set in the win over No. 5 North Carolina.
- Nine different receivers caught a pass, tying FSU's single-game high this season.
- Tight end Camren McDonald led FSU receivers with seven catches for 61 yards, setting new career highs.
- Tight end Wyatt Rector scored his first career touchdown on a 2-yard sneak. >>
- Running back Lawrance Toafili set a career high in catches with four.
- True freshman quarterback Chubba Purdy recorded the first completion of his collegiate career with a three-yard pass to Camren McDonald in the 3rd quarter. Purdy finished the game 12-of-21 passing.
- Defensive back Jarvis Brownlee Jr. and linebackers Emmett Rice and Stephen Dix Jr. led the Noles in tackles with eight. Brownlee's total doubled his previous single-game career high of four set in the 31-28 win vs. No. 5 North Carolina on Oct. 17.
- Defensive lineman Fabien Lovett picked up his first sack of the season in the 3rd quarter. He finished the game with four tackles, which tied a career high.
