

2020 FLORIDA STATE FOOTBALL

FINAL: NC STATE 38, FSU 22

- » True freshman quarterback **Chubba Purdy** made his first career start for the Seminoles. Purdy becomes the fifth true freshman in FSU history to start a game at quarterback, joining Billy Prescott (1973), Chip Ferguson (1985), James Blackman (2017) and Tate Rodemaker (2020).
- » This is just the second time in school history, and first since 1985, that Florida State has started four different quarterbacks in a season.
- » Florida State started four freshmen on the offensive line - **Darius Washington** (LT), **Thomas Shrader** (LG), **Maurice Smith** (C) and **Robert Scott Jr.** (RT). Starting right guard **Baveon Johnson** is one of just 13 seniors on the FSU roster.
- » FSU last started four freshmen on the offensive line in the 2011 Champs Sports Bowl.
- » Purdy, Shrader and true freshman running back Ja'Khi Douglas earned their first career starts.
- » For the season, 23 players have made the first start of their FSU careers, including 10 freshmen.
- » Purdy threw his first career touchdown pass in the fourth quarter, a 69-yard bomb to wide receiver **Ontaria Wilson**. It was the longest touchdown catch of Wilson's career and the longest for FSU this season.
- » Purdy finished the game 15-of-23 for 181 yards, two touchdowns and 54 yards rushing.
- » Wilson finished with 117 yards, the first 100-yard receiving game of his career. His seven catches were also a career high.
- » Wide receiver **Warren Thompson** caught a 24-yard touchdown pass in the fourth quarter. It was the first toudown reception of his career.
- » Safety **Hamsah Nasirildeen** made his first appearance of the season, registering four tackles and 0.5 TFL. He is FSU's active leader in tackles with 225.
- » Defensive back **Jarvis Brownlee, Jr.** secured his first career interception in the fourth quarter. FSU's defense has five interceptions this year.
- » Defensive end **Janarius Robinson** had five tackles, 2.5 tackles for loss and one sack. His 20.5 career TFL are the most on FSU's active roster. Robinson also stopped NC State for no gain on 4th-and-1 at the FSU 10-yard line in the first quarter.
- » Linebacker **Emmett Rice** had a season-high 11 tackles and a career-high 1.5 tackles for loss. He has at least one tackle for loss in six straight games.
- » Rice and linebacker **Amari Gainer** each had nine tackles in the first half. Gainer finished with 12 tackles, tying a career high.
- » Running back **Jashaun Corbin** broke off a 28-yard touchdown run on 4th-and-1 in the third quarter. He finished the game with a season-high 77 yards on 14 carries.
- » Corbin successfully picked up three of FSU's five fourth-down conversions. FSU's five successful fourth-down conversions are tied for the most nationally in a game this season.
