FINAL: FSU 35, NORTH CAROLINA 25

- » Florida State improved to 17-3-1 (.833) all-time against North Carolina and 8-1 (.889) in Chapel Hill. Head coach Mike Norvell is 2-0 against the Tar Heels after last year's 31-28 win over No. 5 UNC in Tallahassee.
- » Starting quarterback Jordan Travis finished 11-for-13 with three TD passes and added a career-high 121 yards and two touchdowns rushing. Travis is the first Seminole over the past 25 years with three passing and two rushing touchdowns in the same game.
- » Travis, who rushed for a then-career-high 113 yards in last week's win vs. Syracuse, is the first QB in FSU history with back-to-back 100-yard rushing games and has three career 100-yard rushing games. As a team, FSU has had a 100-yard rusher and broken the 200-yard mark as a team in five of six games.
- » Travis' five total touchdowns and three passing touchdowns are both new careerhigh totals, and his two rushing scores tied his career high.
- » Travis has at least one rushing and one passing touchdown in six of his eight games started at quarterback.
- » Travis's 53-yard touchdown run gave FSU the lead in the second quarter and was his longest of the year. As a team, FSU has six plays of at least 50 yards on the season.
- » Travis, who holds FSU's single-season and career rushing yards by a quarterback records, ran for 121 yards Saturday, giving him 1,053 for his career. His 53-yard touchdown pushed him past the 1,000-yard mark, the first QB in FSU history to reach that milestone.
- » Ontaria Wilson caught two touchdowns a 32-yard score with 53 seconds remaining before halftime and a 6-yard catch in the third quarter. It was the redshirt junior's first two-touchdown game of his career and the first two-receiving TD game for a Nole this year. Wilson has six career TD catches.
- » Wide receiver Malik McClain got FSU on the board with a 5-yard touchdown catch in the second quarter. It was McClain's first career touchdown.
- » Keyshawn Helton caught 3 passes for a season-high 71 yards. His 44-yard catch set up a touchdown in the third quarter and was his longest of the season.
- » Jammie Robinson led FSU with 12 tackles, his seventh career double-digit tackles game and second this season (13 vs. Louisville). Sidney Williams added a career-high 10 tackles.
- » Defensive back Jarrian Jones made his third start of the season, finishing with three tackles and his first career interception. It was UNC QB Sam Howell's first interception in three games.
- » Jermaine Johnson II had six tackles, including a 3-yard sack, the only sack of the game for either team. His 9.0 TFL and 7.0 sacks lead the team, and his TFL total matches the most for a Nole over the past three seasons (Janarius Robinson, 9.0 in 2019).
- » Florida State was 3-for-3 in the Red Zone with three touchdowns and has converted 10 straight Red Zone trips, scoring a total of 61 points on those drives.
- » Redshirt freshman defensive tackle Malcolm Ray made his first career start. He had his first career tackle for loss on a 2nd-and-1 in the second quarter.
- » Travis Jay returned a kick 41 yards in the first quarter, the longest for a Seminole this season and the longest of his career. The drive ended in FSU's first touchdown of the day.
- » FSU's 21 first-half points were a season high. All 21 points came in the second quarter, FSU's highest-scoring quarter since a 28-point first quarter vs. Duke in 2020. It was FSU's most points in a second quarter since scoring 24 vs. the Tar Heels last season.
- » The loss was UNC's first at home this season (3-1).
