FINAL: NC STATE 28, FSU 14

- » FSU was 2-for-2 with two touchdowns in the Red Zone and has now scored on 19 consecutive Red Zone opportunities for a total of 119 points on those drives. It is the longest streak for the Seminoles since 31 straight over the 2016-17 seasons.
- » The Seminoles were 2-for-4 on fourth down, including a three-yard touchdown run by Jashaun Corbin out of the wildcat. It was just the second rushing touchdown NC State has allowed this season and Corbin's team-high sixth rushing score of the year.
- » Defensively, FSU held NC State to 0-for-1 on fourth down and has stopped eight consecutive fourth-down tries.
- » FSU was penalized just two times for 12 yards against NC State, the Seminoles' fifth game this season with five or fewer penalties. It was the fewest penalties and yards since Nov. 16, 2013 vs. Syracuse (2 for 10). It was just the fourth time since 2000 that FSU had 12 or fewer penalty yards.
- » Jammie Robinson intercepted his second pass of the year at the end of the first half. It was the fourth of his career and FSU's third on a hail mary this season. FSU has an interception in five straight games, the Noles longest streak with an interception since a six-game stretch in the 2014 season.
- » It was the first interception for NC State's Devin Leary in 228 pass attempts, which was the longest active streak in the country and the ninth-longest in ACC history. It was the first interception NC State has thrown since the second week of the season and the first takeaway against the Wolfpack since a fumble vs. Clemson on Sept. 25.
- » Robinson accounted for a team-high 10 tackles, his third game this year and eighth of his career in double digits.
- » Keir Thomas had a career-high-tying and FSU-best 2.0 sacks and has 3.5 over the past two games.
- » Malcolm Ray had a nine-yard sack on 3rd down late in the third quarter. It was the first solo sack of his career (previous half-sack came last week at Clemson.)
- » NC State entered the game allowing an average of 1.5 sacks per game, and FSU's 3.0 sacks marked only the third game this season a team collected multiple sacks against the Wolfpack.
- » Keyshawn Helton caught an eight-yard touchdown to get FSU on the board in the third quarter. He has a team-high eight receiving touchdowns in his career.
- » Tight end Jordan Wilson caught a 35-yard pass, the longest of his career. His long at UCLA from 2016-18 was 25 yards, and his previous high at FSU was 24 yards last week at Clemson. It was quarterback McKenzie Milton's longest completion as a Seminole.
- » Milton's start was the 37th of his career and 4th at Florida State. Ja'Khi Douglas earned his first start of the season and second of his career.
- » Florida State recovered an onside kick to open the second half. It was FSU's first successful onside kick recovery since 2009 against Wake Forest.
- » Punter Alex Mastromanno booted two 58-yard punts, the second-longest of his career. His 65-yard punt against Jacksonville State earlier this year is his longest.
- » Florida State celebrated Military Appreciation Day Saturday with linebacker Stephen Dix, Jr. and offensive lineman Darius Washington leading the team onto the field.
- » Washington, whose father was in the Navy, carried the American flag that was carried on board a C-130J Hercules, Panther 78, assigned to the 772nd Expeditionary Airlift Squadron (AES) while conducting aero medical evacuation missions over hostile territory in Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom.
- » Dix, with both parents in the Army and an uncle in the Navy, carried the Seminole flag that flew for six months at Camp Dwyer in Helmand Province. During this time people stopped by to take pictures with and explain their own allegiances to FSU or the Big Bend area of Florida. Upon the closing of Camp Dwyer SFC Yarbrough secured the flag and took it on his unit's continuing mission supporting the processing of evacuees at Hamid Karzai Airport. Finally, the flag flew out of Afghanistan on August 30th on one of the last aircraft to leave to country.
