'Cuse-Seminole Take #2

Syracuse and Florida State meet for the second time this campaign when the Orange host the Seminoles on Jan. 15 in the Dome. The Orange won in Tallahassee on Dec. 4, 63-60.

The Syracuse-Florida State Series

- ✓ The early-season victory by Syracuse gave the Orange an 8-5 advantage in the all-time series
- ✓ Syracuse's December win stopped Florida State's modest three-game victory streak in the matchups.

Syracuse Notes

- ✓ **Buddy and Jimmy Boeheim** are the second highest scoring brother duo in Division I. They are averaging a combined 33.8 points per game, just 0.3 behind Keegan and Kris Murray at Iowa.
- ✓ **Jesse Edwards** has excelled in ACC play, averaging 12.0 points, 7.6 rebounds and 3.6 blocked shots in five outings.
- ✓ **Cole Swider** is averaging a squad-best 7.1 rebounds per game this season.

Florida State Notes

- ✓ The Seminoles have no less than four seven-foot players on their roster: **Tanor Ngom** (7-2), **Quincy Ballard** (7-0), **John Butler** (7-0) and **Naheem McLeod** (7-4).
- ✓ Houston transfer **Caleb Mills**, a redshirt sophomore guard, is FSU's top scorer (12.6 ppg.)
- ✓ **Malik Osborne**, a redshirt senior forward, leads FSU in rebound average (7.2) and ranks second in scoring (11.1).

- ✓ **Jan. 15:** Buddy Boeheim made four straight 3-pointers in one stretch and finished with 24 points when the Orange defeated Pittsburgh, 77-61.
- ✓ The Syracuse defense held the Panthers without a basket for 10:59, a stretch that began late in the first half.
- ✓ **Jan. 11:** Buddy Boeheim posted a game high off 24 points along with three other starters in double figures.
- ✓ **Jan. 8:** Wake Forest remained unbeaten at home by holding off Syracuse, 77-74, in overtime.
- ✓ **Jimmy Boeheim** had 21 points and **Cole Swider** added 10 points and 14 rebounds. **Buddy Boeheim** had 17 points.
- ✓ **Jan. 5:** Syracuse hit a school record 17 3-pointers but Miami prevailed, 88-87.
- ✓ **Jesse Edwards** had a career-high 22 points and seven blocked shots, to go along with eight boards.
- ✓ **Jan. 1:** Buddy Boeheim scored a game-high 27 points but it was not enough in a loss to Virginia, 74-69.

- ✓ **Dec. 29:** Syracuse defeated Cornell for the 41st straight time, earning an 80-68 decision in the Dome. The Orange never trailed in the 126th meeting between the two Central New York programs.
- ✓ **Buddy Boeheim** had 22 points and **Cole Swider** had his highest scoring output of the season with 21 points.
- ✓ **Dec. 27:** Buddy Boeheim scored 18 of his season-high 28 points in the second half to help Syracuse beat Brown, 92-63.
- ✓ SU hit 13-of-21 (.619) of its 3-pointers.
- ✓ **Dec. 11:** Syracuse squandered a 10-point, halftime lead, and lost at Georgetown, 79-75. **Buddy Boeheim** led the Orange with 17 points.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard** contributed 15 points and seven assists, and **Jesse Edwards** had 12 points and eight rebounds.
- ✓ **Dec. 7:** The Orange were defeated by #6 Villanova, 67-53, in the Jimmy V Classic.
- ✓ **Jimmy Boeheim** had a squad-best 21 points and **Cole Swider** had 12 boards.
- ✓ **Dec. 4:** Syracuse put an end to Florida State's 25-game ACC home court win streak in a 63-60 road triumph. **Cole Swider**, who finished with 16 points and 10 rebounds, converted two free throws with 10 seconds left to secure the win.

November Orange Notes

- ✓ **Nov. 30:** Joseph Girard hit two free throws in the last second of the second overtime to secure SU's 112-110 win versus Indiana in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.
- ✓ **Buddy Boeheim** (27 points), **Jimmy Boeheim** (26) and **Girard** (22) led five Syracuse starters in double digits.
- ✓ **Nov. 26:** Syracuse closed out its three-game set at the Battle 4 Atlantis by losing to 19/22 Auburn, 89-68.
- ✓ **Buddy Boeheim, Jesse Edwards** and **Cole Swider** each had 17 points for the Orange against the Tigers.
- ✓ **Nov. 25:** **Jesse Edwards** had a career-high 21 points and all five Syracuse starters scored in double digits to lead the Orange past Arizona State, 92-84.
- ✓ The **Edwards** offensive outburst represented the most points by a Syracuse center since Arinze Onuaku had 21 in a March 2010 game.
- ✓ **Buddy Boeheim** had 23 points and **Cole Swider** contributed 19 points and 11 rebounds versus the Sun Devils.
- ✓ **Nov. 24:** The Orange let a four-point, halftime advantage get away in a 67-55 loss to VCU at the Battle 4 Atlantis.
- ✓ **Jimmy Boeheim** had his second-straight, double-double, producing 17 points and 12 rebounds. **Buddy Boeheim** added 20 points for the Orange.
- ✓ **Nov. 20:** Syracuse had its 54-game winning streak against Colgate snapped when the visiting Raiders won, 100-85. Colgate tied a Dome opponent record with 18 3-pointers.
- ✓ The Orange built a 22-5 advantage to start the game but by halftime Colgate had gained the lead.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard** led both teams with 27 points and added eight assists.
- ✓ **Joseph Girard** made his first 3-point attempt against Colgate, extending his consecutive makes streak to nine to start the season. He missed his 10th attempt.
- ✓ **Nov. 14:** The Orange came back from a six-point, first-half deficit to defeat Drexel, 75-50. **Buddy Boeheim** led the way with 23 points.

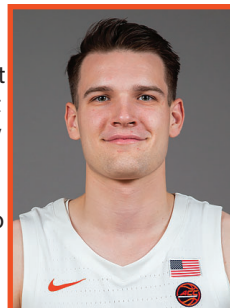
SU START ME UP

Maliq Brown from Blue Ridge School (Va.), **Chris Bunch** from Wasatch Academy (Utah), **Peter Carey** from Northfield Mount Hermon School (Mass.), and **Quadir Copeland** and **Justin Taylor** from IMG Academy (Fla.), have signed National Letters of Intent (NLI) to enroll and play basketball for the Orange starting in 2022.

The 2022 Syracuse recruiting class is ranked 14th overall and the fourth best in the ACC according to *247sports.com*.

Brown, a 6-9, 210 forward, plays at Blue Ridge School for Coach Cade Lemcke. He is a native of Culpeper, Va., and averaged 12.9 points per game in his junior season. *247sports.com* ranks Brown as the seventh best player in Virginia. He is rated 47th among power forwards by *ESPN.com*.

Bunch, a 6-8, 190 forward, is enrolled at Wasatch Academy in Mount Pleasant, Utah. He is from Concord, Calif. and is a four-star prospect.
