SEMINOLES CLOSE OUT REGULAR SEASON AGAINST NC STATE ON SATURDAY AT HOME

Florida State, which has defeated Virginia (64-63, February 26) and Notre Dame (74-70, March 2) in its last two games, plays host to NC State on Senior Day on March 5, 2022 at 2:00 p.m. at the Donald L Tucker Center. Seminole head coach Leonard Hamilton and his staff will honor seven seniors who are scheduled to play their final regular season home games: RayQuan Evans, Justin Lindner, Tanor Ngom, Malik Osborne, Anthony Polite, Harrison Prieto and Wyatt Wilkes. Florida State has won two consecutive and three of its last five ACC games despite missing each of its five starters for a significant amount of time during the month of February. After winning six straight games from January 8 against Louisville through January 22 against Miami including a win of No. 5 ranked and ACC Tournament top seeded Duke, the Seminoles enter Saturday's game against NC State looking for their 10th ACC win of the season. Following Saturday's game against NC State, the Seminoles travel to play in the ACC Tournament at the Barclays Center where they will face Syracuse on Wednesday, March 9 at 12 Noon. The game between the Seminoles and the Orange will be televised on either ESPN or ESPN2. The winner of that game will face the No. 1 seeded Duke Blue Devils on Thursday, November 10, also at 12 Noon.

SEMINOLES LOOKING FOR 10TH ACC WIN OF THE SEASON

Florida State enters Saturday's game against NC State looking to win its 10th ACC game of the season. It would mark the fourth consecutive year the Seminoles would have reached in double figures for ACC regular season wins and would give the program 50 ACC regular season wins in the last four seasons – a high watermark for the program under Leonard Hamilton. Florida State is 49-23 (.680 winning percentage) in the last four seasons in ACC play – the winningest four-year period in conference play in school history.

FLORIDA STATE AT THE DONALD L. TUCKER CENTER IN THE LAST FIVE SEASONS

Florida State is 86-8 at home in the last five (plus) seasons (.915 winning percentage). The Seminoles have won 86 of their last 94 home games since February 27, 2015. The Seminoles won their final three home games of the 2015-16 season (Notre Dame, Syracuse, Davidson) and have won 83 of 90 home games (.922 winning percentage) in the last five seasons. The Seminoles have lost just four ACC home game since a 77-68 win over Clemson on January 22, 2019. Florida State has won 30 of its last 35 ACC home games since defeating the Tigers and won 25 consecutive ACC home games from January 22, 2019 through March 3, 2021 – the second longest conference winning streak in ACC history. Only Duke, who won 26 straight ACC home games from 1997-2002, has a longer streak than then Seminoles in the history of the ACC.

HAMILTON TO BE INDUCTED INTO FLORIDA STATE HALL OF FAME

The Florida State University's Athletics Hall of Fame will induct nine new members on Friday, April 8, including men's basketball coach Leonard Hamilton and All-Americans from six different sports. Hamilton, who is the Seminoles' all-time winningest basketball coach and currently the fifth all-time winningest coach in ACC history, will be inducted along with one of his former players in star point guard Toney Douglas.

HAMILTON IS THE FIFTH WINNINGEST COACH IN ACC HISTORY

Seminole Head Coach Leonard Hamilton is the fifth winningest coach in ACC history with 393 career wins and ranked fifth in ACC history with 176 career ACC wins at Florida State.

LOOK FOR FLORIDA STATE TO...

...Defeat NC State and earn a two-game regular season series win against the Wolfpack. The Seminoles defeated the Wolfpack, 83-81, earlier this season on January 1 at the PNC Arena in Raleigh;

...Defeat NC State and gain a win over the Wolfpack for the seventh time in the last eight games in the series. The Seminoles defeated the Wolfpack, 85-78, in Raleigh and have won seven of the last eight meetings between the two teams;

...Defeat NC State and win its 10th ACC game of the season. It would mark the school record tying fourth consecutive season the Seminoles will have reached double digits in regular season ACC wins. Florida State earned at least 10 ACC wins from 2009-12 (43 total regular season ACC wins) and have currently won at least 11 ACC regular season games from 2019-21 (40 ACC wins).

SEMINOLES NOW WITH SIX ONE-POINT VICTORIES

Florida State won its sixth game decided by one point with its 64-63 win over Virginia on February 26 in Charlottesville. The Seminoles have defeated five ACC teams by one point (Miami, 65-64 on January 11; Duke, 79-78 in overtime on January 18; at Miami, 61-60, January 22; Clemson, 81-80, February 15 and at Virginia, 64-63 on February 26) and defeated Boston University in a non-conference game (81-80, November 24). The Seminoles are the first team in ACC history to win each of its five ACC games that were decided by exactly one point. The ACC record for games decided by one point for any ACC team is six by Notre Dame during the 2019-20 season. The Fighting Irish were 3-3 in one-point decisions during the 2019-20 season.

SEMINOLES' COLLEGE BASKETBALL RECORD OVERTIME WINNING STREAK

Florida State defeated Duke, 79-70, in overtime on January 18 in Tallahassee for its all-time college basketball record 13th consecutive overtime victory. The Seminoles have won each of the their overtime decisions since a 101-90 double overtime win over Syracuse on January 13, 2018 in a game played at the Donald L. Tucker Center in Tallahassee. Florida State has defeated 11 teams during their overtime streak. The Seminoles are 2-0 in OT games this year.

FLORIDA STATE AGAINST THE TOP FOUR ACC TOURNAMENT SEEDS

Florida State is 4-2 against the top four seeds in the upcoming ACC Tournament with victories over Duke (1-1), Notre Dame (1-0) and Miami (2-0).

HAMILTON, FLORIDA STATE WITH TWO NATIONAL HISTORICAL RECORDS

...Under Head Coach Leonard Hamilton, the Seminoles have won a NCAA record 13 consecutive overtime games. The streak began with a 101-90 double overtime win over Syracuse on January 13, 2018 and continued on January 18, 2022 with their 79-78 overtime win over Duke;

...Speaking to the ability of Head Coach Leonard Hamilton and how he develops talent, Hamilton has now won an NCAA record 55 games over ranked teams while his teams were unranked. Hamilton's 55th win over a ranked team as the coach of an unranked team came as a 79-78 overtime win over Duke on January 18.

FLORIDA STATE BY THE NUMBERS...

...Florida State made 12 3-point field goals in its 74-70 win over Notre Dame on Wednesday in Tallahassee. It marked the fourth time this season (and second time in ACC play) that the Seminoles have made double digit 3-point shots in a game. The Seminoles made a season-high 14 shots from long range in its win over Lipscomb (14-26, .538), 12 in their win at Syracuse (12-20, .600), 12 in their win over Notre Dame (12 of 29, .414) and 10 in their win over Missouri (10 of 24, .417). The Seminoles are 4-0 when they make at least 10 3-point field goals in a game this season;

...Florida State enters Saturday's game against NC State with 198 made 3-point field goals. The Seminoles have made at least 200 3-point field goals in five of the last six seasons;

...Florida State has blocked 23 shots in its last three games (7.7 bpg) including a season-high tying nine in its victory over Virginia on February 26. The Seminoles blocked nine shots against Virginia and eight against Notre Dame on Wednesday in Tallahassee – the highest two-game total for the team this season.

FLORIDA STATE VS. NC STATE – THE LAST MEETING

Malik Osborne scored 12 of his 19 points in the second half and Cam'Ron Fletcher and Matthew Cleveland made big plays in the final seconds to help Florida State edge NC State, 83-81, at PNC Arena in Raleigh, N.C. Fletcher scored 14 points and Cleveland and Caleb Mills 13 each as the Seminoles survived a 32-point performance by Dereon Seabron. After Terquavion Smith hit a 3-pointer off a Seabron assist to cut FSU's lead to 79-78, Cleveland was fouled after an offensive rebound and made 1 of 2 free throws. NC State called timeout with 8.4 seconds remaining but Fletcher stole the inbounds pass meant for Seabron and was fouled. He made the first free throw and missed the second but NC State's Jericole Hellems was called for a foul going for the rebound and Cleveland sank two more free throws. Smith hit his seventh 3-pointer as the game ended. Seabron was 12-of-14 shooting. His only 2-point miss came with NC State up by a point with a minute to go and led to a held-ball and an FSU possession that began the Seminoles' 9-6 game-ending run. Neither team led by more than seven points and there were 14 lead changes.

.263 Florida State's defense held Notre Dame to a .263 shooting percentage from 3-point range in the Seminoles' victory over the Fighting Irish on Wednesday night. Notre Dame is ranked fourth in the ACC with a .374 shooting percentage from 3-point range for the season.

.929 Redshirt senior Tanor Ngom is shooting .909 from the free throw line in the last five games. He enters Saturday's game having made four consecutive free throws.

1 Freshman Matthew Cleveland leads the Seminoles in field goals made (122), free throws made (59), offensive rebounds (41), defensive rebounds (86), total rebounds (127) and total points scored (309) entering Saturday's game against NC State.

0 Florida State's defense held Notre Dame, the fourth-best 3-point shooting team in the ACC with a .374 mark for the season, to zero 3-point shots made in the second half of the Seminoles' 74-70 win over the Irish on Wednesday night in Tallahassee. Notre Dame was 0-10 from the bonusphere and was outscored 35-26 after halftime.

0 Florida State did not have a single shot blocked in its 74-70 win over Notre Dame on Wednesday night in Tallahassee. The Seminoles have played five games (against Loyola Marymount, Louisville, at Georgia Tech and Notre Dame) where they did not have a single shot blocked. The Seminoles are 4-1 when they don't have a single shot blocked.

FLORIDA STATE ON SENIOR DAY UNDER LEONARD HAMILTON

Florida State enters Saturday's game against NC State having won seven consecutive and nine of its last 10 Senior Day games. The Seminoles are 16-3 on Senior Day game since March 1, 2003 under 20th year head coach Leonard Hamilton. The Seminoles most recently played NC State on Senior Day in Tallahassee on February 24, 2007 – a 78-52 Florida State victory.

CLEVELAND NAMED ACC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK FOR SECOND TIME

Freshman Matthew Cleveland, who made the shot heard around the college basketball world against Virginia on February 26, was named the ACC Freshman of the Week on February 28. It marks the second time this season that he has earned the weekly award from the ACC. Cleveland averaged 19.0 points and 5.5 rebounds as he led Florida State to its fourth ACC road win of the season. He scored the game winning 3-point basket with no time remaining in Florida State's come-from-behind road win at Virginia after the Seminoles were down by 11 points with under 11 minutes left to be played in the Seminoles' 64-63 win over the Cavaliers. He scored nine points in the final 2:06 of the Seminoles' victory over Virginia to rally the Seminoles from a nine point deficit (59-50 at the 2:41 mark) to a one point advantage (and win) at the buzzer. He scored 14 of his 20 points in the second half as Florida State came back from a 34-28 halftime disadvantage.

9 Freshman John Butler's team-leading 31 blocked shots entering Saturday's game against NC State is the ninth highest mark by a freshman in Florida State history. The school-record for blocked shots by a freshman is 74 by Corey Louis (1994-95).

11 Freshman John Butler scored 11 first half points (on three of three made 3-point shots) in Florida State's 74-70 win over Notre Dame on Wednesday night. His 11 first half points were more than he had scored in 26 games during his freshman season. He has scored in double figures four times during his freshman season.

12 Redshirt senior Tanor Ngom scored his ACC career-high of 12 points in Florida State's victory over Notre Dame. He has scored in double figures four times during the 2021-22 season.

16 Florida State is undefeated, 16-0, when it outscores its opponent.

23 Freshman John Butler has started a team-high 23 consecutive games. He has been in Florida State's starting lineup in each game since November 30 against Purdue in the Big Ten / ACC Challenge.

Florida State's Late-Season Fight Is A Positive Sign For Future Of The Program

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Players come and go; culture lasts.

This recent stretch from the Florida State men's basketball team, including Wednesday's 74-70 win over Notre Dame, is proof positive of that.

This year's team has been as unlucky with injuries as any team I have covered. What began as an injury that veteran forward Malik Osborne was able to play through evolved into the Seminoles being without five starters for a game at No. 5 Duke a few weeks ago.

Fifth-year guard Anthony Polite was somewhat unexpectedly able to return to the lineup Wednesday night. Before that, the Seminoles had been without both of their senior leaders for the last seven games and without three of their top four scorers for the last four games.

As the injuries mounted, so did the losses. A team that was trending toward the right side of the NCAA Tournament bubble fell off the face of the postseason cliff.

That still remains the case for the Seminoles. Barring a highly unlikely run to an ACC Championship, FSU's season will end next week in Brooklyn, N.Y., with the exception of a possible NIT bid.

But after the last two games, it's hard to deny feeling significantly better about the state of the program going forward.

There were plenty of times where it didn't seem like there was any fight left in this team. A game at UNC in which FSU trailed by 40 early in the second half, a staggering home loss to Pitt and an uninspired 16-point loss at Boston College stood out as low points.

There were moments where the Seminoles looked totally out of place and others where they appeared utterly despondent. And given the state of the active roster for those games, who could blame them?

"It was a little bit all over the board," FSU head coach Leonard Hamilton said.

"We had guys stepping into different roles. We had guys some being motivated by it, some being depressed about it. Emotions were all over the place so we were struggling a little bit to try to find a way to bring everybody together."

FSU lost six straight games between Jan. 26 and Feb. 12, the program's longest losing streak in 17 years. Entering last weekend, the Seminoles had lost eight of their last nine games, falling from first to ninth in the ACC standings.

But then Saturday's shocking win over Virginia happened on the arms of a stunning 30-foot buzzer-beater from freshman Matthew Cleveland.

It was a special moment in a brutal stretch and a nice silver lining for the Seminoles to play spoiler, effectively killing UVA's NCAA Tournament hopes.

But there was little belief that this progress would be carried over into Wednesday's game against Notre Dame.

This was especially true once it was revealed during pregame that Cleveland would not be available due to a non-COVID illness in a plot point that really should have been predicted with how the season has played out.

But shame on us for doubting this program. The Seminoles delivered one of their more shocking wins in recent memory, downing a visiting Irish team that was just outside this week's top 25.

Considering FSU lost its chance to repeat as ACC Champions in a stunning loss at Notre Dame last season, this one surely felt extra sweet for the Seminoles.

FSU should be favored against NC State this weekend as it looks to win on Senior Day for the eighth straight year. If that happens, it will enter next week's ACC Tournament on a three-game winning streak that no one saw coming.

It's a testament to what Hamilton and his staff have built in Tallahassee. Even in a down year where the fanbase and media members left the team for dead, the Seminoles are fighting to the bitter end.

That fight has been admirable. It also leads one to believe that next year's team will be a step toward the last few years instead of another step in the wrong direction.

"Our culture is just getting back to its normal way of operating," Hamilton said.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. – RayQuan Evans made two free throws with 12 seconds remaining and John Butler blocked a jump shot by Wendell More, Jr., with two seconds remaining, and Florida State won its NCAA record 13th consecutive overtime decision with a 79-78 win over No. 5 Duke at the Donald L. Tucker Center. Caleb Mills led the Seminoles with 18 points, while Butler added a career-high 14. The Seminoles outscored the Blue Devils by a 12-11 margin in the overtime period to win their 13th consecutive overtime game. The Seminoles' overtime winning streak dates back to a 101-90 double overtime win over Syracuse on January 13, 2018. Florida State has defeated 11 different teams during the overtime streak with its win over Duke marking its first over the Blue Devils during the streak. The win was Florida State head coach Leonard Hamilton's eighth all-time win over Duke. The win was also the Seminoles' first over a top-5 ranked team since a 69-69 win over Virginia on March 15, 2019 in the semifinals of the ACC Tournament. Florida State gained its first win over a nationally ranked opponent this season and snapped a five-game losing streak to the Blue Devils. The Seminoles started the second half in a 38-33 hole at half but turned it around at the under 16-minute media timeout to lead by a 44-34 margin. Sophomore Naheem McLeod started for the second time in his season and finished with a near a double-double with a career-high nine points and 10 rebounds.

Devon Smith's layup gave Georgia Tech a 50-37 lead with 17:08 left before the Seminoles began whittling away. John Butler's 3-point nine minutes later reduced FSU's deficit to 57-53 but it never got closer. Usher buried a 3 with 2:05 to go for a 71-60 lead to seal it. Michael Devos scored 15 points, reserve Dallan Coleman 14 and Kyle Sturdivant 12 for Tech. The Yellow Jackets were 8-for-19 shooting from 3-point range in the first half and led 44-33 at the break. Georgia Tech also went to the foul line 16 times and converted 10 while the Seminoles went 3 for 4. Georgia Tech's defense proved problematic for the Seminoles as it came away with 10 steals in the first half, which led to 12 points. FSU turned it over 12 times alone before the break. Butler threw down a dunk to give the Seminoles a 26-25 lead with 6:05 before halftime. From there, Georgia Tech got hot and closed the half outscoring the Seminoles 19-7. Anthony Polite scored 11 and Naheem McLeod 10 for Florida State, which saw its six-game win streak end.

TALLAHASSEE, Fla. — John Butler had 16 points, eight re-bounds and four blocks — all career highs — to lead Florida State to a 74-70 win over Notre Dame. Butler, a freshman, also had a career-best four 3-pointers for Florida State to keep the Fighting Irish (21-9, 14-5) from clinching the No. 2 seed in the ACC tournament and their first-ever victory in Tallahassee in six visits. RayQuan Evans, Anthony Polite and Tanor Ngom scored 12 points each for the Seminoles with Evans adding seven rebounds and five assists. Blake Wesley scored 21 points, Paul Atkinson Jr. had 17 points and 10 rebounds for his seventh double-double this season and Prentiss Hubb added 10 points for Notre Dame. The Seminoles were without ACC freshman of the week and second-leading scorer Matthew Cleveland, sidelined by a non-COVID illness. Cleveland had a last-second 3-pointer to beat Virginia 64-63 in FSU's previous game. FSU did get Polite back after he missed the last seven games following surgery for a fractured wrist and he came through with a 3-pointer for a five-point lead with 46.8 seconds left. Atkinson responded with a three-point play before Evans made two free throws with 9.7 seconds left. Butler blocked Wesley on the other end as time expired. The Seminoles, who opened the game with five 3-pointers in the first four minutes but trailed 44-39 at halftime, made four in the first five minutes of the second half to grab a 53-48 edge after trailing by five at halftime and clung to the lead. FSU made 12 of 29 from the arc, matching its best in ACC action this season. Notre Dame missed all 10 of its second-half 3-point tries.
