NUMBERS TO WATCH

- 74** The Mercer coaching staff scored 74 points against Florida State during their playing careers at Tulane. Head coach Greg Gary scored 38 points across four games against the Seminoles while assistant coach Kim Lewis logged 36 points in two games.
- 26** This is the 26th meeting between the two programs, dating back to 1947 when the teams were members of the Dixie Conference. The Bears opened the all-time series with the Seminoles with four straight wins from 1947-49.
- 21.5** Mercer is averaging 21.5 more points per game than FSU through four games this season. Mercer boasts an 88.3 PPG with a 14.8 average scoring margin while FSU posts a 66.8 PPG with a -9.8 average scoring margin.
- 1,057** It had been 1,057 days since the Bears had two players record double-doubles in the same game until David Craig and Luis Hurtado Jr. broke the streak on Saturday against Winthrop.

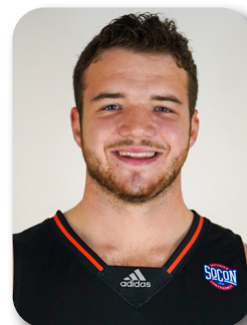

Season Outlook

Despite losing their top three scorers, the Bears still have quality experienced players returning. Senior Kamar Robertson started 17-of-29 games he played in last season and played some of his best basketball at the end of the season in the Southern Conference Tournament. Robertson had a double-double, 16 points and 12 rebounds, in the tournament opener against Western Carolina, and scored 20 points the next game against Furman. For the season, Robertson averaged in double figures scoring 10.5 per game.

Senior James Glisson III is the other returning starter who averaged in doubles figures last season at 10 points per game. Glisson was a starter in 21-31 games he played, scoring a season high 25 points against Georgia State. Post player Shannon Grant returns for his junior season after seeing action in 31 games last year. Against Samford last season, Grant showed what a force he can be inside when he tallied 23 points, shooting 10-14 from the floor, and pulling down 10 rebounds.

Shawn Walker Jr. will be another senior who started 20 games in 2021-22. Local product Jordan Jones who played high school ball at First Presbyterian Day School in Macon, became a fan favorite last season when he stepped in and started 10 games at point guard as a true freshman.

The Transfers

The Bears also welcome four new transfer players for the 2022-23 season: Nana Akenten from Nebraska/Southeast Missouri State University, Jalen Cobb from Fordham, Jalyn McCreary from South Carolina/South Florida and Luis Hurtado Jr. from UAB/Bryant University.

Scouting Florida State

Florida State is led by head coach Leonard Hamilton in his 21st season with the program. The Seminoles were picked to finish fifth in the ACC this year.

The Seminoles proved to be a powerhouse in recent years, competing in the NCAA tournament for five straight years from 2017-21, but seem to have stalled after finishing eighth in the ACC and failing to make the NCAA tournament last season. FSU is currently 0-4 this season with losses to Stetson, UCF, Troy, and Florida.

Coach Hamilton is dealing with a depleted roster, forcing him to play more inexperienced players for increased minutes. Darin Green Jr. and Caleb Mills lead the Seminoles as the only players averaging double figures in scoring.

HAWKINS ARENA

Hawkins Arena was originally opened in 2005 as The University Center and immediately vaulted Mercer to a position among not only the best, but most efficient facilities for any university of its size. The arena facility not only provides a premiere venue for athletics competition – basketball and volleyball – but as serves as a centerpiece for Mercer's vibrant campus life.

The 3,200-seat main arena was renamed Hawkins Arena in the spring of 2012 in response to a \$1 million donation by Macon cardiologist, Dr. Chuck Hawkins, and his wife, Kathy. Hawkins Arena is home to Mercer's men's basketball, women's basketball and women's volleyball teams.

Hawkins Arena served as host to the 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Atlantic Sun Men's and Women's Basketball Tournaments.

The facility is comprised of three main floor levels. The bottom level is home to Mercer's Athletics Department offices and conference rooms. The lower level (arena floor level) houses team/locker rooms for each of Mercer's varsity programs, visiting team and officials locker areas, sports medicine offices and athletics training facilities, as well as an aquatics area. The upper level includes Mercer's ticket office, Board of Trustees meeting room, the President's Dining Room, Bear Market and Heritage Hall.

Adjacent to the arena via the upper level of the facility is a food court and solarium-style eating and congregation area, floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the pool, weight room and exercise rooms, a fitness center, offices for University Center employees and offices for Recreation Sports and Wellness.

Greg Gary

Head Coach ♦ 6th Season Overall ♦ 4th Season at Mercer ♦ Tulane '96

Head coach Greg Gary begins his fourth season leading the Mercer men's program. Gary's squads have recorded 51 wins in his first three seasons; 51 wins in three seasons is the most by any coach in school history.

The Bears have quality experienced players returning. Senior Kamar Robertson started 17-29 games he played in last season and played some of his best basketball at the end of the season in the Southern Conference Tournament. Robertson had a double-double, 16 points and 12 rebounds, in the tournament opener against Western Carolina, and scored 20 points the next game against Furman. For the season, Robertson averaged in double figures scoring 10.5 per game. Senior James Glisson III is the other returning starter who averaged in doubles figures last season at 10 points per game. Glisson was a starter in 21-31 games he played, scoring a season high 25 points against Georgia State. Post player Shannon Grant returns for his junior season after seeing action in 31 games last year. Against Samford last season, Grant showed what a force he can be inside when he tallied 23 points, shooting 10-14 from the floor, and pulling down 10 rebounds. Shawn Walker Jr. will be another senior starter for the Bears after starting 20 games in 2021-22. Of the returners, Walker Jr. is the leading free-throw shooter at 81.1 percent. Local product Jordan Jones, who played high school ball at First Presbyterian Day School in Macon, became a fan favorite last season when he stepped in and started 10 games at point guard as a true freshman. The Bears also welcome four new transfer players for the 2022-23 season: Nana Akenten from Nebraska/Southeast Missouri State University, Jalen Cobb from Fordham, Jalyn McCreary from South Carolina/South Florida and Luis Hurtado Jr. From UAB/Bryant University.

Gary led the Bears to 18 wins in year two and 17 wins in year one. In his second season in charge, he led the Orange & Black to its first Southern Conference championship game since the University joined the conference prior to the start of the 2014-15 academic year. Mercer got off to a hot start in 2020-21 beginning the year 6-0 for the first time since the 1966-67 campaign. In just the second game of the season, the Bears defeated Georgia Tech on the road, 83-73, for the team's first win over a Power Five opponent under Gary's tutelage. In a nationally televised game against Wofford, redshirt senior guard Ross Cummings reached a pair of milestones, scoring his 1000th career point and knocking down his 200th three-pointer. Cummings finished his time with the Orange & Black with 246 career three-pointers, the second-most in program history behind Langston Hall's 257, and 1,244 points, the 16th-best total in Mercer men's hoops history. The Bears entered the Southern Conference tournament led by a pair of All-SoCon selections in Cummings (Second Team Coaches, Third Team Media) and Neftali Alvarez (Third Team Coaches and Media). The seventh-seeded Bears promptly dispatched No. 10 Samford, 87-59, No. 2 Wofford, 61-60, and No. 6 VMI, 73-59, to reach the winner-take-all championship game against UCG. A trio of Bears – Alvarez, Leon Ayers III and Felipe Haase – earned all-tournament honors as Mercer finished as the runner-up. Mercer led the SoCon and finished 11th nationally with 479 total assists, and the Bears concluded the 2020-21 season with an RPI higher than multiple P5 schools including Duke, Georgia, Indiana, Kentucky, Miami, NC State and a host of others.

By virtue of 17 wins in year one, Gary is tied for the most victories by a first-year head coach in Mercer men's basketball program history. His first season in Macon was notable due to several team and individual accomplishments – including a record 30 assists by the Bears in a 106-66 rout of Samford. His nephew, Jeff Gary, tied the Hawkins Arena record for made three-pointers in that same contest with eight. Gary led Mercer to six consecutive Southern Conference victories from January 15 – February 1, 2020, which was the program's longest winning streak since 2017-18. On February 4, the team was named the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week thanks to wins at ETSU and in Hawkins Arena against The Citadel. The Bears were the only team to defeat ETSU on its home floor in 2019-20.



At season's end, Mercer secured the No. 4 seed in the Southern Conference tournament but bowed out to Western Carolina. Three players – Djordje Dimitrijevic, Ethan Stair and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic also earned NABC Second District XXI recognition and was named a Second Team College Sports Information Association of America (CoSIDA) Academic All-America, becoming the first Mercer men's basketball player to accomplish such a feat since Will Emerson in 2006.

Off the court, the Bears earned the NABC's Team Academic Excellence Award, which was given to teams that had a 3.0 GPA or higher for the 2019-20 academic year. Three of Gary's players - Dimitrijevic, Victor Bafutto and Mitch Prendergast - were named to the NABC's Honor Court.

Gary was appointed head coach on March 26, 2019. He was introduced as the program's new leader at a formal introductory press conference on April 3, 2019.

A veteran coach entering his 29th year at the NCAA Division I level, Gary spent the eight seasons prior to his arrival in Macon working under Matt Painter at Purdue University. He helped the Boilermakers reach the NCAA Tournament Elite Eight in 2019 and make back-to-back Sweet 16 appearances in 2017 and 2018.

Gary has made 16 postseason appearances as a college assistant and player, reaching the NCAA Tournament nine times.

His on-court focus for the Boilermakers centered on the development of their wing and post players. Calling Purdue's offensive sets, Gary helped Purdue lead the Big Ten Conference in scoring in two of his last three seasons with the nation's second-most efficient offense. The Boilermakers led the Big Ten in three-point percentage and free throw percentage while ranking second nationally in assists per game during the 2016-17 season.

Gary's guidance was significant in the improvement of Purdue standouts Vincent Edwards, Ryan Cline and Dakota Mathias during the 2016-17 campaign. During that season, Edwards made a jump from the power forward to small forward position and led the team in assists while ranking second on the team in scoring and third in rebounding.

In 2014-15, Gary had a large impact on the development of Mathias, Rapheal Davis, and Kendall Stephens and helped the Boilermakers to the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2012. Gary's tutelage helped Davis become the Big Ten's best defensive player, while also improving his offensive game. In Big Ten games, Davis averaged 12.2 points per game, a 5.3 points per game improvement from the previous season. He also improved his three-point shooting 13.2 percent from his freshman to his junior year.

In 2012-13, Gary oversaw an influx of youth in the Boilermaker frontcourt and helped guide center A.J. Hammons through one of the finest freshman seasons in program history. Hammons earned Big Ten All-Freshman Team honors after finishing the season with averages of 10.6 points, 6.0 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game. He led the Big Ten with an average of 2.3 blocks per contest in league play, and wrapped up the campaign ranked second on Purdue's freshman charts in blocks (67), third in rebounds (204) and sixth in points (359).

After graduating from Anderson Highland High School in 1988 and spending a year at Aquinas College in Nashville, Tenn., Gary transferred to Tulane. He was a vital component in the revitalization of a program that was dropped in 1985 and reinstated in 1988, leading the Green Wave to the 1992 NCAA Tournament as a senior. Despite playing only three seasons in New Orleans, Gary finished his career as Tulane's all-time leader in assists and now ranks fifth (370). He is second in career assist-to-turnover ratio (1.97).

Gary and his teammates, including assistant coach Kim Lewis from the 1991-92 Green Wave team, the first in program history to make the NCAA Tournament, were inducted into the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame in April of 2020.

A native of Anderson, Indiana, Gary was born on February 14, 1970. Gary earned a B.S. in sport management from Tulane in 1992. He and his wife, Claudia, have four daughters, Gabrielle, Logan, Alexandra and Brooklyn, and one son, Nash.



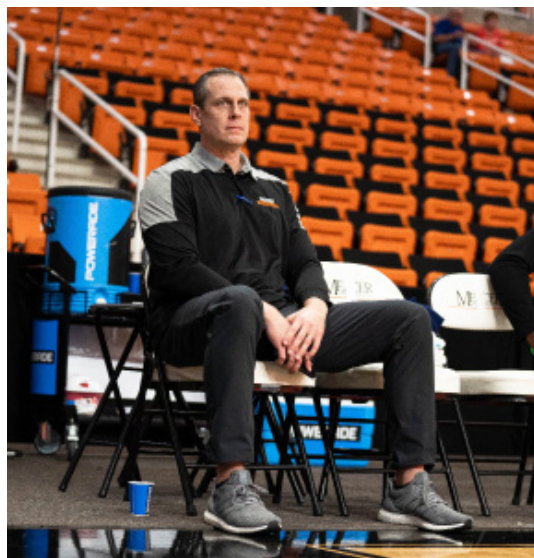
Bobby Kummer

Assistant Coach ♦ 4th Season at Mercer ♦ Charlotte '96

Bobby Kummer was hired as an assistant coach on Greg Gary's staff on April 17, 2019 and will begin year three with the Mercer Bears and his 26th season at the NCAA Division I level for the 2021-22 season.

Kummer mentored the Mercer big men throughout the 2020-21 season, which ended with an appearance in the Southern Conference championship game. Mercer started the year 6-0 for the first time since 1966-67 and upset Georgia Tech on the road, 83-73. Kummer was responsible, in large part for the development of forward Felipe Haase, who played his first season in a Mercer uniform in '20-21. Haase was instrumental in Mercer's quick start, reaching double figures in four of the Bears' six wins and recording his first double-double in a narrow win at Georgia Southern

on Dec. 16. Haase shot 5-of-7 from the floor in the win over the Eagles and pulled down a career-high 16 boards. Haase and fellow big man James Glisson III utilized Kummer's instruction in a big way when Mercer made its run through the SoCon tournament. Haase averaged 11.9 points and a team-best 7.9 boards over the course of the season but increased his averages to 14.5 points and 10.5 boards during Mercer's four tournament games, earning All-SoCon Tournament honors. Glisson III started the final 13 games of the season and provided a major spark in the Southern Conference championship, going 7-of-8 from the floor and 2-of-2 at the charity stripe, tying his season-high of 16 points and finishing one rebound shy of a double-double.



In year one as an assistant coach under Gary, Kummer was instrumental in helping the team win 17 games overall and 11 in the Southern Conference en route to securing the No. 4 seed for the league tournament. The Detroit, Mich. native was a driving force behind Mercer's six-game winning streak from January 15 – February 1, 2020 which garnered the squad National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week honors on February 4. Under Kummer's mentorship, three players – Ethan Stair, Djordje Dimitrijevic and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic was also recognized by the NABC as a Second Team All-District XXI selection and a College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Second Team Academic All-America

Prior to Mercer, Kummer was on staff at Lamar for five years, the last three of which he held the title of associate head coach. He helped turn the Cardinals' program from a Southland Conference bottom feeder to a conference title contender in a short span. After winning a total of seven games in the two seasons prior to his arrival, Lamar won 19-plus games in each of his last three seasons.

Before arriving at Lamar, Kummer spent four seasons at Appalachian State, including three as the Mountaineers' associate head coach. Kummer also spent time as an assistant coach at his alma mater, Charlotte, and Texas A&M. His coaching career began in 1996 at Charlotte, where he helped the

49ers reach two NCAA Tournaments. After his time at Texas A&M, Kummer returned to Charlotte for six seasons.

An accomplished recruiter, Kummer has helped coach 20-plus all-conference selections, two conference players of the year, two conference defensive players of the year and two conference freshmen of the year and has been instrumental in signing five top-20 recruiting classes, of which nearly 40 players have gone on to sign professional contracts.

A two-time team captain at Charlotte, Kummer guided the 49ers to a 1995 Metro Conference title and a trip to the 1995 NCAA Tournament. He graduated from Charlotte in 1996.

Kim Lewis

Assistant Coach ♦ 4th Season at Mercer ♦ Tulane '94

Kim Lewis will begin his fourth season as an assistant coach at Mercer for the 2022-23 season, which will be his 22nd at the NCAA Division I level. He was hired on April 17, 2019.

Lewis helped the Bears go 18-11 overall in his second season under Gary and advance to the SoCon championship game for the first time since the University joined the league in 2014-15. The Bears began the season with a bang, starting 6-0, which included an 83-73 win at Georgia Tech, for their best start since 1966-67. Lewis worked primarily with the guards and played a vital role in the development of redshirt sophomore guard Neftali Alvarez. In his first season with the Orange & Black, Alvarez led the team with 13.3 points and 4.2 assists per game. He dished out 113 assists, the second-highest total in the Southern Conference, which placed him 69th nationally. As a team, the Bears led the conference and were 11th among all NCAA Division I schools with 479 total helpers. Under Lewis' guidance, Ross Cummings reached 1,000 career points and 200 made three-pointers, reaching both milestones in a December game against Wofford on national TV. Cummings ended his career with 246 three-pointers, second only to Langston Hall's 257, and 1,244 points, which placed him 16th all-time. Cummings and Alvarez both earned All-SoCon honors at the end of the regular season. At the end of the conference tournament, two of Lewis' mentees – Alvarez and Leon Ayers III – were named to the All-SoCon Tournament team.



Lewis played a pivotal role in Mercer's 17 wins in 2019-20, including six consecutive from January 15 – February 1, 2020, which helped Mercer earn National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) Division I Team of the Week honors on February 4. The Bears won 11 Southern Conference contests and locked up the No. 4 seed for the league tournament before bowing out in the quarterfinals. Three players – Djordje Dimitrijevic, Ethan Stair and Kamar Robertson – earned All-SoCon honors. Dimitrijevic was also honored by the NABC as a Second Team All-District XXI selection and a College Sports Information Directors of America (CoSIDA) Second Team Academic All-American.

Prior to Mercer, Lewis served on Richmond's staff from 2011-19 with the last seven being as an assistant coach. The Spiders won 19-plus games in four different seasons during Lewis' tenure, including 22 in 2016-17 when they made a run to the NIT semifinals.

Before Richmond, Lewis was at Texas A&M - Corpus Christi where he spent one season as an assistant coach under his former Tulane coach Perry Clark. Lewis had two stints as an assistant coach at Tulane (2008-10 and 1997-99), spent two seasons at Duquesne (2006-08) and coached NBA Champions Linton Johnson at Tulane and Jose Barea at Northeastern. He also coached at Xavier University of Louisiana, McNeese State and Northeastern. He began his career at Tulane as a volunteer assistant coach for the 1996-97 season.

Lewis was the Metro Conference Freshman of the Year at Tulane in 1990-91. He set the Tulane career record for steals (242) and is third in games played (125). In

125 games, Lewis scored 1,384 points, the 12th most in program history.

As a sophomore, Lewis led the Green Wave in scoring with 15.4 points a game, helping the school to its first conference crown and its first-ever berth in the NCAA Tournament which included a first round victory over St. John's and a No. 14 national ranking. In April 2020, he was selected to the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame as a member of that 1991-92 squad.

After advancing to the NIT as a junior, the Green Wave returned to the NCAA Tournament his senior season with a 23-10 record. In November 2014, Lewis was enshrined in the Tulane Athletics Hall of Fame for his individual accomplishments.

He won a championship at every level of his playing career from Varnado High School in Angie, La., to Tulane where he won a conference championship in 1991-92 to the professional leagues with Grindavik in Iceland, winning the Mjorir Cup and earning MVP honors.

DJ Byrd

Assistant Coach ♦ 4th Season at Mercer ♦ Purdue '13

The 2021-22 season is D.J. Byrd's third season as part of the Mercer Bears men's basketball program and second as an assistant coach.

Byrd was elevated to assistant coach from Director of Basketball Operations in late July 2020.

In his first season as an assistant coach, Byrd helped Mercer make its first trip to the Southern Conference title game. The Bears finished 18-11 overall after jumping out to a 6-0 start for the first time since 1966-67, and in the former Purdue standout's second game as an assistant coach, Mercer topped Georgia Tech, 83-73, on the road. Byrd mentored Mercer's guards and helped Neftali Alvarez lead the team in both points (13.3) and assists (4.2) per game. Alvarez's 113 assists ranked second in the SoCon and 69th nationally, and as a team, the Bears finished the season 11th overall with 479 assists. Guard Ross Cummings also reached a pair of milestones, surpassing 1,000 points and 200 made three-pointers. He finished the season with 1,244 points, the 16th-highest total in program history, and 246 three-pointers. Cummings ended his time with the Bears only 11 treys away from surpassing Langston Hall's school record. Both Alvarez and Cummings were All-SoCon selections, while Alvarez and another guard that Byrd guided, Leon Ayers III, landed a spot on the conference's all-tournament team.

The Crawfordsville, Ind. native spent the 2019-20 as DOBO and was in charge of all logistical aspects of the program including but not limited to travel arrangements, practice schedules, overseeing all undergraduate and graduate managers and ensuring that team needs were met.

Byrd spent the 2017-19 seasons as a graduate assistant for the 2019 NABC National Coach of the Year, Matt Painter, at Purdue University. The Boilermakers won the 2019 regular season Big Ten Championship and had the school's first NCAA Tournament Elite Eight appearance since the 1999-2000 season.

Before joining Purdue as a graduate assistant, Byrd was the JV basketball coach and varsity assistant at Franklin Community High School from 2015-2017. He aided coach Brad Dickey and staff to back-to-back (2016, 2017) Mid-State Conference Championships and helped the team win the conference title outright (2017) for the first time since the 1986-1987 season.

During that same time at Franklin, he owned & operated RIMROC Basketball, an organization that provides Indiana youth with training opportunities, league games, tournaments and team camps. He also was the Director of Operations of Robbie Hummel Basketball Camps (2017, 2018) as well as Dakota Mathias Basketball Camps (2018).

Byrd returned to his alma-mater, North Montgomery High School, as a volunteer assistant coach for the 2014-2015 season. There he helped coach Joel Grindle and staff to a Montgomery County Championship and Sugar Creek Classic Championship. Byrd was able to coach his cousin, Grant Gayler, who earned a scholarship to play at Bethel College.

As a player, Byrd played the 2013-2014 season professionally in Germany with the Kirchheim Knights in the Pro A League.

A former standout on the hardwood at Purdue, Byrd played in 130 career games, scoring 890 points and making 195 three-pointers, the ninth-most in a career in school history. Byrd was the Big Ten's Sixth Man of the Year in 2012 and helped lead Purdue to three NCAA Tournaments as a player (2010, 2011, 2012). In 2010, Purdue won the regular season Big Ten Championship and went to the Sweet Sixteen before falling to the eventual NCAA National Champion Duke Blue Devils.

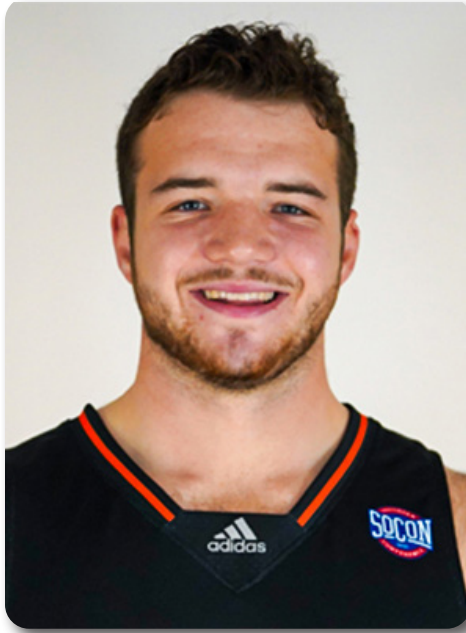
