SEMINOLES FACE NEBRASKA IN FINAL ROUND OF ESPN EVENTS INVITATIONAL

Florida State plays in third and final game in the ESPN Events Invitational as it faces Nebraska in the State Farm Field House in Lake Buena Vista, Fla., on Sunday, November 27, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. The Seminoles' game against the Cornhuskers is the third game in a series with began during the 2005-06 season and is tied at one game each. The game marks the second meeting on a neutral court and the third in the state of Florida. The Seminoles gained their first win in the series with a 74-60 win over Nebraska at the Orange Bowl Classic in Sunrise, Fla. on December 31, 2005. The second game of the series was in Tallahassee in the 2014 ACC / Big Ten Challenge. Following Sunday's game against Nebraska, the Seminoles play host to Purdue in the ACC Big Ten Challenge presented by Continental Tire at home in the Donald L. Tucker Center on November 30, 2022 at 7:15 p.m.

FLORIDA STATE VS. NEBRASKA - CONNECTIONS

Florida State faces Nebraska in the ESPN Events Invitational at Disney on November 27, 2022 at the State Farm Field House. The Seminoles and the Cornhuskers have played twice, with both teams winning once. Nebraska is led by Fred Hoiberg, who is in his fourth season as the Cornhuskers' Head coach. He has never coached against Florida State. As a player at Iowa State (1992-95), Hoiberg faced the Seminoles once – he scored 15 points with two steals in a 109-96 Seminole win over the Cyclones at the Tallahassee Leon County Civic Center on November 20, 1992.

HAMILTON IS THE FIFTH WINNINGEST COACH IN ACC HISTORY

Seminole Head Coach Leonard Hamilton is the fifth winningest coach in ACC history with 396 career wins and ranked fifth in ACC history with 177 career ACC wins at Florida State.

HAMILTON APPROACHING ACC MILESTONE

Florida State Head Coach Leonard Hamilton enters the 2022 ESPN Events Invitational with 396 career wins as the Seminoles' Head Coach in the ACC. He is just four wins shy of becoming the fifth coach in ACC history with 400 or more wins as a coach in the nation's top conference for basketball. Hamilton is looking to join a select group that consists of Mike Krzyzewski, Duke (1,129 wins), Dean Smith of North Carolina (879 wins), Roy Williams of North Carolina (485 wins) and Gary Williams of Maryland (461 wins).

HAMILTON PRESENTED WITH PRESTIGIOUS JOE LAPCHICK AWARD IN NEW YORK CITY

Florida State men's basketball coach Leonard Hamilton received the Joe Lapchick Character Award presented by the Joe Lapchick Foundation during a ceremony at the New York Athletic Club on September 16, 2022. Hamilton was honored with the award which celebrates the life and career of Joe Lapchick, a Hall of Fame coach at St. John's University (1936-47) and the New York Knicks (1947-56), who was well known for his compassion and integrity off the court. The award is given to coaches who exhibit honorable character and who have impacted the game of basketball as did Lapchick. Hamilton is just the fifth head coach from the ACC to earn the award. He joins Georgia Tech's Bobby Cremins, Virginia's Pete Gillen, Duke's Mike Krzyzewski, and North Carolina's Dean Smith as Lapchick Award winners from the nation's top college basketball conference.

CLEVELAND NAMED TO JULIUS ERVING AWARD WATCH LIST

Florida State's Matthew Cleveland has been named to the Julius Erving Watch List as the nation's top collegiate small forward by the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame. It marks the second consecutive season Cleveland has been named to the initial watch list for the prestigious Julius Erving Award. Cleveland is one of three players from the ACC named to the Julius Erving Watch List. He is joined on the list by Dariq Whitehead of Duke and Leaky Black of North Carolina. The award is named for Julius Erving, who attended the University of Massachusetts (1969-71). He averaged 26.3 points and 20.2 rebounds per game, making him one of only six NCAA men's basketball players to average more than 20 points and 20 rebounds per game during his career.

Florida State has earned 21 steals in its first two games of the ESPN Events Invitational - 11 against Siena and 10 against Stanford. Junior Cam'Ron Fletcher leads the Florida State with seven steals (five against Siena and two against Stanford) and Caleb Mills (four against Stanford and two against Siena) has six steals in the two games on the State Farm Field House court. A total of seven different Seminoles have at least one steal in the first two games of the ESPN Events Invitational.

Fletcher is on the best streak of his career in the last three games against Mercer (three of three), Siena (two of four) and Stanford (three of seven) as he is shooting .571 from the bonusphere (eight of 14) in the games this week.

Junior Cam'Ron Fletcher has led the Seminoles in rebounds in both of Florida State's games in the ESPN Events Invitational (six against Siena and five against Stanford). He has led, or been tied for the Florida State team lead in rebounds, in five of its first seven games of the season. Fletcher enters Sunday's game against Nebraska averaging a career-high 7.1 rebounds per game with 10 coming against Troy and nine against Stetson.

Junior Cam'Ron Fletcher has seven steals in the first two games of the ESPN Events Invitational and enters Sunday's game against Nebraska with nine steals in the first seven games of the season for a career-high of 1.7 spg. He entered his third collegiate season with 32 steals in his fist 38 career games for an average of 0.8 steals per game. Fletcher has 36 steals in his first 36 games at Florida State.

MILLS AS FLORIDA STATE'S CHIEF THIEF

Junior Caleb Mills enters Sunday's game against Nebraska as Florida State's leader in steals with 17 steals in the first seven games of the season (2.4 spg). With four steals against Stanford on Friday, Mills surpassed his total for the entire 2019-20 season (16 steals in 31 games). Mills has 56 steals in 33 games as a Seminole (1.7spg) after earning 21 steals in 35 games in his first two seasons at Houston.

FLORIDA STATE VS. NEBRASKA - THE LAST MEETING

Terran Pettaway scored 25 points and Shavon Shields added 21 as Nebraska defeated Florida State by a 70-65 margin in the ACC / Big Ten Challenge at the Donald L. Tucker Center in Tallahassee on December 1, 2014. Nebraska took a 37-21 halftime lead and held off the fast-charging Seminoles to gain the win. The Seminoles outscored the Cornhuskers by a 44-33 margin in the second half as they worked to get back into the game. Xavier Rathan-Mayes scored a team-high 17 points for the Seminoles. Aaron Thomas added 11 and Boris Bojanovsky scored 10 for the Seminoles who fell to 3-4. Bojanovksy recorded a double double with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Florida State fell despite outrebounding Nebraska by a 41-30 margin. Nebraska made seven 3-point field goals (including five in the first half) as compared to Florida State's 2-18 mark from long range.

FSU Guard Darin Green Finds Success On The Basketball Court

Darin Green's love for basketball came at an early age.

It was hard not to, growing up in a basketball family with both parents having played the sport: Mom in high school and Dad at George Washington University.

His father first put a basketball in his 3-year-old son's hands and eventually taught him how to shoot.

"He played guard as well, but he was more an athlete — a slasher and dunker — who could get above the rim," said Green. "He got hurt and that's when he learned to shoot, so he taught me to shoot early on because he knew that would last longer than your athleticism."

Those shooting skills have helped Green Jr. as he's made his way from high school to college.

Green transferred to Florida State after spending three seasons at UCF, averaging 11.6 points in 82 games for the Knights. The 6-foot-4 guard shot

"It just felt like home," Green said of the decision to transfer to FSU. "They preach the same things my parents preach. The discipline part of this program and the attention to detail. The ability to come off ball screens and show I can do more than just shoot."

It's been a challenging start for Florida State (0-3), which lost its first three games for the first time since 2000-01. A loss to Florida (2-1) on Friday would be the worst start by a Seminoles team since 1959-60.

Injuries and a suspension have reduced FSU's lineup to seven scholarship players, led by Green, averaging 16.3 points and 35.5 minutes per game. It's not an ideal situation, admits coach Leonard Hamilton, who has been forced to lean on the transfer guard more than anticipated.

"It is almost virtually impossible to play 36 minutes a game and live with it," said Hamilton. "But we're doing what we have to do to compete at this level."

Hamilton believes the last time a Seminoles player averaged 36 minutes was Toney Douglas, the former guard who logged 36.5 minutes in 2008-09.

"That's almost abusive, and it might get me arrested," he joked. "My point is that's not healthy, but that's where we are right now."

The extra minutes haven't bothered Green, who is willing to do whatever it takes to help the Seminoles win. "If I've got to play 36 minutes or if I've got to play three minutes, I'll do whatever coach asks, at least to the best of my ability," said Green. "I'm not focused on how long I've had to play. I don't get tired out there, so I didn't notice it was 36 minutes until after."

Green isn't the only one playing significantly more minutes because of the short bench, with the remaining four starters averaging 29 minutes. Hamilton hopes help will be on the way as center Naheem McLeod (ankle), forward Baba Miller (16-game suspension) and De'Ante Green (knee) and guards Chandler Jackson (broken thumb) and Jeremiah Bembry (undisclosed injury) return.

Meanwhile, Hamilton wants the team to be more efficient, especially on the offensive end. He would like to see the Seminoles pass the ball around more, creating open shots for Green

"We've got to make sure that we find ways to get him the looks that allow him to utilize his skills and talents," said Hamilton.

That was on display against Troy on Monday when Green connected on 7 of 9 3-pointers (78%) on his way to a season-high 24 points.

As one of a handful of veterans on the roster, Green also has been a crucial voice in the locker room and court, especially with a lineup featuring seven freshmen.

"Coaches have been harping on me to become a leader on and off the court," he said. "In study hall, in class, in apartments and also here in practice or the film room."

That leadership role is something else he can trace back to his upbringing. His parents stressed the importance of academics, rewarding him for working hard in the classroom.

"I got to meet [Golden State Warriors guard] Stephen Curry off my success in the classroom," Green recalled. "In sixth grade, my dad told me that if I got straight A's, he would take me to a Golden State Warriors game. So I did and I got to meet, Steph. He told me how hard work pays off and some shooting things he does."


